- · Vanderbilt goes on the road for the first time this season after winning its first two contests at home. The Commodores visit Wake Forest on Saturday for the 18th meeting all-time against the Demon Deacons. Vanderbilt has won three of the last four meetings with two of those wins coming in Winston-Salem (2011, 2012).
- Vanderbilt handled business Saturday against Alabama A&M to move to 2-0 on the season with a 47-13 win. The Commodores put up 462 yards of total offense and scored 35 of their 47 points in the second half. Will Sheppard caught two touchdowns for the second consecutive game and Sedrick Alexander found the end zone twice on the ground.
- Will Sheppard went over 1,500 career receiving yards in the contest against Alabama A&M. He also had two receiving touchdowns that equaled his total from the previous week against Hawai'i and gave him four for the season. It is the second time in Sheppard's career that he has caught two touchdowns in consecutive games, as he also had two receiving touchdowns in back-to-back outings to open the 2022 season. With 17 career touchdown catches, Sheppard has tied Bucky Curtis (1947-50) for seventh in program history. Allama Matthews (1981-82) is sixth with 18.
- · Vanderbilt has won four of its last five games dating to the 2022 season, securing wins over Kentucky, Florida, Hawai'i and Alabama A&M in that stretch. It marks the most successful run for the Commodores since they won five-of-six games at the end of the 2016 and beginning of the 2017 seasons and is just the second time since 2014 the Dores have won four of five.
- Vanderbilt's special teams rank 10th in the nation per ESPN's FPI. The unit has produced an efficiency grade of 96.6. In the opener against Hawai'i, Vandy had a 97-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, a 27-yard punt return, averaged 53.7 yards on three punts with a long of 71 yards, notched two touchbacks on kickoffs and made all three PATs. Against Alabama A&M, Vandy blocked two punts, including one for a safety, produced a long punt return of 39 yards, a long kickoff return of 29 yards, made all six point-after attempts and made its lone field goal attempt of the year from 23 yards. Vanderbilt's special teams units has scored points in three of the last four games. In last season's penultimate game against Florida, long snapper Wesley Schelling recovered a fumbled punt in the end zone for a touchdown.
- The special teams performance over the first two games shows continued progress under associate head coach and special teams coordinator Justin Lustig. The Dores ranked 117th in special teams (ESPN FPI) prior to Lustig's arrival and were 127th during his first season. In 2022, Vandy jumped to 44th in the nation (55.4). It was the fourth-largest jump in FBS, trailing only Mississippi State, West Virginia and UTEP, and Vanderbilt was one of just five teams in the nation to improve its special teams efficiency by at least 25 points.

By The Numbers

- Head coach Clark Lea is in his third season at his alma mater. The Commodores doubled their win total in Lea's second season in 2022 and won consecutive SEC games for the first time since 2018, defeating Kentucky and Florida, respectively.
- Will Sheppard has four touchdowns this season, hauling in a pair of scores in each of Vandy's first two contests. The senior has 17 career receiving touchdowns, which is seventh all-time at Vanderbilt.
- Jayden McGowan's 97-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Hawai'i was the school's first since 2014 (Darrius Sims vs. South Carolina 9.20.04) and was tied for the fourth-longest kick return for a touchdown in program history.
- Sophomore quarterback AJ Swann had 159 consecutive pass attempts to begin his career last season before throwing his first interception against Missouri. His 159 pass attempts marked the most pass attempts without an interception 159 by a Vandy quarterback to begin his career since 1996 and the most by an SEC quarterback to begin his FBS career since
- De'Rickey Wright has recorded two interceptions in a game twice in his career. Wright picked off two passes in Vandy's season-opening win over Hawai'i and tallied two interceptions against Ole Miss in 2022.
- Matthew Hayball leads all active punters across all divisions of NCAA football (FBS, FCS, Division II and Division III) with 10k 10,627 career punting yards. He is one of two punters in all four divisions to have eclipsed 10,000 career yards.

- After committing eight penalties in the season-opener, Vanderbilt was flagged just three times against Alabama A&M. The Commodores drew the fewest flags in the SEC a season ago and third-fewest in the league in 2021.
- De'Rickey Wright was named Defensive Player of the Week by the Reese's Senior Bowl after his two-interception performance in Week 0. Wright has two multi-INT games to his name after picking off two passes against Ole Miss last season.
- Patrick Smith scored the first touchdown of 2023 on a 21-yard rush. Vanderbilt's first drive of the season went four plays for 32 yards over 1:22. This marked his third career rushing touchdown.
- In the last 37 nonconference, regular season contests, dating to the 2013 season, Vanderbilt is 28-10. Vanderbilt has won 20 of its last 22 games against non-Power 5 opponents, including all three of its matchups last season.
- Those visiting Nashville this season will take notice of the ongoing Vandy United projects that include enhancements in the north and south end zones at FirstBank Stadium. An integral part of Vanderbilt's recently launched \$3.2 billion Dare to Grow campaign, the largest in the university's 150-year history, Vandy United's next phase looks to build on its foundation with more facilities and operational enhancements.
- Vanderbilt developed an identity over the course of the 2022 season that saw the Commodores play disciplined, maximize possessions and protect the quarterback (see Page 9).
- In his third season at the helm of his alma mater, Vanderbilt football coach Clark Lea signed a contract extension to remain in his native Nashville. Athletics director Candice Storey Lee announced the extension in July.
- Vanderbilt ranked 21st in FBS and fourth in the SEC in time of possession last season, averaging 32:03 per game. The Commodores have averaged over 30 minutes of possession per game in both seasons under Lea.
- The Dores notched four defensive touchdowns in 2022. That figure led the SEC and ranked fourth nationally. The four scores came after Vanderbilt did not score a defensive touchdown in 2021.
- With just six interceptions a season ago, Vanderbilt threw the second-fewest picks in the SEC and ranked 12th in FBS. Season-over-season, the Dores sliced their number of interceptions by more than half in 2022. In 2021, Vandy threw 14 interceptions, worst in the SEC and 110th nationally.
- The offensive line, known as the "Grease Gang," allowed 1.25 sacks per game last season, an improvement of 1.08 sacks per game over 2021. The mark ranked fourth in the SEC and 26th nationally. Vandy was one of 10 Power 5 teams to drop its sacks per game rate by more than one per contest from 2021 to 2022.
- Over his first two seasons at his alma mater, Lea has snapped multiple inherited streaks that included the first win since 2019, first road win since 2018, first SEC win since 2019, first Power 5 win since 2019, first SEC road win since 2018, first win against Florida since 2013 and first home win versus the Gators since 1988.
- With the five victories last season, Lea posted the second-highest win total by a second-year Vanderbilt head coach since 1975. Only James Franklin won more games in his second season among the 10 Vanderbilt coaches in that time period.
- Sophomore quarterback **AJ Swann** looks to build off an impressive debut campaign in 2022. As a freshman, Swann threw 159 pass attempts before throwing his first interception. It marked the longest stretch to open a career by a Vandy quarterback since at least 1996 and the longest by an SEC quarterback to start their career since 2002. On the season, Swann threw the fewest interceptions of any true freshman FBS quarterback with at least 200 drop backs.
- Senior **Will Sheppard** has been named to the watch list for the Biletnikoff Award. Sheppard is one of 50 players on the Biletnikoff list and one of seven from the SEC. The senior has also been named to the Maxwell Award Watch List, given to the nation's top player each year, the Shrine Bowl 1000 and a preseason All-SEC selection by Phil Steele and the league's coaches.
- After putting together an impressive freshman season in 2022, sophomore **Jayden McGowan** has been named to the watch list for the Paul Hornung Award, given annually to the most versatile player in college football. He played in all 12 games last season and caught 44 passes for 453 yards and three touchdowns while returning 16 kickoffs for 384 yards.
- Senior linebacker **Ethan Barr** has been named to the Wuerffel Trophy Watch List. The award is presented annually to college football's most impactful community leader. Barr will be a captain for the Commodores for the second-straight year in 2023. He has started the last 27 games for Vanderbilt and enters the Alabama A&M game with 167 career tackles. The Flower Mound, Texas, native has been a leader in Vanderbilt's team community service efforts, including with the Boys & Girls Club, Metro Nashville Schools and Turner's Heroes.

- Graduate student **Matthew Hayball** has been named to the Ray Guy Award Watch List, the award given annually to the nation's best punter. Hayball punted 59 times in his first season at Vanderbilt last year, averaging 45.36 yards. The Australian ranked second in the SEC and 11th in FBS in punting average. The mark ranks fourth in Vanderbilt history. He posted a long punt of 65 yards and pinned opponents inside the 20-yard line on 18 occasions.
- Senior **Wesley Schelling** has been named to the Patrick Mannelly Award Watch List, presented annually to the long snapper of the year in college football. Schelling, a Nashville native, is one of 25 long snappers on the watch list and one of six from the SEC. It marks the second consecutive year Schelling has made the Mannelly Award preseason watch list.

Nonconference Wins

- The Commodores concluded their 2022 nonconference slate with a 3-1 record.
- In the last 37 nonconference, regular season contests, dating to the 2013 season, Vanderbilt is 28-10.
- Vanderbilt has won 20 of its last 22 games against non-Power 5 opponents, including all three of its matchups last season.

Football in August

- Vanderbilt is one of just three Power 5 programs that competed Week 0. Vandy is the only Power 5 program, and one of just five programs overall, to play Week 0 in both 2022 and 2023.
- Vanderbilt has played 11 games during the month of August dating back to 1997 with the Commodores owning a 4-7 record in those contests.
- Vandy's season opener vs. Hawaii will mark the earliest on-record start for the program:

Win the Response

- Vanderbilt battled back from deficits in three of its five wins last season.
- The Commodores faced an early seven-point deficit in the season opener at Hawai'i, while battling back from a 14-point deficit in the second half at Northern Illinois.
- Vandy scored 49 unanswered points against the Rainbow Warriors, and 24 unanswered against the Huskies.
- Vandy trailed by four points with 5:03 remaining at Kentucky before scoring a touchdown on its final drive to take a three-point lead with 32 seconds left.
- The comeback against the Wildcats marked Vanderbilt's first fourth-quarter comeback in a road SEC game since the Commodores' earned a 17-16 comeback win at Georgia on Oct. 15, 2016.
- Vandy also trailed in both wins this season, albeit early in the contest. Hawai'i took a 7-6 first quarter lead and Alabama A&M kicked a field goal on the game's opening drive.

Two Leading at Their Alma Maters

- With Lea and director of athletics Candice Storey Lee, Vanderbilt is one of three Power 5 programs to have both its head football coach and athletic director as undergraduate alumni of the school.
- The Commodores join Michigan (Warde Manuel, Jim Harbaugh) and Oklahoma State (Chad Weiberg, Mike Gundy).

Offensive Success

- The Vanderbilt offense made major strides last season. The Commodores totaled 295 points, averaging 24.6 points per game. This was an improvement of 8.8 points per game over 2021.
- It took just nine games for Vandy to surpass the previous season's 12-game scoring total.
- $\bullet \, \text{The Commodores scored 30 or more points four times last season, after only doing so once in 2021.} \\$
- With its point totals against Hawai'i and Elon, Vandy scored 42 or more points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2005 when the Dores scored 42 at Florida on Nov. 5, and followed up with 43 points against Kentucky on Nov. 12.
- In its seven games against teams outside the AP Top 25 last season, Vandy averaged 33.0 points per game.

Red Zone Efficiency

- The Commodores scored on 30 of their 35 trips to the red zone last season, converting for touchdowns on 24 of those opportunities.
- Vanderbilt scored on 85.7 percent of its red zone trips, while recording touchdowns on 68.6 percent of opportunities.
- The Dores improved in both categories over 2021, when they scored on 77.4 percent of their trips with touchdowns on 51.6 percent.

Grease Gang Shining in the Trenches

- The Vander bilt offensive line play was strong last season, having an impact in both the passing game and the running game.
- The Commodore blockers allowed just 12 sacks while producing 100-yard rushers in six of Vandy's 12 games
- The Dores averaged just 1.3 sacks allowed per game, which ranked third in the SEC and 25th in the FBS. Additionally, Vanderbilt allowed just 4.9 tackles for loss per game, which ranked fourth in the conference and 30th in the nation.
- The Vandy offensive line remained steady despite battling injuries last season, as eight different Commodores recorded at least one start up front.

Touchdown Target

- Senior wide receiver **Will Sheppard** enjoyed an electric junior campaign in 2022 and is off to a hot start in 2023 with two touchdowns in each of Vandy's first two games.
- Sheppard hauled in multiple touchdown grabs in three games in 2022, totaling nine on the season.
- With two scores each against Hawai'i and Elon last season, the Mandeville, Louisiana, native became the first Vandy receiver with multiple receiving touchdowns in back-to-back games since Earl Bennett in 2005.
- With his two-touchdown performance against Alabama A&M, Sheppard has now accomplished the feat twice.
- Sheppard's nine touchdowns in 2022 tied him for third in a season in program history and ranked second in the SEC.

Swann's Streak

- AJ Swann had 159 consecutive pass attempts to begin his career before throwing his first interception against Missouri last season.
- Swann's streak came with his first two collegiate starts on the road and it survived games at No. 2 Alabama, versus No. 9 Ole Miss and at No. 2 Georgia.

Career Day for Sheppard

- Senior wide receiver **Will Sheppard** registered a career day at Northern Illinois last season. He hauled in 10 receptions for 171 yards both career highs while picking up two receiving touchdowns.
- Sheppard's 171 yards marked the most by a Vanderbilt receiver since Sept. 29, 2018, when Kalija Lipscomb had 174 yards against Tennessee State.
- The Mandeville, Louisiana, native became the fourth Commodore pass catcher to record multiple receiving touchdowns and at least 150 receiving yards in a game since 1996:

Turnovers Galore

- Vanderbilt continued to show its ability to force turnovers in the opener, securing a pair of interceptions by safety **De'Rickey Wright**.
- The Vanderbilt defense posted a strong performance at Missouri last season, forcing three turnovers in the game. The Commodores recorded one interception against the Tigers, while recovering two fumbles.
- The contest marked just the third time since 2018 that Vandy has forced three or more turnovers in a game.
- Vanderbilt forced multiple turnovers in two games last season.
- On the year, the Commodores recorded 16 takeaways last season, sixth in the SEC .

Recovering Fumbles

- Vanderbilt came away with 10 fumble recoveries in 2022. The Commodores recovered fumbles in six of their 12 games, including multiple recoveries against Hawai'i and Missouri.
- Vandy recovered just three fumbles during the 2021 season, and did not recover its first fumble until Week 7 at South Carolina.
- Six different Commodores recovered a fumble last year, while the trio of Cooper Lutz, Anfernee Orji and CJ Taylor each recovered multiple.
- \bullet The Dores ranked 28th nationally in fumble recoveries.

Mahoney Matches Record

- Graduate defensive back Jaylen Mahoney matched the Vanderbilt single-game record for tackles for loss with 5.0 in the matchup at Missouri last season.
- He became the first Commodore to record 5.0 tackles for loss in a game since Stephen Weatherly made five against Tennessee in 2014.
- Mahoney recorded 4.0 tackles for loss in the first half against the Tigers before picking up his fifth of the game in the fourth quarter.
- His 5.0 tackles for loss marked the most by an SEC player in any game last season.
- The Rock Hill, South Carolina, native registered a career-high 12 tackles in the contest, including a team-high 11 solo stops. He also picked up one sack for a loss of nine yards.

Securing the Picks, Part 2

- Senior De'Rickey Wright picked up where he left off in the season opener, intercepting a pair of Hawai'i passes. It marked the second multi-interception game of his career.
- Wright posted a strong performance against No. 9 Ole Miss last season, recording two interceptions.
- He became the first Vanderbilt player to register multiple interceptions in a single game since Tae Daley picked off two passes at Florida on Nov. 9, 2019.
- Wright had three of Vanderbilt's six interceptions on the year and was one of seven players in the SEC with at least three picks on the season.

Settling In

- After allowing a touchdown on the opening drive of the game against Hawai'i last season, the Vandy defense held the Rainbow Warriors in check for the remainder of the contest.
- The Commodores limited Hawai'i to just three points across the final three quarters, while holding the Rainbow Warriors scoreless in the second half.
- Vandy also forced six punts and four turnovers on down, while holding Hawai'i to four three-and-outs.
- The 10 points allowed marked the fewest points that Vanderbilt has given up across the last two seasons, and the fewest points allowed since the Commodores held East Tennessee State scoreless on Nov. 23, 2019.

Scoop and Dore

- Vanderbilt recorded four defensive/special teams scores last season, with each coming on a fumble return.
- The defense recorded two scores in the matchup at Hawai'i, while picking up their third defensive score in the matchup at Missouri. The fourth score came on a special teams play in the win over Florida.
- Junior Anfernee Orji notched his first career touchdown at Hawai'i with a 28-yard fumble return in the first quarter, while sophomore CJ Taylor returned a fumble 14 yards in the third quarter for his first career score.
- The performance against the Rainbow Warriors marked the first time the Commodore defense scored two touchdowns in a game since scoring twice against LSU on Sept. 21, 2019.
- It also marked the first time that the Commodores returned multiple fumbles for touchdowns in a game since 1996.
- Taylor picked up his second defensive touchdown on the year with a scoop and score against Missouri.
- Long snapper Wesley Schelling recovered a muffed punt in the end zone against Florida.
