HEAD COACH JEREMY ORGAN

Jeremy Organ is in his 14th season as the head coach of the Vanderbilt swimming team.

Bringing in a strong freshman classes, Organ and the Commodores saw a successful 2018-19 season conquering a 6-4 overall record. The Dores opened the season taking down Campbell followed by sweeping the quad meet against Colorado School of Mines, Colorado Mesa University and Air Force Academy. At the Houston Invite, Organ coached the Commodores to an eighth-place finish with multiple swimmers earning season best and personal best times. Wrapping up the season at the 2019 SEC Championships, the Commodores set new freshman records as well as a new school record in the 100 back.

The Dores fought through a tough schedule in the 2017-18 season however, Coach Organ coached multiple swimmers to beat their personal records as well as beat previous school records. The Phill Hansel Invitational, the SEC Championships and the CSCAA National Invitational were all strong tournaments for the Dores where multiple swimmers took the podium and accomplished their best times. Overall the team finished with an even 4-4 record under Coach Organ and are working towards becoming even stronger going into the 2018-19 season.

The Dores faced a challenged slate of teams during the 2016-17 season. Over the course of the year, they faced four SEC opponents, including in-state foe Tennessee. The schedule prepared the team for the SEC Championships which they set two school records and numerous personal bests against the best competition in the conference.

The 2015-16 season saw continued success for the 'Dores in the pool. They finished the year at 8-7, achieving their second-consecutive winning season for the first time since the program was resurrected in 2006. The Commodores were led by their lone senior Hannah Martin but saw major contributions from the young core that Organ brought to campus the previous year. The sophomore class was led by Kara Lucenti and Breanna Sapienza. That second year class played a role in all six school records that were set the previous year. Organ also brought in another talented freshman class led by Johanna Goldblatt who set a freshman record in the 50 freestyle. All four freshman last season made swims at the SEC Championships. The 'Dores opened and closed the SEC Championships with school records for the second consecutive season.

In 2014-15 Organ and the 'Dores went 10-9, defeating Campbell, WKU, UALR, UWF, UNF, Marshall, Xavier and Wingate. At the 2015 SEC Championships, Vanderbilt opened and closed the competition breaking a school record. In all, the Commodores broke eight school records in the Auburn Tiger's pool and finished 12th with 173 points. In all, five freshman records were set during the 2014-15 season. Organ brought in several talented freshmen that proved to be essential to the Commodores success in the freestyle, butterfly, backstroke and relay events.

He continues to show improvement with a program that was resurrected in 2006. To cap off the 2013 season the Commodores broke 14 school records at SECs, only to out-do the feat last season setting 15 school marks. Vandy also posted six NCAA B-cuts in the 2014 season SEC Championships, two

better than the 2012-13 season.

During the 2011-12 season, he oversaw his 200 medley relay team that set a new school record at the SEC Championships and Caroline Thomas set a new school record in the 100 yard freestyle, while four individual swimmers set new personal records at the SEC Championships. The squad picked up meet wins versus Marshall and Arkansas-Little Rock for the season.

The 2010-11 squad continued to improve throughout the season, culminating with seven school records being set at the 2011 SEC Championships (five individual, two relay). The team also scored a dual meet win at Marshall.

This came following a 2009-10 season that saw progress, as well. While the team finished 10th at the SEC Championships, the swimmers posted 92% season best times with almost half being lifetime bests.

In 2006, Organ directed the first swim team at Vanderbilt since the 1992 season when the university was forced to drop the team. The Commodores finished the season with an 0-3 dual meet record and finished 10th at the team's first Southeastern Conference meet since 1992.

Before coming to Vanderbilt, Organ served as the senior assistant coach of the Nashville Aquatic Club, one of swimming's most competitive club teams. While coaching the NAC, Organ mentored six national championship qualifiers in addition to assisting 20 swimmers earn Division I scholarships.

Organ also served as the senior coach at the Greater Pensacola Aquatic Club. While in Pensacola, the club produced several national qualifiers and national age group top-16 swimmers.

Organ enjoyed a highly successful collegiate career, swimming at the University of North Dakota. While at UND, Organ was a six-time All-American. Organ also earned North Central Conference Swimmer of the Year honors in 1995.

Following graduation, Organ stayed with North Dakota to become Head Assistant Coach from 1996-2000. He helped establish the swimming strength and conditioning program, supervising student-athlete's academic progress and implementing community service programs.

While working as a coach at UND, Organ also served as the head coach for the Forks Area Swim Team. During that time, he garnered North Dakota Age Group Coach of the Year honors in 1998 and 1999.

Organ also has extensive experience in overseeing the growth of several swim programs, including the Great Pensacola Aquatic Club, where he nearly doubled the senior swim program in just two years. Also, while Organ was with the Nashville Aquatic Club, the program grew from 250 participants in 2002, to over 300 swimmers in 2005.

A native of Cranbrook British Columbia Canada, Organ is married to the former Margaret Davidson. They have two daughters, Ella and Kathryn Rose, and are the proud owners of two dogs, Nash and Napa.

ASSISTANT COACH CHELSEA BAILEY

The 2019-20 season is the first for Chelsea Bailey as an assistant coach with the Vanderbilt swimming program.

A native of Seattle, Washington, Bailey has always had a passion for the water. During her 14 years of competitive swimming, she qualified multiple times for World Trials, NCAA Championships, and national championships, and competed in the 2016 Olympic Trials.

Bailey attended, graduated, and swam for San Diego State, earning a bachelor's in social science with an emphasis in psychology. While there, she was an active member of the Aztecs' student-athlete committee, qualified as an All-American, served as team captain for two years, and was recognized as a scholar athlete while also earning dean's list recognition.

Upon completion of the Olympic Trials, Bailey felt naturally drawn to coaching and had the desire to give back to the sport that shaped so much of her young life. She became an assistant coach at Seattle University, where she guided the sprint group to a successful 2018-19 season.

After moving to Tennessee, Chelsea became an assistant coach to the Nashville Aquatic Club's senior group while obtaining her master's in secondary education from Grand Canyon.

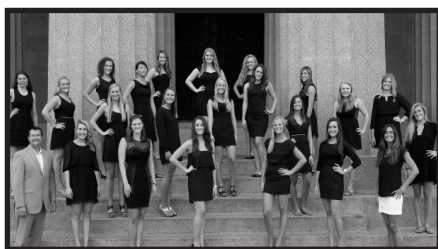

CENTENNIAL SPORTSPLEX



Located just off campus near Centennial Park, the Centennial Sportsplex serves as the home and practice facility for the Vanderbilt swimming and diving team. Opened in 1990, it is Middle Tennessee's premier fitness, recreation and sports complex.

The 145,000-square-foot facility contains two pools, including a 50 meters by 25 meters competition pool and a diving well with a depth of 14 feet and three spring boards: two one-meter boards and a three-meter. The Tracy Caulkins Competition Pool is considered one of the fastest in the Southeast, and has a state-of-the-art Colorado timing scoreboard that provides swimmer, coaches and fans easy-to-read results.

Centennial Sportsplex also features facilities for ice skating, fitness and tennis. It is also the practice facility for the NHL's Nashville Predators.

VANDERBILT ADMINISTRATION

Candice Storey Lee, a native of Madison, Alabama, and former student-athlete at Vanderbilt, is the interim vice chancellor for athletics and university affairs and interim athletic director.

Lee is Vanderbilt's first female athletic director and the first African American woman to head an SEC athletics program. Lee has served as an integral leader at the university and in Athletics for almost 20 years, most recently serving as deputy director of the program, a role she was appointed to in 2016. She has also served as the department's senior woman administrator since 2004.

In addition to her responsibilities of overseeing the day-to-day operations of the athletics department, she is also the sport administrator for the football and women's basketball programs.

In 2019, Sports Business Journal named Lee to its "Power Players: College Sports" list, which recognizes individuals who have "distinguished themselves as some of the best thinkers, problem-solvers and dealmakers in college sports and they will play a distinctly important role in its future." In 2018, Adidas named Lee to its prestigious "NEXT UP" class, comprising "senior-level administrators, handpicked by some of the most respected athletic directors in the industry, who are believed to be ready to take the next step as athletic directors in their own right."

Along with her roles as associate vice chancellor and deputy athletic director, Lee has served as the department's senior woman administrator since 2004. She oversees the day-to-day operations of the athletics department and also serves as the sport administrator for the football and women's basketball programs. Lee formerly served as a member of the NCAA Women's Basketball Rules Committee, is the former chair of the NCAA Division I Women's Lacrosse Committee and a former chair of the SEC Senior Woman Administrators.

In September 2019, Lee was named a 2019-20 fellow of the Tennessee Independent Colleges and Universities Association's Pressnell Executive Leadership Institute. She is a member of the 2012 Class of Leadership Nashville, the 2012 Vanderbilt Leadership Academy, the YWCA of Middle Tennessee Board of Directors and the SEC Executive Committee.

As a captain and four-year letter winner for Vanderbilt's women's basketball team, Lee graduated with a bachelor of science degree in human and organizational development in 2000. She also received her master's degree in counseling from Vanderbilt in 2002, and in 2012, Lee earned her doctorate from Vanderbilt in higher education administration.

She is married to Sean Lee, who is the executive director of the Smyrna Housing Authority.
