PACK FACTS

A WIN ON WEDNESDAY WOULD

- Be the 1,026th win in program history (1,025-490)
- Be head coach Wes Moore's 808th career win (807-250)
- Be Moore's 250th win at NC State (249-81)
- Be NC State's seventh home win in a row
- Give the Wolfpack an 8-0 start for the fourth time in 11 seasons of the Moore era
- Be the Pack's fifth in a row over Vanderbilt
- Mark the Pack's 56th consecutive home win over an unranked non-conference opponent

NOTING THE WOLFPACK (7-0)

- Wednesday's inaugural ACC/SEC Women's Basketball Challenge game features two out of a total of 26 remaining unbeaten teams in NCAA Division I women's basketball (as of Nov. 26 games).
- NC State jumped five spots in the AP Top 25 to check in at No. 5 in the Week 4 poll. It marks the 71st week in program history that the Pack has been a top-five team and is the team's first such ranking since ending the 2021-22 season at No. 3.
- The Pack defeated two AP Top 3 teams (No. 2 UConn on Nov. 12, No. 3 Colorado on Nov. 25) in the span of 13 days. It marked the fourth time in team history that NC State has defeated two top-three teams in the same season and was the second-shortest span of time between two Wolfpack wins over top-three squads.
- River Baldwin was named a USBWA National Player of the Week (one of five) following the best three-game stretch of her career.

- All four of the Pack's players who average double figures this season (Aziaha James, Saniya Rivers, Madison Hayes, Mimi Collins) have scored 10+ points in at least four of seven games played.
- NC State has two of the nation's top-10 free throw percentage games this season against Elon (17-of-17, 1.00) and Colorado (20-of-21, .952).
- The Wolfpack is ranked in the national top 30 in: field-goal percentage defense (5th - .308), free throw percentage (8th - .816), rebounds per game (11th - 47.1), rebound margin (14th - +14.4), scoring margin (16th - +28.1), scoring offense (27th - 82.0), blocks per game (27th - 5.1), field goal percentage (.472 - 30th).
- The Wolfpack's non-conference schedule is the fifth-toughest among Power schools as it relates to average opponent final NET from last season. The team's 2023-24 non-conference opponents had an average 2022-23 NET of 110. NC State ranks behind only Maryland, Tennessee, South Carolina and Iowa in this category.
- NC State was picked to finish eighth in the ACC after trying for eighth last season. As of Nov. 26 games, the Pack is one of two remaining unbeaten teams in the ACC alongside Miami.

SERIES HISTORY (NC STATE LEADS 6-2)

- Thursday marks the ninth overall meeting between NC State and Vanderbilt.
- The teams met for the first time on Feb. 4, 1996 in a game played in the Charlotte Coliseum and most recently squared off in the first game of last year's Cancun Challenge in November 2022.

LAST MEETING

CANCUN, Mexico – NC State (5-1) shot above 50 percent in each of the final three quarters of its Cancun Challenge opener as the Wolfpack defeated Vanderbilt (5-2) by a 82-73 score on Thursday evening.

The Wolfpack ended the night with a .525 field-goal percentage, shooting 31-of-59 overall while also knocking down nine threes as a squad. Three players finished with multiple triples – Diamond Johnson (4-of-6), Jakia Brown-Turner (3-of-4) and Madison Hayes (2-of-4).

The Wolfpack used a dominant second quarter to pull away from the Commodores, shooting 56.3 percent (9-of-16) in the period while limiting Vanderbilt to 18.8 percent (3-of-16) from the floor. Hobby secured NC State's first points of the second quarter at the 7:52 mark, and that started a string of 15 unanswered points scored by the squad. In total, NC State outscored Vanderbilt 20-9 in the second quarter to take a 45-27 lead into the break.

The Wolfpack opened up its advantage to as many as 26 points (62-36, 4:45) in the third quarter, but Vanderbilt scored the last 10 of that period and the first three of the fourth to draw within 11. The fourth quarter was a back-and-forth battle, with Vanderbilt bringing it back within single digits with late free throws before NC State closed out the nine-point victory.

The outing marked the Pack's second time this season ending a game with a shooting percentage of better than 50 percent. NC State also held a +16 advantage rebound on the boards and in the paint.

- The Wolfpack is on a four-game winning streak in the series between the teams.
- Vanderbilt has not beat NC State since Nov. 28, 2009, with that game played on the Commodores' home floor. Vandy's only other win in the series was the first meeting between the squads.
- NC State came away with the 82-73 win in the teams' Cancun Challenge meeting just over a year ago.

RANKINGS REVIEW

- NC State was unranked (receiving votes as the No. 27 team) to start the season before re-entering the AP Top 25 on Nov. 13, 2023 for the first time since Feb. 6, 2023.
- The Wolfpack is the first women's basketball team to enter a season unranked and reach the AP Top 5 before the end of that November.
- Prior to NC State's No. 5 ranking on Monday, the earliest a preseason unranked team entered the AP Top 5 was Wisconsin (Week 9 of 2001-02).

PARTIES IN PARADISE

- The Pack is coming off a 3-0 week at the 2023 Paradise Jam during which it won its bracket with victories over Kentucky, Cincinnati and No. 3 Colorado.
- NC State won those games by an average of 27 points, with its largest win coming in the form of a 34-point decision over the Bearcats.
- Since the 2018-19, NC State has gone a perfect 12-0 in its Thanksgiving holiday tournament games: 2-0 in the 2018 Cancun Challenge, 3-0 in the 2019 Hawaii Tournament, 2-0 in the 2021 Baha Mar Hoops event, 2-0 in the 2022 Cancun Challenge and 3-0 in the 2023 Paradise Jam.
- In those 12 wins, eight were against fellow Power Five teams and two (2021 Baha Mar vs. No. 2 Maryland and 2023 Paradise Jam vs. No. 3 Colorado) were against AP Top 5 squads.

STRENGTH IN THE PACK

- Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State has gone 104-14 (.881) in home games.
- That record includes 58 out of 60 possible non-conference wins (both losses were to Top 25 opponents) and 46 out of 58 possible league wins.
- Another record number of season ticket holders committed to backing the Pack in 2023-24. The team sold 3,300 season tickets, hitting that mark three months before the start of the campaign.
- In 2022-23, NC State had a program-best average percent capacity (91.62%) in its home games. That number ranked second nationally behind only UConn.
- For the 2022-23 campaign, NC State's eight sellouts were all against ACC opponents. The team sold out every ACC home game except for its conference opener against Clemson.

JUNIOR GUARDS GOING OFF

- Aziaha James (26 points vs. Charlotte) and Sania Rivers (33 points vs. UConn) kicked off their junior campaigns with career highs in back-to-back games.
- Prior to James' 26-point night on Nov. 7, a member of the Pack had not scored 25+ points since March 3, 2021 when Elissa Cunane

- had 27 in the ACC Tournament semifinal.
- Rivers then notched the Pack's first 30+ point performance since Feb. 13, 2019 (Kiara Leslie, 30 points) and the most points scored by a member of the squad since Feb. 27, 2011 (Amber White, 33 points).
- James scored 19 of her 26 points against Charlotte in the first quarter, setting a single-quarter program record. Rivers' 15 third-quarter points against the Huskies tied for third in the quarter scoring records.
- The Wolfpack duo are the 13th and 14th players in the Moore era to notch 25+ point games. NC State has not had multiple players post 25+ point games in the same season since 2020-21.
- Rivers is one of six ACC players to have a 30+ point game this season, with her 33 against UConn ranking as the second-most posted by a league player in 2023-24.

DEFENSIVE PROWESS

- NC State has given up more than 60 points just once this season, and that was to then-No. 2 UConn.
- In the Wes Moore era, the Wolfpack has held opponents to fewer than 60 points in 156 games.
- NC State is 147-9 (.942) in such outings and is 80-1 in such games since the start of the 2018-19 campaign, with the sole loss in the last six seasons marking its Jan. 15, 2023 game at UNC. Prior to that outing, the Wolfpack had won 76 games in a row when holding teams to fewer than 60 points.
- The Pack is one of 26 teams in the nation to hold at least one opponent to 35 or fewer points in a game this season. NC State is one of just eight teams to do so while scoring 90+ points of its own.
- NC State has allowed just one opponent (No. 2 UConn) this season to shoot better than 40 percent and has limited four teams to below 30 percent from the field.

BALANCED ATTACK

- Six Wolfpack players average more than eight points per game, and each of those women are shooting better than 46 percent from the field while putting up those numbers. Only South Carolina has more players with such averages this season.
- Eight of 12 active players on the Pack's 2023-24 roster have had at least one 10+ point game this season.
- NC State had six double-figure scorers in its Nov. 24 win over Cincinnati. It marked the first time that the Pack has had more than five players with 10+ points since Dec. 6, 2020.
- The Pack had a 20+ point scorer in each of its first three games of the season. It marked the team's longest such streak since Elissa Cunane had 20+ points in each of the team's three 2021 ACC Tournament games.
- Three different Wolfpack players have scored 20+ points this season -- Aziaha James twice, Sania Rivers and River Baldwin.
- Post players Mimi Collins (6.3 rpg) and River Baldwin (6.1 rpg) lead the way in what is a true team effort that has seen six different leading rebounders through its first seven games.

POSTS CAME TO PLAY

- River Baldwin posted three 10+ point games in a row at the Paradise Jam. It is the first time in her two-season stint with

the Pack that she has strung together a streak of double-figure scoring games.

- Baldwin averaged 4.0 points per game going into the tournament and doubled that mark as she now averages 8.7 points per game.
- Mimi Collins shot a perfect 8-of-8 from the field against the Phoenix. The only better perfect shooting mark by a member of the Pack in a home game was a 9-of-9 clip by Elissa Cunane in January 2021.
- Collins is one of 13 players in Division I women's basketball to attempt 8+ field goals in a game this season and not miss.
- Through the first seven games, Collins has knocked down eight threes to rank third on the team in that category. That is already nearly at her full-season total from 2022-23 (9) and over halfway to the way to the most she's made in a season in her career (14).
- Baldwin dished out two assists in each of the three Paradise Jam wins. Those were the first multi-assist games of her Wolfpack career, and the six total were the most assists for her in any three-game stretch in her career.

SPECIAL START FOR 35

- Rookie guard Zoe Brooks has played 20+ minutes off the bench in all seven Wolfpack wins this season. She led the team in minutes played against Charlotte (29) and Elon (27).
- Brooks joined Jakia Brown-Turner (2019-20) as the only two Wolfpack rookies in 11 years of the Moore era to score 10+ points in their first two games.
- Coming off the bench, Brooks is one of three players nationally to average 9+ points and 3+ assists while not having started a single game this season.
- Brooks' 3.6 assists per game ranks in the top 15 in the ACC and is the third-highest average among league freshmen.

SELLOUT TRACKER

NC State sold out five games before the 2023-24 season tipped off on Nov. 7 and has since sold out a sixth game (North Carolina). The Pack's program record for number of sellouts is eight (hit in both 2021-22 and 2022-23).

WOLFPACK WES

- Head coach Wes Moore secured his 800th career win on March 2, 2023. With that victory, Moore became the fifth active, third-ever ACC and 15th NCAA Division I women's basketball coach of all time to reach the 800 wins mark. He accomplished the feat in 1,048 games across stints at NC State (242), Chattanooga (358), Francis Marion (69) and Maryville College (131).
- Moore's 804 career wins rank fifth among active NCAA Division I women's basketball head coaches and 14th all time. He has the most wins of any active coach in the ACC. Moore is also ranked 11th nationally among active coaches with his .763 career winning percentage.

BACK WITH THE PACK

- At the start of 2023-24, NC State brought back:
- Five of nine players from the final 2023-24 roster, all of whom posted a double-figure scoring outing last season and led or tied for the team lead in scoring at least once in 2022-23
 - One player (Madison Hayes) who started 20+ games and four players (Hayes, Saniya Rivers, Mimi Collins, Aziaha James) who made at least six starts
 - Last season's team leaders in rebounding (Rivers - 5.2), three-point percentage (Hayes - .364), steals (Rivers - 1.8) and

blocks (Rivers - 1.0)

- Five players who averaged at least five points per game in 2022-23 - Rivers (8.6), Hayes (7.0), Collins (6.9), James (6.8) and Baldwin (5.7)
- 48.9 percent of its points scored (1,109 of 2,266)
- 49.2 percent of its made shots (422 of 858)
- 49.3 percent of its rebounds (626 of 1,270)
- 60.6 percent of its steals (132 of 218)
- 53.5 percent of its assists (230 of 430)
- 60.7 percent of its blocked shots (85 of 140)

FRESH FACES

NC State's freshman class is the highest-ranked group of rookies in program history. The class was ranked as high as fourth nationally by ESPN, and the four top-100 signees marked the best-ranked class coming into the ACC this season.

Included in the Pack's 2023 freshman class are:

- Zoe Brooks (ESPN No. 9) - the program's first freshman McDonald's All-American since 2019
- Mallory Collier (ESPN No. 55)
- Laci Steele (ESPN No. 56)
- Maddie Cox (ESPN No. 71)

NEXT WOMAN UP

- Last season, Saniya Rivers was the third Wolfpack woman in a row to claim ACC Sixth Player of the Year honors, joining Jada Boyd (2020-21) and Diamond Johnson (2021-22).
- The Pack joins Florida State as the only two schools to win the honor three times in a row since it was established in 2007-08.
- Rivers scored in double figures nine times during the 2022-23 regular season, with five of those occurring when she came off the bench. She posted last year's season high of 22 points, which tied as the most scored by a member of the team that season, in 29 minutes of action off the bench at No. 10 Iowa.

SUSTAINING SUCCESS

- The Wes Moore era has included some of the best years in NC State women's basketball history. In addition to reaching four NCAA Sweet 16s and winning three-straight ACC Tournament titles (2020-22), the Pack ranked seventh among all D1 teams in win percentage (.840) and overall wins (136) from 2017-18 through 2021-22.
- Since the start of the 2019-20 campaign, NC State has lost 23 games. Eight of those have been by double-digit margins, and the remaining 15 losses are by an average of just 5.5 points.

RANKED WINS UNDER MOORE

- NC State has defeated a total of 38 nationally-ranked opponents (38-44) in the Wes Moore era.
- The Pack has defeated eight top-five foes (8-14) under Moore's leadership: No. 2 Notre Dame in 2016-17, No. 1 South Carolina in 2020-21, No. 1 Louisville in 2020-21, No. 5 Louisville in 2020-21, No. 2 Maryland in 2021-22, No. 3 Louisville in 2021-22, No. 2 UConn in 2023-24, No. 3 Colorado in 2023-24.
- NC State has hosted a total of 21 opponents ranked in the AP Top 25 since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum (start of 2016-17 season). NC State has won 14 of those 21 home games. Prior to its Feb. 6, 2023 home loss to No. 11 Virginia Tech, the Pack had a streak of five-straight ranked wins at home.
- Since Moore took over ahead of the 2013-14 campaign, the Wolfpack has played 27 road games against AP Top 25 opponents. NC State is 9-18 in those games (6-8 against AP Top 10 opponents and 2-5 against AP Top 5 teams).

YEAR 50

- 2023-24 marks the 50th season of NC State women's basketball, and the program will celebrate its tradition of excellence throughout the upcoming campaign.
- The Wolfpack is encouraging fans to use #PackWBBSeason50 on social media to share past memories and create new ones this year.
- NC State's largest celebration of the 50th season will take place on Dec. 3 when it hosts its annual Alumni Reunion. The team

will welcome back players and staff members from all 49 previous squads with an alumni reunion and in-game recognitions. The game is being played against Illinois State, which is coached by Kristen Gillespie who was a member of the Pack's 1998 Final Four squad.

- The program created a logo to commemorate the 50th season. It prominently features Reynolds Coliseum, which has served as the Wolfpack's home arena for the entirety of its existence as a varsity team.
- The Pack played its first season as a varsity team in 1974-75. Since then, the program has amassed over 1,000 victories, 42 winning seasons, 9 top-10 final rankings, 28 NCAA Tournament appearances, 15 Sweet 16 berths, 91 All-ACC selections, 5 All-Americans and 37 1,000+ point scorers.

2023-24 REWIND

- NC State went 20-12 overall in 2022-23 and ended its season in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The postseason berth was its sixth in a row, the longest such NCAA Tournament streak for the Pack since 1995-2001.
- Last year was the Pack's 10th winning season and ninth 20+ win season in 10 completed years of the Moore era. NC State now has eight 20+ win seasons in a row, marking the longest such streak since the team had nine consecutive 20+ win seasons from 1976-77 through 1984-85.
- The team went 9-9 in league action to place tied for eighth in the ACC.
- NC State had the tiebreaker to end up as the No. 8 seed for the conference tournament where it won its first game against Syracuse before falling to a top-15 Notre Dame team in the quarterfinal.
- The Pack defeated three ranked opponents last season in No. 10 Iowa, No. 7 Notre Dame and No. 19 UNC. NC State was 3-6 in games played against ranked teams in 2022-23.
- Going into the 2023 NCAA Tournament, the Wolfpack was ranked No. 17 in the NCAA Evaluation Tool (NET) standings. The team's average opponent NET (69) last year ranked second nationally behind only UConn, and the team also had the nation's second-highest opponent success rating.
- The Wolfpack earned four wins over NET Top 25 teams last year, defeating Iowa, Notre Dame, Louisville and North Carolina during the regular season. The Pack's Dec. 5, 2022 win at Iowa was the only home loss for the Hawkeyes, who went on to play in the NCAA championship game.

LOCKER ROOM RENO

Ahead of the season, NC State Athletics finished construction on a renovated and enhanced women's basketball locker room inside of Reynolds Coliseum. The space is named the Gayle and Dwain Lanier Women's Basketball Locker Room in honor of the team's loyal supporters who made the single-largest gift ever to the program.

Gayle (Class of 1982) and Dwain (Class of 1979) Lanier have a rich history of helping NC State students pursue their dreams. They established the Dwain K. and Gayle S. Lanier Scholarship endowments to help underrepresented students from North Carolina study engineering, and they generously donate to other scholarships and programs across campus. NC State Athletics is excited for this opportunity to have its student-athletes see a woman's name on their locker room every day.

The locker room was officially dedicated with an in-game recognition for the Laniers during the Nov. 12 contest against UConn.

WELCOME HOME, KAYLA JONES

Kayla Jones, also known as KJ, returned to Raleigh as NC State women's basketball's graduate manager. She spent the last year playing professionally overseas after getting selected by the Minnesota Lynx in the 2022 WNBA Draft (round 2, pick 22). Jones earned her undergraduate degree in Sport Management from NC State in May 2021 and added a graduate certificate in Sport and Entertainment Venue Management in May 2022.

After stepping permanently into the starting five in 2019-20, Jones was considered the "glue player" for a Wolfpack team that won three-straight ACC Tournament titles, claimed the ACC regular-season crown in her graduate year and reached the NCAA Elite Eight in her final sea-

son on the squad. Jones was a First Team All-ACC honoree in 2020-21, and she earned All-ACC recognition again in 2021-22.

Jones is the program alumna turned staff member, joining assistant coach Ashley Williams (Class of 2017) as former players under Wes Moore's leadership who now coach alongside him.

WOLF-PUPS

NC State women's basketball secured its second-straight top-10 signing class on Nov. 8 as three high school student-athletes inked National Letters of Intent to join the squad beginning with the 2024-25 season. The Wolfpack received official commitments from ESPN No. 17 Zamareya Jones, ESPN No. 47 Devyn Quigley and Lorena Awou. The three players make up a 2024 class that has been ranked as high as 10th nationally by ESPN.

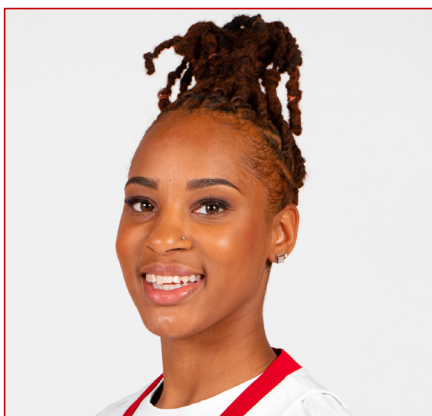
