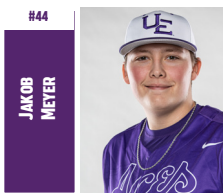

- Evansville and Vanderbilt are meeting for the 51st time in program history with the Commodores owning a 34-16 advantage in the series.
- The Aces and Vanderbilt last met on Feb. 20, 2019 with Vandy earning a narrow 5-4 win.
- Evansville's last win over the Commodores came on Feb. 26, 2014 in an 8-3 Aces' win.
- After hitting another home run at Austin Peay of Sunday, sophomore Tanner Craig has six dingers on the season, placing Craig in second in the nation in total home runs.
- Vanderbilt enters Tuesday's matchup with a 6-2 record, coming off a weekend sweep of UIC that saw the Commodores out-score the Flames, 23-5. Vandy looks to make it six wins in a row with a victory over the Aces.

Offense is Rolling

Through seven games, the Aces have already scored double-digit runs twice. Last season in 53 games, Evansville reached double-digit runs just twice.

Home Run Derby

Evansville and Tennessee Tech put on a home run exhibition last weekend in Cookeville, Tenn. The two teams combined to hit 15 homers with the Aces hitting six and the Golden Eagles recording nine.

Youth at the Top

Through seven games, the Aces have been led at the plate by younger players. Despite boasting seven seniors on the roster, Evansville's top four hitters are juniors or younger, including two players who are either underclassmen or newcomers to the roster.

Patience at the Plate

The Aces showed discipline at the plate in the opening seven games. Evansville has earned 40 walks this season to just 29 for its opponents.

Distributing the Hits

Evansville has spread out the types of hits it has recorded so far this season. The Aces have hit 34 singles, six doubles, two triples, and 10 home runs through seven games. The two triples Evansville has hit are one-third of the way to the triples the Aces hit all of last season.

Time to Shine

The Aces faced a tough challenge last season when Evansville made the trip to face the eventual national champions on Feb. 20. Evansville took an early 2-0 lead in the second inning and battled back to tie it at four midway through the game. Vanderbilt would get what would be the winning run in the sixth inning before holding Evansville off the board in the final three innings.

Looking to Close Games

Evansville has had its successes this season, leading in all but one of its seven games this season, but the Aces are still looking for their first win. This season, Evansville has been dealt a few heart-breaking losses in late innings. The Aces have lost three games in which they held a lead after seventh inning and lost two more that they led going into the ninth.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Craig Continues Success

After being named MVC player of the week and one of Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week last weekend, junior Tanner Craig continued to hit the ball well this weekend. Craig added two more home runs to his total with homers against Lipscomb and Austin Peay, giving him six on the season. On the year, Craig is hitting .478 with 12 RBI and nine runs scored.

Indiana Stanley Shows Ability

After going hitless in his first five games for the Aces, sophomore Indiana Stanley found his bat towards the end of the weekend. Starting the season 0-14 from the plate, Stanley closed the weekend going 6-10 with seven RBI and a pair of home runs.

Craig Takes Base

Because of his ability to hit the ball out of the park that has been showcased early this season, Craig has been a bat opposing teams don't want to have to deal with. This season, Craig has been walked 11 times, placing the junior in fifth in the nation in walks. Comparatively, Craig walked just 28 times last season in 52 games.

Kressin's Numbers

Pitching 3.1 innings this season, Jace Kressin has an odd stat line at first glance. Kressin holds an 8.10 ERA, but in his just over three innings of work he has yet to allow a run. Opposing batters are hitting .000 of Kressin, who has walked three batters and struck out three more.

Ellis' Chance at Revenge

Pitching a host of Aces due to the mid-week match, Evansville will have a few arms available on Tuesday that pitched in the narrow 5-4 loss to the Commodore's last season. David Ellis received the loss in the last meeting, but turned in a respectable performance, pitching one inning, allowing two hits and one run to Vandy.

Borgstrom is Back

After starting the season well, Danny Borgstrom gets another chance to face a team he performed well against last season. In the 2019 meeting between Evansville and Vanderbilt, Borgstrom went 2-for-4 with an RBI.

Shallenberger's Six-Game Streak

Entering Tuesday, Aces' newcomer Mark Shallenberger holds a six-game hitting streak, the longest current streak on the team.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Team 78

The 2020 edition of the Aces is the 78th team fielded by the University of Evansville. First starting in 1924, the Aces have racked up 1,184 wins during their 77 seasons.

Canadian Connection

Coming from nearly 1,500 miles away, two natives of Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada have joined forces for the Aces. Senior Ben Komonosky and junior Robbie Wilkes both call the town in southern Canada home. An odd connection between Regina and Evansville exists. Bonnie Baker, a native of Regina, was an all-star catcher in the All-American Girls Professional Baseball League (AAGPBL). Baker's life was loosely portrayed in the 1992 movie *A League of their Own* with Baker played by Geena Davis. The movie that portrays Baker's life and the lives of 12 other Regina natives filmed many scenes at Bosse Field, located on the north west side of Evansville.

Carroll's Coaching Tenure

This season represents Evansville head coach Wes Carroll's 12th season at the helm of the Aces. Carroll is the second longest tenured head coach in Evansville baseball history behind Jim Brownlee (23 seasons) and Don Ping (20 seasons).

Up Next for Evansville

Following Tuesday's showdown with No. 2 Vanderbilt, the Aces come home for their first games of the season, hosting Butler for a three-game series at Bosse Field.

Twin Rockies

Entering Spring Training, the Aces have a pair of alums in major league camps with both on the same team. LHP Kyle Freeland and SS Eric Stamets both enter spring training with the Rockies after Stamets was signed by Colorado as a free agent to a minor league contract in November.

Evansville vs. the State of Tennessee

Playing five games against teams from the state over a span of six days, the Aces are in familiar territory. In all, the Aces have played 207 games all-time against schools from Tennessee, holding a 103-100-3 record in games against Tennessee schools.

Aces vs. SEC

Evansville has played 2,352 games in its 78 seasons and 102 of them have been against teams from the SEC. All-time against the SEC, the SEC holds a 35-67 advantage in series against Evansville.

Coach Notes

- Evansville alum Wes Carroll heads into his 13th season as head baseball coach at the University of Evansville as the Aces usher in a new era of Evansville Baseball.

- In July, the Aces announced that German American Bank had made a financial commitment to University of Evansville athletics that will result in an impressive renovation to the Aces baseball stadium, which will now be named "German American Bank Field at Charles H. Braun Stadium." Included in the renovations will be a full AstroTurf field, padded walls throughout the entire stadium with new fence lines down the first and third base lines, dugout and bullpen renovations as well as a new LED scoreboard.

- A season ago in 2019, Carroll led the Aces to a strong start to the season, en route to 24 wins, including series victories over Iowa and Creighton. After the season, Carroll saw another player graduate to professional baseball after being under his tutelage as pitcher Adam Lukas was selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 12th round of the MLB Amateur Player Draft.

- Carroll learned the game "the Purple Aces' way" growing up just minutes from the UE campus in nearby Newburgh, Indiana. He watched his older brother and current Major League infielder, Jamey Carroll, excel at shortstop for UE, and later got to experience the success the program is capable of first-hand as a four-year starter for the Purple Aces and a member of UE's 2000 NCAA Tournament team.

- Wes Carroll became UE's first Freshman All-America selection in 1998, thanks to a rookie campaign in which he hit .355 with 18 doubles, two home runs, and 39 runs batted in. Carroll went on to hit .299 or better in each of his four years at UE, and finished his career by setting the school's all-time career record for doubles (74), while also ranking in the school's career top 10 in six different categories. He still holds the record for career doubles, has the second-most base hits in school history with 308, and ranks 10th all-time in UE history with a .339 career batting average. Carroll earned all-conference and all-region honors on the UE infield during his four-year career, before being named to the Missouri Valley Conference's All-Centennial Team in 2007 as one of the top players in league history.
