TCU NOTABLES

- TCU saw its five game winning streak come to an end with an extra-inning loss on Tuesday.
- TCU has opened the season with a 10-2 mark for the sixth time under Jim Schlossnagle.
- TCU leads the Big 12 and ranks ninth nationally with a 2.13 ERA.
- TCU has allowed two or fewer earned runs in a game seven times this season.
- TCU is averaging 7.9 runs per game which is second in the Big 12 and 30th nationally.
- TCU's 28 doubles ranks 18th nationally and the 24 stolen bases are 23rd nationally.
- Gray Rodgers has reached safely in all 12 games this season and owns a six game hitting streak.
- Tommy Sacco has reached safely in 10 straight contests.
- Six Horned Frogs have registered at least 10 RBIs this season led by 13 from Austin Henry.
- Harrison Beethe and Haylen Green each tallied a save over the weekend.
- Zach Humphreys ranks 11th nationally with seven doubles.

ROAD/NEUTRAL SITE NOTABLES

- TCU will play 24 road games during the 2020 season.
- TCU went 9-12 on the road in 2019 and is 2-1 to start the 2020 season.
- TCU is 72-61 in road regular season non-conference games since 2004.
- TCU is 219-149 on the road under the guidance of Jim Schlossnagle.
- TCU went 9-5 at neutral sites in 2019.
- TCU is 86-49 all-time in neutral site contests under the tutelage of Jim Schlossnagle.

SOUTHERN CALIF. COLLEGE BASEBALL CLASSIC

- This season's appearance in the Classic will mark the program's third appearance (2015, 2018).
- TCU is 3-2 all-time in the Classic, having gone 2-1 in 2015 and 1-1 in 2018.
- The Frogs went 1-1 in the tournament two years ago with a win at USC (1-1) and a loss vs. Vanderbilt (7-4). The game at UCLA was cancelled due to weather.
- TCU is 30-17 in regular season tournaments under head coach Jim Schlossnagle.

SERIES NOTABLES

- Friday's meeting against USC will be the 10th in the all-time series.
- TCU leads the series 5-4 heading into Friday's game.
- The Frogs have made three prior trips and own a 3-2 record at Dedeaux Field.
- They took 2-of-3 in 2013, dropped an extra-inning affair in 2015 and won the lone game in 2018.
- Saturday's contest against UCLA will be the seventh in the series.
- Five of the six previous meetings have come in the postseason with the lone regular season coming in 2015 at the Classic in which TCU won 3-1.
- TCU went 1-2 against the Bruins in the 2010 CWS.
- UCLA was TCU's 2012 NCAA Super Regional opponent. The Bruins swept the Frogs in 2012 by scores of 6-2 and 4-1.
- TCU and Vanderbilt will be meeting for the sixth time and the third time in the Classic. All five meetings have been at a neutral site.
- TCU won the Classic meeting at Dodger Stadium 4-2 and 10-2 at the 2019 MLB4 Tournament in Arizona.
- Vanderbilt topped TCU twice in the 2015 College World Series.

FROG TIDBITS

Conner Shepherd has hit the last three home runs for the Horned Frogs.

Seven of Zach Humphreys' nine hits on the season have gone for doubles.

Five of Austin Henry's six hits on the year have driven in runs.

Russell Smith has surrendered three earned runs this season, all three via the solo home run.

TCU has stolen a base in all but one game this season (2/29 vs. Cal).

Prior to Tuesday, TCU had hit into just three double plays on the season. The Frogs hit into four double plays on Tuesday night.

OUT OF THE GATE

TCU has vaulted to a 10-2 record to start the season. It's the second time in the Jim Schlossnagle tenure the Frogs have won 10 of their first 11 games. The best start under Schlossnagle game in 2017 when the Frogs went 11-1 to open the campaign.

TCU's best start to a season came in 1985 when it went 11-0 to start the season and won 19 of its first 20 games.

EXTRA FUN

The Horned Frogs have registered an extra base hit in all but one game this season. They boast a .438 slugging percentage. TCU has tallied 28 doubles, three triples and 12 home runs this season.

Zach Humphreys (7 doubles) and Gray Rodgers (5 doubles, 2 home runs) lead the team with seven extra base hit.

TWO-OUT MAGIC

A big part TCU's 10-2 start to the season has been the ability to score two-out runs. TCU scored 19 two-out runs in the series at Minnesota. Seven of the 14 runs scored against Cal, including all three in Saturday's win, came with two outs.

This season, the Horned Frogs have scored 44 of 95 (46%) runs with two outs.

The Frogs are hitting .315 as a team with two outs. Six Frogs have at least five two-out hits. Eleven Frogs have registered a two-out RBI, led by eight each from Hunter Wolfe and Tommy Sacco.

TOUGH OUT

The TCU offense has been relentless early in the season, averaging 7.0 runs per game. The Horned Frogs boast a .391 on-base percentage. TCU ranks 22nd nationally in runs per game. The Frogs have only not had a base runner in 19 of 103 offensive innings played so far this season.

FRESH CONTRIBUTIONS

TCU has seen 16 players make their debuts this season. Nine of the 16 players appeared in the lineup, while seven others made their first appearance on the mound.

At the plate, the group of new faces are hitting .363 (70-for-193) with 12 doubles, six home runs and 44 runs driven in.

On the mound, the staff is 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA. They combined to strike out 55 batters in 56.2 innings of work.

MOUND DOMINANCE

Twelve different pitchers have toed the rubber this season. The group combined to post a 2.13 ERA, a mark that is ninth nationally.

Over the course of 110 innings, they faced the minimum 45 times. Only 29 times has the group faced more than four batters. TCU has only allowed a run in 20 of the 110 frames.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

The Horned Frogs have had a penchant for scoring runs in bunches since the arrival of Bill Mosiello on campus in 2014. That trend has shown itself early in the 2020 campaign. The Frogs have scored multiple runs in 26 innings this year, striking for five runs three times.

Over the last five-plus years, TCU has scored multiple runs in 604 innings. In 173 innings, TCU has produced four or more runs.

TCU has scored 10 or more runs 81 times over the last six-plus seasons and tallied 121 wins of 5+ runs. Conversely, the Frogs have lost just 36 games by five or more runs since 2014.

SPEED FACTOR

The Frogs have stolen 599 bases over the last 6+ years. TCU is averaging 2.0 stolen bases per game already this season.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced a high success rate, converting on 77% of their attempts over the last six years (599-781).

STINGY STAFF

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 172 times over the last 396 games played. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 139 times.

NATIONWIDE

The United States is well-represented on the Horned Frogs rosters. The 35 athletes hail from 14 states spanning the continental USA.

Twenty of the 36 players are from the state of Texas. Two players each are natives of Colorado (Cornelio, Sloan) and Illinois (Coughlin, Ray). The roster also features a player from Arizona (Sacco), California (Shepherd), Florida (Hudi), Iowa (Krob), Michigan (Henry), Mississippi (Wood), Missouri (Byrne), Oklahoma (Thompson), Tennessee (Wolfe), Utah (Martin) and Wisconsin (Mihlbauer).

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 65 extra inning games since 2004 and holds a 41-24 mark in those games.

TCU went to extra innings for the first time in 2020 on March 3 against UT Arlington, dropping a 6-4 decision in 12 innings.

TCU owns a 9-4 record in extra innings dating back to the 2015 campaign.

The Frogs longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.

TCU's longest regular-season extra inning game was 15 innings against Texas A&M on March 4, 2017.

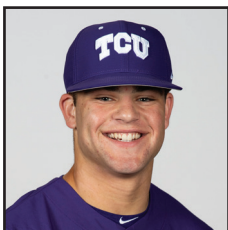

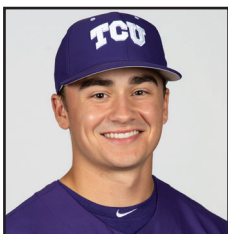
