• Toledo is in the midst of an 11-day spring break trip. After today's game at Vanderbilt, they head to Kennesaw State for a three-game weekend series.

• Toledo's home opener is scheduled for Tuesday, March 17 against Youngstown State.

The Rockets will host Ball State

The Rockets visited Belmont on Tuesday and lost 8-7. The Rockets jumped out to an early 6-0 lead, scoring four in the top of the second and two in the top of the third. But the Bruins chipped away at Toledo's lead in the middle innings, eventually tying the game at 7-7 in the bottom of the sev-

enth. With one out in the bottom of the ninth, Belmont's Tommy Crider singled up the middle to drive in the winning run, handing Toledo its fifth walk-off loss of the season.

Chris Meyers started on the mound for the Rockets and was spectacular, throwing two perfect innings and striking out five. Meyers walked twice and drove in a pair of runs at the plate as well

ROCKET NOTES

• Darryn Davis' hitting streak ended at 20 games after he did not get a hit in the Belmont game on Tuesday. He had hit safely in all 14 games this season and ended the 2019 season on a six-game streak. Davis is the first Rocket with a 20-game hitting streak since Chris Dudics' 39-game streak in 2010.

• Davis leads the MAC in batting average (.436) and on-base percentage (.569). He ranks 16th in the country in OBP%.

• One more Davis note: when he leads off an inning he is 17-for-23 (.739).

• Chris Meyers is tied with Miami's Will Vogelgesang atop the MAC with four home runs.

• Meyers had five RBI in the 13-4 win at UAB, making him one of two MAC players with a 5-RBI game this season.

• Kyle Bischoff has struck out 15 batters in 8.2 innings of work this year and opponents are hitting just .129 against him.

• Trey Wright is 9-for-18 (.500) with runners on base, best batting average on the team.

• Starting pitchers Wyatt Jefferson and Jordan Power have done a good job of slamming the door with two outs. Opposing hitters are 2-for-13 (.154) against Jefferson and 4-for-25 (.160) against Power when batting with two outs.

• The two toughest players to strike out in the MAC are both Rockets. Trey Wright (three strikeouts in 36 at-bats) and Davis (five strikeouts in 55 at-bats) rank one and two, respectively. Wright also ranks fourth among all freshmen in that category.

• John Servello has six stolen bases so far this season. He had five stolen bases combined in his freshman and sophomore campaigns.

• The Rockets are near the top of the MAC in several offensive categories. Their .263 batting average is second in the league, and their 196 total bases also rank second. UT's .374 slugging percentage is third in the conference.

• Thomas Eitniear has come on as a defensive replacement at shortstop in eight of 15 games this season.

STREAKING

Darryn Davis enters Wednesday's game having reached base in 21 consecutive games dating back to last season. He has been especially outstanding in his last 10 games, reaching base multiple times in all 10 contests and posting a triple slash line of .514/.667.686. Davis has either walked or been hit by a pitch 16 times in his last 10 games. Ten of those 21 games have been multi-hit efforts and the sophomore is hitting .430 (34-79) during the streak. Twelve of his 29 hits have gone for extra bases as well.

ROCKETS TAKE TWO OF THREE AT UAB

Toledo took two out of three against UAB this past weekend. The Rockets won Friday's game, 13-4, and Sunday's game, 6-4 in 10 innings.

Toledo played its most complete game of the year on Friday, pounding out 17 hits while walking just three batters on the mound. Chris Meyers tallied a career-high five RBIs, four of which came on a grand slam. Darryn Davis played the hero in Sunday's win, recording the game-winning hit in the top of the 10th inning. With the bases loaded, he ripped a two-out single that scored two runs. Kyle Bischoff was terrific out of the bullpen, throwing 3.1 scoreless innings to earn the win.

BROTHERLY LOVE

Toledo has three sets of brothers within the baseball program. Junior John Servello and freshman Sam Servello form the only player-player brother duo. Assistant coach Tommy Winterstein is the older brother of senior Nicky Winterstein. Sophomore Kyle Jones is the younger brother of fourth-year team manager Kevin Jones.

LATE HEARTBREAK

After the weekend trip to Alabama State, Toledo has now been walked off five times this season. The Rockets lost in the bottom of the ninth yesterday at Belmont after leading 6-0 through three innings. They were also walked off in the series finale at East Tennessee State and in the final three games at Alabama State. Three of those games were tied going into the bottom of the ninth; Toledo had leads heading into the bottom of the ninth in the other two walk-off losses.

NEWCOMERS

Toledo has 18 newcomers on its roster for 2020, including seven freshmen. Matt Benavidez, Lorenzo DeBrecht, Chipper Holland, Wyatt Jefferson, Matt Kirk, Wyatt O'Brien, Danny O'Reilly, Jordan Power, Sam Prince, Sam Servello, and Nicky Winterstein all join the program as transfers from other schools. Connor Brandon, Yassir Kahook, Connor O'Donnell, Sam Seeker, Spencer Stanton, Trey Wright, and Jason Young are all true freshmen with the Rockets this season.

NEW FACES

In addition to the litany of new players taking the field for the Rockets in 2020, there will be some new faces in the dugout as well. Joining firstyear head coach Rob Reinstetle on the coaching staff are Tommy Winterstein and Sean Repay. Winterstein was most recently the volunteer assistant at Western Kentucky where he coached alongside Reinstetle. Repay was an assistant coach at Indiana University Southeast and also coached the Bismarck Larks of the Northwoods League. Assistant coach Nick McIntyre returns to Toledo for his 12th season and former Rocket Caleb Scoles will spend the 2020 season as a student assistant coach.

ROCKET REWIND: 2019

Toledo finished the 2019 season with a record of 17-35 (4-21 MAC) and missed out on the MAC Tournament for just the second time in the last 11 seasons. The Rockets entered conference play with a record of 9-9, but they were unable to find their footing against MAC competition.

Rob Reinstetle (pronounced RINE-stet-ul) was named the head baseball coach at The University of Toledo on July 8, 2019. A Columbus, Ohio native, Reinstetle is the 12th coach in program history and comes to Toledo following a fouryear stint as an assistant coach at Western Kentucky University.

Prior to arriving at WKU, Reinstetle also served on coaching staffs at Ole Miss (2007-09), South Alabama (2006), College of Charleston (2004-05), Northwest Florida State College (2003), Cincinnati (2002) and Ohio Dominican (2000-01). Before beginning his coaching career at ODU in 2001, Reinstetle served as an associate professional scout for the Los Angeles Dodgers.

In 12 seasons as a college assistant, Reinstetle was part of programs that compiled records of 449-313-1, won four conference championships, advanced to six NCAA Regionals, as well as a pair of Super Regionals. Seventy-nine players coached by Reinstetle have been selected in the MLB Draft, highlighted by major leaguers Zack Cozart, David Freese, Brett Gardner, Lance Lynn and Drew Pomeranz.

In 2018, Reinstetle helped mentor WKU's Jake Sanford, who earned All-America honors after becoming Conference USA's first regular-season Triple Crown winner (.402 average, 22 HR, 65 RBI) and a third-round draft pick by the New York Yankees in this year's MLB draft.

Reinstetle served as the recruiting coordinator at Ole Miss from 2007-09, where he helped sign four Top-20 recruiting classes and

aided the Rebels in two Super Regional appearances. In his last season, Ole Miss fell one game shy of the College World Series and had five everyday starters finish the season with a batting average of .335 or higher. Reinstetle left Ole Miss following the 2009 season to work in the private business sector for his family-owned business in Powell, Ohio. During this time, he also provided personal baseball instruction for six- to 18-year olds.

Reinstetle also helped attract a Top-50 recruiting class as the recruiting coordinator at South Alabama in 2006. The Jaguars set single-season school records in hits (707) and batting average (.326), in addition to posting a 39-21 record and making an NCAA Regional appearance.

Reinstetle is a 1999 graduate of

Ohio Dominican University. He and his wife Christy are the parents of one son, Cale (9). He also has two stepdaughters, Brittany (24) and McKenzie (18).

REINSTETLE LOOKS TO MAKE HIS MARK ON TOLEDO BASEBALL

Without a doubt, Reinstetle has already made his mark on the program in just a few months' time. In January, Toledo announced several changes to its baseball facilities, including locker room renovations, rebuilt pitching mounds, new dugout benches, and new fencing along the right and left field lines at Scott Park.

"We're very excited about all the renovations and work we have completed to this point," Reinstetle said. "As soon as I got here, my focus was to upgrade and enhance the areas that would impact player development. Our players are thrilled with what we have done, and it has already had an impact on our recruiting efforts. I couldn't be happier with how everything has turned out."

Reinstetle also had to put together a coaching staff, which includes a couple new names and one familiar face. Tommy Winterstein will serve as Toledo's pitching coach and Sean Repay will be the Rockets' volunteer assistant coach. Returning for his 12th season as an assistant coach is Nick McIntyre.

"When I was hired to be head coach at Toledo, I knew that one of my first priorities was to get my staff in place," Reinstetle said. "Nick has all the qualities that I was looking for in an assistant, and we share a lot of the same principles. He is a very knowledgeable baseball coach, yet he is versatile in his roles. He has that energy that I was looking for and is wellliked by everyone."



Reinstetle and Winterstein worked with each other at WKU when the latter was a volunteer assistant. Winterstein

is entering new territory, having never led a pitching staff before, but Reinstetle has been impressed with what he's seen.

"Tommy has taken the reins of the pitching staff and has done far better than I could have even imagined," Reinstetle said. "He's been outstanding."

As for Repay, he comes to Toledo from Indiana University Southeast, where he was the team's pitching coach. According to Reinstetle, Repay's pitching background gives the Rockets a coaching advantage.

"On a lot of college coaching staffs, three of the coaches are focused more on the position players and the fourth coach handles pitching," he said. "But rosters are almost split half and half between pitchers and hitters. For me, I wanted to bring in another assistant coach who could support Tommy with the pitchers. It helps gives us a better coach-to-player ratio."

Reinstetle and his staff hope to get the Rockets back on track this season after missing the MAC Tournament last year.

"The players have really bought into what my staff and I are trying to do," Reinstetle said. "I can already see the positive results in the team culture and the way we go about our business on a daily basis. We're excited to see what this group can do this spring."
