#### SERIES RECON

- Vanderbilt is 1-5 in the all-time series versus Temple.
- The Commodores defeated the Owls in 2015 for their lone win in the series.
- Vandy has since lost four in a row to Temple.

#### RANKINGS

- Vanderbilt is receiving votes in the Inside Lacrosse Top 20 poll
- Temple is receiving votes in the in the Inside Lacrosse and the US Lacrosse Magazine polls.

#### LOOKING AHEAD

- Vanderbilt dropped a pair of American Athletic Conference road games at Florida.
- The Dores fell by a 17-7 final score on April 16
- In the second game on April 18, Vandy fell by a 22-9 margin.
- Bri Gross led the offense with seven total goals in the series (three in game one; four in game two).

#### THE STREAK END

- Vanderbilt had a nine-game winning streak, the second-longest in school history.
- During the run, the Commodores outscored opponents by a 146-89 margin.
- The school record for consecutive wins is 10 set by the 2010 squad.
- This season, Vanderbilt will finish above .500 in league play for the first time since 2015 (4-3 in the BIG EAST).

#### DOUBLE DIGITS

- 2021 is Vanderbilt's 26th season playing NCAA lacrosse.
- The 11 wins are tied for the fourth-most in program history.
- In the previous 25 seasons, the Commodores have had 10 seasons with 10 or more wins.
- The school record for wins in a season is 13 set in 2008.

#### CHASING HISTORY AT HOME

- The Dores are 7-0 at home this season and are looking to go undefeated at home for the first time in school history.
- Vandy has nine seasons with just one home loss ('96, '97, '98, '00, '02, '04, '09, '10, '19).

#### FORNIA'S RECORD

- Senior Gabby Forna broke the program's all-time career assists record on March 10 versus Kennesaw State. She currently has 113 career assists.
- Forna leads the nation with 43 assists. She is seventh nationally in assists per game with 2.87.
- A 2019 All-AAC honoree, Forna held the single-season school assists record with 36 assists set in 2019. She broke that record this season.
- Earlier this season, Forna tied the program record for assists in a game with seven against High Point on March 7. She then broke the Vanderbilt and AAC record with nine assists at East Carolina on March 28.
- In the March 28 game, Forna totaled 12 points (3 goals, 9 assists), tying the Vanderbilt record and breaking the AAC record for single-game points.

#### FORNIA'S NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Senior Gabby Forna was named Inside Lacrosse Midseason All-America Honorable Mention.
- She earned US Lacrosse Magazine Division I Player of the Week on March 30.
- The awards came after posting five goals and 10 assists in the two games at ECU.

#### ON DECK

- The Commodores and Owls will square off again on May 6 for the Semifinals of the AAC Tournament.

**GUNNING STARS**

- Sophomore goalkeeper Paige Gunning is second in the nation with 138 saves.
- Gunning is 28th among D-1 goalies this season with a .466 save percentage.
- She has made 10 or more saves in seven games in 2021.
- Gunning made a career-high 15 saves in the March 19 win at Cincinnati.

**CENTURY CLUB**

- In the game at North Carolina, junior Bri Gross recorded her 100th career draw control.
- She is the 11th player in school history to reach 100 career draw controls.
- Gross leads the Commodores with 65 draw controls this season.
- With 147 career draw controls, she ranks fifth in program history.
- The Vanderbilt record for career draw controls is 263 set by Ally Carey ('12).

**DEFENSIVE HERO**

- Senior Melissa Hawkins is tied for fourth in school history with 89 caused turnovers.
- The school record is 133 by Sasha Cielak ('08).

**SHE SHOOTS, SHE SCORES**

- The 20-goal output against Kennesaw State on March 10 was the highest for Vanderbilt this season.
- Under third-year head coach Beth Hewitt, the Commodores have scored 20 of more goals in a game four times.
- The Does have put up 19 goals this season on two occasions (March 26 at East Carolina; April 3 versus Old Dominion).
- The school record for goals in a game is 24 set on Feb. 7, 2015, versus Kennesaw State.

**NATIONAL ATTENTION**

- Vanderbilt was ranked No. 20 in the April 12 Inside Lacrosse poll.
- Earlier this season, Vanderbilt was ranked No. 25 in the Feb. 22 IWLCA Top 25 poll.
- The ranking came after beating No. 24 Colorado in an 11-10 overtime thriller on Feb. 21 in Nashville.
- It was Vanderbilt's first appearance in the IWLCA national poll since ranking No. 20 on April 23, 2012.
- Vanderbilt received votes for four weeks in the Inside Lacrosse poll and US Lacrosse Magazine poll for three weeks.

**NASHVILLE IS OUR HOME**

- Vanderbilt has won every home opener dating back to 2015, including all three in the Beth Hewitt era.
- Now in year three at the helm, Hewitt is 15-5 in home games.
- The Commodores have nine scheduled home games in 2021, which will be played in three different on-campus venues: Vanderbilt Lacrosse Complex, David Williams II Recreation and Wellness Center, Vanderbilt Stadium

**TOUGH TESTS**

- Counting the last four games of 2020 and the first four of 2021, the Commodores faced seven ranked opponents in an eight-game stretch. The seven are: No. 10 Denver, No. 13 Michigan, No. 21 Penn State, No. 2 Notre Dame (twice), No. 24 Colorado and No. 1 North Carolina.
- The Does are no stranger to tough schedules — Vanderbilt has had stretches of playing at least three ranked opponents in four games six times since 2013 (the 2013 squad faced eight ranked teams in 17 games, including seven of nine).
