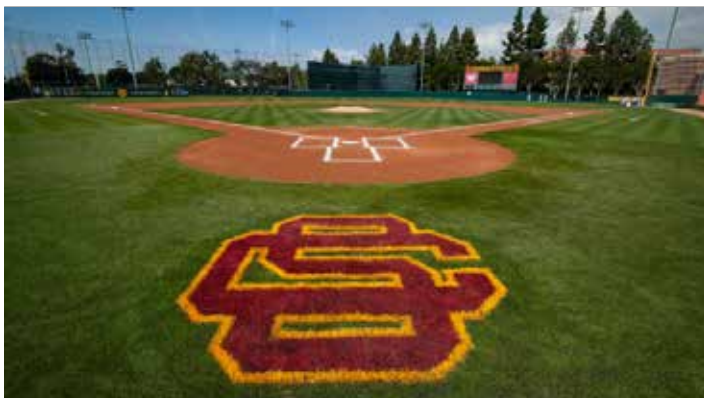

Dedeaux Field

You knew there had to be something special about Dedeaux Field from the day it first opened its gates on March 30, 1974.

Righthander Russ McQueen threw a no-hitter that afternoon in the first game ever played at Dedeaux Field as USC swept a doubleheader from California. The Trojans went on to win the national championship that year and Dedeaux Field has been their home ever since.

The 2020 season marks the 46th season of play at Dedeaux Field.

The facility has continually been improved over recent years with the grandest project taking place before the 2002 season. A \$4 million project signified the largest improvement made to the facility as a new clubhouse and players' lounge were added on the first base side. Expanded offices for the coaching staff and new Hall of Fame were also part of the project, along with a new restroom pavilion.

A new bleacher section was added on the first base side, pushing capacity to 2,500 at Dedeaux Field.

The 2008 season brought a new scoreboard, along with the million-dollar Rod Dedeaux Research for Baseball Institute (RDRBI) which added batting cages, a new weight room and state-of-the-art video motion analysis.

Prior to the 2011 season, a \$600,000 project added new lights to Dedeaux Field to bring the facility to NCAA-mandated standards for hosting postseason play.

With dimensions of 335 feet down the right and left field lines, 365 in the right field power alleys and 375 to the left field power alleys, and 395 to straightaway center, Dedeaux Field is a natural grass field.

Dedeaux Field has also been used extensively by the entertainment industry. It has been the site of MTV's "Rock-and-Jock" softball game and was used in the production and filming of several motion pictures, including "Mr. Baseball," "The Big Leaguer," "A League of Their Own" and "For Love of the Game."

TROJANS

Jason Gill, who has College World Series experience as both a player and coach, and guided Loyola Marymount to the brink of a 2019 NCAA Super Regional appearance, was named USC baseball's head coach on June 14, 2019.

Gill comes to USC after 11 seasons at Loyola Marymount, where he posted a 322-286-1 (.530) overall record. This past year, he led the Lions to a 34-25 record and into the NCAA postseason, with LMU reaching the final of the Los Angeles Regional after wins over Baylor and UCLA, before narrowly falling to the top-seeded Bruins.

Gill's LMU teams have made the West Coast Conference Tournament (top four teams in the conference) five of the last six years, with the Lions winning the tournament title this past season and a regular season title in 2017.

He has made a total of four trips to Omaha as a player and coach, reaching the College World Series as a player with Cal State Fullerton in 1994 and then returning as an undergraduate assistant under legendary coach Augie Garrido with the Titans' 1995 National Championship squad. Gill later served under George Horton as an assistant coach at his alma mater, helping to lead the Titans to CWS appearances in 2006 and 2007. In total, Gill has been to the postseason nine times as a coach.

Known as an outstanding recruiter and developer of talent, Gill has seen 31 Lions selected in the MLB Draft during his tenure at LMU and three of them have reached the big leagues, including David Fletcher with the Angels. Over the entirety of his coaching career, both as an assistant and head coach, Gill has worked with 24 players who went on to make it to the majors. Notable names on that list include Khris Davis, Justin Turner, Lyle Overbay, Aaron Rowand, Mike Lamb, Mark Kotsay and Jeremy Giambi.

Gill brought in a pair of Top 25 recruiting classes while at LMU, something that hadn't been done in 15 years at the school. In total during his time as an assistant, Gill served as a collegiate recruiting coordinator for seven seasons, recording six recruiting classes in the Top 30 and two in the Top 10 over that span to solidify his place as one of the top recruiters in the country. In his 11 years as a head coach at LMU, Gill helped develop 62 All-WCC players, four WCC Defensive Players of the Year, two WCC Pitchers of the Year and five All-Americans.

Prior to his time at LMU, he was the hitting coach and recruiting coordinator under Horton at both Cal State Fullerton and Oregon, bringing in a Top 10 recruiting class in 2007 at Fullerton. He was Horton's first hire as both men left Cal State Fullerton to begin the reconstruction of the Oregon baseball program in 2007.

Gill spent the three years (2001-04) preceding his time with the Titans at UC Irvine, where he brought in the No. 8 class in the country for the Anteaters in 2002 and had a pair of Top 30 classes following that. At UC Irvine, he helped guide the program back from extinction and worked alongside then UCI head coach John Savage to get the Anteaters back to the postseason in 2004.

Gill was an assistant at LMU in 1999 and 2000, helping to lead the Lions to WCC titles in both seasons, and prior to that worked as an assistant at Nevada (1997-98), helping to lead the Wolfpack to the program's second ever postseason appearance.

He also comes to the Trojans with Team USA experience, serving as an assistant coach for the U.S. Collegiate National Team in both 2012 and 2016.

NOTES

1970 CHAMPS: USC will honor the Trojans' 1970 NCAA Championship team this weekend, marking the 50th anniversary of USC's sixth College World Series title winning team. The 1970 alums will be honored prior to Sunday's game against UCLA. The alums will also have an event on Saturday and will be recognized at the USC basketball game against UCLA that afternoon. The 1970 champs, led by legendary coach Rod Dedeaux, went 45-13 that season, defeating Florida State 2-1 in the title game. It was the first of an unprecedented five straight titles for USC. See page 30 of the notes for more info on the 1970 team.

SATURDAY DOUBLE FEATURE: The Trojans' men's basketball team will be playing UCLA on Saturday at the Galen Center starting at 12:15 p.m. Trojan fans who attend that game can use their ticket to also attend USC's baseball game against reigning NCAA Champions Vanderbilt at 2 p.m. for no additional charge.

A NEW ERA BEGINS: The Trojans open the 2020 season with a new manager at the helm in collegiate coaching veteran Jason Gill. Gill was hired this past June to replace Dan Hubbs, whose contract was not renewed after seven seasons. A 25-year veteran of the college coaching ranks, Gill is the fifth USC head coach since the famed Rod Dedeaux retired in 1986. He comes to USC after 11 years at the helm for Loyola Marymount and a postseason run into the finals of the UCLA regional last season.

SERIES VS TCU: TCU leads 5-4 | Last meeting: 2018 | Notes: The teams last played in the Dodger Stadium Classic in 2018, with TCU picking up a 10-1 win.

SERIES VS VANDERBILT: VU leads 3-1 | Last meeting: 2015 | Notes: Vanderbilt was in town for the 2018 Dodger Stadium Classic, but their game against the Trojans was rained out. USC won the last meeting between the teams, 6-5, in the 2015 Dodger Stadium Classic.

SERIES VS UCLA: USC leads 263-143 | Last meeting: 2019 | Note: The crosstown classic was first played in 1928. UCLA won three of the four meetings last year. The two teams will play a conference series at UCLA (May 21-23) to close the year. Sunday's game this week will count as a non-conference matchup for the teams.

LAST WEEK: The Trojans won 2-of-3 games against Seton Hall at home last weekend, dropping the opener before coming back to win the final two. USC then fell to UC Irvine, 5-1, on Tuesday, despite 6.0 no-hit innings from Brian Gursky.

PLAYER NOTES:

- **Brian Gursky** tossed a career-high 6.0 no-hit innings against UC Irvine, giving up just an unearned run. He also struck out a career-best seven batters.
- After battling through injuries the past two seasons, **Alex Cornwell** impressed in his debut on the mound, throwing 5.2 innings against Western Michigan. He picked up the win giving up three hits and two runs while striking out six batters and walking two. Cornwell also had a strong outing against Seton Hall, tossing a season-high 6.0 innings, giving up one run.
- **Johnny Olmstead** had an explosive start to his collegiate career, hitting a pinch-hit grand slam against Western Michigan in his first ever at-bat as a Trojan.

SEASON NOTES

- **Ben Ramirez** posted the first two-homer game of his career, hitting two balls off the right field scoreboard against the Broncos. He also hit a key three-run triple to spark USC's comeback against San Diego State. Ramirez is second on the team with 9 RBI on the year.
- Grad transfer **Ben Wanger** leads the team and is 17th in the country and second in the Pac-12 with a .484 batting average and has also posted 4.1 relief innings on the mound without an earned run. Wanger had a 4-for-4 day against Fullerton, hitting 3 doubles and driving in 3 runs. Wanger also has a .584 on-base percentage, good for 28th in the country, and a .677 slugging percentage.
- **Clay Owens** is tied for the team lead with 15 hits this year, leads the team with 13 RBI and is second with a .395 avg. His average is ninth in the Pac-12 and 13 RBI are sixth.
- **Jamal O'Guinn** has worked 12 free bases in 45 plate appearances to help him to a .533 on-base percentage. O'Guinn's nine walks are eighth in the Pac-12.
- In his first start this year, **John Beller** threw a season-high 7.0 shutout innings against Seton Hall, striking out six batters. Beller's 1.12 ERA is eighth in the Pac-12 and his .140 opponent batting average is third in the league among qualifying pitchers.
- Freshman **Rhyllan Thomas** has been a spark plug for the USC offense since being inserted in the leadoff spot, batting .394 which is good for 10th in the Pac-12.
- Freshman **Tyresse Turner** has also given USC a spark at the top of the lineup, currently sitting second in the Pac-12 with six stolen bases. He has yet to be caught stealing.
- **Ethan Hoopingartner** has proven to be a reliable arm out of the bullpen for USC as a freshman, making a team-high seven appearances so far and posting a 1.08 ERA. His seven appearances are 17th in the NCAA and third in the Pac-12.
- **Isaac Esqueda** is seventh in the Pac-12 with just three runs allowed so far this year. He owns a 1.20 ERA, good for 10th in the league.

TEAM NOTES

- USC's 7-4 record is tied for fourth best in the Pac-12.
- The Trojans have taken 2-of-3 games each of the first three weekends to start the year.
- USC is second in the Pac-12 in batting average (.291).
- The Trojans' .982 fielding percentage is 26th in the country and second in the Pac-12.
- USC has seven triples on the year, leading the Pac-12 and sitting fifth in the NCAA.
- Trojan batters have recorded the second fewest strikeouts in the Pac-12 so far, with a total of 72 in 11 games.
- USC is third in the Pac-12 with 15 stolen bases.
- The Trojans' 2.39 team ERA is second in the conference.
- Trojan pitchers have surrendered just 16 extra-base hits this year, second fewest in the Pac-12.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE: Including defending national champs Vanderbilt, USC faces seven teams that made it to the 2019 postseason this year (TCU, Stanford, Cal, Oregon State, Arizona State and UCLA). Four Trojan opponents finished last year in the Top 25 (Vanderbilt-No. 1, UCLA-No. 8, Stanford-No. 10, Oregon State-No. 23) and two others were receiving votes at the end of the year (Arizona State, Cal). Of the Trojans' 24 opponents, 13 finished with records better than .500.

TOP PROSPECTS: D1Baseball.com released its Pac-12 prospect rankings and impact freshmen lists, and nine USC baseball players were named to the lists. The prospect rankings included lists for the 2020 and 2021 drafts, to go along with the Top 30 impact freshmen in the conference. In addition, Kyle Hurt was named the No. 98 draft prospect nationally by MLB Pipeline. *2020 Draft Prospects:* No. 14 – RHP Kyle Hurt, No. 17 – RHP Chandler Champlain, No. 20 – SS Ben Ramirez, No. 23 – 3B Jamal O'Guinn, No. 39 – LHP Alex Cornwell, No. 50 – LHP John Beller. *2021 Draft Prospects:* No. 26 – RHP Carson Lambert, No. 38 – OF Preston Hartsell. *Impact Freshmen:* No. 29 – OF/INF Tyresse Turner.

DRAFTED: The Trojans lost seven players to last year's MLB Draft, and had one more sign as a free agent immediately following the draft. Chris Clarke was taken in the fourth round by the Cubs, Blake Sabol in the seventh round by the Pirates, CJ Stubbs in the 10th round by the Astros, Connor Lunn in the 11th round by the Cardinals, Matthew Acosta in the 12th round by the Padres, Austin Manning in the 19th round by the Royals and Augie Sytk in the 38th round by the Royals. Chase Bushor also signed as a free agent with the Royals. It was the most players selected for the Trojans since 12 USC players were taken in the 2016 draft.

LAST YEAR: The Trojans went 25-29-1 overall last year and 13-15-1 in conference play, finishing seventh in the Pac-12 and missing the postseason.

USC TO THE MLB: No other school can claim a larger number of alumni who have made it to the big leagues, with 114 Trojans having played in the MLB. The list includes three Trojans who have made it to the MLB Hall of Fame (Randy Johnson, Tom Seaver, Pat Gillick), nine Cy Young Awards (Johnson 5 times, Seaver 3 times, Barry Zito once), three Rookie of the Years (Seaver, Fred Lynn, Mark McGwire), one American League MVP (Lynn), one World Series MVP (Johnson), 29 World Series appearances and 67 All-Star Game appearances. In all, 340 Trojans have been selected in the MLB Draft.

CHAMPIONSHIP HISTORY: The Trojans have an unparalleled history of championship success at the College World Series, winning 12 total national titles (1948, 1958, 1961, 1963, 1968, 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973, 1974, 1978, 1998). The 12 titles are double any other team in the country and were won in 21 CWS appearances by the Trojans. USC won five straight NCAA Championships from 1970-74, a feat no other program has accomplished.

Two years later, USC won the first of an unprecedented five straight NCAA baseball titles, though it took many extra innings to accomplish the feat.

As in 1958 and 1963, the Trojans lost their opening game, 4-1 to Ohio, and had to win all of the rest of their games for the national title. The loss to the Bobcats snapped the Trojans' 13-game winning streak. But the Trojans came back with easy victories over Delaware, 7-1, and Dartmouth, 6-1.

Things looked bleak in the next game against Texas when the Trojans fell behind, 7-1, after six innings. But USC exploded for six runs in the top of the seventh, and the game stayed tied until the top of the 14th inning, when outfielder Jeff Pedersen singled and scored on shortstop Cal Meier's triple. Righthander Jim Barr pitched eight innings of scoreless relief in the 8-7 victory.

In an interesting situation, the remaining three teams — USC, Texas and Florida State — all had records of 3-1. The Trojans won a coin flip, giving them a bye and putting them into the final.

The championship game against Florida State was another extra-inning affair, as it took 15 innings to earn a 2-1 victory. Barr pitched another eight scoreless innings in relief on just one day's rest to earn the win.

Meier led off the bottom of the 15th inning with a walk. Third baseman Dan Storigrosz walked and rightfielder Dave Kingman singled to load the bases with nobody out. Second baseman Frank Alfano, who already had two hits on the day, singled home the winning run.

USC won the regular-season Pac-8 title, the Pac-8 Tournament and the District 8 Playoffs before moving on to the CWS.
