GAME STORYLINES

► This week's season-opening road game at Vanderbilt will mark just the fifth time in program history that UH will play an SEC team on the road and first since the 2008 season-opener at Florida (UH lost 56-10).

► UH has a 3-3 all-time record in Week 0 including a 2-2 mark on the road which includes wins at UMass (2017) and at Colorado State (2018).

► Hawai'i opens on the road in Week 0 for the fifth time since 2016 and UH will open the season away from home for the sixth time in the last eight seasons.

► UH is 3-10-1 all-time against current SEC teams, including 0-4 on the road.

► Hawai'i is 63-38-5 (.618) all-time in season openers, including a 7-7 mark on the road (includes 2016 game vs. Cal in Sydney, Australia).

► UH has dropped its last two season openers after winning the previous four.

► UH will travel 4,340 air miles (8,680 round trip) for this week's trip to Nashville, Tenn. In contrast, Vanderbilt will travel approximately 3,154 total miles (6,308 RT) for its six road trips this season. Hawai'i's six road trips this season will total 37,720 round trip air miles.

► Hawai'i and Vanderbilt met for the first time in last year's season opener with the Commodores winning 63-10 in Honolulu. Vandy led 21-10 at halftime and out-scored the Warriors 42-0 in the second half, including 35-0 in the third quarter.

► Head coach Timmy Chang begins his second season leading his alma mater in 2023. This season, Chang has implemented the Run-and-Shoot offense and will be the primary offensive play-caller. Chang set numerous NCAA, Western Athletic Conference, and school records during his playing career (2000-04) within the offense and finished as the NCAA's all-time leader in passing yards, total offense, and passing touchdowns.

► Chang was the play-caller and offensive coordinator at both Jackson State (2014-15) and Emory & Henry (2016), where he ran the Run-and-Shoot.

► UH famously ran the Run-and-Shoot with notable success from 1999-2011 and again from 2018-19. During those years, UH ranked No. 1 nationally in passing TDs (564) and 300-yard passing games (143) and was No. 2 in passing yards per game (354.6) and No. 6 in scoring offense (33.6).

► UH returns 13 starters (4-offense, 7-defense, 2-special teams) and lost 11 starters from a season ago. Among the returning starters include QB Brayden Schager and honorable mention all-Mountain West selections DL John Tuitupou, RB Tylan Hines, and DB Peter Manuma.

► UH's all-time record in the month of August is 7-9 (*Division I era*).

► Chang and Vanderbilt's Clark Lea are among a group of 18 FBS head coaches currently heading their alma mater.

► UH enters the contest with a six-game road losing streak.

NEW HOME STADIUM

UH began playing its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex in 2021. The stadium increased capacity to approximately 15,000 this season. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"

Hawai'i's men's team nickname is the "Rainbow Warriors" while the women's teams are referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'i? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

▶ UH is 63-38-5 (.618) all-time in season openers, including a 7-7 mark on the road (includes game vs. Cal in Sydney).

▶ Hawai'i will open the season away from home for the sixth time in eight years and 10th time in the last 23 seasons.

▶ UH has lost its last two season openers after winning the previous four from 2017-20.

▶ Prior to 2006, the last time UH opened on the continent was 1992.

HAWAII VS. THE SEC

▶ UH is 3-10-1 (.250) all-time against current SEC teams, including a 0-4 record on the road.

▶ The last time UH played an SEC team on the road was at Florida in the 2008 season opener.

▶ The last time UH defeated an SEC team was against Alabama in 2003 (37-29) at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu.

▶ UH's two other wins against an SEC team were against South Carolina (1977 and '81).

HAWAII VS. THE POWER 5

▶ UH will play three Power 5 teams in the first four weeks of the 2023 season — Aug. 26 at Vanderbilt (SEC), Sept. 1 vs. Stanford (Pac-12), and Sept. 16 at Oregon (Pac-12).

▶ UH will play two road games at Power 5 conference teams in the same year for the second time in three seasons.

▶ Since 2003, UH has 12 wins versus teams from the Power 5 conferences, the last eight of which were against Pac-12 opponents.

▶ The last time UH beat two Power 5 teams in the same season was 2019 (def. Arizona, 45-38 and Oregon State, 31-28).

ROAD WARRIORS

▶ Over the last decade (not including 2020 COVID season), UH played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021.

▶ UH will make six road trips this season, including a 8,680-mile trek to Nashville, Tenn. to open its season at Vanderbilt.

▶ The six trips will total 37,720 air miles.

▶ The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

EXPLOSIVE PRODUCTION

▶ UH famously ran the **Run-and-Shoot** offense with notable success and national recognition from 1999-2011 and again from 2018-19.

▶ UH went 94-60 (.610) during those seasons with 10 bowl appearances including a trip to the Allstate Sugar Bowl during its memorable 2007 season.

▶ In 15 seasons of the Run-and-Shoot offense, UH ranked No. 1 nationally in passing TDs (564) and 300-yard passing games (143) and was No. 2 in passing yards per game (354.6) and No. 6 in scoring offense (33.6).

TEXAS GUNSLINGER

► Quarterback **Brayden Schager** started 10 games in 2022 including the team's last nine.

► The Dallas, Texas native threw for 2,348 yards on 221-of-400 passing (55.3%) with 13 touchdowns and 10 interceptions last season.

► Named to the preseason watch list for the Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award, given to the best offensive player with ties to Texas.

► Made three starts as a true freshman in 2021 and is 4-9 in his career which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State.

► Recorded his first 300-yard passing game with a career-high 306 yards and two touchdowns in a loss to Utah State last season in which he completed 23 passes in a career-high 46 attempts.

► Threw for 200+ yards seven times last season and had a career-high three touchdown passes in a win over UNLV.

THE LAND OF TYLAN

► Freshman **Tylan Hines**, who provided a spark and change of pace back for the Warriors last season, will be the featured back in 2023.

► The Mt. Pleasant, Texas native ranked first nationally among freshmen in yards per carry at 7.64. In addition, he was one of two freshmen nationally averaging over seven yards per carry (Taylen Green-Boise State).

► Tied for seventh among freshmen running backs nationally with seven runs of 20-plus yards.

► Ranked second on the team behind Dedrick Parson with 634 yards rushing on 83 carries and two TDs. Also had nine catches for 82 yards.

► Season-high 103 yards rushing on 11 carries versus Wyoming.

O-LINE EXPERIENCE

► UH's offensive line unit is among the most experienced in the country with 178 career games played, led by **Solo Vaipulu's** 46.

► The unit has a combined 65 career starts, including 43 by Vaipulu.

► Vaipulu, who is in his sixth year with the program, redshirted last season after appearing in 43 of the team's 51 games over the previous four seasons.

DEFENSE NOTES

TAYLOR MADE

► Linebacker **Logan Taylor** started the final six games last season in place of an injured Isaiah Tufaga and recorded double-digit tackles in each game.

► Became the first UH player to record double-digit tackles in six straight games since Jacob Espiau in 2001.

► Averaged 12.8 tackles per game and had 77 tackles during that stretch, the second-most nationally during that span.

► Finished the season as the team's leading tackler (85) with 49 solo and 4.0 for loss.

► In his first start against Colorado State, became one of just three UH players since 2000 to record at least 15 tackles and 1.5 TFLs in a game.

MANUMA MAGIC

► Safety **Peter Manuma** entered the starting lineup in the fifth game of last season and finished the season third on the team with 70 total tackles, including three for loss, on sack, two interceptions, four pass breakups, and two forced fumbles

► Posted career-high of 10 tackles each against San Diego State and Colorado State.

► Had two interceptions, a sack, and a forced fumble against Wyoming. Entering the day, no FBS player that season had accomplished that feat in a game until Ohio State's JT Tuimoloau also recorded the same statistics against Penn State.

► The Campbell High School product also played with a heavy heart last season as his mother succumbed to breast cancer on Oct. 11. He wore pink gloves, wristbands, and socks in her honor.

SET IN STONE

► Perhaps the biggest acquisition during the off-season for the Hawai'i was Wyoming transfer cornerback **Cam Stone**.

► The Angleton, Texas native appeared in 28 games over three seasons for the Cowboys and was an honorable mention all-Mountain West pick in 2022 after tying for second in the league with 10 pass breakups along with two interceptions.

► Stone was a preseason all-MW selection and was named to the Jim Thorpe Award preseason watch list.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

ROCKET SHIP

► Kicker **Matthew Shipley** enters his fourth season as the team's starting placekicker.

► In his career, the Liberty Hill, Texas native has made 42-of-55 (76.4%) field goal attempts and 95-of-96 PAT attempts.

► Coming off his second straight season in which he converted 80 percent of his field goal attempts after making 16-of-20 with a long of 49. Made 34-of-41 attempts and was also 69-of-70 in PAT attempts over the last two seasons.

► Named to the preseason watch list of the Lou Groza Award for the second straight year and was a semifinalist in 2021.

► Has made 24 of his last 26 field goal attempts from 40 yards and in dating back to last season.

► Team's starting punter for the second straight season last year and averaged 40.7 yards on 63 punts. Also had 19 punts inside the 20 and nine punts of 50+ yards.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

A BIGGER HOME

► UH will play its third season at the Clarence T.C. Ching Complex, which will seat 15,000 in 2023 after Phase 2 of renovations increased the seating capacity by 6,000.

► The latest renovation project also includes the installation of Aloha Stadium's 75-foot scoreboard.

► UH has a 7-6 all-time record in Ching Complex. Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season of 2021 and finished with a 3-4 mark last year.

HISTORY OF THE RUN-AND-SHOOT

► The most productive offensive scheme in program history is the Run-and-Shoot, which Hawai'i used for 15 seasons since 1999.

► UH ran the offense for 13 consecutive seasons under coaches June Jones (1999-2007) and Greg McMackin (2008-11) until Nick Rolovich brought it back for the 2018 & '19 seasons.

► UH finished in the Top 10 nationally in passing in 13 of 15 seasons and led the country in 2002, '06 & '10. UH also led the nation in scoring in 2006 and '07.

► UH is the only school to feature three 1,000-yard receivers in the same season twice — 2018 (JoJo Ward, Jared Smart, Cedric Byrd II) and 2007 (Ryan Grice-Mullen, Davone Bess, Jason Rivers).

SCHEDULE NOTES

► Six of UH's opponents this season played in bowl games in 2022—Air Force (Armed Forces Bowl), New Mexico State (Quick Lane Bowl), Oregon (Holiday Bowl), Wyoming (Arizona Bowl), San Diego State (Hawai'i Bowl), and San Jose State (Potato Bowl).

► UH will not play Fresno State this season, which will snap a streak of 31 consecutive years played.

HAWAII IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST

► Hawai'i enters its 12th season in the Mountain West in 2023.

► UH is 28-60 (.318) all-time in the MW—16-29 at home and 12-31 on the road—and have appeared in one Mountain West Championship game during the 2019 season.

TROPHY GAMES

► UH will play all four of its rivalry trophy games in 2023—Island Showdown (at UNLV, Sept. 30), Dick Tomey Legacy (vs. San José State, Oct. 28), Kuter (vs. Air Force, Nov. 11), and Paniolo (at Wyoming, Nov. 18)—marking the first time in program history the team will play all four in the same season.

► The Warriors only have possession of one of the trophies—the Island Showdown Trophy by virtue of 31-25 win last season in Honolulu.

► Last season, UH lost control of the Paniolo Trophy after a 27-20 defeat in Honolulu and lost its opportunity to win back the Dick Tomey Trophy with a season-ending 27-14 loss in San Jose. Air Force owns possession of the Kuter Trophy, by virtue of a 2019 win.

WATCH OUT

► Nine Warriors were named to Watch Lists for national awards: CB **Cam Stone**—Jim Thorpe Award (best defensive back); PK **Matthew Shipley**—Lou Groza Award (best placekicker); DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch**—Wuerffel Trophy (best community service), and QB **Brayden Schager**—Earl Campbell Tyler Rose Award (best offensive player from Texas).

► In addition, Kahahawai-Welch, OL **Sergio Muasau**, WR **Jonah Panoke**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, DL **John Tuitupou** and OL **Solo Vaipulu** were selected to the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year watch list.

WALK-ON U.

► UH has a reputation of turning walk-ons into stars most notably Colt Brennan, who finished his career as a Heisman Trophy finalist.

► Former walk-ons who have made starts include DL **Andrew Choi**, OL **Eliki Tanuvasa**, DL **John Tuitupou**, WR **Koali Nishigaya**, and DB **Meki Pei**.

ALL IN THE FAMILY

► The 2023 squad features seven second-generation Warriors—Wynden **Ho'ohuli** (Watson, 2000-05), **Kila** & **Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** (Kila, 2002-05); **Landon Sims** (Travis, 1989-92), **Ethan Spencer** (Sean), **Matagi Thompson** (Afatia, 1998-2000), and **Chad Owens, Jr.** (Chad, 2001-04).

► Two sets of brothers are on the 2023 squad—**Kila** & **Kalani Kamakawiwo'ole** and **Anthony** & **Josh Sagapolutele**.

► Two others have older brothers who once suited

up for UH—**Andrew Choi** (Zeno), **Sergio Muasau** (Darius), and **Maurice Ta'ala** (Blessman).

SPANNING THE GLOBE

► UH's roster features players from eight countries—United States (104), American Samoa (7), Australia (1), Canada (1), England (1), Japan (1), New Zealand (1), and Samoa (1).

► UH ranks second nationally for most countries represented to Temple's 10.

► Fifty-one of the 118-man roster hails from the state of Hawai'i while California (19) and Texas (12) combine to make up more than a quarter of the roster. In addition, Arizona and Florida each have four.

► UH also has players from 15 states, encompassing five time zones.

WE ARE THE "BRADDAHOOD"

► Following the 2021 season, the "Braddahood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach **Timmy Chang**, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

BROTHERHOOD TO BRADDAHOOD

► Honolulu prep football powerhouse Saint Louis School has the most players of any Hawai'i high school on the current Rainbow Warrior roster.

► Fifteen Warriors are former Crusaders including **Kamalu DeBlake**, **Ka'ena Decambra**, **Nick Delgadillo**, **Kila Kamakawiwo'ole**, **Kona Moore**, **Arasi Mose**, **Koali Nishigaya**, **Jonah Panoke**, **Anthony Sagapolutele**, **Josh Sagapolutele**, **Ethan Spencer**, **Tasi Tadio**, **Eliki Tanuvasa**, **Devon Tauaefa**, and **Isalah Tufaga**.

► Head coach **Timmy Chang** and defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro** also prepped at Saint Louis.

NINTH ISLAND PIPELINE

► UH has started a pipeline with Las Vegas power Bishop Gorman High School with three players from the 2023 signing class: **Aiden McComber**, **Jamih Otis**, and **Elijah Palmer**.

► LB coach **Chris Brown** was Bishop Gorman's assistant head coach and defensive coordinator from 2015-21.

'BOWS IN THE PROS

► Seven former Warriors are currently in NFL camps, highlighted by seven-year veteran punter **Rigoberto Sanchez** of the Indianapolis Colts.

► **Marcus Kemp** (Washington Commanders) and **Jahlani Tavai** (New England Patriots) each enter their fifth pro seasons. Kemp won two Super Bowls with the Kansas City Chiefs (2020, '23).

► **Zion Bowens** (Washington Commanders), **Ilim Manning** (San Francisco 49ers), **Jordan Murray** (Houston Texans), and **Micah Vanterpool** (New England Patriots) are also in camp.

► Two others are currently in the Canadian Football League—**Penei Pavihi** (Hamilton Tiger Cats) and **Blessman Ta'ala** (Ottawa Redblacks).

'BOW BITES

► WR **Karsyn Pupunu** of Lahaina, Maui lost four members of his family (uncle, aunt, two cousins) in the Maui wildfires. DB **Kimo Holo Holt-Mossman** of Kula, Maui, lost his childhood home in the fires.

► QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in Texas for special-needs youth. As a 10-year-old, he had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.

► DB Eli **Matagi Thompson** was named after his uncle Eli Thompson who was committed to play at UH but who passed away his senior year of HS. Fire knife dances for his father's luau company "Tihati Productions."

► PK **Matthew Shipley** has a twin brother (Mason) who kicks for Texas State. Older brother Michael kicked at West Texas A&M.

► WR **Jonah Panoke** and DL **John Tuitupou** each have three children while LB **Logan Taylor** has two children.

► OL **Fred Pelling** is the tallest Warrior at 6-9 while RB **Tylan Hines** and WR **Koali Nishigaya** are the shortest at 5-7.

► DB **Isaiah Malloe** is the son of former UH assistant and current UCLA assistant Ikaika Malloe.

► WR **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala's** brother Titus played at UCF and now plays for UCLA.

► LS **Solomon Landrum's** father Mike played tight end for the Atlanta Falcons.

► DL **Fo'i Sila** changed his last name in the off-season. He was previously Fo'i Shaw in his first five seasons as a Rainbow Warrior.

► WR **Eddie Osei-Nketia** is a world-class sprinter, having competed in international competition for both Australia and New Zealand. He is the current New Zealand 100m record holder.

► WR **Chuuky Hines's** mother is from Hawai'i and is of Micronesian and Hawaiian descent. His first name Chuuky translates to "mountain" in the Micronesian language of Chuukese.

► RB **Landon Sims** dons the same jersey number (#30) as his famous UH football father, Travis Sims, who was a member of the 1992 Holiday Bowl champion squad. WR **Chad Owens, Jr.**, also sports the original jersey number of his famous father, All-American and CFL star, Chad Owens.

► LB **Malaki Te'o** is cousins with former Notre Dame and NFL linebacker Manti Te'o.

► DB **CJ Williams** has had lupus, an auto-immune disease where the body's defense system attacks healthy cells and tissues, since the age of 13.

► WR **MacLane Watkins** older sister Avery is a member of the UH women's basketball team.

► QB **Dalen Morris** joined the team as a walk-on this past spring after being stationed at Pearl Harbor on Oahu. The Navy graduate last played college football in 2020 and was the team's starting quarterback in that season's opener versus BYU.

Former record setting quarterback Timmy Chang is the sixth former Rainbow Warrior to head the program, joining Tom Kaulukukui (1946-50),

Jim Asato (1962-64), Larry Price (1974-76), June Jones (1999-2007), and Nick Rolovich (2016-19).

Chang was hired as UH's 25th head football coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022. He completed his first season with a 3-10 record which included career win No. 1 against Duquesne.

Chang spent the previous five seasons as the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, under coach Jay Norvell. He helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

In 2021, Nevada placed three different pass catchers on the Fred Biletnikoff Award Watch List, including two-time All-Mountain West selections Romeo Doubs and Cole Turner.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia and also spent two seasons at Jackson State in Mississippi from 2014-15.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons assisting with the quarterbacks. In Chang's first season in 2012, SMU earned an invite to the Hawai'i Bowl where they defeated Fresno State.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at quarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his collegiate career, Chang played professionally in the NFL, Canadian Football League, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from pro football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

- ▶ **Timmy Chang** is one of two Polynesian head coaches (Kalani Sitake-BYU) in FBS.
- ▶ **Chang** is also one of 18 head coaches who is coaching at his alma mater, including one of four in the Mountain West (Andy Avalos-Boise State, Troy Calhoun-Air Force, and Danny Gonzales-New Mexico).
- ▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), three other former Warriors are on the full-time coaching staff: LB coach **Chris Brown** (1998-2002), RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** (2001), and DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** (2012-14).
- ▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang has previous coaching ties with only **Thomas Sheffield** at Nevada. In addition, **Silas Clapham** (Dir. of Player Personnel) and **Cade Socha** (Analyst) also were on the same staff at Nevada.
- ▶ Defensive coordinator **Jacob Yoro**, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.
- ▶ WR coach **Jared Ursua** is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.
- ▶ Co-OC/TE coach **Ian Shoemaker** and co-DC/DL coach **Eti Ena** both coached at Eastern Washington in 2021. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro at Cal Poly.
- ▶ Co-OC/OL coach **Roman Sapolu**'s father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.
- ▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).
- ▶ New to the full-time staff this season are DT coach **Jordan Pu'u-Robinson** and CB coach **Steve Irvin**. Pu'u-Robinson, a Maui native, spent the 2021 and '22 seasons as a graduate assistant and quality control coach, respectively, before briefly taking a full-time job at The Citadel in the spring. He returned to UH in the summer. Irvin has 25 years of coaching experience at eight different schools, including 10 years at the University of San Diego, where he was defensive coordinator from 2013-17.
- ▶ The 11 full-time coaches have a combined 33 children. RB coach **Keiki Misipeka** has eight children, all of whom begin with the letter K and have Hawaiian first names.
