CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Angel Reese set a career-high with 36 points and hauled in 20 rebounds against Ole Miss, her fourth game of the season with 20+ points and 20+ rebounds. It marked the first time since 1978 (Maree Jackson) that a LSU player had 30+ points (or 35+ points) and 20+ rebounds. It marked the 11th time in LSU history a player had 30 and 20 and it was the seventh time a player had 35 and 20. Jackson had previously recorded all of LSU's 35/20 games. Julie Gross had one 30/20 game. Gross, Jackson and Reese are the only three players in LSU history to record 30/20 games. Reese's 36 points were the most by a LSU player since Cornelia Gayden scored 49 vs. Jackson State in 1995. Against Florida, Reese was the first SEC player over the last 20 seasons with 25 points, 15 rebounds and 5 assists in a conference game. Reese has a double-double in 25 of LSU's 26 games this season. For the week she averaged 30.5 ppg, 18.0 rpg, 2.5 apg, 1.5 bpg and .0 spg.

Freshman of the Week

• Missouri's Ashton Judd scored a career-high 17 points in a win over Mississippi State, including going perfect from the three-point line (3-of-3). She has scored 10+ in four of the Tigers last five games. Judd's two steals against Mississippi State were part of an effort that saw Missouri notch 15 as a team, the most for the program since Dec. 2, 2017 against New Orleans. They also helped Missouri force 20+ turnovers in back-to-back conference games, the Tigers last accomplished that feat on Jan. 17 and Jan. 20, 2010 as a member of the Big 12. In the win over Texas A&M, Judd had 16 points and seven rebounds. Her 7-of-8 shooting performance over Texas A&M was her most efficient performance of the season with six or more attempts. For the week, Judd went 14-of-20 (.700). She has notched 10 games of 10+ points this season and is currently second in the SEC in 3-point efficiency at 45.5%.

Around the League

• Mississippi State's JerKaila Jordan leads her team in scoring, rebounding, steals, blocks, 3-point percentage and field goal percentage. The only player in the league to lead her team in all categories.

• Sacha Washington turned in back-to-back double-doubles for the first time this season last week, giving her a team-leading total of five in 2022-23. She scored a career-best 26 points while leading all players with 11 rebounds at Alabama on Thursday, then recorded a season-high 15 rebounds to go along with 15 points in the Commodores' 22-point win over Kentucky

• Tennessee's Rickea Jackson has been on a tear, scoring 21 points or more in her last four games and now has nine 20-point scoring efforts in league play.

• South Carolina's Zia Cooke posted her fifth and sixth 20-point games of the season last week. That's ties her efforts in 2020-21 for her most in a single season.

• Javyn Nicholson turned in the best game of her career to help lead Georgia to its fourth-straight win. The senior tied a career high with 24 points off a 10-for-15 shooting effort and brought down seven rebounds against Arkansas.

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2023 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with seven, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

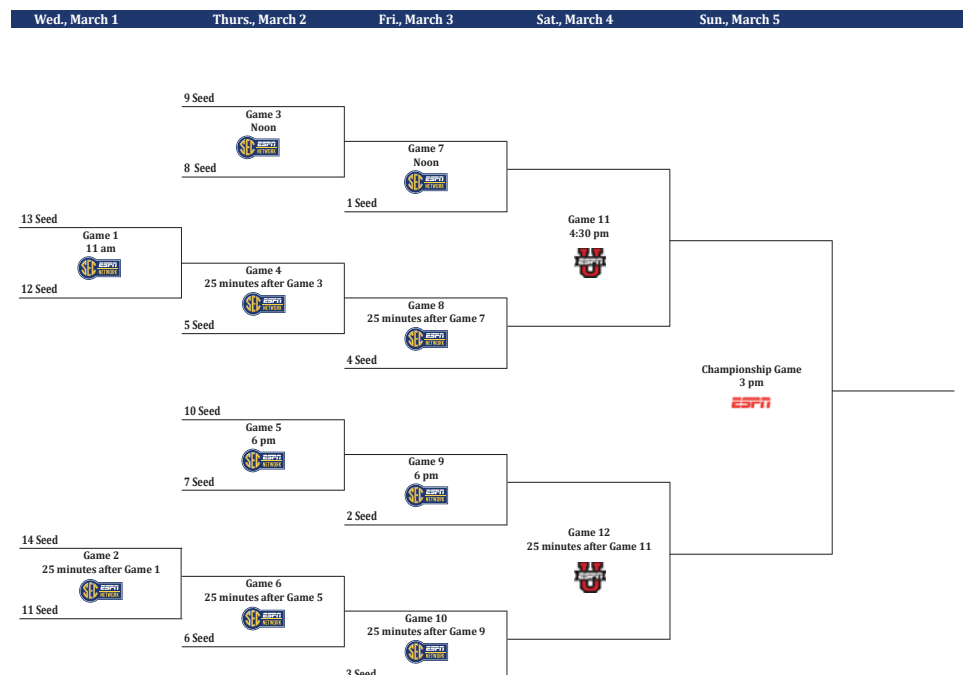
D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 10 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 40 Final Four appearances and 159 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Eleven of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, nine with their respective SEC teams.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 14 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 79 players named first-team a total of 159 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdscaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The league has also had two Honda-Broderick Cup winners. South Carolina's Aliyah Boston won in 2022 with Tennessee's Chamique Holdscaw claiming it in 1998.
- The Southeastern Conference had 23 former student-athletes make 2022 WNBA opening day rosters.
- Overall, the SEC has had 159 former players go on to play in the league.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 179 former players drafted for the professional league, including six No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- A total of 112 women's basketball students were named to the 2021-22 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball attendance for the seventh consecutive season. A total of 1,016,345 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. The conference set the all-time attendance high for any conference with 1,108,511 fans in 2016. The SEC and the Big 12 Conference remain the only two conferences to host more than 1 million fans during the course of a season.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.

Polls

• Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/WBCA poll began in the 1985-86 season).

• Two SEC teams have run the season at the No. 1 spot in the both the AP and USA Today coaches poll. Tennessee in the 1997-98 season and South Carolina in the 2021-22 season.

• The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).

• Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.

• Since the 1982 season, SEC teams have been ranked for 764 consecutive weeks of the AP poll.

• Since 1982, league teams have been ranked in the AP poll 3,768 times, including 1,770 Top 10 appearances, 960 Top 5 appearances and 197 No. 1 rankings.

• Overall, SEC teams have been ranked 839 weeks for a total of 4,599 times. The SEC has 1,867 Top 10 appearances and 1,021 Top Five appearances. SEC teams can also boost a total of 209 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

• The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week two in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

• Since the USA Today Coaches poll began in 1985 season, SEC teams have been ranked in every poll. A total of 709 consecutive weeks.

• League teams have been ranked in the coaches poll 3,424 times, including 1,594 Top 10 appearances, 926 Top 5 appearances and 187 No. 1 rankings.

• The most SEC teams in the final coaches poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1995, 1997, 2003, and 2021).

• The league has had the top three teams in the coaches poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week seven in 1989.

Non-Conference Success

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5849-1710 (.774) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 519-273 (.655) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6368-1983 (.763).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 27 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
