### PACK FACTS

#### A WIN ON THURSDAY WOULD

- Be the 1,003rd win in program history (1,002-479)
- Be head coach Wes Moore's 785th career win (784-239)
- Be Moore's 227th win at NC State (226-70)
- Extend the Pack's winning run against unranked teams to 37 games, a streak that started on Feb. 11, 2021

#### MILESTONE WATCH

- This season marks the 25 Year Anniversary of the team's first and only NCAA Final Four appearance. On March 21, 1998, NC State defeated UConn in the regional final to advance to the national semifinal.
- Wes Moore would reach the 800 career victories mark with another 20-win season at NC State this year. He is currently 16 victories away from that mark.
- Moore is also four games away from his 300th game at NC State.

#### NOTING THE WOLFPACK (4-1)

- The Wolfpack ranks in the top 30 nationally in rebound margin (4th - +19.4), rebounds per game (21st - 47.4), scoring margin (21st - +29.0) and scoring offense (27th - 84.4).
- NC State won each of its first four games of the year by 34 or more points - Quinnipiac (37 points), Elon (34 points), Mount St. Mary's (48 points), Charlotte (48 points). The Pack joins LSU, Michigan State and Stanford as the four schools in the nation to have four or more win margins of 34+ this season, and all of those teams have

- also held their opponents to less than 60 points in every game.
- Diamond Johnson leads the team in scoring (12.6), steals (1.8) and assists (3.6). Her assist-to-turnover ratio of 4.50 is among the best in the country (1st in ACC, 14th nationally) as she has dished out 18 assists with just four turnovers in the Pack's first five games.
- Three Wolfpack players average 10+ points - Johnson (12.6), Madison Hayes (11.2) and Jada Boyd (11.0). All three of those players also average over four rebounds per game and are shooting 40+ percent from the field.
- NC State checked in at No. 13 in Monday's release of the AP Top 25, falling outside of the Top 10 for the first time since Dec. 9, 2019.
- The Wolfpack was picked to finish third in the ACC behind Louisville and Virginia Tech. NC State has been selected to finish in the top three in the league four seasons in a row and has successfully finished in the top four in the league (tiebreakers included) every year since 2016-17.
- NC State's 2022-23 roster is made up of 11 players - eight returners from last season and three transfers (two graduates, one sophomore).
- The Wolfpack opened its 2022-23 campaign with four home games in the first nine days and is now amidst a five-game stretch away from home that spans from Nov. 20 through Dec. 5.

LAST MEETING - NC STATE vs. Vanderbilt

RALEIGH - The 17th-ranked NC State women's basketball team improved to 3-0 for the eighth straight season on Thursday evening by defeating visiting Vanderbilt 74-54 on Kay Yow Court inside Reynolds Coliseum.

NC State fought through a challenging first quarter and emerged with a 16-15 lead through 10 minutes before scoring 21 of 29 points in the second quarter to take a commanding 37-23 advantage into halftime. The Wolfpack did not once allow the Commodores to pull within single digits during the second half, and ultimately ended the game on a 5-0 run over the final 3:24 to close out the comfortable victory.

Kiara Leslie led all players with 21 points on 7-11 shooting from the field. She was joined in double figures by Aislinn Konig (16 points), Grace Hunter (13), and freshman Elissa Cunane (10). Leslie added five assists and seven rebounds to her strong offensive effort. Sophomore Kai Crutchfield dished out a career high six assists, a figure that doubled her previous career high in the statistical category and ran up against zero turnovers committed.

Cierra Walker (17 points) led three Vanderbilt players in double figures. Chelsie Hall (14) and Mariella Fasoula (12) also had effective offensive performances for the visitors. Fasoula, a Boston College transfer, collected a game-high 11 rebounds for the lone double-double of the evening.

- The Wolfpack is on a three-game winning streak in the series between the teams.
  - NC State last took on Vandy at home on Nov. 15, 2018 during non-conference play that season. The Wolfpack earned a 20-point victory over the Commodores in what rounded out a home-and-home series between the squads.
  - Vanderbilt has not beat NC State since Nov. 28, 2009.
- NC State and Vanderbilt have faced each other just once in neutral territory, with that matchup marking their first in February of 1996. That game was played in Charlotte.

the Pack's third game of the year. It took Brown-Turner 95 career games to surpass 1,000 points as she had a career average of 10.5 points per game at the time of hitting it.

BALANCING ACT

- Eight different players have posted a double-figure scoring outing this season - Camille Hobby, Diamond Johnson, Jada Boyd, Jessica Timmons, Madison Hayes, Jakia Brown-Turner, Aziaha James and River Baldwin.
- The Pack has gone to all 11 members of its roster in every game this season, and the team has played all 11 of those women before halftime in three of five contests.
- Eight NC State players are averaging at least 5 shots per game this season. Seven of those women are shooting at clips of 40 percent or better, with Madison Hayes leading the way with her 60 percent clip after 30 shot attempts this season.
- Seven different players have knocked down threes for the Wolfpack, led by a total of 13 on the year by Johnson.
- Through five games, no player averages more than 25.1 minutes per game, and eight players average more than 15 minute per game.

EARLY SEASON QUICK HITS

- NC State pulled down 64 rebounds in the Pack's Nov. 10 game against Elon, which marked the most for the team in the Wes Moore era. Twenty-four rebounds were offensive boards, marking the most for the team since Nov. 17, 2017 and the sixth 20+ offensive rebound game in Moore's tenure.
- The Wolfpack limited The Mount to single digits in three of four quarters on Nov. 13. The opponent's 38 points marked the fewest allowed by NC State in nearly a year, dating back to just 34 scored by Washington State in the 2021 Baha Mar tournament.
- Aziaha James led the team in scoring against Mount St. Mary's with 19 points, 17 scored in the second half, that marked a new collegiate best for the sophomore. She shot 6-of-7 during her career day that marks the highest scoring game by a member of the Pack so far this year.
- Diamond Johnson has knocked down multiple three pointers in every game this season, including three-straight games with three triples. She has scored in double figures in all but the first game of the 2022-23 campaign.
- Madison Hayes has also scored in double figures in four-straight games. She notched her first career double-double against Mount St. Mary's, scoring 11 points and leading the team on the boards with 10. She then followed up with a career-high scoring performance (15 points) against Charlotte, shooting 6-of-7 overall and 3-of-4 from distance in the win.
- Over the last three games, transfer center River Baldwin has totaled 24 points (8.0 per game), 10-of-13 shooting (.769) and 24 rebounds (8.0 per game). She leads the team in rebounding average with 8.6 per game, a number that also ranks in the top 20 in the ACC this season.

D3

- Diamond Johnson changed her jersey number from zero to three (previously worn by Kai Crutchfield) ahead of the season. It is the number that she wore during her rookie campaign at Rutgers and throughout her high school/AAU career.
- In addition to being the Pack's leading scorer in 2022-23 (12.6 points per game), Johnson once again leads the way with 1.8 steals per game and 3.6 assists per game. She has scored in double figures in all but the first outing of the year.
- Among the over 250 players nationally who have attempted 20+ threes this season, Johnson's three-point percentage of .448 ranks 17th nationally.
- Johnson is the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 10.8 points per game last season. She led NC State in scoring in eight games in 2021-22 while coming off the bench in each of those contests.
- The Philadelphia native also was last year's team leader in steals (47, 1.3 per game) and was second in assists (78, 2.2 per game).
- Johnson scored a season-high 24 points in the Pack's Nov. 27, 2021 win over Washington State last year. The performance stood as the highest scoring performance by a member of the Wolfpack for the rest of the season.
- In 2021-22, Johnson posted: 18 games with 10+ points, 13 games with 5+ rebounds, 17 games with 3+ assists and 13 games with 2+ steals.

BOUNCING BACK

Since the start of the 2019-20 campaign, NC State has lost just 12 games. Only two of those losses have been by double-digit margins, and the remaining 10 losses were by an average of just 5.2 points. Sunday's 91-69 setback at fifth-ranked UConn marked the Pack's only time losing by double figures in regulation since the 2018-19 season.

WE WIN 1,000

With its Nov. 10 win over Elon, NC State became the 19th NCAA Division I program and the third ACC program (Notre Dame, UNC) to reach 1,000 victories in program history. The team accomplished that feat in 1,478 games and early in the 49th season in its history, putting itself 522 games over the .500 mark on the day of its 1,000th win. NC State is one of just 12 women's basketball programs with 1,000 wins in less than 50 years of action.

1K CLUB

With a jumper in the middle of the third quarter against Mount St. Mary's (Nov. 13), senior Jakia Brown-Turner became the 37th player in program history to reach 1,000 career points. She needed 19 points coming into her senior season and accomplished that in

The Wolfpack has not suffered back-to-back losses in the same season since 2019-20 when it fell to ninth-ranked Louisville (2/13/20) and Georgia Tech (2/16/20) in consecutive home games.

NC State's three most recent losses prior to Sunday have resulted in it beating its next opponent by 20 or more points in each game.

**RANKED WINS UNDER MOORE**

NC State has defeated a total of 33 nationally-ranked opponents (33-39) in the Wes Moore era. The Pack has defeated six top-five foes (6-14) under Moore's leadership: No. 2 Notre Dame in 2016-17, No. 1 South Carolina in 2020-21, No. 1 Louisville in 2020-21, No. 5 Louisville in 2020-21, No. 2 Maryland in 2021-22, No. 3 Louisville in 2021-22.

Since Moore took over ahead of the 2013-14 campaign, the Wolfpack has played 23 road games against AP Top 25 opponents. NC State is 8-15 in those games (5-8 against AP Top 10 opponents and 2-5 against AP Top 5 teams).

**CAREER COUNTDOWNS**

Jakia Brown-Turner became the only player on this year's Wolfpack roster with 1,000 career points. Three Wolfpack players are within 300 points of hitting that milestone respective careers:

- Diamond Johnson (787, 213 points away)
- Jada Boyd (767, 233 points away)
- Mimi Collins (764, 236 points away)

**THREE BALL**

- Against Charlotte on Nov. 16, NC State shot 11-of-19 (.579) from three-point range. That percentage is the best by any ACC team this season and eighth-best in the nation.
- The Wolfpack has knocked down 10+ threes in 62 games under Wes Moore's leadership. NC State is 58-4 (.935) in those games and has not lost a game in which it hit at least 10 triples since Jan. 9, 2020 (UNC).

**SUSTAINING SUCCESS**

The Wes Moore era, and the last five completed seasons especially, have been some of the best in NC State women's basketball history. In addition to reaching four NCAA Sweet 16s and winning three ACC titles in a row, the Wolfpack ranked seventh among all Division I teams in win percentage (.840) and overall wins (136-26) from 2017-18 through 2021-22. The only other ACC school with a better mark in that time period is Louisville (151-20, .883).

**STRONG STARTING SLATE**

In advance of its league slate, NC State is challenging itself with a non-conference schedule that is one of the toughest in the nation. The average final 2021-22 NET ranking of the Wolfpack's non-conference opponents (91) is the highest in the ACC and is tied with Maryland for the national lead among Power Five squads. Highlighting the team's early-season games are road trips to a pair of AP Top 10 teams in No. 4 Iowa and No. 5 UConn.

**FAMILIAR HEIGHTS**

- Prior to the start of the season, the Wolfpack had spent 34 polls in a row in the national top five, which was then a nation-best active streak.
- The team posted a program record-tying No. 3 finish in the AP Poll each of the last two years and has finished the year ranked in the Top 10 four seasons in a row.
- NC State has ascended as high as a program-best No. 2 in the nation for three weeks each in the middle of both 2020-21 and 2021-22. The Wolfpack has been ranked No. 2 for 14 weeks in its 49-season history and has never reached a No. 1 ranking.

**HOBBY HEATING UP**

- Senior center Camille Hobby has played in all 66 of the Pack's games since the start of the 2020-21 campaign.
- Hobby has started each of the Pack's first five games of the year and scored in double figures in two of those outings.

• While coming off the bench in all but one contest during her sophomore and junior years, Hobby averaged 11.9 minutes in those 61 games between 2020-21 and 2021-22 and scored in double figures eight times, then playing behind All-American center Elissa Cunane.

• Hobby hit 10+ points in five games in 2021-22 after reaching that mark just three times in her sophomore year and zero times as a rookie.

**STRENGTH IN THE PACK**

Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State has gone 92-11 (.893) in home games. That record includes 48 out of 50 possible non-conference wins (both losses were to Top 25 opponents) and 40 out of 49 possible league wins.

The Wolfpack sold out a program-record eight games in 2021-22 and ranked second nationally in percent capacity (85.53%). For the 2022-23 campaign, NC State sold out of season tickets with a record number of 3,295 and has already sold out of seats for the upcoming Jan. 29, 2023 home game against Notre Dame.

**ALWAYS THERE**

Jakia Brown-Turner has played in 96 of the Wolfpack's 97 games since she started her collegiate career in 2019-20. In those 96 appearances, she has earned the start in 95 outings. The lone time she was left out of the starting five was during her rookie campaign when that year's seniors were given the opportunity to start in the last home game of their career.

**BOYD BUCKETS**

- Jada Boyd has 36 double-figure scoring outings in her 89-game career at NC State. All but one of those performances have come when she played less than 30 minutes, and 15 have been when she played 20 minutes or less.
- On her career, Boyd has shot 50+ percent in 56 career games. She averages 6.6 shots per game (371 total) in those outings.
- Narrowing that number down and looking only at games in which Boyd attempted a minimum of five shots, the Wolfpack junior has 40 games shooting 50+ percent, 28 shooting 60+ percent and 12 shooting 70+ percent.
- Boyd's career high still remains a 26-point night at Georgia Tech on Dec. 31, 2020. She scored 14 of those points in just eight minutes of action in the first half of that game.
- The Petersburg, Va., native has started 12 career games (all five in 2022-23, two in 2021-22 and five in 2020-21). Her first career start was in the Pack's 2021-22 season opener against North Florida during which she posted a double-double with 15 points and a team-leading 10 rebounds.

**SENIOR CLASS**

NC State's fourth-year seniors (Jada Boyd, Jakia Brown-Turner, Camille Hobby) entered their careers as the then highest-ranked freshman class in program history and will end up leaving among the best. Those three players have been part of helping the Pack compile records of 86-12 overall, 45-5 at home and 43-7 in ACC play.

The group needs 19 overall wins and just six ACC wins to tie for the most by any four-year class in team history.

**EYES ON THE PACK**

- Three members of the Wolfpack were listed on the Atlantic Coast Conference's preseason awards lists as Jakia Brown-Turner and Diamond Johnson were named to the Preseason All-ACC Team and Saniya Rivers was featured on the Newcomer Watch List.
- Brown-Turner (Ann Meyers Drysdale Award) and Mimi Collins (Cheryl Miller Award) start 2022-23 on watch lists for the respective positional awards. The nod marked Brown-Turner's third year in a row earning a spot on the preseason list.
- Brown-Turner and Johnson are in early consideration for the Naismith Trophy, marking the second year in a row that the Pack has had two on that list to start the season. The pair was also

named to the Wooden Award Top 50 watch list.

### **WOLFPACK WES**

Head coach Wes Moore's 784 career wins rank fifth among active NCAA Division I women's basketball head coaches and 14th all time. He has the most wins of any active coach in the ACC. Moore is also ranked 10th nationally among active coaches with his .766 career winning percentage.

One of the most successful coaches in collegiate women's basketball, Moore was named consensus 2022 ACC Coach of the Year. He was also the 2021 WBCA National Coach of the Year and one of four finalists for Naismith Coach of the Year in 2019, 2021 and 2022.

### **DEFENSIVE HIGHLIGHTS**

- In the Wes Moore era, the Wolfpack has held 141 of its 296 opponents (47.6 percent) to fewer than 60 points. NC State is 133-8 (.943) in such outings and is a perfect 67-0 in such games since the start of the 2018-19 campaign.
- NC State has kept its average opponent shooting percentage to below .400 every year since 2015-16. Four of those campaigns have also included an average opponent scoring mark of less than 60 points per game, including a Moore era-best mark of 57.0 in 2019-20.

### **BACK WITH THE PACK**

In 2022-23, NC State welcomes back:

- Eight of 14 players from the 2021-22 roster (one starter - Jakia Brown-Turner)
- Second and third leading scorers from last season in Diamond Johnson and Brown-Turner
- Four players who averaged at least five points per game in 2021-22 - Johnson (10.8), Brown-Turner (9.8), Jada Boyd (7.6) and Camille Hobby (5.1)
- The team's leader in field-goal percentage - Boyd (.595), who was ACC Sixth Player of the Year in 2021
- 50.1 percent of its points scored (1,395 of 2,782)
- 50.8 percent of its made shots (538 of 1,060)
- 50.2 percent of its total steals (134 of 267)

### **BROWN-TURNER BALLING OUT**

- After averaging 8.2 points in the Pack's first 17 games of 2021-22, Jakia Brown-Turner upped her scoring average to 11.1 points in the Pack's last 19 outings of her junior campaign.
- She scored in double figures five times in that front half of the season but hit that threshold 11 times after, including a season-high 20 points scored in the Pack's finale against UConn.
- Perhaps most impressive was Brown-Turner's field-goal percentage increase in that time span. Prior to Jan. 20, she averaged 38.5 percent shooting and upped that mark to a blistering 50.0 percent in the last two months of 2021-22.

### **TURNING UP THE PRESSURE**

- The Pack has forced 20+ turnovers and snagged 10+ steals in a total of 26 games under the leadership of Wes Moore, most recently doing so with 23 turnovers forced and 12 steals against Elon.
- In the Moore era, NC State is 31-8 when its opponents have at least 20 turnovers.
- NC State's 23 turnovers forced against the Phoenix marked the most for the team since it also forced Clemson into 23 mishandles on Dec. 30, 2021.
- Through Nov. 20 games, the Wolfpack joins Virginia Tech and Arizona as the only three Power Five teams to post two outings with 20+ opponent turnovers forced and 10 or fewer turnovers of their own at the same time.

### **THREE FOR JBT**

Jakia Brown-Turner has hit 128 three pointers in her career, which ranks 14th on NC State's all-time list. As the wing looks to work her way up that list, she needs 16 more threes to tie with Billie McDowell and Tynesha Lewis for 12th in program history with 142.

### **WOLF-PUPS**

On National Signing Day (Nov. 9, 2022), NC State inked its highest-ranked class of future Wolfpackers as four high school student-athletes signed to join the squad beginning with the 2023-24 season. The class was ranked a high as fourth nationally by ESPN, and the four top-100 signees mark the best-ranked class in the ACC.

### **WELCOME HOME, COACH ASHLEY**

Wolfpack women's basketball alumna Ashley Williams (Class of 2017) makes her return to Raleigh as an assistant coach on NC State's staff. Williams joins the staff after spending the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons as an assistant coach at Indiana, which is where she also completed a two-year graduate manager stint (2017-19) immediately following her graduation from NC State.

Williams was recognized as one of the WBCA's Thirty Under 30 honorees in 2020-21 for exemplifying her involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others in the game.

As a player, Williams played in 117 games for the Wolfpack and earned the starting nod in 61 of those outings. Williams ended her NC State career ranked fourth in program history in career three-point percentage (.376) and sixth in career three pointers made (168). As a senior in 2016-17, Williams averaged 7.8 points, 3.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists as a starting guard on an NC State squad that advanced past the first round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 10 years.

### **21-22 REWIND**

- NC State went 32-4 overall in 2021-22 and reached the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight for the second time in team history (joining the 1997-98 squad).
- The team's 32 wins last season marked the most in a single year in 48 completed seasons of NC State women's basketball. The campaign marked the first 30+ win season in program history as the Wolfpack became the 63rd NCAA Division I women's basketball team to hit that mark at least once in its history.
- The Wolfpack earned a No. 1 seed in the national tournament for the second season in a row. The 2020-21 campaign marked the first-ever No. 1 tournament seed for the team in program history.
- NC State swept the ACC Tournament and regular-season crowns for the third time in team history and the first time since 1984-85.
- The team went 17-1 in league action to claim the regular-season title for the first time since 1990.
- The Pack compiled a 20+ win season for the seventh year in a row and the eighth time in nine completed seasons under the leadership of head coach Wes Moore. It marks the longest such streak since the team had nine consecutive 20+ win seasons from 1976-77 through 1984-85.
- It also marked the Pack's 13th time winning 25+ games in a year and the fifth time in the Coach Moore era.
- Nine of the Pack's wins were against nationally-ranked opponents, the most such victories in a single season for the Wolfpack. The squad played one of the toughest non-conference schedules in the nation in 2021-22, tying for the national lead in number of fellow Power Five teams played with seven.
- All four of the Pack's losses were to opponents ranked in the Top 25.

### **LOCKER ROOM RENO**

Following the 2022-23 season, NC State Athletics will begin

construction on a renovated and enhanced locker room inside of Reynolds Coliseum. The space will be named the Gayle and Dwain Lanier Women's Basketball Locker Room in honor of the team's loyal supporters who made the single-largest gift ever to the program.

Gayle (Class of 1982) and Dwain (Class of 1979) Lanier have a rich history of helping NC State students pursue their dreams. They previously established the Dwain K. and Gayle S. Lanier Scholarship endowments to help underrepresented students from North Carolina study engineering, and they have generously donated to other scholarships and programs across campus. NC State Athletics is excited for this opportunity to have its student-athletes see a woman's name on their locker room every day.

### FINALLY A HALL OF FAMER

Program alumna and current national broadcaster **Debbie Antonelli** was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame as a member of the Class of 2022. Antonelli is a 1986 NC State graduate who was a three-year starter on the women's basketball team for legendary head coach Kay Yow. During her career, the Wolfpack made four NCAA Tournament appearances and advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 twice. Antonelli was a member of the historic 1984-85 squad which was the last team until last season's 2021-22 team to sweep the ACC regular season and ACC Tournament titles.
