• **Player of the Week:** Tennessee guard Jordan Horston continued her stellar play in 2021-22, earning Most Outstanding Player and All-Tournament honors at the South Point Thanksgiving Shootout in Las Vegas over the weekend. The 6-foot-2 junior averaged 15.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 5.5 assists per contest, as No. 11/10 Tennessee collected wins over Kansas and Oklahoma State at the event and improved to 6-0 on the season. The Lady Vols also won their third straight game over a Big 12 opponent after beginning the spree with a 74-70 overtime win over No. 12/21 Texas a week earlier. Horston has now led UT in scoring in all five of her games played this season, assuming a leadership role after starters Rae Burrell and Marta Suárez were sidelined by injuries. She has registered three double-doubles thus far and is two rebounds shy of having one in all five games. On Saturday vs. Oklahoma State, she nearly missed her first career triple-double and UT's second in less than a week when she led Tennessee to an 80-55 win over Oklahoma State with 17 points, nine rebounds, nine assists and an impressive +35 plus/minus. She was seven of 11 from the field and three of four from the free-throw line, as the Lady Vols posted their first wire-to-wire win and biggest scoring margin of the season. Her defense also helped UT limit OSU to 30.9 shooting from the field, including a dismal 2-of-21 effort beyond the arc. On Friday, Horston carded season double-double number three, firing in 14 points, pulling down 11 rebounds and adding a pair of assists and a blocked shot. She had the second-best plus/minus on the team at +19.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Jersey Wolfenbarger helped Arkansas win both of its games this weekend, as the Hogs beat both Sam Houston and Belmont in back-to-back days. Against Sam Houston, Wolfenbarger put forth the best game of her young career, going for a season-best 16 points on an efficient 5-8 shooting clip. She also hit three of her four triples, showcasing the guard skills that make a player with her 6-5 frame so unique. The Fort Smith, Ark. native got into double figures for the second straight game, dropping in 10 more points against Belmont. Her night helped the Hogs drop 83 points on Belmont, the most surrendered by the Bruins since March 6, 2020. Wolfenbarger made three of her seven shots and hit three of her four attempts from the foul line. She also

pulled down four rebounds and dished three assists. Over the two games in two days stretch, Wolfenbarger averaged 13 points, 3.5 boards, 1.5 assists and 0.5 steals per game.

### Notes:

• South Carolina's Aliyah Boston was perfect from the field against NC A&T, setting the school record for most field goals in a perfect shooting game (13-of-13), there have only been eight perfect shooting games with more field goals in NCAA history.

• Missouri's Hayley Frank matched her career high with 29 points against Columbia, the first Tiger to eclipse 21 points in a game this season.

• Ole Miss' Shakira Austin was named the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational Powered by Cal Tournament MVP, as the Rebels won their first multi-team event since 2014.

• This is the eighth year of the Big 12/SEC Challenge. The inaugural challenge was held in 2014 with the first 10-game slate in 2016. The SEC edged the Big 12, 6-4 that year, with the conferences splitting the challenge, 5-5, in 2017, 2018. The Big 12 took home the trophy in 2019 with it returning to the SEC last season.

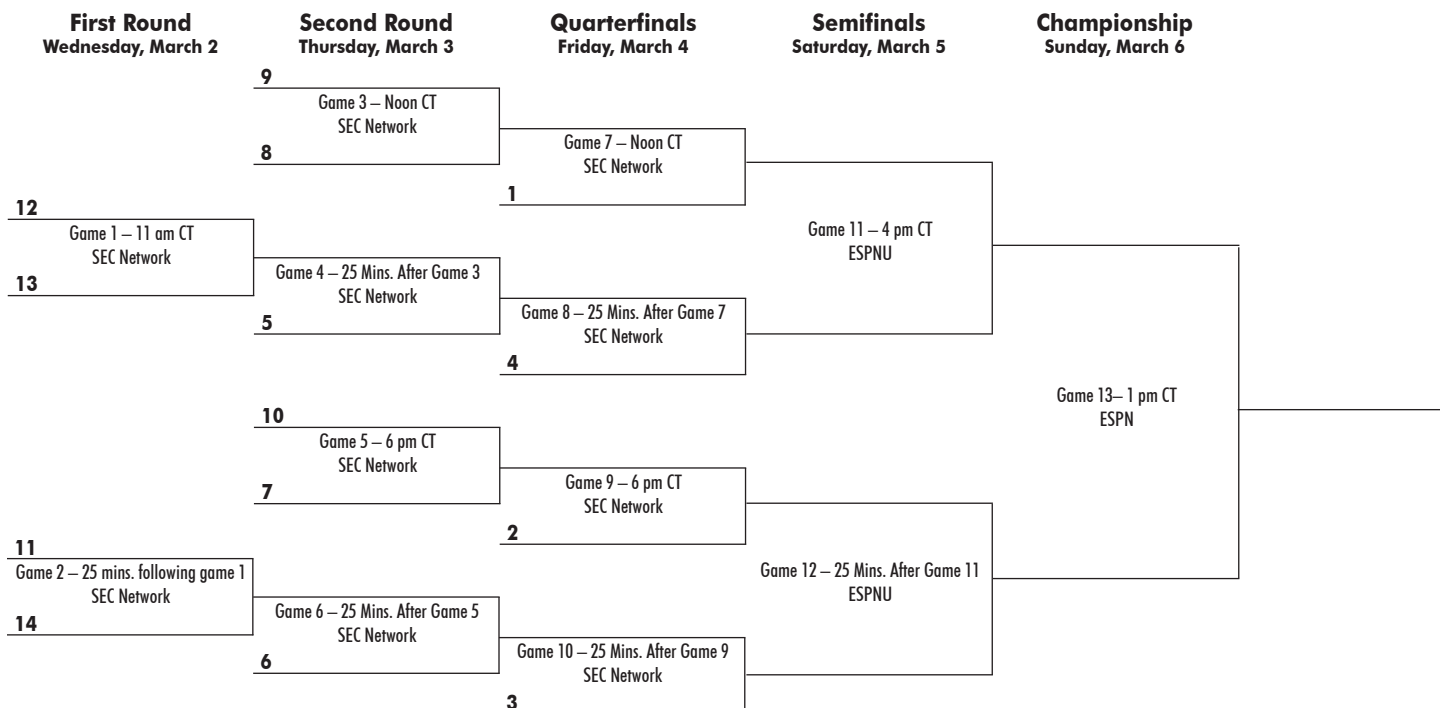

**2022 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN**



The Southeastern Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will be played for the seventh time in Nashville, Tenn. when Bridgestone Arena plays host to the 2022 event.

Formerly known as the Nashville Arena, the Gaylord Entertainment Center and the Sommet Center, the building became Bridgestone Arena in 2010. Bridgestone Arena opened in December 1996 and has hosted more than 13 million guests. It is Nashville's number one venue for large-scale musical productions, as well as one of the nation's most highly-acclaimed entertainment and sports venues. Seating capacity is approximately 20,000 for concerts, 19,395 for basketball and 17,113 for Nashville Predators games.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the 13-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 13 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only

twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. Vanderbilt is second with six, while South Carolina has six, Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

**SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures**

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.
2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

**SEC Success**

- With **nine** national championships, **12** runner-up finishes, a nation-leading **39** Final Four appearances and **153** first-team All-America honors, the Southeastern Conference stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- **Ten** of the current SEC head coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, **eight** with their respective SEC teams.
- **Six** SEC coaches have helmed teams to the Sweet 16, **five** have advanced to the Elite Eight and **five** have gone on to the Final Four.
- **Five** SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with three winning national championships.
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last **12** seasons.
- **Nine** SEC players were picked in the 2021 WNBA Draft.
- Over the last **12** WNBA Drafts, **68** SEC players have heard their names called, with **26** of those being selected in the first round and **six** as the No. 1 overall pick.
- **Five** WNBA MVPs (Candace Parker: 2008, 2013; Tamika Catchings: 2011; Sylvia Fowles: 2017; A'ja Wilson: 2020) and **six** WNBA Tournament MVPs hail from the SEC (Deanna Nolan: 2006; Seimone Augustus: 2011; Tamika Catchings: 2012; Sylvia Fowles: 2015, 2017; Candace Parker: 2016).
- **Ten** SEC teams (Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Georgia, LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt) have appeared at least once in the Final Four.
- SEC teams have earned appearances in **29** of **39** NCAA Final Fours, an accomplishment unmatched by any other league. The next closest is the Big East with 23.
- SEC teams have made **21** appearances in a nation-high **18** NCAA Championship games, winning nine NCAA Championships (Tennessee: 1987, 1989, 1991, 1996, 1997, 1998, 2007, 2008); South Carolina (2017).
- Overall, SEC squads have filled **39** of the **156** Final Four berths, including having two Final Four teams in 1988 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1989 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1995 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1996 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1998 (Arkansas, Tennessee), 2004 (LSU, Tennessee), 2005 (LSU, Tennessee), 2007 (LSU, Tennessee), 2008 (LSU, Tennessee), 2017 (Mississippi State, South Carolina).
- A total of **123** women's basketball students were named to the 2020-21 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Since the 1990 season, the SEC has compiled a **4524-1361 (.767)** record against other conferences. The league has recorded 150+ wins during **13** seasons and has never recorded a non-conference winning percentage below **.703**.
