### • BEAR TRACKS •

#### • SERIES HISTORY

UCA and Vanderbilt have met four times in baseball, with the Commodores winning all four matchups. The last was a two-game set in 2017 at Hawkins Field. All four games in the series have been played in Nashville.

The last two games in the series were played in March 2017, with Vandy winning 10-5 and 9-1. UCA hit just .200 in the two games while the Commodores hit .328. UCA's staff ERA was 9.56 while Vanderbilt's was 2.00.

The only two current Bears who saw action in that series were senior pitchers Mark Moyer and Conner Williams. Moyer started and went 4.0 innings, striking out 3 and allowing 2 hits and 2 earned runs. Williams had one relief appearance (0.1 innings) and allowed 2 hits and 1 run while striking out 1. Vandy's pitchers struck out 23 Bears and walked 11.

#### • LAST WEEKEND

The Bears won their first weekend series of the season, taking 2 of 3 games from the SIU-Edwardsville Cougars at Bear Stadium.

UCA won the opener 9-6 on Friday night behind a solid outing on the mound from junior starter Gavin Stone and a shut-down, two-inning save from senior Conner Williams. Stone struck out seven in six innings and allowed six hits and two earned runs. Williams went 2.1 innings, striking out five of the seven batters he faced, including the third out in the seventh with the bases loaded and three straight in the ninth. Connor Emmet went 3 for 4 while Beau Orlando scored three times and reached base four times.

The Bears saw their rally fall short on Saturday in a 3-2 loss. Cole Fiori led off the ninth with a double and made it to third on a wild pitch but was left stranded there. Connor Emmet, Josh Ragan and Coby Potvin had two hits each as the Bears out-hitted the Cougars 10-8.

In Sunday's finale, senior Mark Moyer set a career high with 10 strikeouts over seven innings, with just one walk and four total hits. Williams entered again in the eighth and struck out four and walked none for his league-leading fifth save (in six appearances). Benny Ayala and Ragan had two hits each for UCA.

#### • LAST MID-WEEK GAME

The Bears struck out a season-high 16 times and dropped an 8-5 decision at Memphis on Tuesday night at FedEx Park in Memphis. UCA tallied 10 hits and drew six walks but left 12 runners on base. Still, the Bears had a shot in the ninth inning as sophomore Hunter Hicks and senior Coby Potvin had consecutive one-out base hits but Memphis closer Takota Metoxen struck out the final two batters.

Hicks, a designated hitting sophomore from Sheridan, went 3 for 4 and had two RBI. Senior center fielder Josh Ragan had a pair of RBIs and junior outfielder Connor Emmet went 2 for 3. Redshirt freshman Tyler Cleveland tossed the final three innings, striking out five and allowing no hits and no runs.

#### • LAST SEASON

The Bears finished 32-27 overall and went 19-11 in the Southland Conference, good for a tie for second place in the SLC standings and a No. 2 seed at the postseason tournament.

The 19 conference victories was a school record for UCA since joining the league in 2007. The No. 2 seed for the conference tournament was also a high for the Bears.

UCA started the season 4-6, and at one point stood 10-13 before going 23-14 down the stretch. UCA won five of its final six SLC games to earn the No. 2 seed.

During the regular season, the Bears beat No. 23 Oklahoma State 8-4 in Stillwater, along with victories over Oral Roberts, Tennessee Tech (twice) and a three-game sweep of eventual SLC regular-season champion Sam Houston State.

The Bears finished 18-11 at home at Bear Stadium, and 12-3 at home in Southland games.

UCA played six extra-inning games, winning three, including a 6-3 win in 10 innings over Southeastern Louisiana in the SLC semifinals. The longest was a 12-inning, 3-1 win over SLU in the series opener in Hammond, La. Ironically, the third game of the series went 11 innings, with the Lions winning 3-2. UCA also had one run-rule game, beating Stephen F. Austin 6-3 in 10 innings in the second game of the SLC tourney.

## • 500 CLUB

UCA head coach Allen Gum joined the 300 Club in 2013, the 400 Club in 2016, and the 500-win mark last season with a win over ACU on May 12. He now stands at 510-306 as a collegiate head coach. He ranks fourth in the Southland Conference in overall career victories behind Jim Gilligan at Lamar (1,111), Butch McBroom at UT-Arlington (756) and Pat Patterson at Louisiana Tech (538).

Gum was 226-68 in five seasons at his alma mater Division II Southern Arkansas (Magnolia, Ark.), and is now 284-238 in his 10th season at UCA. He is the winningest coach in UCA history, ahead of second-place Doug Clark (209 wins, 2003-10).

## • ALL-SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE

The Bears had three players named All-Southland Conference last season, along with one honorable mention, and two others named to the SLC All-Defensive team.

Three of those players (LHP Noah Cameron, RHP Gavin Stone, OF Josh Ragan) return for 2020.

UCA tied for the team lead with five players named to the 2020 preseason All-SLC team in February. Those include: Cameron, Stone, Ragan, RHP Conner Williams and 3B Beau Orlando.

Orlando, a 5-foot-10, 195-pounder from Houston, Texas, was UCA's second leading hitter last season at .290 in 56 starts at third base, catcher and designated hitter. Orlando had 56 hits, 36 runs batted in and 36 walks, with an on-base percentage of .419. He was named to the SLC All-Tournament team.

Ragan, a 6-0, 200-pounder from Irving, Texas, tied for the team lead with four home runs a year ago, hitting .277 with a team-high 18 doubles, 31 RBI and a .427 slugging percentage. Ragan was a third-team All-SLC selection and on the SLC All-Defensive team with a .993 fielding percentage.

Williams, a 6-3, 185-pounder from Conway, went 4-1 with a 3.83 earned-run average and a pair of saves in 2019. Williams struck out 42 in 42.1 innings and walked just 15.

Stone, a 6-1, 170-pounder from Lake City, Ark., had UCA's best ERA last season at 1.52 and team-high six saves and finished with a 4-3 record. He had 58 strikeouts in 47.1 innings and walked just 11 batters and earned SLC All-Academic honors.

Cameron, a 6-3, 215-pounder from St. Joseph, Mo., was a second-team All-SLC selection last year as a freshman when he went 6-2 with a 2.95 ERA. Cameron, named a freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball, struck out 91 and walked 19 over 94.2 innings (14 starts). He struck out a career-high 13 batters against Nicholls in a four-hit shutout that earned him SLC Pitcher of the Week honors.

## • SOUTHLAND TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Bears reached the Southland Conference championship game for the fourth time since 2013, losing to McNeese 4-2 in the title game after playing a 10-inning game earlier in the day (6-3 win over Southeastern Louisiana).

UCA won the 2013 SLC Tournament as the seventh seed after losing its opener to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, then winning five consecutive elimination games, shutting out third-seeded Southeastern Louisiana 4-0 in the title game. The Bears were runnerup in 2014 as the tournament host at Bear Stadium, and again in 2017 and 2019.

In 2014, UCA beat Texas A&M-Corpus Christi 3-1 in the opener, knocked off McNeese State 11-3 the next day, beat McNeese again 8-6 in the semifinals, then lost to Southeastern Louisiana 9-4 in a rematch of the previous year's championship game.

UCA made its eighth consecutive tournament appearance last season, one of only three schools to reach the tournament every year since 2012 (McNeese, Sam Houston).

After the 2013 championship, the Bears advanced to their first NCAA Regional at Starkville, Miss. UCA went 3-3 in the regional, beating every team there (Mercer, South Alabama, MSU) before losing to the Bulldogs in the final.

Last year's No. 2 seed in the SLC Tournament was the highest for the Bears since becoming eligible for the tournament. UCA was the No. 2 seed despite losing 12 seniors from the 2018 team.

## • VICTORIES

The 19 conference victories for the Bears last season was the most since moving to the Southland Conference in 2007. The previous best was 17 (2014, 2017, 2018). UCA's overall wins mark was 42 in 2013. UCA has won at least 29 games for the past seven years. UCA has won at least 10 league games in all nine seasons under Head Coach Allen Gum.

## • FRIENDLY CONFINES

The Bears went 18-11 at home at Bear Stadium last season, and 22-13 the previous year. UCA was 20-8 in 2017 and 21-6 in 2016. They were 12-7 in 2015, making them 93-45 over the past five seasons at The Bear.

## • SENIOR CLASS

UCA must replace six seniors from last year's team, including starting pitchers Cody Davenport, Tanner Wiley and Taylor Anders; 1B Tyler Smith; 2B Jay Anderson, and OF Brett D'Amico.

Those seniors combined to win 127 games and made four consecutive trips to the Southland Conference Tournament in Sugar Land, Texas.

UCA lost five other lettermen who saw action, including OF Marco Navarro (36 games/35 starts), SS Joshmar Doran (41 games/38 starts) and pitchers Zach Smith, Matthew Patton and Gavin Heltemes.

UCA's 2020 roster features 12 seniors, the most in recent history.

## • 2020 SCHEDULE

UCA will play another formidable schedule this season, including series with Missouri State and Southern Miss in the first two weeks

of the season. The Bears will also play single games at Vanderbilt (March 2), Oral Roberts (March 24) and Oklahoma State (May 12) and host a weekend series with Tennessee Tech. UCA will face both Memphis and Arkansas State home and home and have a three-game series with Little Rock. UCA has 29 home games scheduled in 2020, including 11 of the first 16.

In Southland Conference play, the Bears will host Southeastern Louisiana, Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, Houston Baptist, Lamar and Incarnate Word, while traveling to Nicholls (Thibodaux, La.), Stephen F. Austin (Nacogdoches, Texas), McNeese (Lake Charles, La.), Sam Houston State (Huntsville, Texas) and Abilene Christian (Abilene, Texas).

## • MLB BEARS

Senior righthander Tyler Gray (7th round, 2017), junior left fielder Hunter Strong (25th, 2018) and junior catcher William Hancock (31st, 2018) were all drafted by the Kansas City Royals in the MLB Draft. Gray was the SLC Pitcher of the Year, while Strong and Hancock were first-team All-SLC selections. Gray and Hancock are still in the Royals' organization, along with last year's draftee, righthander Cody Davenport (20th round, Royals, 2019).

They are joined by former Bears' outfielder Jonathan Davis and RHP Ty Tice, who are both with the Toronto Blue Jays. Davis (15th round, 2013) was up with the Blue Jays for 37 games a year ago and was featured on ESPN SportsCenter Top Plays several times for his outfield catches. Tice (16th round, 2017, Twins) pitched mostly at the AA/AAA level last year (3-4 record, 2.34 ERA, 8 saves combined) but got a non-roster invite to spring training this month.

Gray played all of the 2019 season at Lexington (Class A full) after spending 2018 at Idaho Falls (Rookie). Hancock spent the 2019 season at Burlington (Rookie).

UCA has had 12 MLB draft selections since moving to NCAA Division I for the 2007 season. Prior to that, the Bears had only had 10 in school history. The Bears have had multiple players drafted three times in the past six years, including three each in 2013 and 2018.

## • 2019 SLC WEEKLY HONORS

True freshman left hander Noah Cameron earned Southland Conference Pitcher of the Week honors last March 18 the St. Joseph (Mo.) High School native tossed a complete-game, four-hit shutout against Nicholls, striking out a career-high 13 and walking just 1, while allowing just four singles.

Junior lefty Brad Verel earned POW honors on April 8 after earning two victories that week. He got the W in relief against No. 23 Oklahoma State with 4.2 innings, allowing six hits and two runs while striking out five and walking none. In the win over MSU, in just his second start of the season, Verel went 5 scoreless innings, allowing four hits, striking out five and walking none. For the week, Verel had a 1.86 earned run average and struck out 10 and walked one.

Senior Cody Davenport made it three UCA pitchers to receive the award on May 10 after his 13-strikeout performance in a 4-1 win over ACU. He dropped his ERA to 2.16 after the 8-inning outing in the final home appearance of his career.

## • GOVERNOR'S I-40 SHOWDOWN

The Bears and Little Rock Trojans will compete in the second year of the "Governor's I-40 Showdown" in a year-long battle between the schools who are just 25 miles apart. The teams will compete for points in each sport that both schools sponsor, amounting to 17 contests and a total of 43 points available.

UCA easily won last year's trophy, which wrapped up with the third of three meetings with the Trojans at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock, home of the Seattle Mariners' AA club, the Arkansas Travelers. A year ago, Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson threw out the first pitch. The series is one game each at UCA, at Little Rock and at the neutral site on the banks of the Arkansas River.

## NOTABLES

- Senior righthander Conner Williams has an SLC-best five saves in six appearances this season.
- UCA is third in the Southland in batting average (.267), fourth in ERA (3.50) and fourth in fielding percentage (.973). UCA is No. 1 in walks allowed with 27 (2.4 per game).
- Conner Emmet is 2nd in batting average (.452) and hits (19). Benny Ayala is tied for first in HRs with 3, while Beau Orlando is third in on-base percentage (.542).
- The Bears feature 18 newcomers on the 2020 roster.
- UCA was 12th (next to last) in the Southland Conference in batting average last season (.245) but first in earned-run average (3.50). UCA's pitching staff was second in strikeouts with 486 and first in walks with just 155. UCA's pitchers allowed a league-low 253 runs and were second in earned runs allowed (205). They also just a league-low 31 batters. The league leader was Houston Baptist, which hit 81.
- UCA's 20 home runs ranked 11th in the league but its 256 walks was second. The Bears had a league-best 64 sacrifice bunts, nearly double second-place Houston Baptist and A&M-Corpus Christi (36).
- The combination of catchers Nathaniel Sagdahl and Beau Orlando threw out an SLC-best 30 runners attempting to steal. Sagdahl threw out 26 of 62 runners (41.9%).
- UCA won eight of 10 SLC series last season, losing only to fourth-place UIW (1-2) and eighth-place Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (0-3). Both of those series were on the road.
- A year ago, UCA played only 3 of its final 14 regular-season games at home at Bear Stadium, that being an SLC series with Abilene Christian on May 10-12. UCA finished with three of four SLC series on the road. On the flip side, the Bears opened the season playing 18 of their first 23 games in Conway.
- The Bears went 2-5 against in-state competition last season, losing to LR (three times), to Arkansas State (twice) and beating UA-Pine Bluff twice.
- The Bears finished the 2019 season with 16 outfield assists, led by Josh Ragan with 8. Kolby Johnson added five and Alonso Bibiano had three, with three of Johnson's coming in the first nine games of the season of his freshman campaign. Ragan has three outfield assists through 11 games this season.
- Johnson is also penciled in as a pitcher this season after starting 39 games in right field and four in center as a freshman.
- Beau Orlando's brother Zach Orlando is a sophomore pitcher at cross-town Division III Hendrix College. The brothers are from Cy-Fair HS in Houston, Texas. Beau Orlando transferred to UCA from Navarro College prior to last season.

## HEAD COACH ALLEN GUM

Allen Gum brought a successful track record to the Central Arkansas baseball program in June 2010, and in just nine short years, has brought that same winning tradition to the Bears' program, putting it on the regional and national map. Along the way, Gum became the winning coach in UCA history and also surpassed the 500-victory mark for his career.

Under Gum's leadership, UCA has won 247 games over the past eight seasons and is the winningest coach in UCA history. The highlight was a record-setting 2013 season that saw the Bears accomplish things that had never been done before at UCA. The 2013 edition of the Bears won a school-record 42 games and reached the NCAA Regionals for the first time since moving to Division I in 2007. The real story is the route they took to get there.

The Bears entered the Southland Conference Tournament as the seventh seed, a team that finished just 12-15 in conference play during the regular season. After losing their opening game, Gum's Bears reeled off five straight elimination-game victories, eventually taking the SLC Tournament championship with a 4-0 win over Southeastern Louisiana.

That title earned the Bears a trip back to Starkville, Miss., for the NCAA Regional. Once there, the Bears defeated two conference champions in Mercer (Atlantic Sun) and South Alabama (Sun Belt) and knocked off host Mississippi State to become the only team at the Starkville Regional to defeat every opponent. UCA, which had taken a series 2-1 from the Bulldogs during the regular season, ultimately lost in a winner-take-all championship game at historic Dudy Noble Field. The Bulldogs would eventually finish as national runnerup to UCLA at the College World Series.

UCA's three victories (3-3 overall for the year) over the Bulldogs were MSU's only non-SEC losses of the season until the College World Series championship series against UCLA. In all, the Bears won eight consecutive elimination games between the SLC Tournament and Starkville Regional.

For the first time in history, UCA had three players selected in the 2014 Major League Baseball Draft. Forrestt Allday, Jonathan Davis and Jeffery Enloe were all drafted and played in their respective minor league systems last summer. Allday, the Most Valuable Player of the SLC Tournament, was named a first-team All-American by Rawlings/American Baseball Coaches Association, making him the first NCAA Division I All-American for the program.

Despite losing 10 seniors and three MLB draftees, the Bears returned to the SLC championship game again in 2014, losing to Southeastern Louisiana in the final before a packed house at Bear Stadium. UCA entered the SLC Tournament as the No. 6 seed but won three straight games to reach the title game. UCA added another draftee in senior center fielder Doug Votolato, who went in the ninth round to the Rangers.

UCA reached the SLC championship game again in 2017, making it three trips in five seasons.

Over the course of his career, Gum has won more than 400 games as a head coach.

Gum came to UCA from a highly successful five-year stint at Southern Arkansas University in Magnolia. Gum compiled a 226-68 record in five seasons at the SAU helm and recorded five consecutive 40-plus win seasons. His .769 winning percentage is the second best in the Gulf South Conference. The Muleriders have also spent 24 weeks at number one in the nation over the past three seasons.

Gum led SAU to a 47-10 record in 2010, winning the Gulf South Conference-West Division, as well as being the top seed of the NCAA II South Regional. He had four players taken in the Major League Baseball Draft, including the No. 16 overall pick, and had two more sign professional contracts.

Gum's 2009 squad was ranked No. 1 for much of the season and at 52-11, finished with the most wins in school history and advanced to the semi-finals of the NCAA Division II South Region tournament, which the Muleriders hosted by virtue of being the top seed in the region. Advancing to the Gulf South Conference tournament for the 11th consecutive year, the club captured SAU's second league championship with a 5-0 sweep in the tourney, and also claimed its first-ever share of a GSC West Division title. Despite not being one of the final eight teams to advance to the College World Series, Southern Arkansas still finished the season ranked fourth.

Gum's first year (2006) at the helm of the Muleriders proved to be quite a successful one as he led the team to a 40-18 overall record and the program's first-ever GSC championship. SAU advanced to the South Central Region tournament, making it to the semi-finals before their season ended as the 18th-ranked team in the country.

In 2007, Gum's squad concluded their first-ever back-to-back 40-win seasons as members of the NCAA when the team finished 41-17 and again made the conference tournament field. The following year, Southern Arkansas finished 46-12 and reached a No. 1 national ranking for the first time in the history of the program. They made their 10th straight league tournament and moved on to the semi-finals of the South Central regional, ending the season ranked 12th.

A native of Bentonville, Gum played collegiate baseball at Crowder Community College (now Crowder College) in Neosho, Mo., before playing two years at Southern Arkansas for Coach Steve Goodheart, who retired in 2003 after coaching the Muleriders for 23 years. Gum is a member of the Crowder College Baseball Hall of Fame.

In 1990, Gum led SAU in hitting as a junior outfielder with a .338 average and fielded .975 as Southern Arkansas won the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference (AIC) championship with a 20-4 record and finished the season 27-23 overall. As a senior, Gum hit .328 and fielded .961 while helping the Muleriders win their sixth consecutive AIC championship with a 20-4 record and an overall record of 44-15-1. The 1991 team also won the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) Area 5 Tournament by defeating the nation's number-one ranked team, North Florida, in the championship game, to advance to the NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho. Gum was honored with the Charles Berry Hustle Award at the World Series.

Prior to returning to SAU, Gum served as assistant baseball coach at Sheridan High School for six years, before moving to Batesville as the head baseball coach in 2000. Batesville had a 75-25 record in his three years with the Pioneers, and was the Class AAAA runner-up in 2002 and 2003. Gum served two seasons (2004-2005) as an assistant coach for Southern Arkansas before assuming the head coaching duties.

Gum is married to the former Shenna Calloway of Strong, and they have two sons, Tyler, a UCA student, and Calloway.
