### Opener Turns Into Sack Party

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Kyle Shurmur threw for 170 yards and two touchdowns as Vanderbilt routed Middle Tennessee 35-7 in the season opener for both teams.

Dayo Odeyingbo returned a fumble 3 yards for a TD, and Khari Blasingame also ran for a score as the Commodores won their second straight opener at Middle Tennessee's expense. They also wrapped a four-game contract with their fourth straight victory against the Conference USA school less than 40 miles away.

The Commodores had six sacks and forced two turnovers.

With a pair of senior quarterbacks starting, this was expected to be a showdown through the air. Vanderbilt stuck to the ground on its opening touchdown drive, and Shurmur had just 28 yards passing in the first half compared to Brent Stockstill who hit 10 of his first 12 passes for 100 yards in the first quarter alone.

Stockstill had only 78 yards passing in the second half.

Shurmur put Vanderbilt up 21-7 midway through the third quarter with a 17-yard TD pass to Chris Pierce on his first career reception. Shurmur set up the TD with a perfect 49-yard pass to Donaven Tennyson two plays earlier, and he hit Kalija Lipscomb on a 28-yarder in the fourth quarter for a 28-7 lead.

Vanderbilt led 7-0 in the first quarter when the Commodores lost one of its best defenders and its second safety for the game. Review showed LaDarius Wiley lowered his helmet and popped off Middle Tennessee running back Tavares Thomas' helmet at the end of a run. Wiley was ejected, with Zaire Jones already suspended over an arrest Aug. 23.

The penalty kept Middle Tennessee's drive alive, and Stockstill finished off a 93-yard drive with a 4-yard TD pass to C.J. Windham tying it at 7-7 late in the first quarter.

### Dores Blast Nevada

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Vanderbilt overcame two early red-zone disappointments and bottled up a high-scoring Nevada offense, winning a critical early-season nonconference game 41-10 with a dominant second-half performance.

Carrying on from the opener against Middle Tennessee, the Commodores (2-0) were rock-solid defensively from the start, holding the Wolf Pack to 124 yards in the first half and 250 overall, a week after coach Jay Norvell's team scored 72 points on 636 yards against Portland State.

But Vanderbilt's failure to score on two promising drives into the red zone to start the game allowed the visitors from the Mountain West Conference to keep things close, tightening the score to 17-10 on a 9-yard Ty Gangi pass to Brendan O'Leary-Orange in the final minute of the first half.

Nevada (1-1) never closed the gap, though, going three-and-out to start the third quarter. Vanderbilt responded with an impressive 11-play, 77-yard drive, draining 6:17 off the clock, ending with a 25-yard Ryley Guay field goal.

In contrast to the game's start, Vanderbilt scored on three straight drives to open the second half with a 46-yard dash from the speedy Ke'Shawn Vaughn and Kalija Lipscomb's second touchdown catch of the day from Kyle Shurmur following Guay's kick, stretching a one-touchdown lead to a 24-point margin.

Shurmur finished 23 for 32 for 258 yards passing with no interceptions for the second straight week. Senior linebacker Josh Smith finished with 10 tackles, three for loss, in a standout defensive performance for Vanderbilt.

### Late Rally Falls Short

**NOTRE DAME, Ind.** - Jalen Elliott knocked the ball loose from Vanderbilt receiver Kalija Lipscomb with 1:07 remaining to give Notre Dame a fourth-down stop and No. 8 Notre Dame held on for a 22-17 victory over the Commodores.

Kyle Shurmur threw for 326 yards and one touchdown for Vanderbilt (2-1), rallying his team back from a 16-3 halftime deficit. His fourth-and-4 pass from the Notre Dame 31 to Lipscomb, who caught a game-high 11 passes, was nicely thrown and the receiver almost made a reaching catch at the 11. But the safety Elliott, with some help from the ground, knocked the ball loose and incomplete.

Tony Jones Jr. finished with 118 yards on 17 carries for Notre Dame (3-0). He also caught two passes from quarterback Brandon Wimbush for 56 yards.

Wimbush, who had 297 passing yards but three interceptions in the 24-16 victory against Ball State, threw for 122 yards and added 84 yards on the ground, including a 13-yard scramble for a touchdown as Notre Dame took an early 10-0 lead late in the first quarter. But despite a 2-yard TD pass from backup quarterback Ian Book to tight end Nic Weishar early in the fourth quarter for a 22-10 lead, the Irish struggled over the last three quarters and had to hold on.

Vanderbilt finished with 420 yards to 380 for the Irish, who did not turn the ball over but got three from the Commodores.

The Commodores couldn't get anything on the ground early against the defense coordinated by Clark Lea, a former Vanderbilt fullback. They rushed for minus 1 yard on their first eight carries before Ke'Shawn Vaughn ripped off an 18-yard run with 7:33 left before half and finished with 27 yards on 11 carries in the first half that Notre Dame led 16-3. They finished with 94 rushing yards on 27 carries.

## Home Stumble

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Jake Bentley threw for 261 yards and a touchdown, and the South Carolina Gamecocks bounced back from their hurricane-forced break to defeat Vanderbilt 37-14.

South Carolina (2-1, 1-1 Southeastern Conference) had its game against Marshall canceled by Hurricane Florence, leaving the Gamecocks looking for a 12th game this season. The Gamecocks hadn't played since being routed 41-17 by now-No. 2 Georgia on Sept. 8.

They showed no rust as South Carolina won its 10th straight and 17th in the last 19 years against Vanderbilt.

The Gamecocks scored the game's first 10 points and then reeled off 20 straight after Vanderbilt got within 17-14 late in the first half. South Carolina could have had a bigger margin of victory but lost two fumbles inside the Vandy 30 in the fourth quarter after a 39-minute lightning and rain delay.

Rico Dowdle ran for a TD and 112 yards, and Mon Denson and Ty'Son Williams each ran for touchdowns. Parker White kicked three field goals for South Carolina.

Vanderbilt (2-2, 0-1) felt pretty confident coming into its SEC opener after coming up just short in a 22-17 loss at No. 8 Notre Dame last week. The Commodores couldn't match Bentley and the Gamecocks who outgained them 149-32 in the first quarter and finished 534-284 in total offense.

Ke'Shawn Vaughn scored on a 2-yard TD run after an interception. Kyle Shurmur added a 2-yard TD pass for Vanderbilt. The Commodores struggled with snapping the ball and even switched right guard Bruno Reagan over to center late. It didn't help with a bad snap on third down and Vanderbilt trying to chip away at the Gamecocks' lead late.

The Commodores got a big defensive wakeup call. They came in ranked 15th nationally giving up just 13 points a game, and Vanderbilt had given up only six points in the second half this season. The defense came through with its biggest play with Dare Odeyingbo's first career interception at the end of the first quarter. But the Commodores gave up 10 points in the third quarter to South Carolina

### Survive and Move On

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Vanderbilt survived a strong effort from crosstown foe Tennessee State, notching a 31-27 home win against the Tigers.

Sparked by a pair of Power 5 transfers in quarterback Demry Croft and wide receiver Treon Harris, the Tigers (2-1) rode their pass-happy offense and played opportunistic defense for a 13-10 halftime lead.

Vanderbilt responded with two rapid-fire touchdowns -- a 38-yard pass from Kyle Shurmur to Kalija Lipscomb and a weaving 78-yard run by Ke'Shawn Vaughn -- in the first six minutes of the second half and looked to be salting away the win. But TSU refused to go quietly, charging back and putting the game in doubt until Croft, a Minnesota transfer, threw incomplete on fourth down, turning the ball over on downs with 1:25 remaining in the game.

### Georgia Gets by Vandy

**ATHENS, Ga.** - Georgia found paydirt on three consecutive possessions, breaking open a once eight-point game as the No. 2 Bulldogs defeated Vanderbilt, 41-13, in front of 92,746 spectators at Sanford Stadium.

The Commodores (3-3, 0-2 SEC) jumped ahead 3-0 on a 25-yard field goal from Ryley Guay but surrendered the lead on Georgia's (6-0, 4-0 SEC) next offensive snap when Jake Fromm connected with Terry Godwin on a 75-yard touchdown pass.

Trailing 7-3 early in the second quarter, Vanderbilt elected to go for it on 4th-and-1 at the Georgia 14-yard line but Khari Blasingame was tackled for no gain. The Bulldogs went on to outscore the Commodores, 34-10 the remainder of the contest.

Quarterback Kyle Shurmur surpassed 7,000 career passing yards, completing 14-of-28 passes for 169 yards. Ke'Shawn Vaughn led the Commodores with 79 rushing yards on nine carries. C.J. Bolar was the leading wideout, catching four passes for 46 yards.

Backup Mo Hasan led the Commodores on a 7-play, 53-yard drive which was capped by a 2-yard score from Josh Crawford with two seconds remaining.

Fromm continued his stellar season, connecting with seven receivers while throwing for 276 yards on 17-of-23 passing, including three touchdowns. Georgia's offense piled up 560 yards of total offense including 341 through the air.

The Gators (6-1, 4-1 Southeastern Conference) scored 24 straight points after Vanderbilt jumped out to a 21-3 lead midway through the second quarter.

With the comeback, Florida won its fifth straight game of the season. The Gators also topped Vanderbilt (3-4, 0-3) for the fifth straight year.

Vanderbilt turned three turnovers into 17 points, and the Commodores also sacked Feleipe Franks twice and stripped him of the ball once. They also intercepted Franks once. Kyle Shurmur threw two touchdowns with his father, New York Giants coach Pat Shurmur, in the stands. Jamauri Wakefield also ran for a TD.

Scarlett finished with 113 yards rushing, and Lamical Perine added a TD run and 121 yards rushing. Franks threw for 284 yards and two touchdowns. His second, an 11-yarder to Freddie Swain, padded the lead midway through the fourth quarter to seal the comeback.

The Commodores fell to 0-3 in SEC play. It didn't help that they lost running back Ke'Shawn Vaughn early in the second quarter to an unspecified injury. Vaughn finished with one catch for 75 yards and a TD, and he ran seven times for 56 yards before being hurt.

## Vaughn Runs Wild in Fayetteville

**FAYETTEVILLE, Ark.** - Vanderbilt used a balanced attack offensively and a tremendous effort from running back Ke'Shawn Vaughn to snap its three-game losing streak and take down Arkansas 45-31 at Reynolds Razorback Stadium.

Vaughn set a season high for a Vandy rusher, carrying the ball 26 times for 172 yards and a career-high three scores. The final touchdown came from three yards out and helped lift Vandy's lead to 14 points with under five minutes remaining.

The victory was the Commodores first in Southeastern Conference action and moved the squad to 4-5 overall. The Razorbacks fell to 2-7 overall and 0-5 in the SEC. All three of Vanderbilt's wins against the Hogs have come on the road.

Quarterback Kyle Shurmur, who reached 2,000 career passing yards for a third consecutive season, threw for 192 yards on 13-of-19 passing and three touchdowns, including a pair to Jared Pinkney. The tight end hauled in a team-leading five receptions for 93 yards.

Vanderbilt found paydirt on three of its first five drives. The offense countered Arkansas' output throughout and with under four minutes to play, defensive lineman Louis Vecchio sealed the win by picking off quarterback Ty Storey.

The Commodores scored on their fourth consecutive possession following the turnover as Khari Blasingame punched it in from five yards out. Vanderbilt rushed for 250 yards on the day, averaging 5.1 yards per carry.

The Vanderbilt offense produced 442 total yards on 68 plays.

It also marked Vanderbilt's first SEC road victory since they defeated Tennessee in Neyland Stadium to conclude the 2018 regular season.

### Late Lead Gets Away

**COLUMBIA, Mo.** - Missouri's defense bent but didn't break during Vanderbilt's final drive, and the Tigers defeated the Commodores 33-28 to clinch bowl eligibility.

Missouri kicker Tucker McCann had a chance to ice the game with 1:48 remaining, but the junior missed a 31-yard field goal to give Vanderbilt a last chance. The Commodores drove down to Missouri's 25-yard line, but couldn't convert a last-second heave to win the game.

Junior Ke'Shawn Vaughn was superb for the Commodores, rushing for 182 yards and one touchdown on 15 carries, good for 12.1 yards per carry. The performance follows on the heels of a 172-yard rushing effort at Arkansas in Vanderbilt's last outing.

Vanderbilt had led all game until Missouri running backs Damarea Crockett and Larry Rountree III fueled a 99-yard drive to start the fourth quarter. The Tigers trekked down the field for a 14-play drive that lasted 5:38. Quarterback Drew Lock trotted three yards into the endzone to give Missouri its first lead of the game, 33-28, with 9:18 remaining.

Vanderbilt quarterback Kyle Shurmur outplayed Lock for the majority of the game. Shurmur tossed for 249 yards and three touchdowns on 24-for-35 passing. Lock, a former Heisman hopeful, passed for 253 yards, two touchdowns and two interceptions on 22-for-33 passing.

Crockett bolted for 122 yards and a touchdown on 22 carries and Rountree added 92 yards on 21 rushes.

Vanderbilt quarterback Kyle Shurmur was 24 of 35 for 249 yards. He connected with wide receiver Kalija Lipscomb and tight end Jared Pinkney for 99 yards and 88 yards, respectively.

## Home Thriller in Overtime

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Kyle Shurmur hit Kalija Lipscomb with a 5-yard touchdown pass in overtime, and the Vanderbilt Commodores edged Mississippi 36-29 to keep their bowl hopes alive for another week.

Vandy scored first, and an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty on Lipscomb for tossing the ball in the air after his TD gave Ole Miss the ball at the 12. Three plays later, review overturned Jordan Ta'amu's 8-yard TD pass to A.J. Brown, ruling that Brown did not maintain possession.

On fourth down, Joejuan Williams helped break up the throw to DaMarkus Lodge at the left pylon after a defensive change.

Vanderbilt (5-6, 2-5 Southeastern Conference) trailed 13-0 early in the second quarter and rallied by scoring 19 straight points to beat Ole Miss for the second time in three years. The game featured three ties in the second half, and Luke Logan's fifth field goal from 32 yards with 40 seconds left for Ole Miss set up overtime.

Shurmur's game-winning TD was his third of the game and set Vandy's career record with 60 passing Jay Cutler.

Ke'Shawn Vaughn ran for 127 yards and a TD. Williams and LaDarius Wiley each had an interception in the fourth quarter, and Dayo Odeyingbo had two of Vanderbilt's three sacks.

Ole Miss (5-6, 1-6) lost its fourth straight despite outgaining Vandy 578-387 in total offense. Ta'amu had a career-high 457 yards passing and two TDs, and Brown finished with a season-high 212 yards and a TD.

Ole Miss appeared in total control after Brown took a pass 84 yards for a TD and a 13-0 lead. At that point, Ole Miss had outgained Vandy 271-73.

Max Worship blocked a Mac Brown punt through the end zone for a safety that Mason said changed the momentum, and the Commodores drove 53 yards off the following kick.

Shurmur hit Lipscomb with a 2-yard TD pass with 62 seconds left in the first half to pull Vandy within 13-12. Vaughn capped the opening drive of the third quarter with a 1-yard TD run for Vandy's first lead of the game at 19-13.

## Third Straight Over Vols

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - Kyle Shurmur completed his first 15 passes and finished with 367 yards and three touchdowns as the Vanderbilt Commodores routed in-state rival Tennessee 38-13 to become bowl eligible for the second time in three seasons.

Vanderbilt (6-6, 3-5 Southeastern Conference) also won its third straight over Tennessee, something the Commodores hadn't managed since a six-game streak that ended in 1926. Head coach Derek Mason beat three different Tennessee coaches in each of the last three seasons, and Vanderbilt has beaten four Vols coaches winning five of the last seven.

Tennessee (5-7, 2-6) sacked Shurmur three times. That didn't stop Vanderbilt from simply dominating the Vols, outgaining them 467-242 in total offense and holding the ball for more than 43 minutes.

Shurmur saves his best each season for the Vols. He threw for a career-high 416 yards in 2016 and four TD passes in last season's win. In his final game at Vanderbilt Stadium, Shurmur put on a show with his first incompletion coming with 56 seconds left in the first half. He finished 31 of 35 completing passes to nine different receivers with TD passes of 17 yards to Jared Pinkney, 26 yards to freshman Amir Abdur-Rahman and Cody Markel. Wide receiver Kalija Lipscomb and Khari Blasingame each ran for TDs, and Ryley Guay added a 43-yard field goal for the Commodores.

Tennessee played without starting right guard Nathan Niehaus, who didn't dress for the game, and lost left guard Jahmir Johnson late in the final seconds of the first half for targeting. Review showed Johnson hit Vanderbilt safety LaDarius Wiley in the head after an interception by Commodores safety Frank Coppet.

That interception ended Jarrett Guarantano's school record at 167 straight passes without a pick. While Shurmur was picking the Tennessee defense apart, Guarantano struggled to move the offense as the Vols managed 85 yards in the first half.

Ty Chandler went 75 yards untouched on the Vols' first play of the third quarter to pull Tennessee within 17-7, and Guarantano hit Marquez Callaway with a TD pass in the fourth quarter.

Ke'Shawn Vaughn became only the sixth different running back to rush for 1,000 yards with the Commodores' eighth all-time 1,000-yard season. He ran six times for 25 yards, giving him 1,001 yards for the season. He also caught two passes for 33 yards more. But Vaughn took a hit to the head on Vandy's first TD drive, then he got hit by a pair of Tennessee defenders on his sixth and final run. He went to the locker room with an injured left arm and shoulder.

## Texas Shootout

**HOUSTON** - Baylor quarterback Charlie Brewer threw for 384 yards and two touchdowns, the second a tiebreaking 52-yarder in the fourth quarter, and ran for 109 yards and another score to help the Bears beat Vanderbilt 45-38 in the Academy Sports + Outdoors Texas Bowl.

Brewer connected with Marques Jones for the 52-yard stroke that that made it 45-38 with less than two minutes left. The Bears then stopped Vanderbilt on fourth-and-5 to secure the victory.

Brewer's other touchdown pass was a 75-yarder earlier in the fourth quarter and he scored on a 1-yard run in the third quarter. The Bears finished 7-6 a year after they managed just one in coach Matt Rhule's first season.

Vanderbilt (6-7) was led by Kyle Shurmur, who threw for 286 yards and a touchdown, and Ke'Shawn Vaughn, who ran for two touchdowns and set a Texas Bowl record with 243 yards rushing -- which ranks second in school history. Shurmur moved past Jay Cutler (8,697) for most career yards passing in school history with 8,865.

Baylor led by 3 with about 10 minutes left when a pass intended for Denzel Mims bounced off of him as he fell in the end zone and was intercepted by Randall Haynie. Haynie grabbed the ball and stood on tiptoes before falling backward out of the end zone.

Two plays later, Vaughn ran 66 yards to get Vanderbilt to the 1, and Khari Blasingame ran it in on the next play to put Vanderbilt up 35-31. The Bears regained the lead when Trestan Ebner scored on the 75-yard catch and run on the first play of the next drive.

Vanderbilt tied it on a 33-yard field goal with 3 1/2 minutes remaining.

Ebner's 34-yard touchdown run gave Baylor a 24-21 lead early in the third quarter. The Bears padded the lead when Brewer scrambled for a 1-yard score with about five minutes left in the third.

Vanderbilt had a chance to cut the lead to 3 after that, but Jared Pinkney fumbled after a 32-yard reception and the Bears recovered it at their own 2. But Baylor couldn't move the ball and had to punt.

Shurmur threw a 52-yard pass to Amir Abdur-Rahman to get the Commodores to the 2-yard line and Blasingame scored on the next play to get to 31-28 near the end of the third quarter.

The Commodores took a 7-0 lead when Shurmur connected with Blasingame on a short pass and dashed down the field for a career-long 65-yard touchdown reception on the third play of the game.

The Bears settled for a 23-yard field goal on their first drive before taking a 10-7 lead when John Lovett ran 12 yards for a touchdown with about two minutes left in the first quarter. Vanderbilt went back on top 14-10 when Vaughn ran 68 yards for a touchdown late in the first.

JaMycal Hasty gave Baylor a 17-14 lead when he scored on an 18-yard run early in the second quarter.

But Vaughn's second long run came not long after that to make it 21-17. Vaughn broke a couple of tackles and then outran the rest of the defense on the 69-yard score. Jameson Houstondove at his feet near the 20-yard line, but barely clipped one of his legs and Vaughn didn't break his stride on the way to the end zone.
