News and Notes

Taking On No. 1... UConn is 1-3 against the No. 1 team in the country (rankings kept since 2000) and last played the top team in the land in 2016. The Huskies faced off against No. 1 Florida in a Gainesville Regional winners bracket game. The Huskies were tied with the Gators 5-5 in the eighth inning before Jonathan India led off the frame with a home run.

The Huskies notched a win against the No. 1 team in 2001 against No. 1 Notre Dame. The Huskies defeated the Fighting Irish 19-12 on May 6 in South Bend.

Huskies vs. MLB4 Field... The Huskies will play Cal Poly for the first time in program history on Friday. UConn has faced the Commodes (0-3) and Wolverines (1-2) three times in its history. UConn and Michigan will play four-straight games against one another with one game in Scottsdale and then a three-game series in Port St. Lucie, Fla. at the Mets Spring Training facility.

History vs. Big West... UConn is 5-10 all-time against current Big West teams with the most recent meeting coming in 2017 against UC Davis. The Huskies captured a road series win against the Aggies. UConn also holds three wins against CSUN and . The other teams UConn has played are Cal State Fullerton (0-1), UC Irvine (0-1), UCSB (0-3) and Long Beach State (0-1).

History vs. SEC.. UConn is 0-24 all-time against current SEC teams. The Huskies last played an SEC opponent in 2016, with a matchup against No. 1 Florida in the Gainesville Regional. UConn has played Florida (0-6), Georgia (0-4), Mississippi State (0-4), Vanderbilt (0-3), South Carolina (0-3), Tennessee (0-2), Auburn (0-1) and Missouri (0-1).

History vs. Big Ten... UConn is 26-18 against current Big Ten teams since 2010. The Huskies went 6-2 against Big Ten teams in 2019 with a four-game sweep of Michigan State and a victory against No. 25 Illinois. The Huskies lost the first game against Nebraska in the Oklahoma City Regional before ending the Cornhuskers season, 16-1, a couple days later to advance to the OKC Regional Final.

Pat Winkel Lost For Year... Sophomore catcher Pat Winkel will miss the 2020 campaign after getting Tommy John Surgery in the fall. Winkel led the Huskies with seven home runs and hit .318 with eight doubles and 38 RBIs in his first season in Storrs. Winkel was ABCA All-Region Second Team. Winkel played 30 games for the Harwich Mariners in the Cape Cod Baseball League last summer.

2020 Captain... Senior Chris Winkel and redshirt junior Paul Gozzo will captain the 2020 squad and be relied upon for production in the order along with their defense up the middle. Winkel makes the move from first base to center field while Gozzo becomes the Huskies No. 1 catcher after Pat Winkel went down with season-ending surgery.

Fedko Brothers.. Christian and Kyler Fedko will be relied upon once again in 2020 with both guys getting into good shape in the offseason. Both brothers played in the Cape Cod League during the summer with Christian earning All-Star accolades with Harwich and Kyler playing for the Bourne Braves. Christian played in 52 games as a sophomore, hitting .271 with 16 doubles, three homers and 43 RBIs. Kyler hit .273 after beginning his UConn career 0-18 at the dish. The younger Fedko brother hit five home runs and added 12 doubles during his

freshman year.

Rubber Arm Caleb... Caleb Wurster set a single-season record with 36 appearances in 2019 as a redshirt freshman. The left hander went from almost being cut to one of the Huskies go-to relievers in the late innings. With Jake Wallace and CJ Dandeneau off to the pros, Wurster will be the top returning option for the Huskies in their pen.

Big Year For The Dragon and Sim... Juniors Colby Dunlop and Joe Simeone are looking to breakout in 2020 after having solid offseasons for the Huskies. Dunlop finished the 2019 campaign on a high note with two wins in the postseason. First, Dunlop went 5.1 shutout frames allowing just two hits against Wichita State in The American Championship. The right-hander followed it up with a career-high 8.0 innings of one-run ball in an NCAA elimination game against Nebraska.

Simeone finished 2019 with a dominant 3.0 inning performance against Harvard in an NCAA elimination game. Sim earned the win, allowing just one hit against the Crimson. The Groton, Mass native followed it up with a great summer for Keene in the NECBL by leading the league with 66 strikeouts in 14.1 innings.

Welcome To Storrs... The Huskies always bring in a decent amount of junior college transfers but this year UConn has three players coming in from Division I programs. Justin Willis (Vanderbilt) and Erik Stock (Old Dominion) are eligible to compete right away. While Ben Casparius (UNC) is waiting on an appeal to the NCAA.

Baseball Conference... The American Conference continues to distinguish itself as one of the top conferences in college baseball. The league was No. 5 in conference RPI ranking in 2019 with seven of the nine teams in the Top 100 of the RPI. Four teams (UConn, ECU & Cincinnati) reached the 2019 NCAA Tournament and ECU hosted an NCAA Regional. 2020 will be the final year the Huskies will be in the league before moving back to the Big East.

Power Conference Dubs... The Huskies were 10-5 against "Power 5" Conference in 2019 with a 3-2 mark against the ACC and 6-2 record vs. the Big Ten. Since 2010, UConn is 69-51 against teams currently in "Power 5" Conferences. Wins include Clemson, Louisville, Texas, Oregon State, Texas Tech, Oklahoma, Nebraska and Oklahoma State.

MacDonald's All-Americans... UConn has had a ton of success on the mound under eighth year pitching coach Josh MacDonald. The Huskies have had five-straight seasons with an All-American on the mound and six total since 2015. Carson Cross ('15), Anthony Kay ('16), John Russell ('17), Mason Feole ('18), P.J. Poulin ('18) and Jake Wallace ('19) all earned All-America honors under Coach Mac. Coach MacDonald is the only pitching coach in the country that has done that with his current program.

Northern California Flavor... The Huskies have five players on the 35-man roster that are from the California Junior College pipeline. INF David Langer (Chabot College), C/1B Cole Brodnansky (Santa Rosa JC), and RHP Kenny Haus (El Camino College) all return for the Huskies this season. UConn has added INF Zach Bushling (Sierra College) and RHP Nick Krauth (Diablo Valley)

News and Notes

Cali junior college transfer have made a huge impact for the Huskies since the 2014 season. Blake Davey, Joe DeRoche-Duffin, Keith Krueger, Tyler Gnesda, Isaac Feldstein, Mike Woodworth, Jeff Kersten, Chase Gardner and Thad Phillips all have led the Huskies to success.

A New Home For the HookC.. UConn broke ground in the fall of 2018 on a new baseball, soccer and softball complex that will change the game for the Huskies. The facility is going to be ready for a March 29 debut against old Big East foe Seton Hall. The ballpark will be an immense upgrade over previous home, J.O. Christian Field and the program is also going to be part of a new performance center, down the left field line, that will feature hitting tunnels, locker rooms, athletic training, weight room, coaches offices and much more to make the facility a new home for baseball, softball, lacrosse and soccer teams.

Winning Culture... UConn won 368 games from 2010-2019, ranking tied for 34th in the country during that span. The Huskies face off against two teams on that list this season (Vanderbilt (1st, 471), ECU (30th, 374).

2020 Schedule Highlights...UConn will face another challenging schedule in 2020, playing 25 games against 10 programs that finished 2019 in the Top-100 of the RPI. Additionally, the Huskies face eight teams that reached the 2019 NCAA Tournament The Huskies strength of schedule ranked No. 32 in the country in 2019, a program-record.

Connecticut Under Penders... In its 16 seasons of competition under the watch of head coach Jim Penders, UConn owns a 564-392-4 record, advancing to six NCAA Tournaments and winning the 2013 Big East Tournament crown and 2016 American Athletic Conference Tournament. Coach Penders became the all-time winningest coach at UConn after capturing his 557th victory at Tulane on May 16, 2019 to move past his old coach and mentor Andy Baylock. Since 2004, the Huskies have boasted 11 All-Americans. UConn has secured 13 30-win season under Penders and received four at-large bids to the NCAA Tournament.

MLB Pipeline... Connecticut established a new program-record with five former Huskies in Major League Baseball at one time during the 2015 season. The Huskies matched that total again in 2018 with five UConn alums on MLB rosters at the end of the 2018 season (Ahmed, Andreoli, Barnes, Oberg, Springer). The Huskies had alums win World Series titles in back-to-back seasons. In 2017, George Springer won World Series MVP en route to the Astros winning the Commissioner's trophy and Matt Barnes took home the hardware with the Red Sox in 2018. Anthony Kay became the seventh Husky since 2013 to make his MLB debut, appearing for the Toronto Blue Jays in 2019.

MLB Draft Picks... Since the draft's inception in 1965, 100 Connecticut players have been selected by major league teams. Under Jim Penders, 52 Huskies have been drafted or signed by MLB clubs, including five (Jake Wallace, Anthony Prato, Mason Feole, Mike Woodworth and CJ Dandeneau) a season ago. The Huskies have also had four first round picks (Mike Olt, George Springer, Matt Barnes and Anthony Kay) since 2010. 21 players are beginning 2020 spring training with an MLB organization.

Jim Penders has worked with the University of Connecticut baseball program in 27 of the last 29 years, being associated with the Huskies as a student-athlete, an assistant coach and now head coach. He completed his 16th season as head coach in 2019. A four-time conference Coach of the Year, Penders has overseen one of the most successful stretches in the 122-year history of UConn baseball. The Huskies have the longest tenured coaching staff in Division I baseball.

Overall in his tenure, Penders holds a 564-392-5 record. On May 16, 2019, Penders surpassed his mentor, Andy Baylock, for most wins in UConn history by securing his 557th victory in a 8-5 win at Tulane. He has led the Huskies to six NCAA Tournament appearances, including a Super Regional appearance in 2011. UConn has also won a regular season or conference title three times with Penders in the dugout and hosted the 2010 Norwich Regional. Under his watch, 14 Huskies have earned All-America honors, most recently Jacob Wallace in 2019.

In 16 seasons as head coach for the Huskies, Penders has had a total of 52 players either drafted or signed by professional baseball clubs. During the 2015 MLB season a program-record five former Huskies played in the big leagues: Nick Ahmed ('11) of the Diamondbacks, Matt Barnes ('11) of the Red Sox, Scott Oberg ('12) of the Rockies, Mike Olt ('11) of the Cubs and George Springer ('11) of the Astros. The feat occurred again in 2018 with Ahmed, Barnes, Oberg and Springer joined by former teammate John Andreoli ('11) who was called up by the Seattle Mariners on May 23, 2018. Anthony Kay made his MLB Debut on Sept. 7, 2019 for the Toronto Blue Jays.

Penders has led his squad to 30 or more wins in 13 of his 16 years at Connecticut. In 2019, Penders led the Huskies to its fifth at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament and earned the No. 2 seed in the Oklahoma City Regional. The Huskies won three games in the tournament, most since 2011, to reach its second-straight Regional Final. The Huskies finished with 39 wins, eclipsing the 35-win mark for the sixth time in the last 10 seasons. He was named ABCA/Diamond Northeast Coach of the Year for the third time in his career on July 25, 2019.

In 2018, Penders led UConn to its fourth at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament in program history. The Huskies earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Conway Regional and reached the Regional Final by defeating LIU Brooklyn and host, Coastal Carolina.

Mason Feole earned an invite to pitch for the USA Collegiate National Team in 2018, becoming the third Husky in the past four seasons to receive the honor. Penders has had five players don the stars and stripes (Matt Barnes, Tim Cate, Anthony

Penders led the Huskies to their first-ever American Athletic Conference crown in 2016, finishing with a 38-25 overall record en route to their fourth NCAA Tournament appearance in the last seven seasons. Four Huskies were drafted in the 2016 MLB Draft, including Kay, who went 31st overall to the New York Mets.

Penders earned NEIBA New England Coach of the Year honors in 2015 as his squad went 35-25 and reached the semifinal round of the 2015 American Baseball Championship. Seven Huskies earned All-Conference accolades following the season, including American Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year Carson Cross. Along with Siena, the NEIBA New England Player of the Year, Cross was named an ABCA/Rawlings Third-Team All-American following the season and also received All-America laurels from Louisville Slugger. Willy Yahn became UConn's first Freshman All-American since 2009 following the season with a Louisville Slugger nod.

In 2014, UConn struggled with injuries and youth and finished the year with a 27-31 record. The Huskies qualified for the inaugural American Athletic Conference Championship, defeating eventual champion Houston in pool play. Despite the underwhelming record, several Huskies received major individual accolades. Bobby Melley was named NEIBA New England Player of the Year and was one of three All-Conference first team members.

In 2013, the Huskies claimed their final BIG EAST Championship, defeating Notre Dame, 8-1, in Clearwater, Fla. UConn advanced to play in the NCAA tournament for the third time in the past four years. The BIG EAST title was the third in UConn history joining the 1990 and '94 teams. UConn defeated No. 1 seed Virginia Tech in its first game of the 2013 NCAA Regional hosted in Blacksburg, Va., before falling to Oklahoma and the Hokies in consecutive games. The Huskies finished the season with a 35-28 record.

In 2012, the Huskies' season ended in the BIG EAST Championship Semifinals with back-to-back losses to USF. UConn's overall record was 31-27-1.

In 2011, Penders guided the Huskies to the program's first regular-season BIG EAST championship title and first appearance in the NCAA Super Regionals. UConn finished the season with a 22-5 mark in conference play, and ended the year with a 45-20-1 overall record. Following their program-best 22 wins in conference play in 2011, the Huskies earned a bid to the NCAA Tournament for the 17th time, including their second straight appearance. As the No. 2 seed in the Clemson Regional, UConn went 4-1 while eliminating all three opponents from NCAA Tournament play, including No. 1 seed Clemson.

During 2011, Penders coached 11 student-athletes to BIG EAST post season honors, including Pitcher of the Year Matt Barnes and Player of the Year George Springer. Three Huskies also earned All-America status under Penders that season, as Barnes and Springer were named first team All-Americans and Kevin Vance was named a second team All-American.

In the 2011 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft, a program-best 10 Huskies were selected. George Springer (11th overall), and Matt Barnes (19th overall) were first-round selections of the Houston Astros and Boston Red Sox respectively. Joining the two first-rounders were Nick Ahmed (2nd round pick of the Braves), John Andreoli (17th round pick of the Cubs), Greg Nappo (18th round pick of the Marlins), Kevin Vance (19th round pick of the White Sox), Mike Nemeth (21st round pick of the Brewers), Dave Fischer (30th round pick of the Giants), Doug Elliot (35th round pick of the Brewers), and Elliot Glynn (39th round pick of the Brewers).

The 2010 season was one of the most successful seasons in program history, as Penders guided the Huskies to a program-best 48 wins. After being nationally ranked for the first time since 1979, UConn earned an NCAA Tournament berth for the first time since 1994 and hosted the Norwich Regional at Dodd Stadium in Norwich, Conn. Along with the team success, including a UConn-best 22-game win streak, Penders earned multiple coaching accolades as he was named BIG EAST, ECAC, and NEIBA Coach of the Year. He was also named the ABCA/Diamond Northeast Coach of the Year.

In 2009, Penders led the Huskies to a 36-24 overall record and an appearance in the BIG EAST Championship final against Louisville. Under Penders' guidance, George Springer became UConn's first-ever BIG EAST Rookie of the Year following the 2009 season.

During 2007, Penders and the Huskies earned a spot in the BIG EAST Championship game after battling their way through the BIG EAST Tournament by upsetting three higher-seeded teams. UConn's appearance in the title game as the eighth-seed marked the lowest seed in BIG EAST Tournament history to reach the

final game. In addition, Penders guided the Huskies to their third straight season with 34 or more wins, as his 2006 and 2007 squads ended the year with 39 and 34 victories respectively.

After the 2006 season, a year in which the Huskies went 39-18-1, Penders led his program to a second place finish in the BIG EAST and earned BIG EAST Coach of the Year, and NEIBA Coach of the Year honors, while his team was named the NEIBA Team of the Year. In July of 2003, Penders became just the fifth head coach in the program's history since 1924 joining Sumner Dole (1924-35), J.O. Christian (1936-61), Larry Panciera (1962-79) and Andy Baylock (1980-2003).

Penders was an assistant coach for the Huskies for seven years from 1997-2003 as UConn posted winning seasons in each of those campaigns. As an assistant coach, Penders coordinated the Huskies recruiting of student-athletes, served as a hitting coach and worked with the catchers and outfielders.

A standout on the baseball field for Connecticut during his undergraduate career, Penders was a four-year letterwinner as a Husky. He was co-captain of the 1994 UConn squad that won the BIG EAST Conference tournament, and the Huskies advanced to the NCAA Championship in both his junior and senior years. He hit .354 with seven home runs and 46 runs batted in as a senior in 1994. He earned First Team All-Northeast, All-New England and All-BIG EAST honors in his senior year as a catcher.

During his UConn career, the Huskies played in the Championship game of the BIG EAST Tournament three times. Penders helped the Huskies to 99 wins over his four seasons, including a 30-18 record in 1994. He also excelled in the classroom as a three-time BIG EAST Academic All-Star. Penders was a four-year member of the UConn Captains' Council and served as that group's president during his senior year.

Penders graduated from UConn in 1994 with a degree in political science and added a master's degree from UConn in 1998 from the School of Education.

Penders worked in Washington, D.C., from 1994-96 as a political fundraiser for U.S. Senator Tom Harkin of Iowa. Penders returned to UConn for the 1997 season as a graduate assistant baseball coach and became a fulltime assistant coach for the 1999 season. He also founded and directs the Connecticut Baseball School. The popular camp holds sessions during the summer and winter vacation periods, along with a one-day fall session in October every year.

The connection between the Penders family and UConn athletics runs deep. Penders' father, Jim, and uncle, Tom, both graduated from UConn and played on the Huskies' 1965 College World Series team. Jim is a 1966 UConn graduate and recently retired as the baseball coach at East Catholic High School. He won 600 games in 43 seasons and coached his three sons. He was an infielder for the Huskies and had a career batting average of .279, including a .323 mark his senior year. He was a captain of the '65 squad and the only player to hit over .300 for the Huskies that season. Jim has won four Connecticut high school state championships at East Catholic and was named the national high school coach of the year in 1996. In the summer of 2008 he was inducted into the National High School Coaches Association Hall of Fame, and in June of 2009, the baseball field at East Catholic was named in his honor.

Tom, a 1967 UConn graduate, was the head men's basketball coach at Tufts (1971-74), Columbia (1974-78), Fordham (1978-86), Rhode Island (1986-88), Texas (1988-89), George Washington (1998-2000) and Houston (2004-10). Tom was a two-sport star at UConn in baseball and basketball as he played in two NCAA tournaments (1965 and 1967) and the 1965 College World Series. Penders' extended family also includes a prominent former Husky.

His former classmate, teammate, battery-mate and 1994 Lawrence R. Panciera Most Valuable Player, Aaron Quinn, is now his brother-in-law. Quinn pitched for the Huskies from 1991-94 and married Penders' sister-in-law, Courtney in 1999. Penders' younger brother Rob is the head coach of Division II St. Edward's University of Austin, Texas. His grandfather Jim was the longtime baseball coach at Stratford (Conn.) High School from 1931-68 and won four state championships, a record matched by Penders' father at East Catholic. He was also the head of the physical education department and the town's recreation director. The Stratford High School baseball and football complex is named in his honor.

A native of Vernon, Conn., Penders was an all-state performer in baseball at East Catholic High School and served as his senior class president. In 2011, he was inducted into the ECHS Hall of Fame.
