THE RESUME

19th toughest schedule in the nation

19 games vs. Quad 1 and 2 teams

- In SEC, only Tennessee, Missouri and Kentucky played more

9-10 against Quad 1 and 2 teams (4-9 vs. Quad 1; 5-1 vs. Quad 2)

Five games versus teams in the top eight in NET rankings - **Tied for most in the nation**

- Alabama (2x), Tennessee (2x), Saint Mary's

Since Feb. 1, has won 88.9 percent of games (**8-1 record**). Only Houston and UCLA have better winning percentage (100 percent) during that stretch among major conference and AP Top 10 programs.

Fourth-best record in the SEC during the regular season (11-7) - same as Tennessee and Missouri

Due to SEC's unbalanced league schedule, played these partners two times each (home and away):

- Alabama, Tennessee, Kentucky, Florida

11 SEC wins - most for Vandy since the 2016-17 season

6-1 in February - program's best February record since 2008. **2-0** in March

OTHER HIGHLIGHTS

Jerry Stackhouse earned **SEC Co-Coach of the Year** - Vandy's first winner since 2010 (Kevin Stallings)
