» First Pitch

- · Saint Louis heads to Nashville, Tenn., for its first mid-week contest of the season.
- The Billikens are 5-1 on the season and riding a 5-game winning streak following their sweep over Ohio last weekend.
- · SLU and Vanderbilt are meeting for the first time in program history.

» Last Time Out

- SLU swept a 3-game series over the Ohio Bobcats in Lexington, S.C., last weekend.
- The Billikens scored seven in the series opener and 13 in the finale.
- Pitching led the way in game two, in a 2-1 victory.
- · Corrigan Bartlett and Jake Garella each smacked five hits and drove in three runs in the series.

» Boyer Earns A-10 Honor

- · Saint Louis freshman RHP Matt Boyer was named the Atlantic 10 Conference Rookie of the Week, the league office announced Monday.
- · Boyer led the Billikens to a series finale win over Ohio, allowing just two runs and striking out five in 6.0 innings.
- · He surrendered five hits, with only one going for extra bases.
- Boyer went to 2-0 on the season, with a 3.27 ERA.

» First Career Start for Youngbrandt

- · Sophomore RHP Scott Youngbrandt will take the ball for the Billikens in today's game.
- · After appearing in 47 games, including 40 starts, as a position player in 2019, Youngbrandt has only seen action on the mound in 2020.
- In a small sample size, the sophomore has thrown 5.2 innings in his career, allowing eight earned runs.

» New Faces

- Saint Louis begins the season with 21 newcomers, including 11 freshmen.
- · Additional new players include one sophomore, six juniors and two seniors.
- Of the returners, seven are position players and six are pitchers.
- The Billikens lost three position starters, all four starting pitchers and their closer to graduation.

» Newcomers Lead Pitching Staff

- Saint Louis pitching returned just 3.6 percent of its starts (2-of-55) from the 2019 season.
- That mark is second lowest in the nation, behind Northwestern State (1.8 percent, 1-of-55).
- The Billikens have had three new players split the six starts so far this season.
- · Charlie Sheehan has seen the most work of the returners, appearing in two games and throwing 5.1
- Newcomers Marius Balandis and Ryan Nolan have combined for two saves and a 0.00 ERA in 7.1 IP.

» SLU Tabbed Sixth in Preseason Poll

- · Saint Louis was tabbed for a sixth-place finish in the 2020 Atlantic 10 Conference baseball race.
- VCU (162 points, eight first-place votes) was the coaches' pick to capture the conference title.
- · Two other teams received first-place votes, including reigning A-10 Champion Fordham (two, 149 points) and third pick Dayton (three, 144 points).
- Richmond (123) was selected fourth, followed by Davidson (112), Saint Louis (111), Rhode Island (97), George Washington (73), Saint Joseph's (71), George Mason (52), Massachusetts (37), La Salle (31) and St. Bonaventure (21).

» Bartlett Starts Out Hot

- Senior outfielder Corrigan Bartlett has recorded a hit in all six games this season, including three multi-hit contests.
- The 2019 All-Conference first team member leads the league with eight RBIs, while ranking second with nine runs scored and third with 10 hits.
- Bartlett has one of the two Billiken home runs on the year, drilling a ball over the left field fence in his first at bat this season.

» Chasing Records

- Senior Jake Garella broke Saint Louis' single-season doubles record last year, finishing with 27.
- The back-to-back Atlantic 10 All-Conference first team member is third all-time for the Billikens with 52 doubles, just five behind leader Mike Vigliarolo (57).
- Garella currently sits 15th all-time at Saint Louis with a .328 career batting average, while also having a place in the top 20 in hits and total bases.

» 2019 Postseason Awards

- For the second year in a row, Jake Garella had been deemed an All-Conference first team selection in 2019. The two-time A-10 Player of the Week Award winner led the Billikens in multiple hitting categories, including batting average (.335), hits (74), doubles (27), RBIs (46) and SLG (.538).
- Centerfielder Corrigan Bartlett had also been named to the First-Team All-Conference team. The leadoff man hit .317 on the season, with a team-leading .417 OBP and 39 runs scored. He drew 20 walks on the season and was hit by the pitch 18 times. Bartlett played in all 53 games for SLU, and he held a 27-game on-base streak at one point in the year.

» Lehmann Drafted

- Following a five-year career at Saint Louis, Connor Lehmann was drafted in the seventh round (pick 203) by the San Diego Padres in the 2019 MLB Draft.
- In Lehmann's final start as a Billiken he posted a 9.2 inning, 19 strikeout game in an A-10 Championship loss to Rhode Island.
- Lehmann struck out 111 batters in his senior season at SLU, third most in program history.

» Atlantic 10 Success

- Since 2006, SLU has won five regular-season conference championships and four tournament titles.
- The Billikens have eight NCAA Tournament appearances in their history, including three under Hendrickson's helm ('10, '13 and '18).

HEAD COACH DARIN HENDRICKSON

- Became the all-time winningest head coach at Saint Louis on May 19, 2018, when he collected win No. 362, surpassing former head coach Bob Hughes.
- Has coached 11 draft picks at Saint Louis, including Connor Lehmann (seventh round in 2019 by the San Diego Padres) and Miller Hogan (sixth round in 2018 by the Tampa Bay Rays).
- Has led the Billikens to three NCAA Tournament appearances, reaching the regional round in 2010, 2013 and 2018.
- Has won Atlantic 10 regular season titles in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2018.
- Had seven consecutive winning seasons from 2009-15, a Saint Louis record.
- Earned the first national ranking in school history for the Billikens in 2012, coming in at No. 30 in Collegiate Baseball's rankings.

In 12 years at the helm of the Saint Louis University baseball program, head coach Darin Hendrickson has taken the Billikens to new heights. Numerous school records, A-10 regular-season and tournament championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances are just a few of the examples of Hendrickson's work as he transformed the program into one that is recognized regionally and nationally.

In 2019, the Billikens went 25-30, finishing seventh in the Atlantic 10 Conference. Senior RHP Connor Lehmann was drafted in the seventh round, pick 203 by the San Diego Padres. He became the third-highest draft pick at SLU in the modern draft era.

In 2018, the senior-laiden Billikens put together one of the best performances in program histroy with an overall record of 38-20 and a finish in the 2018 NCAA Regional in Oxford, Miss. Saint Louis captured both the A-10 Tournament and regular season crown and went on to numerous conference and national accolades. Junior Miller Hogan, after forgoing a pro career in the summer of 2017, went on to Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Year honors and was named a Second Team All-American by Collegiate Baseball News. Hogan was also named the Perfect Game/Rawlings All-American Third Team and was an ABCA Third Team All-American. Coach Hendrickson was also named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year as his team finished with a 19-4 record in league play. Hendrickson coached five players to conference postseason awards. Further, he coached two MLB Draft picks as Hogan was taken in the sixth round by the Tampa Bay Rays and Alex King was selected in the 35th by the Arizona Diamondbacks.


