ANDY KENNEDY

ALMA MATER: UAB '91

EXPERIENCE: 3rd season at UAB

Andy Kennedy was named the seventh head coach of the UAB men's basketball program, Director of Athletics Mark Ingram announced on March 20, 2020.

Kennedy, who enters his third year with the program in 2022-23, returned to his alma mater where he is the second leading scorer in program history. A two-time SEC Coach of the Year and winningest coach in the University of Mississippi history, Kennedy coached at Ole Miss from 2006-2018, before spending two years as a commentator for ESPN and the SEC Network.

On July 21, 2022, Kennedy signed a six-year contract extension which goes through the 2027-28 season.

In his second season back in Birmingham, Kennedy led UAB to a program-record 27 victories and the Blazers' 16th NCAA Tournament appearance, punching his alma mater's ticket to the Big Dance with an 82-73 victory over Louisiana Tech in the Conference USA Tournament Championship Game. UAB's 16th NCAA Tournament appearance marked Kennedy's third NCAA Tournament appearance as a head coach, taking Ole Miss to the Big Dance in both 2013 and 2015.

Kennedy's Blazers secured their sixth conference tournament title in Frisco on March 12, 2022, marking the program's second tournament championship victory outside of Birmingham. UAB also captured its fifth Conference USA Championship in program history, winning three regular season titles and two postseason titles.

With 27 wins in his second season at UAB, Kennedy surpassed 300 career victories in 2021-22, earning win No. 300 with an 87-59 victory over UTSA on Jan. 1, 2022. Kennedy not only captured his 20th win of the season on Feb. 17 against Rice, but he also became just one of six active head coaches with 20+ wins in 12 of their first 15 seasons, joining John Calipari, Mark Few, Jim Boeheim, Jamie Dixon and Bob Huggins on the distinguished list.

Kennedy's 49 wins in his first two seasons as UAB's head coach are the most in program history, surpassing Mike Anderson's previous record of 43. His 39-11 record through his first 50 games at UAB is also a UAB men's basketball coaching record.

As a team, the Blazers finished with their highest final NET Ranking (No. 46) in program history and won 17 games over conference opponents for the first time in UAB men's basketball's 44-year history. UAB finished first in Conference USA in scoring offense (80.31), scoring margin (+13.57), field-goal percentage (.468), 3-point field-goal percentage (.377), rebounding margin (+4.49), total steals (9.60), turnover margin (+4.26) and offensive rebounding percentage (.337). Nationally, the Blazers ranked fourth in total steals (336), sixth in scoring margin (13.6), sixth in scoring offense (80.3), seventh in steals per game (9.6) and 10th in turnover margin (4.3).

The Blazers led Conference USA in scoring offense for the first time in program history and averaged more than 80 points per game for the first time since 1991, which was Kennedy's senior year as a player at UAB when he led Conference USA with 21.8 points per game (UAB single-season record).

Individually, UAB had multiple all-conference honorees for the first time since 2015-16. Transfer guard Jordan Walker highlighted the group of UAB honorees, taking home C-USA Player of the Year, C-USA Newcomer of the Year, C-USA Tournament MVP, First Team All-Conference USA and First Team NABC District 11 honors in his first season as a Blazer. Walker not only became UAB's third conference Player of the Year in March 2022, but he also joined UAB legend Oliver Robinson as the only two Blazers to earn conference Player of the Year and conference tournament MVP honors in the same season.

Quan Jackson earned Third Team All-Conference USA honors and All-Defensive Team accolades, while KJ Buffen earned All-Conference USA Honorable Mention accolades. Michael Ertel was named to the Conference USA All-Academic Team, which was UAB's first honoree since 2016. Jackson, Ertel and Walker also earned spots on the Conference USA All-Tournament Team.

UAB ranked inside the Top 55 in NET the entire season, reaching its highest NET ranking in program history (No. 28) on Dec. 13. UAB was the only team



in Conference USA with two NET Quadrant I victories during the regular season. The Blazers also reached their highest KenPom ranking in program history (No. 36) on Feb. 9.

In his first season at the helm of his alma mater, Kennedy recorded 22 victories, which was the most for a coach at a new program in 2020-21. He recorded his 20th win in 26 games, the fastest in his head coaching career. The Blazers had 13 Conference USA wins, which was most in the league.

The 2020-21 Blazers were the first squad in program history to begin the season 7-0. The record-setting sixth victory came on Dec. 12 when UAB defeated ETSU 65-61 on the road. The Blazers had one of its best conference starts since the formation of C-USA in 1995-96 as they started off 9-1 for only the second time in league history. UAB received votes in AP Poll for the first time since March 7, 2016 and in the Coaches Poll since November 21, 2017.

Individually, Tavin Lovan was named to NABC District 11 Second Team as well as the Conference USA Second Team. Quan Jackson and Trey Jemison were named to the C-USA All-Defensive Team, which was the first time in program history UAB had two members of the All-Defensive Team. The Blazers' defense was one of the best in the nation. UAB was fourth in the country in scoring defense (60.3 ppg) and turnover margin (5.4).

Kennedy experienced unprecedented success with the Rebels during his tenure in Oxford, securing a school record 245 career victories. Ole Miss captured the SEC Tournament title in 2013 with a 27-9 record, and Kennedy led the Rebels to two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2013 and 2015. Kennedy's teams advanced in both tournament appearances, knocking off fifth-seeded Wisconsin 57-46 in 2013 before rallying from a 17-point halftime deficit in 2015 to defeat BYU 94-90 in the First Four in 2015.

The former Ole Miss coach won SEC Coach of the Year honors twice during his tenure (2007 and 2013). Kennedy also captured two SEC West Division titles and led the Rebels to eight postseason appearances and 11 post-season wins during his time in Oxford. He coached 16 players who earned All-SEC honors for the Rebels. In 12 seasons at Ole Miss, Kennedy guided the Rebels to 20 or more wins nine times and ranks top 20 in SEC history for career wins.

Kennedy's first head coaching duties were at Cincinnati for the 2006 season. Named interim head coach on August 26, 2005, Kennedy took over the reins from his mentor Bob Huggins who resigned two days earlier.

In a loaded Big East Conference, he led the Bearcats a 13-2 start with road wins over Vanderbilt, Marquette, Dayton and LSU, a Final Four team. While playing only eight scholarships players, Cincinnati cracked the AP Top-25, and Kennedy was named Mid-Season National Coach of the Year by CBS Sportsline.

The winning continued when Big East Conference play began. The Bearcats stunned Jim Boeheim's Syracuse Orangemen in the Carrier Dome 82-65, knocked off Rick Pitino's Louisville Cardinals 74-68 and upset 14th-ranked West Virginia 78-75 led by John Beilein.

In his only year as UC's head coach, Kennedy had led the Bearcats to a 21-13 record, defeated 12 foes ranked in the top 100 of the RPI and played a schedule rated fifth toughest in college hoops. The New York Post labeled him the Big East Coach of the Year.

Prior to Cincinnati, Kennedy was an assistant coach at UAB from 1996 to 2001.

Kennedy played at UAB from 1988-91 and holds multiple school records. In just three seasons, he scored 1,787 points - the second most in school history - and also holds the school record for career 3-point field goals made (318) and attempted (728), 3-point field goal percentage (.437), free throw percentage (.872) and highest single-season scoring average (21.8 ppg in 1990-91).

Additionally, he holds UAB's record for most points scored by a sophomore (603) and by a senior (676), most career 20+ point games (43), most career 30+ point games (7).

Kennedy was named First Team All-Sun Belt as a senior in 1990-91, as well as Second Team All-Sun Belt as a junior in 1989-90.

He was inducted into the UAB Athletics Hall of Fame as a player on Oct. 7, 2022.

UAB TRAVELS TO VANDERBILT FOR NIT QUARTERFINALS

UAB men's basketball (27-9, 14-6 C-USA) travels to Nashville to take on Vanderbilt (22-14, 11-7 SEC) for the first time since 1997 in the National Invitation Tournament quarterfinals on Wednesday. Tipoff is set for 6 p.m. CT.

SERIES HISTORY

Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 4-1 and the Commodores have won each of the last four meetings. The Blazers' lone win in the series came in 1988 during Andy Kennedy's first season at UAB as a player. AK has won three-straight games at Memorial Gymnasium, and he has won six of his last seven meetings with the Commodores.

NIT HISTORY

The Blazers are returning to the NIT for the first time since the 2015-16 season. UAB's last win in the tournament came in 2010 when the Blazers reached the quarterfinals. Twice UAB has reached the NIT semifinals, winning the third place game each time.

LAST TIME OUT

The Blazers advanced to the NIT quarterfinals with a 77-59 win over Morehead State. Ty Brewer finished with 25 points and nine rebounds while Trey Jemison added 11 points and grabbed a career high 16 rebounds. The Blazers matched their program record of 27 wins last season.

IN ELITE COMPANY

With the Blazers win over UTSA (2/18), Andy Kennedy became just one of seven active head coaches with 20+ wins in 13 of their first 16 seasons. The six other coaches on the list include John Calipari, Mark Few, Jim Boeheim, Jamie Dixon, Thad Matta and Bob Huggins. Kennedy has led the Blazers to 76 wins over three seasons, the most over a three-year stretch in program history. He holds the best record of any UAB coach over his first 100 games at 76-24, passing Mike Anderson's record of 66-34.

EVER FAITHFUL, EVER LOYAL

Tavin Lovan played in his 138th game as a Blazer against Charlotte, breaking his tie with Anthony Gordon for the most games played by an individual at UAB. Lovan is playing his fifth season in Birmingham.

TALL T'S DOMINANCE

Trey Jemison has closed his UAB career with authority, averaging a career best 9.1 points and 8.4 rebounds per game this season. He matched his previous career high of 17 points at FIU and then set his current career best of 18 points against Middle Tennessee. His tip-in with nine seconds to

go against FIU put the game away for UAB. He has recorded double-doubles in eight of the last 20 games. Jemison set a career high with 16 rebounds in the Blazers' NIT second round win over Morehead State.

MAKING HIMSELF KNOWN

Eric Gaines had a career night when the Blazers defeated Presbyterian (Nov. 16). The LSU transfer scored 16 points while shooting 7-for-11 from the field and 2-for-2 from three. He dished out a career-best 10 assists for his first collegiate double-double. Against South Carolina, he scored 19 points while shooting 7-for-13 from the field. Gaines has recorded six or more assists in four games this season. The athletic guard has made SportsCenter's Top Ten plays twice this season with his electrifying dunks. He scored a career high 22 points in the Blazers' win over Louisiana Tech and followed that up with 21 points in UAB's victory over No. 19 Florida Atlantic.

THE RETURN

Jordan "Jelly" Walker currently sits in fourth nationally in points per game at 22.6 and third in three pointers per game at 4.33. He dropped 38 points in the season opener against Alabama State, the most scored by a UAB player in a season opener ever. Walker then captured Sunshine Slam MVP honors after scoring 31 points to go along with 6 rebounds, five assists and five steals against Georgia. He became the first UAB player to score 30+ points eight times as a Blazer, passing Andy Kennedy. Walker has scored 30 or more points in seven games this season, including a 41-point effort against Charlotte, one point shy of his career high. He is 63 points away from 2,000 for his career and 18 points away from matching the UAB single-season record.

FAST PACED, HIGH POWERED OFFENSE

The Blazers are yet again one of the highest scoring teams in the country under Andy Kennedy. After finishing the 2021-22 season ranking sixth in points per game nationally, UAB finds itself at No. 10 with 81.5 points per game. The Blazers are listed at No. 31 according to KenPom in adjusted tempo.

GETTING "BUFF"

KJ Buffen has been one of the Blazers' most consistent players this season. He is scoring 10.8 points per game while grabbing 6.8 rebounds per game. Buffen scored a career-high 25 points with eight rebounds in the Blazers' win over South Carolina, leading the team in both categories. Buffen earned C-USA Player of the Week honors after putting up back-to-back double-doubles against Louisiana Tech (1/26) and Rice (1/28). He finished with 20 points and 10 rebounds in the Blazers' win over Rice for his second-career 20-point double-double. He led UAB with 26 points and 12 rebounds in the Blazers' opening round win over Southern Miss.

"JELLY" NAMED THIRD CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN UAB HISTORY

Jordan "Jelly" Walker was named UAB's third conference Player of the Year in UAB men's basketball history during the 2021-22 season, joining UAB legends Aaron Johnson (2010-11) and Oliver Robinson (1981-82) in the ex-



clusive club. Walker's Conference USA Player of the Year award is only UAB's second C-USA Player of the Year honor. The transfer guard was also named Conference USA's Newcomer of the Year, joining Robert Vaden (2007-08) and Chad Frazier (2013-14) as the three Blazers to earn C-USA Newcomer of the Year honors. The junior not only led UAB in points per game (19.3) and assists per game (5.1), but he also led the C-USA in points per game (21.6), assists per game (5.33) and 3-pointers made per game (3.83) in league play.

WELCOME TO THE 1K CLUB

KJ Buffen, Tavin Lovan and Jordan Walker each surpassed 1,000 points in their collegiate careers with the Blazers. Buffen, Lovan and Walker are joined by brothers Ty Brewer and Ledarrius Brewer to have scored more than 1,000 points in their college basketball careers.

AK's REVIVAL

Head coach Andy Kennedy often talks about re-establishing the "Bartow Standard" in Birmingham by competing for and winning championships year after year. AK lived up to the standard in 2022, winning his first league tournament championship during his tenure as the Blazers' head coach. A win on Wednesday, Dec. 14, 2022, made Kennedy the only UAB head coach to start each of his first three seasons with at least an 8-2 record through the first 10 games of each campaign. Kennedy added to his already impressive resume in the season opener as he defeated Alabama State, becoming the fastest coach

in UAB history to reach 50 wins.

THE LAST DANCE

After winning Conference USA player of the year and leading the Blazers to their first conference tournament title since 2015, Jordan "Jelly" Walker declared for the NBA draft back in the spring. Despite NBA franchises calling his name, Walker decided to return to school in hopes of making one last magical run with the Blazers. Jelly was named the Conference USA Preseason Player of the Year and was named to the Bob Cousy Award Watchlist, given to the nation's best point guard, during the preseason.

GAINING AN EDGE

During the offseason, UAB added former four-star LSU transfer Eric Gaines to the roster. Gaines, who averaged nine points a game and was 29th in the NCAA with 2.1 steals per contest, will look to become more of a two-way player for the Blazers in the 2022-23 slate. After starting eight games with the Tigers a year ago, Gaines will look to become a full-time starter with the Blazers in his first season on the southside. Gaines was also named to the Conference USA preseason All-conference team alongside Walker.

A TALL TASK

Opposing big men will face an uphill battle against UAB center Trey Jemison, who leads the Blazers in total rebounds (303, 5th in UAB history), rebounds per game (8.4), blocks (67, 9th in UAB history), and blocks per game (1.9) in 2021-22. The 7-foot center teams with transfers Javian Davis and Ty Brewer, along with returners Rongie Gordon and KJ Buffen, to form one of the best front courts in Conference USA.

300 IN THE RECORD BOOKS

Along with posting his 12th 20-win season in 2021-22, Andy Kennedy earned win No. 300 of his career when the Blazers opened 2022 with an 87-59 victory over UTSA in Bartow Arena. Kennedy joins UAB Athletics founder Gene Bartow as only the second Blazer head coach to notch career victory No. 300 while coaching the Green and Gold.

GET TO THE LINE

The Blazers are one of the best teams in the country at getting to the charity stripe. UAB is 16th in the nation in free throws made per game at 16.4 while ranking No. 20 nationally in free throw attempts per game with 22.4. At the line, the Blazers are knocking down their attempts at a 73.3 percent clip, ranking 112th in the country.

ATTACK THE GLASS

UAB currently ranks near the top of the NCAA leaderboards in rebounds per game and offensive rebounds per game. The Blazers currently sit at No. 2 in the NCAA in rebounds per game at 40.8 and they are No. 6 in offensive rebounds per game at 13.44. The Blazers lead Conference USA in both categories.

THE BREWER BROTHERS

In the offseason, Andy Kennedy added brothers Ty and Ledarrius Brewer from



via the transfer portal. The Brewer brothers provide valuable experience for the Blazers, having played a combined nine years of college basketball. Ledarius, the older brother, began his career at SEMO before transferring to ETSU for the last two seasons. He averages 14.4 points and 4.6 rebounds per game during his career entering 2022-23. Ty Brewer began his collegiate career at Southeastern Louisiana before transferring to ETSU to play with his brother. He averages 9.8 points and 5.5 rebounds during his collegiate career.

SHARING IS CARING

The Blazers have shown a plethora of scoring options in 2022-23. Eleven different Blazers have finished in double figures in a game this season, including Jordan Walker, Eric Gaines, KJ Buffen, Ledarius Brewer, Javian Davis, Tavin Lovan, Trey Jemison, Ty Brewer, Tyler Bertram, Efre Johnson and Tony Toney.

BLOCK PARTY

UAB's 157 blocks this season are the most since 2016-2017, when the Blazers recorded 161 blocks. Trey "Tall T" Jemison leads UAB with 67 blocks this season, the ninth most in program history.

SCORING IN BUNCHES

The 2022-23 UAB men's basketball team scored 111 points in its season-opening game on Nov. 7, getting fans in Bartow on their feet for what hopes to be another successful season on the offensive end for the Blazers and third-year head coach Andy Kennedy. The 111-point total is the most points scored by a UAB team in a season-opener in program history. The Blazers, who averaged over 80 points per game a season ago (1st in CUSA, 6th nationally) and surpassed 80 points in 15 of their 35 games, will look to continue their high-scoring ways.

WELCOME TO THE 205

Once again, head coach Andy Kennedy's philosophy over the offseason was to target the transfer portal and hit it hard. He succeeded. The Blazers added six new players over the offseason, five of which were transfers. UAB added two SEC transfers to its 2022-23 roster - Eric Gaines (LSU) and Javian Davis (MSU). The Blazers also added Division I transfers Tyler Bertram (Binghamton) and brothers Ty and Ledarius Brewer (ETSU) to round out their five Division I transfers. First-year guard Efre "Butta" Johnson was the only player to join the roster out of high school.

SWEET HOME ALABAMA

With the addition of Efre "Butta" Johnson and Seth Sigmon, the Blazers now have six players on their roster who played high school basketball in Alabama. Trey Jemison (Hoover High School) and Ryan Donohoo (Briarwood Christian) played in the Birmingham area. UAB also has Alabama natives Tony Toney (Huntsville) and Rongie Gordon (Montgomery) on the 2022-23 roster.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Throughout its history, the UAB men's basketball program has seen incredible success in Birmingham, holding a 436-106 record in Bartow Arena since the

Blazers' on-campus home opened back in 1988. That success has continued with Andy Kennedy returning to his alma mater, as the third year UAB head coach holds a 48-6 record at home (Bartow and Legacy Arena) since taking over the program.

UAB TO THE AMERICAN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE

On Oct. 21, 2021 American Athletic Conference officials announced that Charlotte, Florida Atlantic, North Texas, Rice and UTSA will join UAB as new members in the AAC and compete against current AAC members East Carolina, Memphis, Navy, USF, SMU, Temple, Tulane, Tulsa and Wichita State.

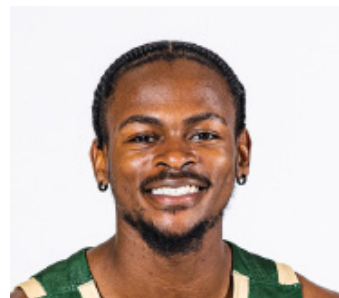
