## Vanderbilt Commodores (0-0-0, 0-0-0 SEC) vs. Evansville Purple Aces (0-0-0, 0-0-0 MVC)

Aug. 18, 2022 • Arad McCutchan Stadium • Evansville, Ind. • ESPN+

#### The Matchup

- The Commodores open their 2022 season on the road at Evansville (Aug. 18).
- The match is set for 7 p.m. at the Arad McCutchan Stadium.
- Fifth-year student Brooke VanDyck returns to her homestate for the matchup. The South Bend, Ind., native joined the team as a grad transfer from Notre Dame during the offseason.
- All-time, the Commodores are undefeated against the Purple Aces, owning a 6-0-0 record. Two current Commodores scored in the home match against Evansville as Peyton Cutshall and Alex Kerr helped lead the team to a 4-0 victory.
- In their latest meeting, Vanderbilt outshot visiting Evansville 27-1 (2019).

#### Last Time Out

- Vanderbilt concluded it's preseason slate at Alabama last weekend. Alex Kerr scored for the Commodores in the team's second exhibition of the month.
- The Commodores fired five shots against the Crimson Tide in the preseason finale while Kate Devine recorded three saves in her 45 minutes played.
- Ella Shamburger and Abena Aidoo both played all 90 minutes on the pitch as the defensive duo stalled multiple Crimson Tide advances in the contest.
- Vanderbilt opened its preseason with a draw against UAB. The Commodores found success dominating the midfield and winning tight battles in all three parts of the pitch.
- The Commodores outshot the Blazers 14-2 in the contest, including nine total shots in the latter half of play.
- Splitting time in goal, both Sara Wojdelko and Kate Devine registered a save in Monday's contest.
- Fifth-year defender, Shamburger spent all 90 minutes of the opening exhibition on the pitch for a team high. Fellow captain Maya Antoine recorded the second-most minutes on the field at 77.

#### Head Coach Darren Ambrose

- In his eighth season leading Vanderbilt soccer, Darren Ambrose has guided one of the best runs in program history.
- The Dores have amassed a 78-47-14 record and 38-24-8 SEC mark during his tenure. Fifteen of those wins are over ranked opponents, meaning Ambrose has guided the program to 15 of its 23 wins over ranked teams.
- To date, Vanderbilt has four appearances in the NCAA Tournament, an SEC regular season championship (2018), a tournament championship (2020) and an SEC East Division championship (2019) under his leadership.
- Ambrose was the first Vanderbilt head coach in 21 years to have three consecutive double-digit win seasons (2017-19) and will make it four years in a row with one more win during the spring season.

#### Veteran Leadership

- The Commodores return two-thirds of their 2021 team, looking to improve upon their second-place finish in the SEC East last year. With a strong upperclassmen corp of nine seniors and graduate students, the team brings vast experience to the 2022 season.
- Peyton Cutshall, Raegan Kelley and Ella Shamburger all return for their fifth season with the Commodores in 2022.
- Last year, Kelley was named First-Team All-SEC and led the team in both points (19) and goals (eight). Against Southern Illinois, Kelley recorded a career-best five points behind two goals and an assist. She was also named to the United Soccer Coaches All-Southeast Region Third Team at the conclusion of the season.
- With the recent change to regular-season scoring, Peyton Cutshall scored the final golden-goal in program history when she net the overtime winner over Tennessee in last season's regular season home finale. With two game winners on the season, Cutshall led the team.
- Shamburger played a key role in the Commodores' success last season, starting all 19 games at defense. She recorded her first collegiate goal in 2021 against Pepperdine en route to three points on the season.
- The team also adds a trio of graduate student transfers for 2022 in Abena Aidoo (Cal), Olivia Stone (Northwestern) and Brooke VanDyck (Notre Dame).

#### New Faces

• Six rookies join the Commodores for 2022, including a forward, two midfielders, two defenders and a goalkeeper.

- In all, the Dores have defeated 23 ranked opponents with 15 of those coming since Ambrose took over ahead of the 2015 season.

#### Transfer Talent

- In the offseason, the Commodores added five individuals from the transfer portal to elevate the team in 2022. Providing a new depth are two forwards (Castillo, Yanchuk), two midfielders (Stone, VanDyck) and a defender (Aidoo).
- · Abena Aidoo comes to Nashville as a graduate transfer from Cal. She and sophomore Francesca Yanchuk (Villanova) joined the team at the start of the 2022 winter semester and are eligible to begin play for the Commodores this fall.
- Oliva Stone (Northwestern) and Brooke VanDyck (Notre Dame) join the team as graduate transfers at the midfield position and will provide an attacking but physical presence on the pitch.
- Mia Castillo will make her debut for the Commodores this fall, having transferred from San Diego following her freshman season.

#### Our State

- In their last 18 games against Tennessee schools (Chattanooga, Lipscomb, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee and Tennessee Tech), the Dores are 13-4-1.
- This season's slate includes bouts with East Tennessee and Lipscomb at home and road matches at Middle Tennessee and Tennessee.

#### There's No Place Like Home

• Two Commodores hail from Tennessee as junior goalkeeper Kate Devine is from nearby Brentwood and rookie Caroline Betts hails from Nashville.

#### Next Level

- In January 2021, Myra Konte became the first Commodore every taken in an NWSL Draft by going 30th overall to the North Carolina Courage.
- Konte's selection marks the first Commodore taken in a draft since 2000 when Asta Helgadottir was selected by the Carolina Courage in the inaugural WUSA Draft after returning to her native Iceland for one season prior to being selected.
- · Maddie Elwell was selected 30th overall by the Washington Spirit in the December 2021 NWSL Draft and made her professional debut on May 18, 2022. The All-SEC honoree scored her first goal with the Spirit less than a month later (June 17, 2022).
- Former Vanderbilt standout Simone Charley has also continued her soccer career at the professional level as a member of Angel City FC.
