• This will mark the Commodores' 25th time competing at the SEC Championships.

• Its the first of three postseason competitions on the schedule for Vandy with both the College Swimming Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) and NCAA Championships set for next month.

• The Dorees have competed just twice since the start of the spring semester, splitting a pair of dual meets against Tennessee and Arkansas-Little Rock the second half of January.

• The freshmen duo of **Mercedes Traba** and **Kailia Utley** have combined to post Vanderbilt's best mark in seven of 14 individual events.

• In fact, underclassmen have accounted for 12 of the team's fastest event times in 2021-22 with **Eleanor Beers** atop the list at three different freestyle distances — 50, 100 and 200 — along with **Faith Knelson** (100 breaststroke) and **Gabriela Pierobon Mays** (100 backstroke).

• Knelson, who joined the program at the start of the spring semester, hit a pair of qualifying standards with her victories in the regular-season finale against UALR, making the NCAA B standard in the 100 breaststroke as well as the A standard for the CSCAA National Invitational Championship in the 50 breast.

• No one has picked up more individual race victories this season than senior **Tonner DeBeer**, who has claimed eight wins in three different events highlighted by five first-place results in the 100 butterfly.

• In her career, DeBeer has won 26 races with 13 of those victories coming in the 100 butterfly; she has also touched the wall first in the 100 backstroke seven times during that span.

• In her first campaign with the program, Traba has touched the wall first in four separate events on six occasions at four meets highlighted by claiming multiple victories to help the Commodores defeat both Florida Gulf Coast (500 and 1,000 free) and Arkansas-Little Rock (300 free and IM).

• Utley's three wins in the 200 butterfly — at Florida Gulf Coast and Miami, as well as in a home dual-meet victory over Tulane — are the second-highest total in an event by a Dore this winter; she also recorded the fastest time in the 100 butterfly at the Miami Invitational to account for Vandy's lone first-place finishes at the competition, making her the first individual in the program to hit the NCAA-B standard in 2021-22.

• Both **Francesca Neubauer** and **Gray Almasi** claimed three individual wins during the season, with both earning a pair of victories in Vandy's defeat of Tulane after the former touched the wall first in both the 100 and 200 breaststroke and the latter beat the field in the 50 and 100 freestyle.

• Over the course of her Commodore career, senior **Lizzy Colwell** has finished first on 11 different occasions in eight events including winning the 100 breaststroke three times her first two seasons with the program.

• During her first two seasons at Vandy, **Abby Burke** posted wins in six events highlighted by multiple victories in the 100 and 500 freestyle.

• **Lauren Thomas** — the lone graduate on the '21-22 roster for the Dorees — picked up three victories her first two seasons at the collegiate level after finishing first in the 200 individual medley against Missouri (2018) and Marshall ('19), adding a win in the 200 backstroke as a sophomore against Florida Gulf Coast.

• The Commodores finished first in the 200 medley relay four times during the 2021-22 campaign, accounting for half the victories recorded in relay events during the season.

• Vandy posted marks that made the NIC A standard in four of five relay races with three of those — in the 200 and 400 freestyle and the 400 medley — set at the Miami Invitational; the Dorees' 200 medley relay team hit the qualifying mark last time out against Arkansas-Little Rock.

• The only two members of the squad to be a part of all four of those relays are Beers and DeBeer, with Pierobon Mays contributing to three of those teams.

NEAR MISSES

- Not only did **Faith Knelson** set a school record in the 50 breaststroke in the victory over UALR, she ended up just over a quarter second shy of adding a second mark in the 100 breaststroke after posting a time of 1:01.68 in winning the race.
- **Eleanor Beers** came within three-tenths of a second of breaking a pair of school marks after posting times of 23.34 seconds in the 50 free and 50.44 in the 100 free, respectively, at the Miami Invitational prior to Thanksgiving weekend.
- **Gabriela Pierobon Mays** touched the wall in the 50 backstroke in 25.63 seconds in the regular-season finale at Arkansas-Little Rock, winning the race as both she and **Abby Burke** finished within a second of the current Vandy standard at that distance.
- **Kailia Utley's** season-best time of 53.73 seconds in the 100 butterfly at the Miami Invitational was less than a second off the current standard set over three years ago — and only .03 seconds from breaking the school's freshman mark — while the next day at the competition she finished the 200 butterfly in 1:59.19, which was also within a second of the best time recorded in event in 2015.
- Utley was also a matter of seconds from setting new freshman records in the 100 and 200 backstroke at the meet in Miami with times of 56.90 and 2:02.61, respectively.
- **Karsyn Cook** touched the wall a quarter second behind Beers in the 50 free in Miami, with her fastest time of the season in the event four-tenths of a second off the Dores' freshman mark; she finished the 100 free in 52.20 later at the same meet that was just over a second behind the best recorded by a freshman first set by **Summer Brown** in 2015.
- **Mercedes Traba's** mark of 4:56.81 in the 500 freestyle at the Miami Invitational was not only the best by any Commodore at the distance during the 2021-22 campaign but just over a second from setting a new standard in the race by a freshman, and she approached the program's freshman record in the 400 individual medley as well after ending up with a time of 4:23.16 the following day.

COMMODORE HISTORY

• This marks the 31st season of competition for the Dores in the pool, with the program's history broken up into two segments — Vandy first sponsored the program from 1977-92, and following a 14-year hiatus the Commodores resumed under the direction of current head coach **Jeremy Organ** in 2006. 
