#### GAME #11 - MEMORIAL GYMNASIUM - NASHVILLE, TENN.

#### **OPENING TIP**

- ▶ Loyola is riding a four-game win streak into Friday's showdown at Vanderbilt and the Ramblers have won eight of their last nine true road games, with the lone setback being a 51-50 overtime decision at Drake last February. Since the start of the 2016-17 season, the Ramblers are 9-8 versus Power 5 conference opponents and a win Friday would give them their first true road victory against a Power 5 foe since a 65-59 decision at No. 5 Florida on December 6, 2017.
- ▶ With a victory over Arizona State under its belt already this season, Loyola is aiming to win multiple regular season (postseason excluded) games from Power 5 opponents for the first time since topping Northwestern and Purdue in 1991-92.
- ▶ Loyola has prevailed in five of its last seven outings versus current members of the Southeastern Conference, boasting victories over Vanderbilt, Tennessee, Florida, Mississippi State and Georgia.
- ▶ Head coach Drew Valentine has led the Ramblers to an 8-2 start to the season and that record is the best by any Loyola first-year head coach through his first 10 games since Tom Haggerty won eight of his first 10 contests in 1945-46.
- First-year head coach Drew Valentine is the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I men's basketball at 30 years of age. He is a year and a half younger than the next youngest head coach in the country, Austin Claunch of Nicholls State.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- ▶ Loyola shot 55 percent (33-for-60) from the field and knocked down 10 three-point field goals as it rolled to an 88-49 decision over NAIA foe Roosevelt on December 7 for its 28th straight home win, the fifth-longest, active streak in NCAA Division I play.
- ▶ Four players scored in double figures for the Ramblers, led by Ryan Schwieger, who dropped in 15 points and added five assists off the bench.

#### **NOTEBOOK**

#### **LOYOLA - VANDERBILT - THE SERIES**

- Friday's game will be the fifth meeting between the Ramblers and Commodores and Loyola has captured each of the first four matchups.
- ▶ This will be Loyola's first trip to Memorial Gymnasium after the first three games of the series were played in Chicago and the last meeting, on December 18, 2019, was played in Phoenix as part of the Basketball Hall of Fame Showcase.
- ▶ In that contest two years ago in Phoenix, Cameron Krutwig went for 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists for the first triple-double in Loyola histiory, and Tate Hall provided 16 points, to lead the Ramblers to a 78-70 decision.
- ▶ Loyola is 16-17 (.485) against current members of the SEC.

#### **SCOUTING VANDERBILT**

- ▶ The Commodores, who are coached by former North Carolina and NBA standout Jerry Stackhouse, have tumbled in their last two games, dropping contests to SMU (84-72) and Temple (72-68 in OT), after winning five of their first six outings of 2021-22
- ▶ Vanderbilt has played six of its first eight games of the season at Memorial Gymnasium, where it is 4-2 this year.
- ▶ Scotty Pippen Jr., the son of the former Chicago Bulls star, is providing a teambest 16.8 points per game, while Jordan Wright contributes 14.9 ppg and 7.0 rpg for a Vanderbilt team that is shooting just 40.4 percent from the field and 30.4 percent from three-point territory this season.
- ▶ Despite the struggles on offense, the Commodores are one of the better defensive teams in the nation and they permit just 60.9 ppg, while holding opponents to 37.5 percent accuracy from the field, a figure that ranks 21st nationally.

#### **COOL HAND LUKE**

- ▶ A Second Team All-MVC and MVC Defensive Player of the Year honoree last season, Lucas Williamson has scored in double figures in 12 of the last 17 outings and is averaging 14.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 1.0 blocks and 1.7 steals, while shooting 51.8 percent (14-for-27) from the field, and 50 percent (7-for-14) from long distance, in the last three contests.
- ▶ Some of the top players in the game have been frustrated by Williamson's stifling defense. Last season, he put the clamps down on Illinois All-America guard Ayo Dosunmu, holding him to nine points and forcing six turnovers in a NCAA Second Round victory. Last weekend, he helped limit DePaul's Javon Freeman-Liberty, who entered the game ranked third in the nation with 23.5 ppg, to seven points on 2-for-9 shooting.
- ▶ The Chicago native has been at his best against top competition and is providing 13.4 ppg, 5.0 rpg and 1.5 apg, on 48 percent (36-for-75) shooting, in his last eight games against Power 6 foes. He had 16 points versus Michigan State last month.
- A starter in 78 consecutive contests, the 6-foot-4 guard has helped the Ramblers to 107 victories during his career.
- ▶ Williamson, the anchor of a staunch Loyola defense, is the second Rambler in the last four years to earn the MVC's top defensive player award, joining former teammate, Ben Richardson, who took home the honors in 2018. Along with teammate Aher Uguak, Williamson, who was named to the 2021-22 Julius Erving Award Watch List, is a strong contender for National Defensive Player of the Year honors.
- ▶ He enters Friday's game needing just two points to reach 1,000 for his career and 41 rebounds to hit the 500 career-rebound plateau. Only 22 players in program history have totaled 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in their career.
- ▶ Quick starts are nothing new to Williamson. A year ago, he averaged 10.1 ppg, 4.6 rpg, 2.6 apg and 1.0 spg through the first seven contests. In 2019-20, he put up 14.0 ppg, 4.6 rpg and 1.8 apg through the first five games and in the first five outings of 2018-19, he produced 10.3 ppg, 7.5 rpg and 2.3 apg. He is putting up 13.2 ppg, 4.4 rpg, 3.2 apg and 1.4 spg, connecting on 55 percent (22-for-40) of his field goal tries, including 54.2 percent (13-for-24) of his treys, in his last five December appearances.
- ▶ Off the court, Williamson served as a writer and narrator for a documentary titled "The Loyola Project," which is being directed by Patrick Creadon and Christine O'Malley. The film will air on CBS during Final Four weekend in 2022. Creadon and O'Malley have produced notable films such as "Hesburgh" and "Catholics vs. Convicts."

# DREW VALENTINE - HEAD COACH OVERALL RECORD: 8-2 At Loyola: 8-2

Drew Valentine, who has spent the last four seasons as an assistant coach at Loyola University Chicago, helping the team to three Missouri Valley Conference regular-season championships, two NCAA Tournament berths and a National Invitation Tournament appearance, was named the Ramblers' head men's basketball coach on April 5, 2021.

In eight seasons on coaching staffs in his career, Valentine has guided teams to the postseason seven times, including four NCAA Sweet 16 appearances, two of which wound up with trips to the Final Four.

At 30 years of age, Valentine, a native of Lansing, Mich., is the youngest head coach in NCAA Division I men's basketball. In 2017, he was named to the Under Armour 30-Under-30 Team, presented by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), as one of the top coaches under the age of 30.

A proven winner, Valentine has helped lead Loyola to four consecutive seasons with at least 20 wins, including a school-record 32 victories in 2017-18 during a magical run to the NCAA Final Four. Loyola is 6-2 in NCAA Tournament games since Valentine joined the Ramblers' staff in 2017-18 and Loyola is one of three teams outside the Power 6 conferences to have reached the Sweet 16 in two of the last three years.

Valentine also spent two seasons as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Oakland University, where he helped the Golden Grizzlies to 48 total wins and a pair of postseason appearances from 2015-17. While there, he played a crucial role in the development of Kay Felder into a second-round selection of the Atlanta Hawks in the 2016 NBA Draft. Felder earned Horizon League Player of the Year and AP Third Team All-America recognition.

Before returning to his alma mater, Valentine spent two seasons as a graduate manager at Michigan State, where he helped coach Tom Izzo's Spartans to a 53-21 record, two Sweet 16 appearances and a berth in the 2015 NCAA Final Four.

As a player, Valentine, whose father, Carlton, was a standout player at Michigan State in the 1980s, was the heart and soul of an Oakland program that notched 87 victories and a pair of NCAA Tournament berths in his career, and he graduated as the winningest player in school history.

#### **DOING IT WITH DEFENSE**

- ▶ One of the top teams in the nation in scoring defense over the last four seasons, Loyola ranked first in the country in that category, with an average of 56.1 ppg, in 2020-21.
- ▶ Loyola ranked sixth among NCAA Division I teams in scoring defense in 2017-18 (62.6), fifth in 2018-19 (60.8) and 21st in 2019-20 (62.7).
- ▶ Over the last nine true road games, the Ramblers are yielding just 51.8 ppg and have forced opponents into just 21.9 percent (35-for-160) accuracy from beyond the arc and 36.9 percent (176-for-477) from the field.
- ▶ In four games against Power 6 conference teams this season, Loyola has surrendered just 62.0 ppg, and those opponents have connected on only 42.5 percent (93-for-219) of their field goal attempts and 28.8 percent (19-for-66) of their triple tries.
- ▶ The Ramblers have ramped up the defensive effort in the last two contests, surrendering only 56.5 ppg as they have locked up the opposition to the tune of 38.6 percent (44-for-114) shooting from the field and 26 percent (13-for-50) from beyond the arc

#### **OHIO PLAYER**

- ▶ Redshirt junior Braden Norris is looking to duplicate his fast December start from last season when he totaled 10.6 ppg, 2.6 rpg and 3.4 apg, on 52.8 percent (19-for-36) accuracy from the field, including 46.4 percent (13-for-28) from long range, in the first five games.
- ▶ A career 44.4 percent (139-for-313) shooter from long distance, the Hilliard, Ohio native is going for 9.9 ppg, 2.5 rpg, 4.5 apg and 1.3 spg, shooting 44.8 percent (39-for-87) from the field and 46.8 percent (29-for-62) from long distance, over his last 13 appearances dating back to last season.
- ▶ Norris, who has knocked down 38 of his last 48 attempts (.792) from the charity stripe, was named to the MVC All-Newcomer Team last season.
- ▶ A Preseason Third Team All-MVC selection, the point guard has hit a three-point field goal in 17 of his last 18 appearances.
- ▶ Over his last three contests, Norris, whose younger brother, Keaton, is a freshman at Wright State, has handed out 14 assists and committed only three turnovers.
- ▶ Norris is tallying 10.1 ppg, 4.6 apg, and 1.6 spg, hitting 45.2 percent (19-for-42) of his three-point attempts, in his last eight games outside Gentile Arena, and in his career, Loyola is 30-3 when he commits two or fewer turnovers. A starter in 40 consecutive contests until missing Tuesday's game versus Roosevelt, Norris has dished out 43 assists to only 12 turnovers in his last 10 games (3.58 ratio).

#### **AHER YE**

- ▶ Like Williamson, Aher Uguak has also established himself as one of the top defensive players in the league and his offensive production also improved last season. A Third Team All-MVC pick in 2020-21, Uguak was an All-Defensive Team selection, earning each of those honors for the first time in his career.
- ▶ The Edmonton, Alberta native, who transferred to Loyola from New Mexico, has emerged as a serious offensive threat and after struggling with his long-range accuracy for the better part of his first two years in Rogers Park, has drained 21 of his last 46 (.457) tries from behind the arc. Through his first three seasons at Loyola, Uguak went just 18-for-72 (.250) from behind the arc.
- ▶ Loyola has won 12 of the last 13 games in which he has scored 10 or more points and the Ramblers are 19-2 in his career when he scores in double figures. He has converted 41 of his last 49 attempts (.837) from the foul line, including 11 of his last 12 (.917).
- ▶ He has been impressive in his last four true road games, producing 13.8 ppg, 4.3 rpg and 1.0 apg, while hitting 76.9 percent (20-for-26) of his field goal tries and all 10 of his attempts from the charity stripe.
- ▶ Uguak has been on fire from the field, hitting 17 of his last 21 shots (.810) in the month of December, and already this season he has scored in double figures on five occasions after needing 20 games a year ago to score 10 or more points five times. In his last two appearances, he is putting up 11.0 ppg on 62.5 percent (5-for-8) shooting from the field after managing 5.0 ppg, on 40 percent (8-for-20) accuracy from the field, in the previous four contests.

#### **TAKING OFFENSE**

- ▶ Loyola's offense has been something special in its eight wins under head coach Drew Valentine, racking up 85.6 points per game on 53.3 percent (244-for-458) shooting from the field, including 43.8 percent (84-for-192) from three-point land.
- ▶ Over the last four contests, the Ramblers are producing 80.3 ppg and draining 55.9 percent (118-for-211) of their field goal attempts and 42 percent (37-for-88) of their treys.
- ▶ In its last four games versus teams from the SEC, Loyola is averaging 64.8 ppg, but shooting at a 50.8 percent (97-for-191) clip from the field, including 40 percent (26-for-65) from beyond the arc.
- ▶ Through 10 games this season, the Ramblers have assisted on 176 of their 287 made field goals. Loyola ranked sixth among all NCAA Division I teams with 176 total assists through games of December 7. In a 103-45 victory over Coppin State (Nov. 9), the Ramblers assisted on 31 of their 38 field goals, then had 20 helpers on 26 field goals in a 77-59 win against Arizona State (Nov. 26)
- ▶ Through games of December 7, Loyola's 50.9 percent (287-for-564) field goal percentage ranked ninth in the nation, while it also sat ninth in three-point field goal percentage (.417).

## **Preseason Player of the Year** AJ Green, Northern Iowa

#### **RAMBLINGS**

- ▶ Loyola is looking to earn back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths for just the second time in the history of the program and the first time since the 1962-63 and 1963-64 campaigns.
- ▶ The Ramblers have gotten off to strong starts in their last pair of outings, tallying 37.5 points, while shooting a blistering 59.6 percent (31-for-52) from the field and 44.4 percent (8-for-18) from downtown, in the first halves of those two contests.
- ▶ Chris Knight, a transfer who scored 1,144 points in three seasons at Dartmouth, is providing some instant offense off the bench for the Ramblers and in the last three contests, is accounting for 12.0 ppg. The 6-foot-7 senior forward has converted 19 of his last 22 attempts (.864) from the field and in his last three true road games dating back to 2019-20, is 19-for-25 (.760) from the field.
- ▶ Drew Valentine will be aiming to become the first men's basketball head coach to guide the Ramblers to the postseason in his first season on the Loyola bench. The school record for most wins by a first-year head coach is 23, set by Tom Haggerty in 1945-46.
- ▶ The Ramblers have not suffered a defeat on their home floor since a 59-56 setback versus Davidson on December 22, 2019. In Missouri Valley Conference action, Loyola has reeled off 21 consecutive wins at Gentile Arena since a 65-61 loss to Missouri State on February 17, 2019.
- ▶ Loyola drained a single-game school record 20 three-point field goals, which also matched a Missouri Valley Conference single-contest mark, in the season-opening, 103-45 victory versus Coppin State on November 9.
- ▶ Prior to this current stretch of four postseason berths in the last seven years, the Ramblers had been to the postseason just once (NCAA Sweet 16 in 1984-85) in the previous 34 seasons.
- ▶ For the first time since doing so for 10 straight campaigns in the 1940s and 1950s, Loyola has produced five consecutive winning seasons and last year, established a school record with 16 Missouri Valley Conference victories.
- ▶ Loyola is one of only six programs in NCAA Division I men's basketball to have won its conference regular season championship in at least three of the last four seasons, joining Vermont (America East), Duke (ACC), Eastern Washington (Big Sky), Gonzaga (West Coast) and South Dakota State (Summit League).
- ▶ A total of 430 seniors opted to use their additional COVID year in 2021-22 and only 30 of those individuals returned to the same institution to finish their collegiate careers. Four of those 30 returnees are Ramblers Keith Clemons, Tate Hall, Aher Uquak and Lucas Williamson.
- ▶ Loyola has won 20 or more games in four consecutive seasons for the first time since the 1945-46 through 1948-49 campaigns. In the storied history of the program, the Ramblers have never posted five straight seasons of 20 or more victories.
- On November 16, Loyola announced that it will be joining the Atlantic 10 Conference, effective July 1, 2022. The A-10 has produced 34 NCAA Tournament teams in men's basketball over the last 10 seasons. Over the last four-plus seasons, the Ramblers have gone 57-16 (.781) against Missouri Valley Conference competition.
- ▶ Chris Knight and Ryan Schwieger are living up to the success of recent transfers into the Loyola program from four-year institutions. Both Clayton Custer (2018) and Marques Townes (2019) earned MVC Player of the Year accolades, Milton Doyle (2017) was a First Team All-MVC selection and Tate Hall (2020) and Aher Uguak (2021) were Third Team All-MVC picks. In addition, last season, Braden Norris was voted to the MVC All-Newcomer Team.
- ▶ Tate Hall, who erupted for 16 points in Loyola's victory over Vanderbilt two seasons ago, made his first start since January on Tuesday night versus Roosevelt and came up with 14 points, which is his best production since going for 24 tallies off the bench against Northern Iowa on January 16, 2021.
- ▶ Loyola has won 14 of its last 17 games in the month of December.
- ▶ Princeton transfer Ryan Schwieger has been a valuable weapon off the bench and is posting 12.1 ppg and shooting 54 percent (34-for-63) from the field and 51.7 percent (15-for-29) from three-point range, in the last eight games. Loyola is 5-0 this year when he scores in double figures and in his last two appearances away from Gentile Arena (including neutral sites), the senior forward is tallying 10.0 ppg, 5.0 rpg, and 1.5 apg, hitting 45 percent (8-for-20) of his attempts from the field and 44.4 percent (4-for-9) from beyond the arc. He torched teams from Chicago this year, producing 17.0 ppg versus teams from the city limits.
