OPENING TIP

- Alabama picked up its ninth overall win and second in Southeastern Conference play on Thursday against LSU.
- The victory for the Crimson Tide ended a three-game losing skid to the Lady Tigers.
- Alabama has now won two of its first three games in league play for the first time since 2017.
- As a team, the Tide is ranked in the top 50 nationally in assist/turnover ratio (33rd), assists (18th), free throw attempts (seventh), free throws made (sixth), free throw percentage (14th), rebounds (29th), scoring margin (45th), scoring offense (40th), three-point field goals attempted (24th), three-point field goals made (17th), three-point field goals per game (42nd) and turnovers per game (39th).
- Individually, Hannah Barber, Ariyah Copeland, Jordan Lewis and Jasmine Walker are ranked nationally in the top 50 in several categories as well.
- Sunday's game will be the 52nd between the two programs with the Commodores leading the series 34-17, however the Tide has won the last five matchups between the two.

- Alabama will be Vanderbilt's first SEC opponent of the season as the Commodores have not played a game since Dec. 20.
- VU had their final nonconference game, which was slated for Dec. 28 against Samford, canceled and their first three league contests postponed.
- The Commodores have won their last four games after dropping the season opener, 82-74, at Little Rock.
- Vanderbilt has won all three of its home games with victories coming against ETSU (81-61), VCU (90-81) and Gardner-Webb (97-58).
- The Commodores are averaging 84.4 points per game, outscoring opponents by 12.4 per contest, while shooting 45.2 percent from the floor.

- Vanderbilt is led in nearly every category by 2020 SEC All-Freshman Team member Koi Love, who averages 22.4 points, 11.0 rebounds, 2.6 steals and 1.6 blocks per game.
- The Commodores are under the direction of Stephanie White, who is in her fifth season at Vanderbilt. She took over in Nashville after having spent two seasons as the head coach of the WNBA's Indiana Fever.

TIDE STANDS AT NO. 26 IN LATEST NET RANKINGS

• In the first installment of the NET, which was announced on Jan. 3, Alabama came in at No. 19. The Tide currently stands at 26th following Thursday's win against LSU.

POINTS A PLENTY

- Alabama scored 74 or more points in its first eight games of the season. The Tide had 83 in the opener against Samford, 88 versus Houston, 98 in the win over USC Upstate, 76 at Oklahoma State, 78 at Mercer, 86 against Nicholls and 74 at Memphis and Missouri.
- The last time Alabama opened the season with eight-straight 74-plus point performances was in 1993-94 when the Tide recorded nine games in a row of 74 or more.

LIVING AT THE LINE

- Alabama hit 32 of its 38 attempts from the free throw line to finish 84.2 percent in the win over Houston on Nov. 25.
- UA's 32 made free throws against were the most since it had 36 against Ole Miss on Jan. 5, 2017.
- Six different players went to the free throw line for the Tide including Ariyah Copeland (10-12), Jordan Lewis (9-9), Jasmine Walker (6-8), Hannah Barber (4-4), Megan Abrams (3-4), and Myra Gordon (0-1).
- Alabama currently ranks 14th in the nation and first in the SEC in free-throw percentage on the season at 78.9 percent and is sixth nationally in free throws made (176).
- Comparatively speaking, the Tide has taken nearly double the amount of attempts from the free throw line than its opponents (223-130).

• Alabama has had 10 different players go perfect from the line on multiple attempts in at least one of the Tide's 10 games this season.

DISCIPLINED DEFENSE

- Alabama is one of the top teams in the nation when it comes to getting to the free throw line, ranking seventh in the nation in free throw attempts. On the flip side, the Tide has been extremely disciplined on the defensive end, committing only 14.1 fouls per game.
- That average ranks 16th nationally and first in the SEC.

DISCIPLINED DEFENSE

- Alabama is one of four SEC teams scheduled to play seven league games against ranked league opponents, joining LSU, Ole Miss and Missouri.
- The Tide will play 5/4 South Carolina and 14/15 Mississippi State twice and 10/8 Kentucky, 8/7 Texas A&M and 13/13 Arkansas once.

THREE-HEADED MONSTER

- Alabama's trio of seniors in Ariyah Copeland, Jordan Lewis and Jasmine Walker has been instrumental to the Tide's success from both a statistical and leadership standpoint.
- The three are affixed at the top of the stat sheet, accounting for over 62 percent of Alabama's scoring and 51 percent of its rebounds.

HARD IN THE PAINT

- Jordan Lewis has never been one to shy away from driving to the hoop with her aggressive play at the point guard position.
- In the eight games she's played this season, she's drawn a total of 49 fouls (average of 6.1 per game), which has resulted in 47 points from the line for the Tide.

WHO'S UP?

- Alabama is fortunate to have multiple players that can step up and score points, when needed
- Ten of the 12 players that have seen time on the court this season have recorded double-digit points in at least one game.
- Three different players have recorded multiple 20-plus point games this season in Jasmine Walker (6), Ariyah Copeland (4) and Jordan Lewis (3).
- Hannah Barber has also added one game over 20 points to the mix.

BIG PRAISE FOR BIG 40

- Jasmine Walker made a commitment to herself and the team in the offseason to really elevate her game, and she is doing just that. In the preseason press conference, Walker said, "I want to win. I want to be SEC First Team. I want to go Pro. I want it all, and I'm going to go for it."
- In a Dec. 21 article on ESPN.com, Mechelle Voepel had high praise for Walker saying, "Led by senior forward Jasmine Walker who averages 22.1 PPG and 9.9 RPG and is someone to watch in the WNBA draft ..."
- Coach Curry also had nothing but positives to say about Jas following the Nicholls game when she scored her 1,000th point: "For what she's done in the time that she's been here, it's just been amazing ... I love how she's become not just a shooter, but a scorer, and it's all because of her hard work. We talk a lot about development, but I think when players decide to own their development, and she's a player that has really owned her development, and she's gotten better because of the things she's taken away from practice and her individual time with Coach Kelly to getting in the gym on her own."

BIG 40 GOES FOR 1,000

- Jasmine Walker scored the 1,000th point of her Alabama career on Dec. 16 against Nicholls on an and-1 at the 3:37 mark of the second quarter.
- She is the 30th member of Alabama's 1,000 Point Club, which she entered in under three full seasons with the Tide.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK 20s FOR BIG 40

- Jasmine Walker scored 20-plus points in Alabama's first four games of the 2020 non-conference slate, including a then-career-best 25 against Houston.
- It marked the first time in her career that she's had four-straight 20-plus point games.
- Walker is also the first UA player since Dominique Canty in 1998 with four-consecutive 20-plus point games and first since Shalonda Enis in 1995 to begin the season with four-straight. Enis had five-consecutive to start the 1995 season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Ariyah Copeland and Jasmine Walker both notched double-doubles in Alabama's win over USC Upstate on Dec. 2. They became the first Alabama duo to record double-doubles in the same game since Walker and Cierra Johnson did so against Ole Miss on Feb. 28, 2019.
- Copeland also had back-to-back games with double-doubles as she had 18 points and 14 rebounds against Houston on Nov. 25.
- Copeland now has 11 career double-doubles, while Walker has 15.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION FOR BIG 40

- Jasmine Walker picked up a pair of preseaon honors as she was one of 20 named to the Katrina McClain Watch List, which is presented annually to the nation's top power forward. Days later, she earned a spot on the Preseason All-SEC Second Team, voted on by the league coaches.
- Big 40 averaged 11.9 points and 7.1 rebounds last season while playing 31.2 minutes per contest.
- She now has 15 career double-doubles and is among the SEC's active leaders in rebounding (No. 4 661) and scoring (No. 8 1,078).

LEWIS DOES IT ALL

- Jordan Lewis has been the heartbeat of the team since she stepped foot on the court her first game. She's started in all 113 games she has played in and will go down as one of the best point guards in program history.
- She is currently the SEC's active career leader in assists (434) and ranks fifth in scoring (1,285), 12th in rebounding (460) and fourth in steals (137).
- Lewis earned the program's first SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year award in 2020. She graduated with a degree in marketing in August 2019 and is currently working on her MBA. She is a four-time SEC Academic Honor Roll member and was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team in 2020.
- She is active in the community, and was named to the SEC Community Service Team for the third consecutive year. Lewis is also a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated.

WELCOME BACK, WELCOME BACK, WELCOME BACK

- The majority of last year's team is back, including four starters and 10 overall letterwinners.
- Statistically speaking, Alabama returned 79.2 percent of its scoring, including its top two point-producers in Jordan Lewis and Jasmine Walker, and 75.8 percent of its rebounding, led by Walker.



TUSCALOOSA, Ala. – Alabama women's basketball improved to 9-1 overall and 2-1 in Southeastern Conference play with a 67-59 victory over LSU (4-5, 2-1 SEC) in Coleman Coliseum.

The Crimson Tide had four players finish in double figures, including Ariyah Copeland and Jasmine Walker, who each recorded double-doubles. For Copeland, it was her third of the season, collecting 20 points and 14 rebounds, while Walker tallied her fifth of the year with 13 points and 10 rebounds. Megan Abrams and Jordan Lewis chipped in 12 points apiece, and Lewis also dished out a game-best five assists.

Alabama got off to a hot start with Walker knocking down a three-pointer 10 seconds into the game. Aside from a pair of ties, the Tide led for the entire game and by as many as 12. LSU rallied for the second tie of the ballgame midway through the fourth, however Alabama responded by scoring eight unanswered to help seal the victory. Hannah Barber also positioned herself perfectly to draw two huge fouls on the defensive end late in the contest.

Head Coach Kristy Curry Said

"Great team effort. Great balance. Four in double figures. Incredible execution down the stretch. I thought when they took one option away, we were able to get it inside and take high-percentage shots and get to the free throw line. I thought the team that got to 60 [points] first would win. It's really hard to score 60. That's one thing I've learned about their style of play. I was so proud of our kids. I thought there was a point in the fourth quarter where it was tied, and we had a choice to make. We chose to be a little tougher and a little bit more aggressive. I thought our point guard play with Hannah [Barber] and

Jordan [Lewis] — having those two on the floor, our execution was tremendous. The thing I'm probably most proud of is how we rebounded the ball tonight. To respond to what happened to us on Monday night — 11 offensive boards to their seven. To turn it over like we did, we balanced it with the ability to rebound. I loved our team's response tonight through some adversity."

News and Notes

- Alabama dominated the glass, outrebounding LSU, 44-27.
- The Tide had four players in double figures for the second time this season.
- Alabama had one of its most efficient shooting quarters of the season, hitting 70 percent (7-10) in the second.
- The Tide scored nearly half of its points in the paint with 32 coming from inside.
- Ariyah Copeland has now scored 20 or more points in four games this season and five times for her career, while Jasmine Walker has done so seven times this year and 13 times for her career.
- Jordan Lewis continued her dominance in the fouls drawn category, racking up six on the night, which resulted in six points from the line.


