GAME STORYLINES

- ▶ Hawai'i and Vanderbilt will be meeting for the first time on the football field.
- ▶ This season marks the sixth time UH will play in Week 0 and second time it is hosting a Week 0 game. UH has a 3-2 mark in Week 0 which includes a home win over Arizona (45-38) in 2019.
- ▶ UH is playing an SEC team for the first time since losing at Florida in the 2008 season opener. UH also closed out the 2007 season with a loss to Georgia in the Sugar Bowl.
- ▶ The last time UH hosted and defeated an SEC team was against Alabama in 2003 (37-29) at Aloha Stadium.
- ▶ UH is 3-9-1 all-time against current SEC teams, including a 3-5-1 record at home.
- ▶ Hawai'i is 63-37-5 (.624) all-time in season openers, with wins in four of the last five since 2017 and five of seven since 2015.
- ▶ UH has won seven straight home openers with the last loss coming against No. 25 Washington (17-16) in 2014.
- ▶ Hawai'i has won its last three home games against Power 5 opponents, beating Arizona and Oregon State in 2019 and Colorado in 2015. The last loss came against Oregon State in 2014.
- ▶ Record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was named the 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022, returning to his alma mater where he set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records from 2000-04.
- ▶ Chang is looking to become the 11th head coach to win in his UH debut and the fifth to do so since the program began playing an all-collegiate schedule in 1966.
- ▶ Entering the second season playing in a retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Complex, the Rainbow Warriors will play a home opener in front of fans for the first time since the 2019 season. Last year marked UH's first season playing on campus in the program's 106-year history.
- ▶ UH's offensive line unit is among the most experienced in the country, ranking third nationally in number of starts returning with 109, trailing only Pitt (130) and UTSA (118).
- ▶ Hawai'i enters the season with 51 newcomers on the roster, including 28 transfers, 16 of which came from Power 5 schools.
- ▶ UH's all-time record in the month of August is 7-8 (*Division I era*).
- ▶ UH has won its last seven non-conference home games with its last loss to Louisiana Tech in the 2018 Hawai'i Bowl.

NEW HOME STADIUM

For the next several years, UH will play its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex. The stadium seats approximately 9,000 with plans to expand in 2023. Previously, Hawaii played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Contact the UH Sports Media Relations Office to arrange player or coach interviews at least 24 hours in advance. Players and coaches will be available for interviews after practice on Tuesday and Wednesday. Every effort will be made to accommodate interview requests but players will not be asked to miss class, study hall, practices, or medical treatment. Players mobile or home numbers will not be released by the Sports Media Relations Office.

MEDICAL POLICY

The UH Sports Media Relations Office abides by federal law pertaining to the releasing of injury information. We will not disseminate any information about a student-athletes' injury without written consent. The only information given to the media will be if a student-athlete is "probable," "questionable," or "doubtful" to play. However, the student-athlete may release information about his/her injury.

WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

In an effort to standardize the school's nicknames, UH officially changed its men's team nickname to "Rainbow Warriors" on July 1, 2013. The school's women's teams are still referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

POST-GAME PRESS CONFERENCE

WE ARE THE "BRADDAAHOO"

▶ The "Braddahhood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy.

▶ WR Jonah Panoke was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach Timmy Chang, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

SEASON OPENERS

▶ UH is 63-37-5 (.624) all-time in season openers, with wins in four of the last five since 2017 and five of seven since 2015.

▶ Last season, UH dropped its first season opener since 2016. It had previously won four straight season openers and five in the last six years.

▶ UH has won seven straight home openers with the last loss coming against No. 25 Washington (17-16) in 2014.

▶ This season marks the sixth time UH will play in Week 0 and second time it is hosting a Week 0 game. UH has a 3-2 mark in Week 0 which includes a home win over Arizona (45-38) in 2019

HAWAII VS. SEC

▶ UH is 3-9-1 all-time against current SEC teams, including a 3-5-1 record at home.

▶ UH is playing an SEC team for the first time since losing at Florida in the 2008 season opener. UH also closed out the 2007 season with a loss to Georgia in the Sugar Bowl.

▶ The last time UH hosted and defeated an SEC team was against Alabama in 2003 (37-29) at Aloha Stadium.

▶ UH also hosted an SEC team (while a member of the conference) two previous times Alabama (2002) and Tennessee (1975).

▶ UH's two other wins against an SEC team were against South Carolina.

HAWAII VS. THE POWER 5

▶ Since 2003, UH has 12 wins versus teams from the Power 5 conferences—ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12 and SEC—in 41 opportunities.

▶ UH's last eight wins against Power 5 conferences have come against Pac-12 opponents.

▶ The last time UH beat two Power 5 teams in the same season was 2019 (def. Arizona, 45-38 and Oregon State, 31-28).

▶ In addition, UH will play at Michigan in Ann Arbor for the second time since 2016.

CALLING THE PLAYS

▶ UH's three coordinators all have experience calling plays in their respective units.

▶ OC Ian Shoemaker has helped establish 61 total offensive school records and orchestrated the number-one ranked offense as offensive coordinator at four different programs over a 20-year career. At his last stop, he directed FCS power Eastern Washington to an average of 537.1 yards and 41.3 points per game over three seasons.

▶ DC Jacob Yoro, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. He previously served as defensive coordinator at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.

▶ ST Thomas Sheffield has brought his "Ride or Die" philosophy to UH after serving as a coordinator at each of his four previous spots, most recently at Nevada for the past two seasons.

SCHEDULE NOTES

▶ Seven of UH's opponents this season played in bowl games in 2021—Western Kentucky (Boca Raton), Michigan (Orange), San Diego State (Frisco), Nevada (Quick Lane), Wyoming (Famous Idaho Potato), Fresno State (New Mexico), and Utah State (Los Angeles).

▶ UH will play two first-time opponents—Vanderbilt and Western Kentucky—in the first two weeks of the season.

▶ UH will host an FCS opponent (Duquesne) for the 14th time in the last 16 years. UH has a

► UH will make six road trips this season, including a 8,920-mile trek to Ann Arbor, Mich., to play at Michigan. The six trips will total 37,080 air miles.

► The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

O-LINE EXPERIENCE

► UH's offensive line unit is among the most experienced in the country, ranking third nationally in number of starts returning with 109, trailing only Georgia State (141), Pitt (130) and UTSA (118).

► Ilm Manning has started 47 of 49 career games and earned all-Mountain West honorable mention honors in 2021.

► Solo Vaipulu is in his fifth year with the program and has the second-most career starts (40). Micah Vanterpool started 11 games last season at left guard and has 16 career starts.

TEXAS GUNSLINGER

► Brayden Schager made three starts at quarterback in 2021 and was one of just 13 true freshmen nationally to start a game last season.

► The Dallas, Texas native was 2-1 as the starter with wins in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State and New Mexico State.

► Became the fifth straight UH QB to win his starting debut and the second straight freshman to do so.

► On the year, he completed 65-of-107 (60.8%) for 615 yards, 2 TDs and 5 INTs.

ONE PARSON PARTY

► After splitting the running back duties last year, Dedrick Parson will carry the load this year.

► The Philadelphia, Pa., native was the team's second-leading rusher (636 yds.) on a team-leading 117 carries (5.3 avg.) and eight touchdowns. Third-leading receiver in terms of receptions with 28 catches for 279 yards and another score.

► Selected first-team all-Mountain West by PFF last season in which he also served as the team's primary punt returner finishing with three returns for 21 yards (7.0 avg.).

► Rushed 25 times for 161 yards and three TDs against NM State (Oct. 23) along with a team-high six receptions for 54 yards for a total of 215 all-purpose yards. Tallied 115 yards receiving vs. Utah

State and scored his first receiving touchdown.

ZOOM ZOOM ZION

► When you're talking straight away speed, no one puts on the jets like Zion Bowens.

► In his first two seasons at UH, the Long Beach, Calif., native has averaged 23.6 yards per catch. Among them was a 93-yard touchdown in last year's home finale versus Colorado State, the second-longest reception in school history.

► Bowens totaled 12 catches for 257 yards last season. In his first season at UH in 2020, two of his five catches went for 40+ yards.

THE GODFATHER

► Linebacker Penei Pavihi enters his sixth season in the program having appeared in 47 career games, with 29 starts.

► The native of American Samoa has been a part of three bowl squads and 32 career victories.

► Team's leading returning tackler with 47 (28 solo) along with 4.5 tackles-for-loss, one sack, and one fumble recovery.

► In his career, has 155 total tackles, 15 tackles-for-loss, four sacks, one interception, three fumble recoveries, and one forced fumble.

IRON MAN

► Defensive lineman Blessman Ta'ala has not missed a single game in four seasons at UH.

► An all-Mountain West honorable mention selection in back-to-back seasons, he has played in 51 straight games, starting 38 of them at nose tackle.

► The Aua, American Samoa native has 102 total tackles, 14.5 tackles-for-loss, two sacks, and two blocked punts in his career, which began in 2018.

BIG-TIME ADDITIONS

► The defense was bolstered in the offseason by a number of Power 5 transfers.

► Mataio Soli brings an impressive frame (6-4, 230) and SEC pedigree to the Warriors. The former four-star recruit appeared in 33 career games over three seasons at Arkansas.

► Andrew Faoliu played in 22 games in three seasons at Oregon while Virdel Edwards II also played three seasons at safety at Iowa State.

► Wynden Ho'ohuli, the top-rated high school player out of Hawai'i in 2021, redshirted last season at Nebraska.

► Oregon State transfer JoJo Forest, Maryland transfer Devyn King, and Arizona transfer Malik Hausman also has big game experience and will contribute immediately for the Warriors.

ROCKET SHIP

► Matthew Shipley excelled at handling both placekicking and punting duties this season.

► The Liberty Hill, Texas native was 18-of-21 in field goals and a perfect 42-of-42 in PAT attempts.

► His 18 field goals were the most by a UH kicker in a single-season since Tyler Hadden in 2014 (18).

► All three of his misses on the year were from 40+ yards out and had a streak of 11 consecutive field goals made snapped at UNLV.

► Among 20 semifinalists for the Lou Groza Award

► WR **Grey Ihu** is named after Earl Grey tea, a favorite of his mom's.

► LB **Riley Wilson**'s father played for the legendary Ohio State coach Woody Hayes.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** and DL **John Tuitupou** each have three children while LB **Logan Taylor** has two children.

► Utah transfer OL **Luke Felix-Fualalo** is the tallest Warrior at 6-8 while RB **Robbie Paikai** is the shortest at 5-4.

► DB **Isalah Malloe** is the son of former UH assistant and current UCLA assistant Ikaika Malloe. WR **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala**'s brother Titus played at UCF and now plays for UCLA. DB **Von Killin**'s brother Adrian was a running back at UCF and played for Philadelphia Eagles (2020) and Denver Broncos (2021). LS **Solomon Landrum**'s father Mike played tight end for the Atlanta Falcons. DL **Mataio Soli**'s father Junior also played at Arkansas and was a fifth-round draft pick by the San Diego Chargers.

► Two players last played football in 2019—RB **Keith Moton III** (Westview HS, Ore.) and DB **JoJo Forest** (Oregon State) while OL **Micah Matearagi** (Virginia) last played in 2018.

► RB **Naszjoe "Mojo" Bryant-Lelei** changed his last name in the off-season to recognize his Polynesian family connections.

► LB **Noah Kema** and LB **Demarii Blanks** were JUCO All-Americans at Snow College and College of San Mateo, respectively.

► WR **Chuuky Hines**'s mother is from Hawaii and is of Micronesian and Hawaiian descent. His first name Chuuky translates to "mountain" in the Micronesian language of Chuukese.

► WR **Chad Owens Jr.** and TE **Landon Sims** both don their famous UH football fathers' jersey numbers. Owens wears #2 and Sims wears #30, for his father Travis.

► In his first year as the primary punter last season, averaged 41.5 yards per punt with a long of 54. Also had eight 50+ yard punts and pinned 15 inside the 20.

► **Kyler Halvorsen** finished ninth in the nation in kickoff average (64.0 yards) last season and produced touchbacks on more than half of his kickoffs.

► UH will have a new long snapper for the first time in four seasons after the departure of three-year starter Wyatt Tucker.

WATCH OUT

► Five Warriors were named to Watch Lists for three different national awards.

► PK **Matthew Shipley** was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list while DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch** is on the Wuerffel Trophy watch list.

► **Kahahawai-Welch**, WR **Jonah Panoke**, DL **Blessman Ta'ala** and OL **Solo Vaipulu** each earned a spot on the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year watch list.

SCHOOL HOUSE SHUFFLE

► This offseason, UH raided the transfer portal welcoming 17 FBS transfers and two FCS transfers.

► Among the FBS transfers, 16 are from Power 5 schools—**McKenzie Barnes** (Arizona), **Cammon Cooper** (Washington State), **Steele Dubar** (Colorado), **Virdel Edwards II** (Iowa State), **Andrew Faoliu** (Oregon), **Luke Felix-Fualalo** (Utah), **JoJo Forest** (Oregon State), **Malik Hausman** (Arizona), **Wynden Ho'ohuli** (Nebraska), **Devyn King** (Maryland), **Solomon Landrum** (Mississippi), **Kaulana Makaula** (USC), **Micah Mariteragi** (Virginia), **Meki Pei** (Washington), **Mataio Soli** (Arkansas), and **Joey Yellen** (Pittsburgh).

► Other transfers for 2022 include **Anthony Sagapolutele** (UNLV), **Jordan Murray** (Missouri State), and **JoJo Faló** (Cal Poly).

► In total, UH has 20 FBS transfers and eight FCS transfers on its roster.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

► The 2022 squad features six second-generation Rainbow Warriors—**Wynden Ho'ohuli** (Watson, 2000-05), **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole** (Kila, 2002-05), **Chad Owens, Jr.** (Chad Sr., 2001-04), **Landon Sims** (Travis, 1989-92), **Ethan Spencer** (Sean), and **Matagi Thompson** (Afatia, 1998-2000).

► Three others have older brothers who once suited up for UH—**Andrew Choi** (Zeno), **Sergio Muasau** (Darius), and **Kamuela Borden** (brothers **Kawika** & **Noah**). **Borden's** sister **Anika** also competed for UH's track and field team.

DIVERSITY U

► One of the most diverse teams in the country, UH has players from 18 states, encompassing five time zones, and five countries.

► Forty percent of the 117-man roster hail from Hawaii (47) while California (23) and Texas (12) combined make up almost a third. In addition, five players each are from Arizona and Florida.

► UH also has players from American Samoa (6), Australia (2), Canada (1), and Puerto Rico (1).

BROTHERHOOD TO BRADDAHHOOD

► Honolulu prep football powerhouse Saint Louis School, whose motto is "The Brotherhood" has the most players of any Hawaii high school on the current Rainbow Warrior roster.

► Fourteen Warriors are former Crusaders including **Kamalu DeBlake**, **Ka'ena Decembra**, **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole**, **Kona Moore**, **Arasi Mose**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Robbie Paikai**, **Jonah Panoke**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Eliki Tanuvasa**, **Devon Tauaefa**, **Isaiah Tufaga**, and **Ronson Young**.

► Linebackers coach **Jacob Yoro** also prepped at Saint Louis.

UH ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

► UH has made 119 all-time appearances on national TV and owns a 29-88-2 (.252) record.

► Hawaii is 9-15 on national television dating back to 2019 including an 1-5 mark last season.

► UH is scheduled to play four games on national television in 2022—Vanderbilt (CBSSN), at Michigan (Big Ten Network), at San Diego State (CBSSN), and at Fresno State (FSN).

ON THE CONTINENT

► Since 2016, UH is 14-22 in road/neutral site games and 11-12 in MW road games. In the eight seasons prior, UH went 11-37 in road/neutral site games and 9-23 in league contests.

TROPHY GAMES

► UH will play three of its four rivalry trophies in 2022—**Paniolo** (vs. Wyoming, Oct. 29), **Island Showdown** (vs. UNLV, Nov. 19), and **Dick Tomey Legacy** (at San José State, Nov. 26).

► The Warriors reclaimed the **Paniolo Trophy** after a season-ending win over the Cowboys in Laramie last season.

► UH and Air Force play for the **Kuter Trophy**, which the Falcons own by virtue of a 2019 win.

HAWAII IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

► Hawaii begins its 11th season in the Mountain West in 2022 and owns a 26-54 (.325) all-time mark—14-27 at home and 12-27 on the road.

► Since the conference moved to two divisions in 2013, UH is 14-26 against the West and 7-17 versus the Mountain.

'BOWS IN THE PROS

► A total of four former Warriors are in NFL camps — **S Trayvon Henderson** (Cincinnati), **WR Marcus Kemp** (NY Giants), **P Rigoberto Sanchez** (Indianapolis), and **LB Jahlan Tavai** (New England).

► **WR Keith Kirkwood** (Carolina) began his career at UH before transferring to Temple.

OTHER TEAM NOTES

► Since 2000, UH is 73-10 when generating 500+ yards of total offense.

► UH concluded the 2021 regular-season with a losing record for the first time since 2017.

► UH's first win at its new home, the **Clarence T.C. Ching Complex**, was against **Portland State** which coincidentally was the same opponent for its first win at its old home, **Aloha Stadium**.

► A total of 21 members of the 2022 team currently hold bachelor degrees.

TIMMY CHANG

Former record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was hired as the University of Hawai'i's 25th head football coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022.

Chang spent the last five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, before recently following former Wolf Pack head coach Jay Norvell at Colorado State. During his five seasons at Nevada, Chang helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

In 2021, Nevada placed three different pass catchers on the Fred Biletnikoff Award Watch List, including two-time All-Mountain West selections Romeo Doubs and Cole Turner. The receiving corps helped power a Wolf Pack passing game that finished fourth nationally.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia. During that season the Wasps averaged 33.0 points and 463.5 yards per game.

Previously, Chang spent two seasons at Jackson State University in Jackson, Miss., as his run-and-shoot offense had the Tigers humming as well. Jackson State led the Southwestern Athletic Conference and finished among the leaders nationally in multiple offensive categories, including passing yardage, completions, completion percentage and total offense.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons. He assisted in all aspects of the Mustangs' offense with a primary focus on the Mustang quarterbacks. In Chang's first season in 2012, SMU earned an invite to the Hawai'i Bowl where they defeated Fresno State.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his illustrious collegiate career at UH, Chang played professional football in the National Football League, Canadian Football League, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from professional football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

▶ Head coach **Timmy Chang** is one of 22 minority head coaches in FBS football and one of three Polynesians (Kalani Sitake-BYU and Ken Niumatalolo-Navy). Among the full-time assistant coaches, UH is tied with Miami (Fla.) for the national lead with eight minority assistants.

▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), several former Warriors are on the coaching staff: ILB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), CB coach **Abe Elimimian** (2001-04), RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** (2001), QC **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14), GA **Alema Kapoi** (2020-21), and intern **Samson Anguay** (2013-14, '16).

▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang coached with both **Thomas Sheffield** and **Josh Brown** at Nevada. In addition, **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel), **Cade Socha** (Quality Control) and **Jimbo Davis** (Quality Control) also were on staff at Nevada.

▶ **Elimimian** enters his eighth season on the coaching staff while working for his fifth head coach (Norm Chow, Chris Naeole-interim, Nick Rolovich, Todd Graham, Timmy Chang). The former UH cornerback earned first-team all-conference honors and played in three bowl games. His younger brother Solomon (2005-08) is UH's all-time tackles leader and retired CFL linebacker, who was the league's Most Outstanding Player in 2014.

▶ Defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.

▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.

▶ OC **Ian Shoemaker** and DL coach **Eti Ena** both coached at Eastern Washington last season. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro and Josh Brown at Cal Poly.

▶ OL coach **Roman Sapolu**'s father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.

▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).

▶ The 11 full-time coaches have a combined 35 children. RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** has eight children, all of whom begin with the letter K and have Hawaiian first names.
