

12/5/2019: VANDERBILT 75, TENNESSEE TECH 61

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – A slow third quarter for the Golden Eagles helped the Vanderbilt Commodores to a 75-61 victory over Tennessee Tech Thursday evening at Memorial Gymnasium.

"I am proud of our kids," expressed head coach Kim Rosamond. "I thought they battled and came in here with the right mindset. Outside of the third quarter, we were right there with them, however, the third quarter was a killer."

Junior Kesha Brady led the Golden Eagles with a team-high 15 points, shooting 10-of-12 from the free throw line and pulling down two boards. Junior Mackenzie Coleman joined Brady in double-digits with 11 points, in addition to four rebounds, a pair of steals, and a block. Senior Anacia Wilkinson was Tech's leading defensive threat as she tied for a team-high eight boards, along with junior Abby Buckner, and tying her season-high with four blocks.

Tech held a 9-7 lead at the 6:07-minute mark of the opening period, before producing a 12-7 run over the final six minutes of play to take a 21-14 lead after the first 10 minutes of play. Tech would extend their lead to double-digits with a little over two minutes to play in the first half, 37-26, before Vanderbilt closed the half with a pair of baskets to bring the deficit down to six at the break, 37-31.

The Golden Eagles outplayed the Commo-

dores in a defensive battle during the first half of play. Tech shot 41.2 percent from the field (14-of-34), 25 percent from long-range (3-of-12), and a perfect 100 percent at the free throw line (6-of-6). Tech caused the Commodores to turn the ball over 10 times, while the Golden Eagles surrendered the ball only five times.

The Commodores maintained the momentum coming out of the locker room, netting seven unanswered points to take their first lead of the contest, 39-37. Harris responded with a layup to bring the game even at 39 at the 7:26-mark of the third. However, Tech struggled to stop the Commodores as they would go on a 20-6 run over the final seven minutes of play to take a 14-point lead heading into the final period.

The Golden Eagles matched the Commodores point-for-point over the final 10 minutes of play, but it just wasn't enough as Vanderbilt would maintain their advantage and take the 75-61 victory.

"We've had six-straight road games, with one more to play after exams," said coach Rosamond. "This will make us better, there is no question about it. I don't think we will go anywhere in our league that is as tough as when we played at Middle Tennessee and against Vanderbilt. We will be battle-tested by the time we get to January and begin league play."



COOKEVILLE, Tenn. – A year ago when the Tennessee Tech women's basketball team opened the season at Chattanooga, the Golden Eagles started strong, but went cold in the second and third quarters as the Mocs dominated under the basket.

Saturday night, it was the exact opposite for Tech as the Golden Eagles shot a scorching 58.9 percent from the field, including an 80.0 percent rate in the second quarter and 60.0 percent in the fourth. Thaat hot hand led Tech to an 85-58 victory over Chattanooga.

Tech (2-0) returns to action on Thursday as it travels to Vanderbilt for a 6 p.m. matchup before returning home for a home showdown with Middle Tennessee on Nov. 22.

The Golden Eagles also dominated in the paint, scoring 46 points as the Tech players were able to work their way in to the basket.

Five players led Tech with double-digit scoring as Anna Jones narrowly missed a double-double with 17 points and nine rebounds, while also collecting six assists and three steals. Jones was 7-for-10 from the field and 2-for-3 from the freethrow line.

Maaliya Owens went 6-for-11 from the field as she added 15 points, while Megan Clark and Jada Guinn each had 11 and Kesha Brady scored 10. Guinn, who tied her career high in assists against Bethel, set a new career mark on Saturday, dishing out eight assists.

Tech also had six blocks in the victory, including three for Mackenzie Coleman.

Defense led to offense for the Golden Eagles as Tech collected 19 points off turnovers, creating 22 points on fast break situations, and controlling the defensive glass with 27 defensive rebounds to Chattanooga's 11 offensive caroms.

The Mocs kept pace for much of the first quarter, but a 10-0 run to close out the first quarter was enough to create separation with the Golden Eagles leading 23-10 after the opening stanza. Both teams ended with 18 points in the second quarter, then Tech continued to break away, outscoring UTC 21-15 in the third quarter and 23-15 in the fourth quarter.

Chattanooga was 4-for-10 from 3-point range in the first half. The Mocs went empty from long range in the second half, going 0-for-9 from beyond the arc. UTC hit four of its 16 shots in the first quarter, then went 4-for-14 in the fourth.

Dana Jarrells led Chattanooga in scoring with 13 points, while Karsen Murphy had 10 points. Abbey Cornelius led UTC in rebounds with nine boards.



Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year, 2019 rich tradition over its 50-year history. Head coach Kim Rosamond, the latest steward of the Golden Eagle heritage, has worked hard with her staff and her young charges to maintain that tradition, reestablish the championship culture that has stood for five decades.

Now entering her sixth season as head coach, the program has made great strides. Tech has pulled together three straight winning seasons for the first time since 2010-11 through 2012-13, consecutive appearances in the Ohio Valley Conference postseason tournament and reached the tournament semifinals twice in the last three.

With 71 wins to her credit over a short span, Rosamond stands as the third-winningest coach in Tech program history.

The greatest signpost to date is the 2018-19 campaign. After finishing with a 7-22 record the season before with a freshman-laden squad, Rosamond and her team worked. Wins came together as the Golden Eagles defeated Middle Tennessee for the first time since 2004, then snapped Belmont's 47-game winning streak in the Ohio Valley Conference.

By the time the season was complete, Tech

went 22-11 – a 15-win improvement and the thirdbest turnaround in the NCAA that season and stands as the 26th best turnaround in NCAA Division I women's basketball history. The Golden Eagles competed in their first postseason event since 2011-12 as they took part in the Women's Basketball Invitational.

That season, which included 12 OVC victories and a fourth-place finish in the league, helped lead Rosamond to her first OVC Coach of the Year honor and the first for the program since Sytia Messer won the award in 2010-11.

While the win total slipped slightly in 2019-20, the momentum did not suffer. Strengthened by the previous year, the Golden Eagles won 11 straight games and 13 out of 15 midway through the campaign, including an 8-0 start in league play.

However, before that season concluded, the COVID-19 pandemic started to build and a tornado hit Cookeville and Putnam County just days before the OVC Tournament. While the overtime loss to eventual tournament champion Southeast Missouri was heartbreaking, the family concept Rosamond built within the team's culture strengthened.

The pandemic stretched into the fall, delaying the start of the 2020-21 campaign into mid-December, shortening the season to nearly just conference opponents. The situation called for flexibility and fortitude, something the 2020-21 Golden Eagles had in spades. Tech finished the year 15-10, 12-8 in the OVC, but the run included a major win at UT Martin in February 2021, breaking the Skyhawks' 19-game OVC home win streak. Tech was able to reach the conference semifinals for the second time in three seasons, while Jordan Brock, Kesha Brady and Anna Jones were named to the All-OVC second team, Jones an OVC All-Newcomer selection.

With the pandemic's effects still felt, but the season kicking into high gear, expectations are high for 2021-22. The Tech women were selected No. 2 in the preseason poll, with four Preseason All-OVC picks with Brady, Brock, Jones and Mackenzie Coleman on the roster, the most since 1995-96. Uncertainty and flexibility are still key words in the impending campaign, but there is consistency as the Golden Eagles bring back almost every player from the 2020-21 campaign, including all five starters. But the Golden Eagles also have an exciting group of newcomers to go along with an extremely deep veteran core.

Under Rosamond's direction, the Golden Eagles are seen as contenders to the OVC crown, a role the program has relished many times over the 50-year history. As the league's preseason poll was released, Tech was projected fourth, with a close margin between the top five projectees.

It doesn't seem that long ago that Rosamond stood at the podium in the Hooper Eblen Center's Eagles Nest, accepting the post. The former Vanderbilt assistant had just completed nine years there as both an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator for legendary Commodores' head coach Melanie Balcomb.

As a member of the Vanderbilt staff, the Commodores earned seven NCAA Tournament berths – including two appearances in the Sweet 16 – as well as a Southeastern Conference tournament championship and numerous appearances in the Top 25 polls.

Joining the staff at Vandy before the 2007-08 year, Rosamond helped the



program consistently land highly rated signing classes to keep the Commodores among the top women's basketball programs in the country. Her 2016 signing class was ranked No. 7 by Blue Star Report and No. 10 by Prospects Nation. Her 2014 class ranked No. 9 by Blue Star Report, and her 2013 class helped Vanderbilt earn its 15th-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance in 2013-14.

In her final season at Vanderbilt, she helped guide the team to victories over No. 12 Kentucky and No. 24 Missouri as well as two wins in the SEC Tournament.

Before residing in Nashville, Rosamond coached in nearby Murfreesboro as she spent two seasons on Middle Tennessee's staff as an assistant coach from 2003-05, then one month as the interim head coach in 2005. While with the Blue Raiders, the team posted consecutive 24-win seasons with a pair of Sun Belt Conference titles and NCAA Tournament upsets over North Carolina and N.C. State.

After earning her degree in journalism and advertising from Ole Miss in 1998, Rosamond stayed at her alma mater and joined Ron Aldy's staff before the 1998-99 season and was promoted to recruiting coordinator in 2001. While in that role, she signed one of top players in Ole Miss history – Armintie (Price) Harrington, who went on to earn All-SEC first team and Associated Press third-team All-American honors and two SEC Defensive Player of the Year

awards in 2006 and 2007. Harrington was later drafted third overall by the Chicago Sky in the 2007 WNBA Draft and went on to an eight-year tenure in the league, highlighted with Rookie of the Year and All-Rookie Team selections and a second-team All-Defensive Team honor in 2011.

During her recruiting effort in Oxford, Rosamond brought in two Top 50 recruiting classes, including two TSSAA Miss Basketball winners. Her final group of signees reached the NCAA Elite Eight in the 2006-07 campaign.

As a student-athlete, Rosamond played for legendary Ole Miss coach Van Chancellor in his final three seasons there before he became the first head coach for the WNBA's Houston Comets. She was a team captain in Aldy's first season as a head coach.

As a member of the Lady Rebels team from the 1994-95 season to the 1997-98 year, Rosamond was a four-year letterwinner and part of two NCAA tournament teams in 1994-95 and 1995-96. She was the first Ole Miss player to earn All-SEC Academic honors in all four years of her collegiate career. Rosamond spent her prep days at Winston Academy in Louisville. Miss.

With the Tech program continuing to celebrate its 50th anniversary this season, Rosamond looks to keep the tradition alive with hopes of bringing another championship back to Cookeville.

A highly decorated player in Tech's backyard, Hurst helped lead Upperman High School to a Class AA state championship and a 37-0 record in the 2017-18 campaign, claiming three regular-season District 8-AA titles, two district tournament crowns and a Region 4-AA championship. She ended her Baxter career with averages of 15.4 ppg, 3.7 rpg, 2.2 apg, 2.1 spg, as well as shooting percentages of 51.4 from the floor, 31.6 from long-range and 68.6 at the free-throw line. As a senior, Hurst averaged 18.8 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 1.1 block and 2.2 steals per game as she shot 53.8 percent from the field, 31.8 beyond the arc and 76.3 at the stripe as she earned TSSAA Class AA Miss Basketball honors.


