- ♦ Georgia (18-10, 3-6 SEC) aims to snap a three-game losing streak Thursday when it begins an SEC series at No. 1 Vanderbilt (24-3, 8-1 SEC). After beating No. 8 South Carolina last Friday, Georgia dropped the series and fell 2-1 to Ga. Southern this past Tuesday. In the three losses, the Bulldogs have been hurt by nine home runs. The loss to the Eagles came on two solo home runs, the last with two outs in the top of the ninth. Did You Know? Georgia is the last team to beat the Commodores in a three-game series, doing it in Athens in April of 2019 in what was a top five showdown. VU won the opener 3-2 in 11 innings, and Georgia claimed the next two games 8-3 and 3-1. The Commodores went on to win the CWS.
- ◆ Georgia leads the all-time series with the Commodores 121-111 as it dates back to 1897. Georgia's last win over a No. 1 team came in 2018 when it beat Florida 4-1 in Gainesville to avoid a sweep. The last time

Georgia won a series over the Commodores in Nashville came in 2008 when it clinched the SEC title at Hawkins Field. Those Bulldogs would reach the CWS Finals, falling to Fresno State in three games.

- ♦ Georgia is batting .273 with a .347 OB%. The team ERA is 3.36 and fielding .980. The Commodores are batting .316 with a .420 OB%. VU's team ERA is 2.31 and fielding .975. The Commodores feature a pair of aces who are combined 14-0 with a 0.63 ERA in 14 starts. They are Kumar Rocker (7-0, 0.84 ERA) and Jack Leiter (7-0, 0.43 ERA). Georgia's SEC rotation through the first three series has been freshman LHP **Luke Wagner** (3-2, 2.95 ERA), senior LHP **Ryan Webb** (2-1, 3.14 ERA) and sophomore RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (1-2, 4.58 ERA).
- ◆ Redshirt junior OF **Connor Tate** (.358-5-17) ranks among the SEC leaders in batting and hits (38-for-106). He saw his career-best seven-game hitting streak end this past Tuesday versus Ga. Southern. Against #8 USC, he hit a pair of home runs while batting .444 in the series.
- ♦ Redshirt junior INF **Josh McAllister** (.362-5-13), who ranks among the SEC leaders in batting, is day-to-day after having to leave last Friday's South Carolina game with a pulled hamstring. It is the second time this year that the injury has flared up. He ranks fourth in SEC action with a .400 batting average (12-for-30) and a .700 slugging percentage. Earlier this year, he had a 17-game on base streak. The Georgia native played his first two seasons at Florida Southwestern State and received scant interest from teams before joining the Bulldogs in 2020 when he was redshirted. This year, he is one of the team's top hitters and utility infielders, making starts at second, third and shortstop.
- ◆ Redshirt junior RHP Darryn Pasqua (1-1, 2.21 ERA, 1 SV) has been of the team's most consistent relievers. In 12 appearances spanning 20.1 innings, he has 26 strikeouts and zero walks. Pasqua focused on his engineering studies as a freshman in 2018 before earning a spot on the team as a walk-on in 2019.
- ◆ The Bulldogs have had six walk-off wins by six different players with three via home runs. The latest was on March 23 versus Kennesaw State when **Parks Harber** blasted a solo shot for a 3-2 win in 10 innings.

- ◆ Three Bulldogs have already earned a UGA degree. Riley King (Exercise & Sports Science), Mason Meadows (Business Management) and Logan Moody (Communication Studies). King and senior Chaney Rogers have started at four different spots in their career. King has made starts at 2B-3B-LF-RF while Rogers has started at 1B-LF-RF-DH.
- ◆ Georgia is 5-3 in one-run games this year, including five walk-offs. Georgia has six total walkoffs including three via the home run!
- ◆ A total of 15 newcomers made their Georgia debut in the season opening series including 12 freshmen. One of those freshman, LHP/OF Luke Wagner, a native of New Cumberland, Penn., earned a win with four shutout innings, allowing just one hit with two walks and three strikeouts in a 7-3 victory. He had a couple at bats in the series too. Freshman reliever Will Pearson notched a win in his debut in game two and then a save in his next outing in game three, needing just an inning apiece with two strikeouts.
- ◆ With the shortened 2020 season including no league games, a third of Georgia's roster had never appeared in an SEC game until this year. During the SEC Opening Weekend against No. 10 Tennessee, 14 Bulldogs including nine pitchers made their league debut.
- ♦ In the 2021 SEC Coaches poll, Georgia is picked to finish 5th in the East behind Florida. Vandy, UT and USC. Missouri is slated to wind up sixth followed by UK. In the West, Ole Miss is the favorite followed by Miss. State, Arkansas, LSU, A&M, Auburn and Alabama.

Florida is picked to win the SEC. The Bulldogs did not have any players chosen for the 1st or 2nd team preseason All-SEC squad.

HEAD BASEBALL COACH SCOTT STRICKLIN

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN

UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 8TH SEASON AT UGA; 17TH OVERALL

Now in his eighth year at the helm, lke Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit.



Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally (USA Today Sports Top 25). The Bulldogs had

jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall) and a school record 26 Bulldogs earned a spot on the SEC Academic Honor Roll. Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in earned run average during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (18) and Keaton (13), and a son, Cale (16).
