TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ With three weeks left in the SEC season, No. 16 Georgia (31-14) is 12-9 in league play, and that puts the Bulldogs second in the Eastern Division and tied for the third best overall mark. Georgia opened a four-game home stand Tuesday with a 10-7 win over Kennesaw State. Up next, Georgia resumes SEC play Friday night with a series against No. 14 Vanderbilt (29-14, 10-11 SEC).

Last year, Georgia beat No. 1 Vanderbilt two out of three in Nashville to claim the series. Georgia owns a 123-112 edge over the Commodores. Georgia captured the 2019 series over then No. 5 Vanderbilt in Athens (2-1). This past weekend, Vanderbilt dropped a home series to a surging No. 21 Texas A&M club. Then VU was blanked 1-0 by #10 Louisville Tuesday in Nashville as seven Cardinals twirled a two-hitter and a solo home run by Ben Bianco in the fifth proved to be enough.

◆ Georgia is a consensus top 25 team again this week and ranked as high as No. 16 (USA TODAY Sports Top 25 Coaches) in the major polls plus has the nation's No. 3 RPI after Tuesday's win according to the NCAA. The Bulldogs are batting .290 with 53 home runs, a 5.38 ERA and a .977 fielding percentage. The Commodores are hitting .288 with 49 home runs, a 3.10 ERA and a .982 fielding percentage.

◆ Georgia will employ the same rotation as last week's LSU series, and this will mark the first SEC weekend this season where Georgia's top two starters in junior Jonathan Cannon (8-1, 2.04 ERA) and sophomore Liam Sullivan (3-2, 5.12 ERA) are not a pitch count. They will go in games two and three of the VU series. While they were returning from injuries, junior RHP Nolan Crisp (1-2, 4.72 ERA) earned the game one SEC starts the past four weeks. Overall, he has gone 1-2 with a 4.17 ERA in five SEC starts. Crisp will start Friday's opener. Cannon ranks 2nd nationally in Wins (8) and WHIP (0.72)

◆ Graduate LF Connor Tate (.337-8-42) leads the team in batting this season and has been even better in SEC action at .355-5-16. He has a team-best 19 multi-hit games this year. Against LSU, he had four hits and three were home runs plus five RBI. His twin brother, graduate SS Cole Tate (.331-2-16), ranks second on the team in batting. He has missed the past 13 games with a stress fracture in his leg and should return for the VU series. Cole could see time at shortstop, third base and designated hitter. He has made 99 starts in his career (80-SS; 9-2B, 6-3B; 4-DH).

◆ Graduate CF Ben Anderson (.287-7-27) ranks second in the SEC with four triples. He has eight in his Bulldog career and 15 total after registering seven as a freshman with Furman in 2018.

◆ Sophomore 3B/1B Parks Harber (.306-9-43) makes his hits count, tallying 48 hits to go with 43 RBI this season. In Saturday's 12-7 road win over No. 20, he hit into a double play in his first at bat and then went 4-for-4 with a pair of home runs. Senior 2B Cory Acton (.271-3-23) enjoyed a fine series at LSU, batting .545 (6-for-11) with a pair of home runs and three RBI.

◆ Senior RHP Jack Gowen (1-0, 1.33 ERA) ranks second in the SEC and 8th nationally with 10 saves (seven of those in league play). His save at #20 LSU was the third time he has gone three innings. Gowen is 10-for-10- in save chances this year while the Bulldogs are 13-for-14 overall. His 10 saves ranks T9th in school history and the most since two-way star Aaron Schunk had 12 in 2019.

Georgia leads 123-112 dating to 1897

Did You Know? In Georgia's road series win over then top-ranked VU in 2021, the Bulldogs slugged .585 with nine home runs. Georgia's pitching staff posted a 2.77 ERA and tallied 42 strikeouts against the league's best offense that ranked second nationally in slugging percentage at .544.

Connor Tate batted .583 (7-for-12) with two doubles, three home runs and six RBI to pace the offense while Jonathan Cannon tossed a career-high seven seven shutout innings with 9Ks and no walks to clinch the series. Both earned National Player/Pitcher as well as SEC weekly honors.

Against #1 Vanderbilt in Nashville last season, Georgia whipped the 'Dores 14-2 and 9-1 The Bulldogs dropped the middle game of the series 5-2 and that one was 1-1 going to the eighth. At No. 1 Arkansas, Georgia dropped the opener 3-0, evened the series with a 7-3 win and saw a 3-0 lead get away in the middle innings en route to a 5-3 loss. At the 2021 SEC Tournament, Georgia lost 11-2 to #1 Arkansas.

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 9TH SEASON AT UGA; 18TH OVERALL

Now in his ninth year at the helm, Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. In April of 2021, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

On March 19, 2022 he became the fifth active coach in the SEC with 600 career wins when the Bulldogs beat No. 24 Miss. State 12-11.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally as it had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall). Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, was a 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins. He graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from KSU in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (19) who attends UGA, and Keaton (14), and a son, Cale (17).
