TRENDING: The Commodores look to keep their momentum rolling into Wednesday's matchup, coming off a series win over Illinois-Chicago, marking their first three-game sweep of the season.

- Vanderbilt is outscoring its opponents 58-16 across the six-game stretch, including thee games with 10+ runs.
- The Commodores' six game streak is the longest since the team won eight in a row last season from Feb. 18-28.

WORKING FROM HOME: The Commodores are opened the season at home for just the second time in the past five seasons and the first time since 2018. Vanderbilt has been tough to beat at Hawkins Field since the facility opened its gates in 2002.

- ★ Vanderbilt 489-167-1 (.744) all-time at Hawkins Field including a 381-108-1 (.777) mark since 2007.
- Against nonconference opponents at the facility, Vanderbilt is 290-53 (.844). Since 2007 at home vs. nonconference teams, the Dores are 224-36 (.860).
- The Dores have won their last 12 regular season home series, including two series in 2020 and eight in 2019. Vandy has won 58-of-70 three-game sets at The Hawk since 2011.
- Opening weekend marked the beginning of a 12-game homestand to open the season.
- The Commodores are scheduled for 34 home games during the regular season this year, which would mark the most since 2016, when the program played 36 home

SEVEN IN SEVEN: Due to inclement weather and snow accumulation in the Nashville area, Vanderbilt's season opener was delayed until Monday, Feb. 22. The Commodores went on to play seven games in seven days, marking the most games in a week span that Vanderbilt has played in the modern-era.

This year's season opener marked the latest that Vanderbilt has opened a season since 2008, when the Commodores began the campaign on Feb. 22, against Oregon State.

THE LONG BALL: Vanderbilt has homered in six consecutive games, spanning from Feb. 27, against Georgia State to March 7 against Illinois-Chicago. The Commodores have tallied 11 long balls across the stretch.

- ★ Carter Young posted four home runs across the span, while **Dominic Keegan** registered three homers.
- The span marked the first time Vanderbilt has homered in five or more consecutive games since homering in six straight from May 12-22, in 2019..
- Vanderbilt ranks seventh in the SEC in home runs, but is tied for the second-fewest games played in the confer-

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT: Vanderbilt has scored 10 or more runs in five of its 10 contests this season, including a season-high 17 runs in the final game of the doubleheader against Georgia State.

- The Commodores put up 29 runs across both games of the twinbill against the Panthers, marking the most in a doubleheader under head coach Tim Corbin.
- Vandy scored 10 or more runs in three consecutive games for the first time since March 22-26, 2019. The Commodores won 12-2 and 17-6 in the final games of the Georgia State series before defeating Illinois-Chicago, 15-0 in the series opener.

SERIES HISTORY: Tuesday's midweek matchup will mark the 32nd time that Vanderbilt and Memphis have met in the all-time history between the two programs.

★ The Commodores own a 17-14 record in the all-time series with the Tigers, with the most recent matchup coming in 2014, resulting in a 2-1 win for Vanderbilt.

MILESTONE MARKERS: Several Commodores have eclipsed milestones throughout the early parts of the season.

- ★ Four Commodores have recorded their first career home runs across the first 10 games, including: Jack Bulger, Dominic Keegan, Parker Noland, Maxwell Romero Jr. and Carter Young.
- Freshman Miles Garrett picked up his first career win to even the series with Georgia State.
- Junior **Luke Murphy** picked up his first save this season, and owns a team-high tying two on the campaign.

A LITTLE EARLY: Vanderbilt added a younger face to the incoming freshman class, as freshman Christian Little joined the Commodores this January as an early-enrollee.

★ The 17-year old was rated the fifth-best right-hander in the 2021 recruiting class by Perfect Game. Little picked up his first career win in a midweek matchup with Western Kentucky earlier this season.

MR. CARTER: Sophomore Carter Young has gotten off to a hot start this season. The Vanderbilt shortstop ranks second on the team in hits (15) and average (.385), while tying for the team lead in home runs with four.

- ★ Young's four home runs have come across the last six
- He has scored a team-high 16 runs, including at least one run in each of the last six games.

SPEED KILLS: Enrique Bradfield Jr. has been a force on the basepaths throughout the early parts of the season. The freshman is a perfect eight-for-eight on stolen base attempts, which ties for third in the nation and ranks first in the SEC.

* Bradfield Jr. swiped four bases across the weekend series with Illinois-Chicago, including two bases in each of the bookend games.

MAJOR LEAGUE DORES: Eleven former student-athletes made an MLB appearance in 2020, a mark that tied for third in the nation

- ★ The Commodores had seven former student-athletes named to playoff rosters, which was a mark that led the nation.
- ★ Former standout Walker Buehler helped the Los Angeles Dodgers to the 2020 World Series title with a dominant start in Game 3.

TV SLATE SET: Vanderbilt is set to appear on national television 11 times across the spring — a total that is tied for the most in the SEC.

- ★ The Commodores will appear on national television at least once each weekend across their first seven SEC
- ★ Vanderbilt will be featured on SEC Network six times throughout the 2021 season, ESPNU four times and ESPN2 once. The Commodores' contest on ESPN2 marks the only regular-season SEC game that will appear the network.

DOM-INANT: Junior **Dominic Keegan** has gotten off to a strong start this season. Entering the week, Keegan ranked among tops in the nation in multiple statistical categories:

PITCHING PROWESS: The Vanderbilt starters have been impressive throughout the first seven games. The duo of Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter have combined for six starts, while Thomas Schultz has made two.

- ★ The Commodore starters have allowed just four earned runs across 46.1 innings of work, good for a 0.78 ERA.
- ★ Vanderbilt's starters have combined for 71 strikeouts.

SEC FAVORITES: Vanderbilt was picked to finish second in the SEC East in the conference's preseason coaches poll. The Commodores garnered 79 total points, good for second-most in the conference behind Florida, who tallied 91 points.

- ★ Twelve of the league's 14 coaches chose the Gators as the conference's preseason favorite, while Mississippi State and Vanderbilt received one vote apiece.
- ★ The duo of Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter were named Preseason All-SEC, as Rocker was named to the first team and Leiter was tabbed to the second team.

WHAT'S NEXT: Following the midweek matchup with the Tigers, Vanderbilt will head to Stillwater, Oklahoma, this weekend for its first road trip of the season. The two teams are set for a threegame series at O'Brate Stadium.

★ The Commodores will return home following the weekend, hosting a midweek contest with Belmont, before opening Southeastern Conference play with South Carolina on March 19.
