#### THE FACTS

- Alabama State was picked to finish second in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) standings in the 2021-22 preseason poll.
- The Hornets returns 11 players from last season led by First Team Preseason All-SWAC members **Ayana Emmanuel** and **Shmya Ward**, both who averaged at least 16 points per game.
- Senior guard Tyesha Rudolph led the Hornets in their last game against North Carolina with a career-high 22 points along with grabbing five rebounds, while **Jayla Crawford** finished with nine points, two rebounds and two assists in the loss.
- The Hornets currently have one player on their roster from the state of Tennessee in All-SWAC performer **Shmya Ward** who attended Whitehaven High School in Memphis, Tennessee.
- Alabama State has started a different lineup in all nine games this season, with 13 different Hornets receiving a start so far and ten averaging at least 15 minutes per contest.

#### **DUNN-OLIVER ACADOME**

The Dunn-Oliver Acadome is a multipurpose facility, featuring a 7,400-seat basketball arena suitable for NCAA Tournaments and concerts, as well as six team locker rooms for athletes, entertainers, banquet facilities and laboratory space for physical education classes. The facility has hosted commencement exercises for Alabama State University, as well as high schools from around the area, and has been the concert venue for some of the biggest names in entertainment such as Earth, Wind and Fire, Kem, The Isley Brothers, Jill Scott, and Frankie Beverly and Maze.

Both Alabama State women's and men's basketball locker rooms were renovated prior to the 2012-13 seasons, and a legacy mural added in 2013, honoring past legends who have competed in the Black and Gold.

Alabama State's arena is named the Dunn-Oliver Acadome after two legendary Hornet basketball coaches, Charles Johnson "C.J." Dunn and James V. Oliver.

Coach Dunn served as head basketball coach between 1934 and 1963, winning 298 games, the most wins of any Hornet coach. Dunn spent 46 years as ASU, serving in a number of capacities as ASU, including baseball coach, instructor, dean of students and athletic director. Dunn also served as Commissioner of the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference from 1970-72.

Coach Oliver also contributed greatly to ASU's athletic program, ushering in a new era of Hornet basketball from 1978. The 1966 ASU graduate led the Hornets for 16 years, compiling a record of 291-192 record, winning back-to-back Southwestern Athletic Conference championships.

#### HORNETS FALL TO NO. 25/20 NORTH CAROLINA

- Alabama State dropped a non-conference women's basketball matchup against North Carolina 83-47 inside the Carmichael Arena (Dec. 21), in their final game before Christmas.
- Tyesha Rudolph led the Hornets with a career-high 22-point outing, shooting 6-of-10 from the field along with grabbing five rebounds. Jayla Crawford finished with nine points, two rebounds and two assists on the afternoon, while Tamia Stallings and Hannah White added six points each in the loss.
- The Hornets finished the game shooting 27 (18-of-67) percent from the floor, 33 (6-of-18) percent from three. They also finished 71 (5-of-7) percent from the free throw line. The two teams finished even with 13 second chance points each, while Alabama State scored 25 points off the bech.
- ASU started their ninth different lineup of the season against UNC, with a lineup of Kailya Jackson, Jada Nneji, Tyesha Rudolph, DaKiyah Sanders and Brazyll Watkins. Watkins, a freshman, started her first game in a Hornet uniform.

#### ASU TAKES ON THE TAR HEELS IN CHAPEL HILL

- Alabama State returns to the court for their final game before Christmas with a matchup against ACC opponent North Carolina on Tuesday afternoon. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 pm (EST) inside the Carmichael Arena.
- The Tar Heels will be the first Atlantic Coast Conference opponent for Alabama State (2-6) this season, and first since the
  Hornets traveled to face Clemson on November 18, 2019. North Carolina and Alabama State have met just once in program
  history, a matchup in November of 2016, also in Chapel Hill.
- Alabama State dropped a 54-84 contest in their only meeting with North Carolina in series history. Both teams are coming off
  wins, with Alabama State defeating Mobile 79-44, while North Carolina beat Boston College on the road 76-73.

#### ALL-SWAC PERFORMER RETURNS FOR FIRST ACTION OF 2021-22 SEASON

• First Team Preseason All-SWAC forward **Shmya Ward** made her season debut against Mobile (Dec. 18), after a late season injury to close last season. The junior added 12 points on 6-of-7 shooting to go along with six rebounds, three blocks, a steal and an assist in just 21 minutes of play in her return to the court.

#### ASU DEFEATS MOBILE IN FINAL HOME GAME OF CALENDAR YEAR

- Alabama State used a balanced scoring attack along with a big second quarter run to pull away from Mobile 79-44 at the
  Dunn-Oliver Acadome. Five players finished in double figures led by DaKiyah Sanders and Tamia Stallings with 14 points
  each in the win. Stallings added seven rebounds and a steal in the game, while Sanders grabbed six rebounds and
  dished out a team-high four assists.
- First Team Preseason All-SWAC forward Shmya Ward added 12 points and six rebounds in 21 minutes of play in her first
  action of the season, while Jada Nneji and Jayla Crawford rounded out the double figure scorers with 11 points and 10 points
  respectively in the win.
- After a tight first quarter ending with Alabama State leading 19-14, the Hornets broke the game open in the second quarter dominating in the paint shooting 68.2 (15-of-22) percent from the field in the frame and outscoring the Rams 34-8. Alabama State forced Mobile into seven turnovers, converting into 12 points while also scoring 22 points in the paint and eight second chance points to head into halftime leading 53-22.
- ◆ The Hornets won every statistical category in the matchup, outrebounding the Rams 44-19, while adding a 42-20 advantage in the paint and outscoring the Ram bench 36-11. Alabama State also led in second chance points (15-4), fast break points (16-8), and points off turnovers (22-15).

#### ALABAMA STATE RETURNS TO DUNN-OLIVER TO HOST MOBILE

- Alabama State returns home to the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Saturday afternoon as they host Mobile in exhibition action for their final home game of the calendar year.
- Alabama State has won 11 consecutive meetings between the two schools, with their last lost being an 87-84 loss in 2008.
   Both teams are coming off road games, with Alabama State playing Ohio State and Mobile playing College of Coastal Georgia.
- The Hornets have displayed a balanced attack so far this season, with 13 players averaging at least 10 minutes per game.
   Newcomers have provided much needed depth thus far, as transfers Kailya Jackson, Jada Nneji, and Tamia Stallings all average over 17 minutes.
- The matchup of Alabama State and Mobile will begin a full week for the Hornets with three games in 10 days as they travel to take on North Carolina (Dec. 21) and Vanderbilt (Dec. 28) to end non-conference play.
- 2020-21 SWAC Freshman of the Year **Farrah Pearson** is the lone Hornet to start all seven games on the season, as ASU has used a different lineup to start in each contest.

#### CAREER HIGHS IN COLUMBUS AT THE SCHOTTENSTEIN CENTER

- Alabama State fell to Big Ten opponent and ranked Ohio State, 97-51, in a road matchup on Wednesday night in Columbus.
- Freshman **Brazyll Watkins** finished with her first double digit outing with 11 points against Ohio State in just her fourth career game, while **DaKiyah Sanders** finished with eight points and five assists on the night.
- Watkins also recorded career-highs shooting 44 (4-of-9) percent from the field and shooting a perfect 3-of-3 from the free throw line in 21 minutes of play her first game with over 10 minutes.

#### HORNETS SET FOR ANOTHER MATCHUP AGAINST RANKED OPPONENT

- Alabama State women's basketball will play their fourth power five opponent so far on the year with a battle against Ohio State on Wednesday in the Schottenstein Center scheduled for 7 pm.
- ◆ The two teams are meeting for just the second time in program history, after a matchup on December 16, 2016, also in Columbus.
- The Buckeyes won the only matchup between the two schools with a 118-61 victory five years ago, on December 16, 2016.

#### ALABAMA STATE DROPS SUNDAY ROAD BATTLE AGAINST JACKSONVILLE STATE

- Alabama State dropped an in-state matchup to Jacksonville State on Sunday afternoon 78-46 in non-conference action inside the Pete Mathews Coliseum.
- Alabama State (1-5) finished the game shooting 23.6 (13-of-55) percent from the field and 70.4 (19-of-27) percent from free the throw line against the Gamecocks, while making just one three-pointer in the contest.
- After struggling to score early, Jayla Crawford sank a pair of free throws to get the Hornets on the board
  with just under seven minutes to play in the opening quarter. With around four and a half minutes remaining in the quarter,
  Tederia Ashley scored on a putback layup to spark a run for the Hornets to close out the quarter, where they
  trailed 16-8 after one.
- Jacksonville State broke the game open in the second, extending their lead to as many as 19 points in the quarter, while
   Alabama State made just three shots with two being made by Crawford including a last second layup and free throw after a
   foul call.
- Crawford led the Hornets with a team-high 16 points and went 9-for-9 from the free throw line along with grabbing a pair of
  rebounds, while Ayana Emmanuel added eight points, four rebounds and two assists in her 24 minutes of play.

#### DECORATED FRESHMAN RECORDS FIRST CAREER POINTS

• After a highly decorated high school career, freshman guard Brazyll Watkins recorded her first career points in a Hornet uniform with a four-point outing on the road against Jacksonville State (Dec.5). The Battle Creek, Michigan native has averaged 7.1 minutes per contest as a true freshman so far this season.

#### HORNETS SET FOR FIFTH ROAD GAME OF THE EARLY SEASON

- Alabama State will travel for the fifth time in six games to open the 2021-22 season, as they are scheduled to face the Jacksonville State Gamecocks at inside the Pete Mathews Coliseum.
- Alabama State is coming off the first win of the season with a win over South Alabama, 69-59, in their home opener at the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Sunday.
- The two teams are meeting for the sixth time the first meeting was held on December 9, 1996, and the last being on November 20, 2019, the last season the Hornets played in non-conference action.
- The win over the Jaguars is their first non-conference win since defeating Paine 84-58 on November 24, 2019, also in the Dunn-Oliver Acadome.
- The Hornets have used five different starting lineups this season, with Ayana Emmanuel and Farrah Pearson making starts
  in every game.

#### ASU EARNS FIRST WIN OF THE YEAR WITH VICTORY OVER SOUTH ALABAMA

- Senior Ayana Emmanuel led three scorers in double figures for Alabama State as they defeated South Alabama, 69-59, in non-conference action inside of the Dunn-Oliver Acadome on Sunday afternoon.
- Alabama State shot a season-high 47.1 (24-of-51) percent from the field and 35.7 (5-of-14) percent from three against the Jaguars, as they trailed just once in the first quarter before controlling the remainder of the game.
- Emmanuel paced the Hornets with a game-high 16 points along with four rebounds and three assists in 24 minutes of play.
   Fellow senior Jayla Crawford added 14 points, seven rebounds and three assists in nearly 28 minutes,
   while graduate transfer Jada Nneji scored in double figures for the first time in an Alabama State uniform, finishing with 14 points and four blocks on the afternoon.

#### ASU HOSTS SOUTH ALABAMA IN HOME OPENER

- After beginning the season with four road contests, Alabama State will return to the Dunn-Oliver Acadome as they host South Alabama in their home opener on Sunday afternoon.
- Alabama State and South Alabama will meet for the 23rd time overall, with the Jaguars leading 18-4 in the all-time series.
- The game on Sunday is the start of a stretch where the Hornets will play three of their next four matches in the state of
  Alabama, with road games against Jacksonville State and Ohio State between another home contest against Mobile
  (Dec.18).

#### CRAWFORD JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB...

Senior guard Jayla Crawford became the 16th player in program history to score 1,000 points after a 14 point outing against
Auburn. The Birmingham, Ala. native has scored in double figures in 52 career games in her four years as a Hornet. Crawford
is one of two current Hornets to cross the 1,000 point mark, with fellow senior Ayana Emmanuel crossing the mark last
season.

#### ROAD BATTLE AGAINST NEARBY AUBURN...

- Alabama State (0-3) kept the game in striking distance for much of the game but fell in a road matchup against the Tigers
  inside Auburn Arena.
- The Hornets outscored their opponent for the first quarter of the year with the 20-16 second quarter and played Auburn in
  the second and third quarters to a score of 33-31. They also forced Auburn into 21 turnovers, compared to 23 of their own and
  were outrebounded for the second time this season.
- Ayana Emmanuel finished with a team-high 18 points, four rebounds and three steals, and was followed by fellow senior
  Jayla Crawford who logged 14 points including shooting a perfect 100 (6-of-6) percent from the charity stripe.

#### HORNETS AND AUBURN TIES...

- Head Coach Freda Freeman-Jackson was a high school varsity girls' coach at Loachapoka High School in the early 90s
  alongside boys' coach Larry DiChiara, who now serves as the color analyst on Auburn women's basketball radio broadcasts.
   Both won state titles at Loachapoka
- Alabama State and Auburn have met 19 times in school history, with the Hornets looking for their first win in the series. The
  two teams last met on December 29, 2018, also inside Auburn Arena where the Tigers defeated the Hornets 83-50.

#### OFFENSIVE STRUGGLES IN TAMPA...

- Alabama State struggled offensively in a matchup against No. 21/22 South Florida in a 72-37 loss in non-conference action inside the Yuengling Center on Thursday, November 11.
- Guards Ayanna Emmanuel and Jayla Crawford combined for all six threes, sinking three a piece, with Emmanuel leading the
  team with 12 points and Crawford adding nine. Graduate transfer Kailya Jackson recorded seven points including going
  5-of-6 from the free throw line.
- Transfers provided much needed depth in the opener, with Stallings reaching double figures and graduate transfer Jada Nneji
  grabbing 10 rebounds in their ASU debuts.
- Alabama State outrebounded Mississippi State 50-48, including 22 offensive that produced 26 second chance points. They
  also scored 26 points in the paint and 20 bench points on the afternoon.

#### TOUGH LOSS IN SEASON OPENER...

- Alabama State fell short in their season opener, 91-62, on the road against Mississippi State inside Humphrey Coliseum on Tuesday, November 9.
- Farrah Pearson finished with 11 points and six rebounds, while Tamia Stallings also added 11 to go along with eight rebounds of her own. Ayana Emmanuel also scored ten points to join the forwards as the three Hornets to reach double figure point totals.
- Transfers provided much needed depth in the opener, with Stallings reaching double figures and graduate transfer Jada Nneji grabbing 10 rebounds in their ASU debuts.
- Alabama State outrebounded Mississippi State 50-48, including 22 offensive that produced 26 second chance points. They
  also scored 26 points in the paint and 20 bench points on the afternoon.

#### ALABAMA STATE PICKED TO FINISH SECOND IN SWAC PRESEASON POLL...

- Alabama State was voted to finish second in the Southwestern Athletic Conference preseason poll, announced on Wednesday morning, voted on by league head coaches and sports information directors.
- Defending SWAC Champions Jackson State was tabbed to repeat this upcoming season, followed by the Hornets, Southern, Alabama A6M and Grambling State to round out the top five.
- Texas Southern, Alcorn State, Bethune-Cookman, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Prairie View A&M, Florida A&M and Mississippi Valley State finished as 6-12 respectively.

#### RETURNING PLAYERS FOR THE HORNETS...

- Alabama State returns just over 92 (1,286 or 1,397) percent of its points from last season, and 86.2 (580 of 673) percent of their rebounds from the 2020-21 conference only season.
- The Lady Hornets will return 11 letter winners from the 2020-21 team, including a pair of First-Team All-SWAC performers in guard Ayana Emmanuel and forward Shmya Ward and Second Team All-SWAC member Jayla Crawford.
- They also return senior guard **Tyesha Rudolph** along with the previous two SWAC Freshman of the Year award winners in forwards **Farrah Pearson** and **Anivah Smith**.

#### TRIO OF NEWCOMERS WITH DIVISION I EXPERIENCE

- Alabama State also added several newcomers to this season's roster including a group of transfers. Kailya Jackson who sat out last season at Florida A&M due to COVID-19. The graduate student averaged 6.9 points and 3.2 rebounds per game during the 2019-20 season with the Rattlers and recorded three or more steals on eight different occasions.
- Joining her is Jada Nneji, who averaged 6.3 points and 4.3 rebounds and was named to the Horizon League All-Defensive
  Team twice. The graduate student is Illinois-Chicago's career leader in blocks with 167 in her four years with the Flames, and
  is joined by Tamia Stallings who averaged 2.2 points and 3.7 rebounds in just over 15 minutes per contest at Jacksonville.

#### TWO-TIME ALL-STATE PERFORMER ADDED TO ROSTER...

- Brazyll Watkins is the lone freshman of the bunch, coming to the Hornets after playing at Lakeview High School and being named All-State twice and the 2021 Battle Creek Enquirer Female Athlete of the Year in her four-year prep career.
- Finished her prep career at Lakeview as the all-time leading scorer, while also breaking the record for most points in the city for boys or girls basketball, ending with 1,565
- Other individual records for Watkins on the basketball court include, single-season scoring, which she set twice in her
  career, as well as the single game scoring mark for Lakeview.

#### THREE TITLES FOR PEARSON IN PREP CAREER...

- Farrah Pearson won three state titles during his prep career at Hazel Green High School in Class 6A of the Alabama High School Athletic Association, including scoring 24 points and grabbing 12 rebounds in the state championship during senior season.
- ◆ The forward was named AHSAA Class 6A All-State as a senior and also scored over 1,000 career points in her Trojan career.

#### ALABAMA STATE HAS TRIO HONORED WITH PRESEASON AWARDS...

- A trio of Alabama State women's basketball players earned preseason conference honors this week, as announced by the conference office Thursday morning.
- Ayana Emmanuel and Shmya Ward were both voted to the Preseason All-SWAC First Team, while Jayla Crawford was named
  to the Second Team in a vote by the league's sport information directors and head coaches.
- Crawford started in all 20 games of the conference only season for the Hornets, averaging 14.1 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.6
  assists per game in just over 26 minutes of play, with shooting percentages of 51.3 percent from the field, 30.1 from deep
  and 78.5 from the free throw line.
- Emmanuel reached double figures in all but one game last season, including four games of 20-plus points and scoring her
  1,000th career point in opening round of SWAC Tournament on Mar. 10. The senior averaged 16.4 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.8
  assists per game, also earning First Team BOXTOROW All-American honors for her play. She dished out a career-high eight
  assists against Prairie View on February 1 and scored a career-high 32 points against Texas Southern on March 10.
- Ward averaged 16.4 points and a team high 10 rebounds along with 1.4 blocks per game as a redshirt sophomore, while shooting 52.9 percent from the field and dishing out 27 assists and recording 16 steals on the year. The forward recorded career-highs of 28 points including going 10-of-10 from the free throw line against Texas Southern on March 10 and reached double figure scoring mark in 18 of 20 games including six over 20, along with recording 11 double-doubles. She also had six games of 12 or more rebounds and blocked two or more shots on eight occasions and grabbed two or more steals in five games.

#### ALABAMA STATE RETURNS TO NON-CONFERENCE PLAY AND RELEASE SCHEDULE..

- The 11-game Hornet non-conference slate includes three games to be played inside the Dunn-Oliver Acadome, along with eight true road contests.
- The Hornets' first game action this fall will come in a home matchup against Tuskegee on Sunday, November 6, kicking off the month with six total games. After the opening contest, Alabama State will begin a four-game road stretch with contests against Mississippi State (November 9), South Florida (November 11), Auburn (November 15) and Georgia (November 21) before returning to Montgomery to take on South Alabama to end the month on November 28.
- Alabama State starts off December with two road contests, traveling to in-state opponent Jacksonville State on December5
   and up to Ohio State on December 15, followed by a matchup against the University of . Mobile for the final non-conference
   home game. The Hornets conclude the 2021 calendar year with trips to North Carolina . and Vanderbilt on December 21 and
   December 28 respectively before beginning SWAC play.
- The Hornets will begin conference play on the road this season, with matchups against Mississippi Valley State
  (January 3) and Arkansas-Pine Bluff (January 5) before a three-game stretch that includes Jackson State (January 8), Alcorn
  State (January 10) and Alabama A6M (January 15), all in the Dunn-Oliver Acadome.
- After the three-game home stand, Alabama State will hit the road for the annual Texas road trip against Prairie View A&M and Texas Southern on January 22 and January 24, before hosting conference newcomers in Bethune-Cookman on January 29 and Florida A&M on January 31 for the first time.
- Alabama State plays a total of nine home contests in SWAC play, finishing with home games against Southern (March 3) and Grambling State (March 5) to conclude the regular season.

#### THE FACE OF ALABAMA STATE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

**Freda Freeman-Jackson** enters her 24th season as the head coach of the Alabama State University women's basketball program, when the 2021-22 season begins.

Jackson joined an illustrious group when she was selected, and later inducted, into the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Hall of Fame during the 2019 academic year. At the time of her induction, she was alongside her husband Lewis as the only two active members coaching in the conference. Jackson became the 19th inductee into the SWAC Hall of Fame from Alabama State.

She has led Alabama State to three conference championships, and three berths in the NCAA Tournament during her career.

Last season with a conference only schedule, Jackson led the Lady Hornets to a 16-4 record and a number two seed in the SWAC standings. She coached another Freshman of the Year in Farrah Pearson, along with two First Team All-SWAC performers in Ayana Emmanuel and Shmya Ward, who both averaged 16.4 points per game and helped Alabama State to an 8-1 at home.

In the 2019-20 season, the Lady Hornets qualified for the 2020 SWAC Basketball Tournament yet again under Jackson. During the 2018-19 season, Jackson joined an elite group when she recorded her 300th career coaching victory at Alabama State. She now stands at 317 career victories over 22 seasons for the Lady Hornets.

In the 2017-18 season, Jackson led a young Alabama State team to a sixth-place finish in the conference while starting as many as three freshmen in the lineup. She coached Freshman of the Year Ayana Emmanuel through the season, leading the team in scoring.

During the 2016-17 season, the Lady Hornets finished third in the regular season conference race with a 12-6 SWAC record, before falling in the semifinals of the tournament to Texas Southern. However, Jackson coached the SWAC Player of the Year in Britney Wright who finished her career as the second leading scorer in school history. That same season, Wright was named the BOXTOROW National Player of the Year and SWAC Player of the Year, averaging a league-leading 18.3 points per game. The senior became the school's second-leading scorer in school history with 12 first quarter points in her final home game, while she is fourth at the school in rebounding. Wright also leads the school in free throws made, free throws attempted, steals and games played. She is also in the top five in school history in field goals made, field goals attempted, field goal percentage, three-point field goals made, rebounding average.

The senior led the conference in free throw shooting (.802), was fourth in rebounding in the conference, seventh in field goal percentage (.439), eighth in minutes played (32.8), 12th in three-point field goal percentage (.278) and 13th in three-point field goals made (1.1) in the regular season.

Additionally, she has produced some of Alabama State's best players. She coached the second leading all-time scorer Shameka Jackson; one of ASU's all-time leading rebounder Crystal Kitt; as well as 1,000-plus point scorers Chrishutta Lewis, Nichole Miller and Tanika Jackson. Britney Wright was the latest player to join the 1,000-point club as a player under coach Freeman-Jackson in the 2015-16 season.

The 2015-2016 campaign marked Freeman-Jackson and the Lady Hornets' third SWAC Tournament title in over a decade and qualified them for their third NCAA tournament appearance since 2003. The Lady Hornets finished the season 19-12 overall and 14-4 in the SWAC. This past SWAC Tourney marked the team's seventh appearance vying for a SWAC Title Championship.

Freeman-Jackson reached another milestone when she won her 250th career game in the 64-52 win against Alabama A&M during the 2015-16 campaign.

Alabama State had had a winning record in three consecutive seasons, winning 16, 17 and 19 games in successive seasons.

During 2010-11, ASU was not able to neither reach nor surpass their previous goal with a first round lost

to the defending champions Southern. In the 2009-10 season, the Lady Hornets reached the SWAC Championship game against Southern, before falling 60-47.

Looking back at her best campaign based on their record was the 2001-2002 season. The Lady Hornets posted a 23-7 overall record and 15-3 in the SWAC. They won the regular season title, but lost to Southern University in the Conference Championship game. The 2002-2003 season is her most decorated. That year the Lady Hornets posted a 20-11 regular season record and a SWAC record of 15-3. They won the programs second SWAC tournament title and advanced to the NCAA tournament for the first time. Coach Freeman-Jackson was also awarded the SWAC Coach of the Year after two straight years of excellent basketball seasons.

In the next season, Jackson set the school record for most career victories with 108 on February 28, 2004. That same season she led the Lady Hornets to a consecutive regular season titles, proving that her transformation of the women's basketball program was well in place. In 2011, she crossed a personal milestone by posting her 200th career win vs. Jackson State on March 3, 2011.

In 1991, Jackson became the head girls coach at Loachapoka High School. In her first season at LHS, she broke the school's three-year losing streak by winning her first five games of the season. Two years later, the Lady Indians competed in their first regional championship and she was named Southeast Coach of the Year.

She began her coaching career at Alabama State, where she was a graduate assistant under Johnny Mitchell and then an assistant coach under her predecessor, the late Ron Mitchell. During her playing days, Jackson was a stellar forward for the Lady Hornets from 1982 to 1984. In her senior season, she earned First Team All-SWAC honors.

She is married to Lewis Jackson, former letterwinner and former head men's basketball coach at Alabama State. They have one daughter, Bianca, who plays for basketball at Florida State.


