CONFERENCE NOTES

Player of the Week

• Cija Harbison tied a school record with a career-best 41 points to lead Vanderbilt to its first SEC win of the season Sunday over Texas A&M, adding a season-high-tying five steals and three rebounds. In equaling a mark first set over 20 years ago, she connected on a career-high 14 field goals—shooting 73.7 percent from the field—while scoring 10 of the Commodores' final 13 points (assisting on the other basket during that stretch) after the Aggies cut the deficit to eight to seal the victory. It was the most points scored by an individual in the SEC this season. She also shot 84.6 percent from the free throw line going 11-of-13. Harbison is the only player in the league currently ranked in the top five in scoring, assists and steals.

Freshman of the Week

• Kharyssa Richardson turned in the best game of her young career Monday night in Auburn's win over Florida. She recorded her first career double-double with career-highs in scoring (15) and rebounds (16) as the Tigers earned their third straight SEC win. It was the first 15-point, 15-rebound game for an Auburn player since the 2021 season and marked the most rebounds by an Auburn player this season. Along with a 7-point, 5-rebound performance in a win at Kentucky, Richardson averaged 11.0 points and 10.5 rebounds for the week.

Around the League

• Diamond Battles led Georgia to back-to-back wins with victories against Missouri and Mississippi State this week. Battles excelled offensively with a pair of double-figure scoring games – her sixth and seventh straight of the year – but also paced the Lady Bulldogs in nearly every other statistical category.

• Angel Reese collected her 21st straight double-double to extend her LSU record with 18 points and 17 rebounds in the win over Tennessee.

• Aliyah Boston posted her sixth-straight double-double and 14th of the season with 16 points and 12 rebounds at Alabama.

• Tess Darby shot 40 percent from beyond the arc at LSU,

hitting two treys to tally multiple 3-pointers for the 14th time this season and bring her 2022-23 total to 46, which is 23 from making the UT season top 10. With 102 made threes in her career, the junior pulls within 31 treys of catching Sidney Spencer to land among the top 10 career totals in program history.

• Erynn Barnum scored a career-high 37 points against Ole Miss, which is the seventh most in a game in Razorbacks history.

• Erasing the 19-point deficit against Arkansas, was the largest comeback win for Ole Miss since storming back from being down 12 against MTSU to win 65-56 in 2017.

• The Tide held South Carolina to its third-lowest score this season and second-lowest score against an SEC opponent... Alabama also held South Carolina to 17 points below the Gamecock's season scoring average heading into the game (82.9).

CONFERENCE STANDINGS

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2023 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with seven, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).

B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.

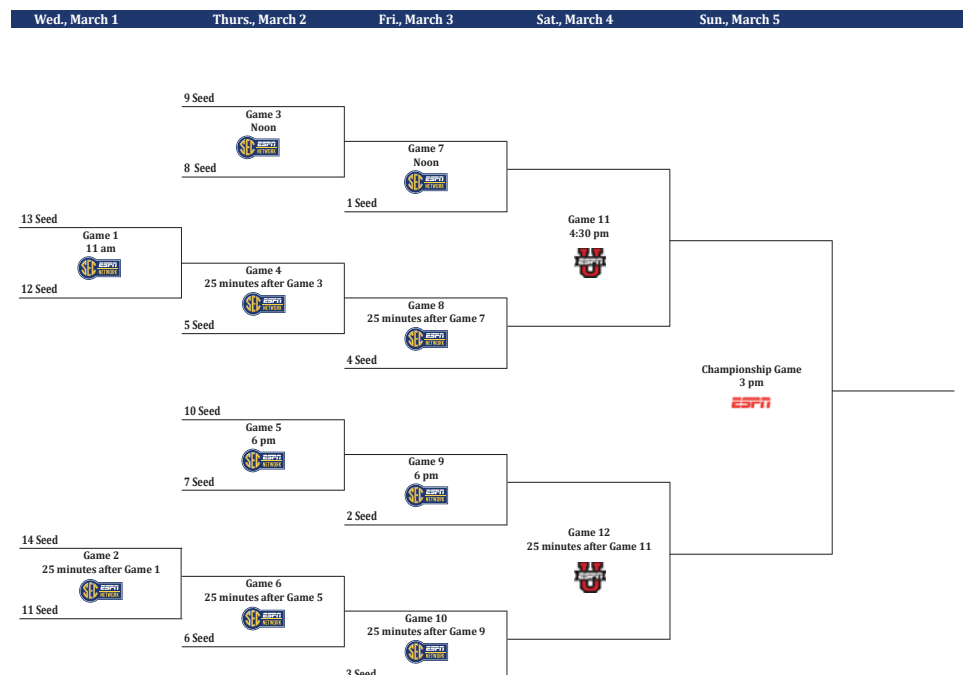
D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 10 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 40 Final Four appearances and 159 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Eleven of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, nine with their respective SEC teams.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 14 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 79 players named first-team a total of 159 times.
- The league has had eight Honda Sports Awards winners in Katrina McClain, Georgia (1987); Bridgette Gordon, Tennessee (1989); Chamique Holdscaw, Tennessee (1997 and 1998); Candace Parker, Tennessee (2007 and 2008); A'ja Wilson, South Carolina (2018) and Aliyah Boston, South Carolina (2022).
- The league has also had two Honda-Broderick Cup winners. South Carolina's Aliyah Boston won in 2022 with Tennessee's Chamique Holdscaw claiming it in 1998.
- The Southeastern Conference had 23 former student-athletes make 2022 WNBA opening day rosters.
- Overall, the SEC has had 159 former players go on to play in the league.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 179 former players drafted for the professional league, including six No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- A total of 112 women's basketball students were named to the 2021-22 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball attendance for the seventh consecutive season. A total of 1,016,345 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. The conference set the all-time attendance high for any conference with 1,108,511 fans in 2016. The SEC and the Big 12 Conference remain the only two conferences to host more than 1 million fans during the course of a season.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.

Polls

• Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/WBCA poll began in the 1985-86 season).

• Two SEC teams have run the season at the No. 1 spot in the both the AP and USA Today coaches poll. Tennessee in the 1997-98 season and South Carolina in the 2021-22 season.

• The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).

• Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.

• Since the 1982 season, SEC teams have been ranked for 761 consecutive weeks of the AP poll.

• Since 1982, league teams have been ranked in the AP poll 3,762 times, including 1,764 Top 10 appearances, 954 Top 5 appearances and 194 No. 1 rankings.

• Overall, SEC teams have been ranked 836 weeks for a total of 4,593 times. The SEC has 1,861 Top 10 appearances and 1,015 Top Five appearances. SEC teams can also boost a total of 206 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll.

• The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week two in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

• Since the USA Today Coaches poll began in 1985 season, SEC teams have been ranked in every poll. A total of 706 consecutive weeks.

• League teams have been ranked in the coaches poll 3,418 times, including 1,588 Top 10 appearances, 920 Top 5 appearances and 184 No. 1 rankings.

• The most SEC teams in the final coaches poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1995, 1997, 2003, and 2021).

• The league has had the top three teams in the coaches poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week seven in 1989.

Non-Conference Success

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5848-1710 (.774) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 519-273 (.655) against non-conference teams. Overall, teams are 6367-1983 (.763).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 27 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
