CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Mississippi State's Jessika Carter tied a career-high with 29 points in the win over New Mexico. She also set a career-high with 4 assists. She earned her 6th double-double of the season, 24th of her career by adding 10 rebounds. Her 14 made field goals were the most by any SEC player this season and her 29 points scored were an SEC-high for the week of Dec. 21-26. Her 2 blocked shots continued her streak of multiple blocked shots in a game to six straight. She is second in the league in blocks with 36. She currently sits at 999 career points and with her next basket will become the 28th member of the MSU 1,000-point club.

Co-Freshmen of the Week

• Alabama's Karly Weathers scored a career-high 21 points and tallied a career-high 6 rebounds in the team's 64-point win over North Florida. She led Alabama in scoring despite playing just 22 minutes against North Florida. She also added three steals and an assist against the Ospreys.

• Auburn's Sydney Shaw scored 14 points in Auburn's 77-49 win over North Florida. She added four assists and a career-high four steals in the win, giving her 46 assists through 12 games. With 3.8 assists per game this year, she leads Auburn and ranks ninth in the SEC among all players and tops among SEC freshmen.

Around the League

• LSU's Angel Reese recorded her 13th double-double in the conference opener. She has a double-double in every game this season.

• Mississippi State's Jessika Carter joined the exclusive 1,000-point club at MSU as the 28th all-time member. She did it with her 25th career double-double, seventh this season.

• The Gamecocks improved to 13-0 for the third time in the past nine seasons with the win over Texas A&M.

• South Carolina's bench out-scored its starters for the seventh time this season, accounting for 42 of the team's 76 points.

• The Lady Vols out-rebounded the Gators 45-27, resulting in 16 second-chance points. Tennessee has now won the rebounding battle in 11 of 15 games this season, including nine of the past 10.

2023 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with seven, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

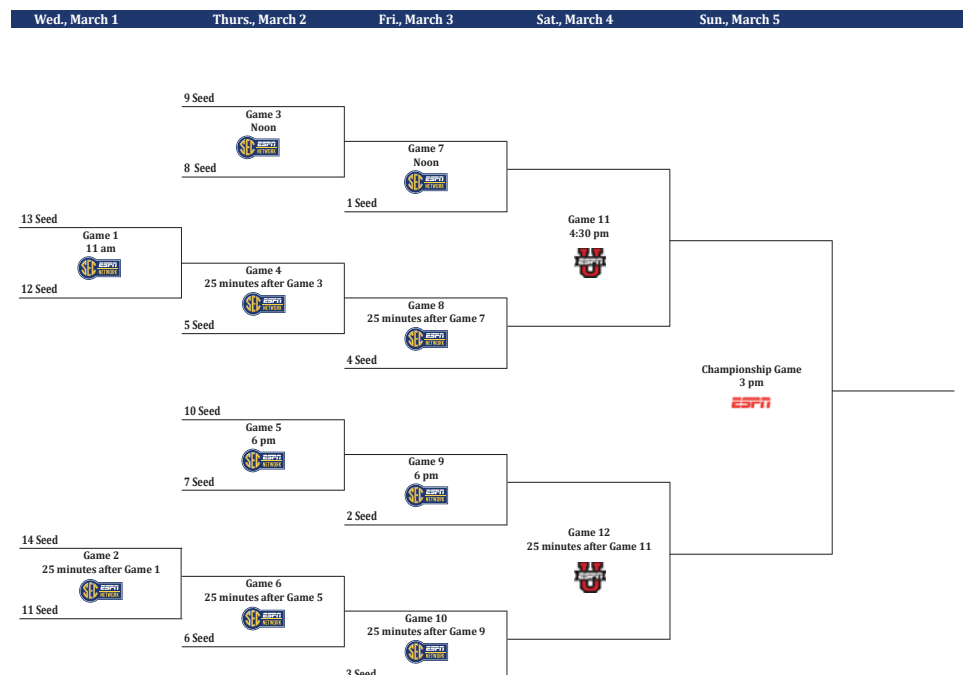
D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 10 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 40 Final Four appearances and 159 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Eleven of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, nine with their respective SEC teams.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 14 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 79 players named first-team a total of 159 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdscaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The league has also had two Honda-Broderick Cup winners. South Carolina's Aliyah Boston won in 2022 with Tennessee's Chamique Holdscaw claiming it in 1998.
- The Southeastern Conference had 23 former student-athletes make 2022 WNBA opening day rosters.
- Overall, the SEC has had 159 former players go on to play in the league.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 179 former players drafted for the professional league, including six No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- A total of 112 women's basketball students were named to the 2021-22 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball attendance for the seventh consecutive season. A total of 1,016,345 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. The conference set the all-time attendance high for any conference with 1,108,511 fans in 2016. The SEC and the Big 12 Conference remain the only two conferences to host more than 1 million fans during the course of a season.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.

Polls

• Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/WBCA poll began in the 1985-86 season).

• Two SEC teams have run the season at the No. 1 spot in the both the AP and USA Today coaches poll. Tennessee in the 1997-98 season and South Carolina in the 2021-22 season.

• The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).

• Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.

• Since the 1982 season, SEC teams have been ranked for 756 consecutive weeks of the AP poll.

• Since 1982, league teams have been ranked in the AP poll 3,752 times, including 1,754 Top 10 appearances, 945 Top 5 appearances and 189 No. 1 rankings.

• Overall, SEC teams have been ranked 831 weeks for a total of 4,583 times. The SEC has 1,851 Top 10 appearances and 1,006 Top Five appearances. SEC teams can also boost a total of 201 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

• The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week two in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

• Since the USA Today Coaches poll began in 1985 season, SEC teams have been ranked in every poll. A total of 701 consecutive weeks.

• League teams have been ranked in the coaches poll 3,405 times, including 1,578 Top 10 appearances, 911 Top 5 appearances and 179 No. 1 rankings.

• The most SEC teams in the final coaches poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1995, 1997, 2003, and 2021).

• The league has had the top three teams in the coaches poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week seven in 1989.
