Game Story Lines

- ▶ UH opens against Vanderbilt in the 12th edition of the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic.
- ▶ The tournament returns after being cancelled in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- ▶ UH and Vanderbilt will meet for just the third time ever and for the first time since 1990. The Commodores won the previous two meetings.
- ▶ UH comes into the game off a two-week hiatus from competition.
- ▶ The 'Bows were last in action on Dec 8 when they buried a school-record 18 three-pointers for their most lopsided victory of the season - an 88-52 blowout of Hawai'i Pacific.
- ▶ UH welcomed the return of Noel Coleman who missed the better part of three games and returned with 23 points and six 3-pointers vs. HPU.
- ▶ UH has been out-rebounded just once in seven games this year and ranks 19th nationally in rebound margin (+8.9).
- ▶ Following the DHC, UH will open Big West play on Dec. 30 at home against UC Davis.



GAME NOTES

Tournament Notables: Five teams will be making their first appearance in the HADHC (Liberty, South Florida, Stanford, Vanderbilt and Wyoming)...this will be the second appearance in the DHC for BYU and Northern lowa who both appeared in 2015... BYU defeated UNI in the fifth-place game that year...this will be first DHC since 2019 after the 2020 edition was cancelled due to COVID...Houston defeated Washington in the 2019 title game...UH head coach Eran Ganot has been a part of six of the previous 11 DHC tournaments - four as a UH head coach, and once each as a UH and Saint Mary's assistant.

Scouting Vanderbilt

- ▶ The Commodores snapped a three-game slide with a 77-51 blowout Austin Peav.
- ▶ All-SEC guard, Scottie Pippen Jr. led the team with 16 points and joined the 1,000 point club in the win.
- ▶ Pippen leads the team at 17.3 ppg while 6-6 wing Jordan Wright averages 13.2 ppg.
- ▶ Vandy is 1-1 on the road this year with a win at Pittsburgh and a loss at SMU.
- ▶ The Commodores were picked 13h in the preseason SEC Poll.

UH-Vanderbilt Series History

- ▶ This will be just the third all-time meeting between the teams and first in more than three decades.
- ▶ Vandy last defeated UH, 74-70, in the 1990 Apple Invitational (hosted by Stanford).
- ▶ The team's first-ever meeting resulted in a 91-62 win for Vandy in Nashville.

Versus The SEC

- ▶ UH is 9-21 all-time vs. current members of SEC.
- ▶ UH is 2-2 against the SEC in the Diamond Head Classic. The 'Bows defeated Mississippi State (2010), lost to Mississippi (2012) and split against Auburn (L - 2011; W - 2015).

UH vs. the The DHC Field: UH has faced five of the seven teams in this year's field and could face a pair of former longtime WAC rivals in BYU and Wyoming. The only teams UH has never faced are Liberty and South Florida. For a complete list of records and results, see page 2.

A UH Win Would...

Give UH its first win over Vanderbilt in three tries...improve the 'Bows to 4-1 at home this year...give UH its second straight openingnight win in the Diamond Head Classic and advance the 'Bows to the championship bracket for the fifth time in 12 tries.

A UH Win Loss Would...

Keep UH winless in three meetings against Vanderbilt...drop UH to 3-2 at home this year...relegate UH to the consolation bracket of the DHC for the fourth time in the last five tournaments

Deja Vu For Desrosiers

- ▶ UH grad transfer Jerome Desrosiers will be making his second appearance in the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Classic.
- ▶ The 6-7 forward was a freshman on the Princeton squad that competed in the 2017 edition of the tournament.
- ▶ In a Christmas Day match-up, Desrosiers scored 10 points against Hawai'i to help Princeton capture fifth-place in the tourney.

A Balanced Diet

- ▶ Five different players are averaging in double-digit scoring for the Rainbow Warriors
 Bernardo da Sliva (15.3), Noel Coleman (14.6), Junior Madut (12.0), Jerome
 Desrosiers (11.6) and Kamaka Hepa (10.4).
- ▶ Nine different 'Bows have scored in double-digits in a game this year,
- ▶ UH had a different player lead the team in scoring in each of its first four games.
- ▶ Four times this year, UH has finished a game with at least five double-digit scorers.
- ▶ In its season-opening win over UH Hilo, six players scored in double-digits, the first time that has happened since 2012.

Bombs Away

- ▶ UH averages 9.1 3-point field goals made per game, the most among Big West teams.
- ▶ The 'Bows drilled a school record 18 three-pointers in a blowout win over Hawai'i Pacific on Dec. 8, easily surpassing the old record of 14 set five previous times.
- → UH, which went 18-of-31 (.58%) against HPU, is shooting 37% on the season.
- ▶ Accuracy has been a calling card for Junior Madut (48%), Kamaka Hepa (47%), Amoro Lado (45%) and Noel Coleman (44%).

Making A Point

- After a rocky start this season shooting the ball, JoVon McClanahan has displayed his capability running the point.
- ▶ In the last four games he has posted 28 assists to just eight turnovers.
- ▶ In UH's road game at Santa Clara on Nov. 30, the Vallejo, Calif. native posted 12 points and a career-high nine assists.
- ▶ McClanahan leads the team in assists (31, 4.4 apg) and free throw attempts (26).

Mate In The Middle

- ▶ Mate Colina was a beast in the post during a three-game stretch.
- ▶ The junior center averaged 17.0 ppg and 9.0 rpg while shooting 64% from the floor in games vs. Illinois-Chicago, South Alabama and Santa Clara.
- ▶ Colina scored a career-high 23 points on 9-of-12 shooting in a win vs. Illinois-Chicago.
- ▶ He also has recorded back-to-back double-doubles against South Alabama (15, 10) and Santa Clara (13, 10).

Pounding The Boards

UH currently ranks 19th nationally in rebounding margin at +8.9 per game...the 'Bows have been out-rebounded in just one game this year...UH has owned double-digit advantages on the glass in three games this year, including a 51-25 advantage in its season-opening win over UH Hilo.

'Bow Bits: UH is the only team in the country scheduled to play on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day...UH has finished with a winning record in five of six seasons under head coach Eran Ganot... at 26 years of age, Michael Thomas is the fourth youngest assistant coach in Division I basketball...the Rainbow Warriors have yet to post a losing conference record in nine seasons of Big West membership.

Walking Wounded: UH has been decimated with key injuries to start the season....before the season even tipped, projected starters Samuta Avea and Juan Munoz were lost to season-ending injuries...both players underwent season-ending surgery this fall and have plans to return to the court next year...UH has also been without the services of guard Noel Coleman and Bernardo da Silva...the pair were the team's top two scorers through the first three games...Coleman was limited to five minutes over the course of three games before returning vs HPU, while da Silva has been sidelined the last four.

Ganot Hits Milestone: Eran Ganot captured his 100th win as UH head coach in UH's 88-80 win over Ilinois-Chicago on Thanksgiving Day...Ganot, in his seventh season at UH, is just the fourth coach in program history to reach the century mark, joining Red Rocha, Larry Little, Riley Wallace... Ganot has 103 career wins having posted three wins as Saint Mary's acting head coach for a five-game stretch during the 2013-14 season.

Experience Counts

UH welcomed three experienced graduate transfers in Jerome Desrosiers (Princeton), Kamaka Hepa (Texas) and Juan Munoz (Longwood)....the trio had a combined 228 games of collegiate experience upon coming

to UH (Desrosiers - 82; Hepa - 60; Munoz - 86)....Desrosiers helped Princeton defeat UH in the 2017 Diamond Head Classic....Hepa was part of last year's Texas squad that was ranked in the Top 10 nationally...Munoz earned all-conference honors as a senior point guard at Longwood...Munoz is out for the season, but Desrosiers (11.6, 7.9 rpg) and Hepa (10.4 ppg and 4.9 rpg) have been vital players thus far for UH.

Tri-Captains

- ▶ UH boasts three captains this year.
- ▶ Samuta Avea enters his fourth season with the Rainbow Warriors having appeared in 82 career games in his first three years.
- ▶ Graduate transfers Jerome Desrosiers and Kamaka Hepa join Avea as captains despite entering their first seasons with the 'Bows.
- ▶ Last year grad transfer Casdon Jardine served as one of two captains for UH.

Calling All Nations: UH fields one of the most geographically diverse squads in the NCAA with players from six time zones (Alaska, Hawai'i, Pacific, Mountain, Central, and Eastern) and five foreign countries (Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada and Slovenia). See page 7 for a complete geographic breakdown of this year's squad.

Big West Preseason Poll: The Big West Conference announced its men's basketball preseason poll with UH picked to finish in fifth place in the coaches poll and sixth in the media poll. The Rainbow Warriors finished in sixth place (9-9) in last year's regular-season standings. Both the coaches and media tabbed defending champs UC Santa Barbara as a slim favorite over UC Irvine.

In April 2015, a 33-year-old Eran Ganot took over a program mired in NCAA limbo. In the years since, he has lifted the the Hawai'i basketball program to unprecedented heights.

Not only has he won 97 games in his first six seasons - in the process, he's built a culture of accountability and character that has bred excellence not just on the court, but also in the classroom and out in the community.

In his first year, Ganot led Hawai'i to a historic 2015-16 season as the Rainbow Warriors claimed both the Big West regular-season and tournament titles and notched a school-record 28 wins. By season's end, he not only led UH to its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2002, but also guided the team to an opening-round upset of California for the program's first-ever win in the Big Dance.

Following the season, Ganot was recognized with a pair of national Coach of the Year awards and was a finalist for several others. The native of Tenafly, N.J., claimed CollegeInsider. com's Joe B. Hall Award, given to the top firstyear head coach, as well as the Red Auerbach College Coach of the Year Award as selected by members of the Jewish Coaches Association.

Ganot also claimed Big West Coach of the Year honors after enjoying the most successful inaugural season of any coach in the history of the conference. His first-year win total surpassed those of collegiate coaching giants Jerry Tarkanian and Lute Olson.

In his second season, Ganot took a squad that lost its top eight players and shaped a resilient group that defied expectations. Picked to finish second-to-last in the preseason Big West poll, the Rainbow Warriors remained in contention for the Big West title until late in the season,

before finishing in fifth place. In 2017-18, UH was one of only two teams to beat each and every team in the Big West Conference. The team turned heads again in 2018-19 as UH defeated Pac-12 squads Utah and Colorado, marking the first time since 1975-76 that UH notched two wins over the Pac-12 in the same season.

All the while, Ganot has continued to raise the stakes. In his second season, he initiated the Tipoff Event, a fundraiser that has generated preseason excitement and has brought in hundreds of thousands of dollars for the program.

He has also been a strong advocate for the student-athlete experience. In the summer of 2018, UH went on a historic 10-day goodwill tour through Australia—just the program's second foreign tour in more than two decades. His tenure has also seen the renovations of Gym 2 and the Stan Sheriff Center locker room.

Under Ganot, the program's APR has risen dramatically during each season, culminating in back-to-back perfect scores. Meanwhile, after a 10-year drought in sellouts, UH had three capacity crowds during his first three seasons.

Ganot has coached at a championship level before. Prior to becoming UH's head coach, he enjoyed two successful assistant- coaching stints at Saint Mary's College in Moraga, Calif. During his latest five-year span at SMC (2010-15), the Gaels made two NCAA and three NIT appearances and won at least 21 games each season—including a three-year stretch with 25 or more wins.

Ganot has been active in the NABC's Coaches vs. Cancer program and in 2017 joined the organization's council to help guide, enhance, and expand the program's reach.
