This will be the first all-time meeting between the Commodores and Gamecocks on the hardwood.

#### **Last Time Out**

Six Commodores scored in double figures as Vanderbilt women's basketball won its exhibition over Palm Beach Atlantic, 116-42, on Sunday afternoon at Memorial Gymnasium. Senior LeaLea Carter and freshman Koi Love each had double-doubles for the Commodores. Carter's double-double included 26 points and 11 rebounds on 10-of-16 shooting, while Love added 11 points, 10 rebounds and three assists in her first collegiate action. That pair was joined in double figures by senior Chelsie Hall (12 points), redshirt senior Mariella Fasoula (18), and sophomores Brinae Alexander (10) and Jordyn Cambridge (10). Hall and Alexander added four assists apiece.

• Vanderbilt capped its 2018-19 season in the SEC Tournament with a 74-57 defeat to Alabama. The Commodores finished last season at 7-23 overall and 2-14 in conference play.

### **Up Next**

Vanderbilt continues its five-game homestand to open the 2019-20 campaign with Friday's matchup against Radford at 7 p.m. on SEC Network+. Then the Commodores welcome UConn to Memorial Gym at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 13.

#### **Home Sweet Home**

- Vanderbilt opens the season with five straight games at Memorial Gymnasium.
- The Commordoes will not leave the friendly confines of the Music City for their first six games. The first road contest of the season will be at neighboring Tennessee Tech on Monday, Nov. 25.
- The first time the Commodores leave Nashville this season will be on a flight to the Bahamas. Vanderbilt will join Rutgers, Seton Hall and Georgia Tech at the Junkanoo Jam in Bimini, Nov. 28-29.
- The only other road contests for the Commodores in the nonconference season will be in Seattle, Washington. Vanderbilt will take on UC Irvine (Dec. 20) and host Washington (Dec. 21) at the Husky Classic.

#### Mariella Fasoula

- An All-SEC second team selection last year, senior Mariella Fasoula was named to the preseason All-SEC second team by the media and coaches this year.
- Fasoula was one of 20 players named to the Lisa Leslie Award preseason watch list. The three-year-old award is given annually to the nation's top center.
- The Greece national team member and communication studies major started all 29 games for the Commodores in 2018-19. She scored in double figures in all but six of those contests and led the team with 15.9 points per game and 7.2 rebounds per game.

### **New Faces**

- Vanderbilt welcomes eight newcomers in 2019-20, including seven freshman and Missouri transfer Akira Levy, who will be eligible to play in 2019-20.
- Coach White and her staff were all over the recruiting trail. Vandy's seven freshmen are from six different states — Tennessee (Chambers), North Carolina (Washington), Texas (Hutchins), Kentucky (Pearl), Georgia (Golden) and Florida (Love, Smith).
- In all, this year's Commodore squad features 10 underclassmen and two scholarship seniors.

### **Carter Rising**

- LeaLea Carter finished the 208-19 season playing some of her best collegiate basketball. The junior had to step up with a slew of injuries and scored into double-digits in seven of the last nine games.
- Carter scored 165 points her freshman season and 22 her sophomore season. She has netted 252 already this season.

### **Injury Plague**

The Commodores battled injuries all season long last year. Vanderbilt missed a combined 35 games, excluding walk-on injuries, due to injury.

Vanderbilt began to get healthy toward the end of last season and had its deepest bench in the last few games of the season, which included the program's first-ever victory at Tennessee.

#### In the Community

- This year's squad has placed an emphasis on volunteering in the local Nashville community. Each team member must complete 10 hours of community service this season. Those hours do not include the team mandated community
- Among some of the team volunteering events, the Commodores spent an afternoon at the Habitat for Humanity Restore in Nashville where they helped stock shelves and move furniture. They also volunteered on Halloween at Vanderbilt's Trick or Treat with the Greeks where they handed out candy and provided Nashville communities and children a fun, safe space for Halloween night.

### **Preseason Polls**

• Vanderbilt was picked to finish 14th in the preseason SEC media poll and predected to finish 12th by the SEC coaches.

### Beyond the Arc

Fasoula

The Athens, Greece, native is the daughter of Panagiotis Fasoula—better known as "The Spider". The 7-foot center is a FIBA Hall of Famer and was dominate on Greece's national team. He played in numerous World Cups, the 1996 Atlanta Olympics and one season for NC State. The Spider was the Mayor of Piraeus, Greece, from 2007-10.

Following in her father's footsteps, Fasoula made noise on the Greece national team in the 2018 World Cup. The squad was stacked with multiple FIBA players and WNBA players.

The Boston College transfer led the Eagles with 16 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game as a sophomore.
