BEAR TRACKS...

✓ THE SERIES: The Bears and Commodores will be meeting for just the second time. Vanderbilt won the only other meeting 83-62 on Nov. 26, 2008 at Memorial Gymnasium. The Commodores had all five starters in double figures, plus another off the bench, and shot 50.8 percent overall. UCA made 10 three-pointers and got 17 points from Marcus Pillow (five threes) as one of four in double figures. Mitch Rueter addd 16 points, while Mike Pouncy and Chris Brown had 12 each.

UCA shot just 36.2 percent from the field. Vandy won the rebound battle 43-28, including 12 offensive boards. The Commodores also had 42 points in the paint to UCA's 14.

 $\sqrt{\rm VS}$ UAPB: The Bears got two good final looks Monday but could not make either in an 85-83 loss to the UAPB Golden Lions in front of a raucous crowd of nearly 3,000 at the Farris Center. It was the first meeting between the schools located just 70 miles apart since 1994.

UCA got a career-high 22 points from junior Elias Cato and 17 from freshman Tucker Anderson. UCA outrebounded UAPB 46-30, including 17 offensive rebounds. The Bears closed the first half on a 15-0 run to overcome a big first-half deficit. They came back again in the second half after the Golden Lions ran out of the gate quickly after halftime.

UAPB made 12 three-pointers and got a combined 68 points from Rashad Williams, Kylen Milton and Lonnell Martin. Both teams shot well from the free-throw line, with UCA making 17 of 21 (81%) and UAPB making 23 of 28 (82.1%).

√ VS HENDRIX: The Bears, playing without four guards, still beat cross-town rival Hendrix 82-39 on Friday night on "Salute to Service" night at the Farris Center. UCA led 38-22 at halftime, then outscored Hendrix 44-17 in the second half. The

GAME INFORMATION

Bears had three players in double figures, led by freshman Tucker Anderson with 20 points. Junior Ibbe Klintman scored 17 points and junior Elias Cato had 14 points and 12 rebounds. Sophomore guard Johannes Kirsipuu had a career-high 8 assists and added three steals.

UCA won the rebound battle 50-33, including 16 offensive boards.

 \checkmark SEASON OPENER: The Bears, playing without All-ASUN guard Camren Hunter and freshman guard Javion Guy-King, dropped their season opener 70-53 at Tulsa on Monday night at the Reynolds Center.

Junior Élias Cato and sophomore Carl Daugherty, Jr., had 19 points each for the Bears, with Daughtery going 3 of 5 from three-point range. UCA shot just 33.3 percent from the field overall and was 6 of 20 (30 percent) from three-point range. UCA's defense forced 18 turnovers and recorded eight steals. Tulsa won the rebound battle 51-31, including 20 offensive boards.

 $\sqrt{\text{LAST SEASON:}}$ The Bears had a rollercoaster season in 2022-23, losing head coach Anthony Boone for the final 16 games because of heart surgery.

UCA finished 9-22 overall and 4-14 in ASUN Conference play. The Bears lost their last four games of the season, all to quality teams in Eastern Kentucky, Bellarmine, Jacksonville State and conference champion Kennesaw State.

UCA opened the season by going 4-3 in its first seven games, with losses at Wichita State, a neutral game vs. Niagara, and a home overtime loss to Northwestern State.

The Bears' non-conference schedule was as formidable as ever, with matchups against Idaho State, Loyola-Chicago, Oral Roberts, TCU and Oklahoma.

UCA went 3-1 against in-state schools, beating Arkansas State and Hendrix and splitting a pair of games with Little Rock.

UCA's conference victories were against Florida Gulf Coast, Austin Peay, Queens and North Florida in overtime.

√ **THE SCHEDULE:** UCA will play four Power 5 schools this season, including Vanderbilt (Nov. 17), Kansas State (Nov. 22), Oklahoma (Dec. 28) and Missouri (Dec. 30). Also on the schedule are Eastern Michigan, Loyola Marymount, Hawaii, Southeast Missouri, Little Rock, New Orleans, Arkansas-Pine Bluff, Eastern Illinois and Western Illinois.

For the second year, UCA will host an MTE with Eastern Michigan (Nov. 25) and New Orleans (Nov. 26) at the Farris Center.

UCA opens its third season in the ASUN Conference on Jan. 6 vs. North Alabama on the road in Florence, Ala. The Bears will play 16 conference games, with eight at home and eight on the road. The ASUN Championship begins on Monday, March 4 at campus sites. Kennesaw State is the defending champion.

V COACH BOONE: UCA head coach Anthony Boone missed UCA's final 16 games last season after emergency heart surgury on Jan. 5.

Boone, a West Helena, Ark., native who played at Ole Miss, is fully recovered and back for the 2023-24 season, his fifth season as the Bears' head coach.

He took over the program midway through the 2019-20 season when then-head coach Russ Pennell left the program.

During Boone's absence last season, assistant coach Brock Widders directed the team. Widders, a native of Alma, Ark., came to UCA beginning with the 2017-18 season after a playing career at Lyon College in Batesville, Ark.

√ **THE RETUREES:** Junior All-ASUN guard Camren Hunter leads a list of seven returnees for the Bears in 2023-24. Hunter was the ASUN Freshman of the Year in 2021-22 and was an All-ASUN selection last season. He led the Bears in scoring (16.9), assists (3.9) and steals (1.5), while also averaging 5.0 rebounds per game and a team-high 33.9 minutes per game. Hunter scored in double figures in 27 of 30 games, wiht highs of 33 points at Queens and 28 vs. Rider. He also made 50 three-pointers and shot 78.6 percent from the free-throw line.

The other returnees are juniors Elias Cato, Ibbe Klintman and Brendan Simmons, along with sophomores Carl Daughtery Jr. and Johannes Kirsipuu. Olowokere returns the most starts among that group with 29 out of 30 games a year ago. He averaged 7.9 points and 5.5 rebounds per game, with highs of 16 points (vs. Northwestern State) and 11 rebounds (vs. Northwestern State). Olowokere also had a pair of double-doubles.

Klintman started 16 (of 18) games despite battling injuries last season. He averaged 4.2 points and 3.1 rebounds a game.

Cato played in 25 games with six starts and averaged 5.2 points and 4.2 rebounds per game. His season highs were 14 points and 9 rebounds. Cato shot 86.0 percent from the free-throw line.

Kirsipuu played in 29 games with 5 starts and averaged 5.1 points and 1.3 rebounds while handing out 47 assists and connecting on 19 threepointers. He also shot 78.7 percent from the free-throw line.

Daughtery, in his true freshman season, played in 23 games off the bench. He averaged 3.8 points and 1.7 rebounds and made 12 threes.

Simmons saw action in five games and made a pair of three-pointers.

UCA returns 44.9 points and 20.8 rebounds per game on the current roster.

√**THE LOSSES:** The Bears lost three key contributors from last year's team, including Eddy Kayouloud, Collin Cooper and V.J. Reeves. That trio combined to score 31.9 points per game and grab 11.8 rebounds while making 123 three-pointers. Kayouloud, who finished fifth in career scoring and fourth in career rebounding at UCA, was UCA's No. 2 scorer (15.0) and Cooper was No. 3 (10.2). Kayouloud exhausted his eligibility, while Cooper and Reeves transferred. Cooper is now at fellow ASUN menber Eastern Kentucky while Reeves is playing at Texas A&M-Commerce.

√ **THE NEWCOMERS:** UCA has added 10 newcomers, including walk-ons, for the 2023-24 season. The top transfer is Daniel Sofield, a 6-7 guard from West Florida who comes to UCA as a graduate transfer. He finished his career at UWF as the all-time leader in three-pointers (236) and is second in career points (1,393).

UCA added size inside, shot-blocking ability and rebounding in Bowling Green transfer Ubongabasi "Glory" Etim, a 6-9, 230-pounder from Richmond, Calif. Freshman guard Javion Guy-King (6-6) from Little Rock (Mills University Studies/Sunrise Christian Academy) will step in imediately in the guard rotation.

Freshman forward Tucker Anderson from Bentonville, Ark., comes to UCA off a stellar high school career at Bentonville West HS. He was named the Most Valuable Player at last summer's Arkansas High School All-Star game that was played at the Farris Center in Conway.

Caleb Carr (6-9, 250) also brings size inside after coming to UCA from Las Cruces (N.M.) High School. Guards Ben Fox from Liftle Rock Christian and J.D. Roberts from Link Year Prep, along with forward Issakha Niang from Ellsworth CC (Dakar, Senegal) will also figure into the mix this season.

√ **DIVERSITY:** The UCA basketball roster for 2023-24 is once again one of the most diverse in the nation, featuring players from all over the United States and from around the world. UCA has players from six different states and four foreign countries. UCA players come from Arkansas, New Mexico, New York, New Jersey, California and Missouri. The international players are from Australia (Elias Cato), Estonia (Johannes Kirsipuu) Sweden (Ibbe Klintman) and Senegal (Issakha Niang).

 $\sqrt{\text{ESTONIAN ROYALTY:}}$ UCA sophomore guard Johannes Kirsipuu had the opportunity to meet met and have lunch with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Estonia (Margus Tsahkna) and the Ambassador of Estonia to the United States (Kristjan Prikk) in Little Rock in October 2023. The vsiit was set up by his coach on the Estonian junior national team, which Kirsipuu was a part of for six years.

√ WHO'S WHO: Since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006-07, the Bears have played a Who's Who of college basketball. The Bears have played the No. 1 and No. 2 teams in the nation since moving up to NCAA Division I in 2006-07. UCA lost 94-44 to the No. 1 Kansas Jayhawks on Nov. 19, 2009 at historic Allen Fieldhouse. The Bears then dropped a 105-54 decision to the No. 2 Duke Blue Devils on Nov. 12, 2019 at equally historic Cameron Indoor Stadium, and lost to No. 2 Baylor in the 2021-22 season.

UCA played four Top 25 teams (Duke, Baylor, Wichita State, Marquette) two years ago, with Baylor also at No. 1 in the country.

Other notable opponents for the Bears include Kansas, Kentucky, UCLA, Butler, Indiana, Oregon, UNLV, Michigan, Connecticut, Oklahoma,

Oklahoma State, Missouri, Arizona State, Iowa, TCU, Creighton, Memphis, New Mexico State, Pittsburgh, Arkansas, Baylor, Wisconsin and Mississippi State, among others.

√ IN-STATE COMPETITION: The Bears will once again face four in-state schools during the regular season, along with a preseason exhibition game at Arkansas State on Oct. 30 to benefit the tornado relief effort for the city of Wynne, Ark. UCA hosts cross-town rival Hendrix, an NCAA Division III school, in the home opener on Friday, Nov. 10. They will follow that with Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Monday, Nov. 13. The LR Trojans are next on Dec. 7, followed by Champion Christian on Jan. 3.

All four of the in-state games will be played at the Farris Center in Conway.

 $\sqrt{50}$ AT FARRIS: The Bears celebrated the 50th year of the Farris Center on last season (Dec. 6) vs. Arkansas State. The first game in the Farris Center was played on Dec. 7, 1972, an 87-85 victory over cross-town rival Hendrix.

Prior to the opening of the Farris Center, the Bears played in what was then called the Old Gym and is now called the Prince Center, located across the street from Farris. The Prince Center is now home the exclusive home to UCA volleyball.

Numerous renovations have taken place at the Farris Center, including recent additions of floor seating, videoboard, wooden playing surface (Scottie Pippen Court), practice gym and renovated locker rooms.

√ TRIPLE DOUBLE: Sophomore guard Camren Hunter recorded UCA's fourth career triple-double on Jan. 18, 2023 against North Alabama.

The 6-3, 200-pounder had 20 points, 12 rebounds and 11 assists in UCA's 78-73 loss to the Lions. It was the first triple-double for the Bears since center Hayden Koval and point guard DeAndre Jones both had one during the 2017-18 season.

Koval had 17 points, 10 rebounds and 11 blocked shots at Houston Baptist (2/718), while Jones had 13 points, 11 rebounds and 11 assists at Lamar (1/6/18).

The school's first triple-double was by Scottie Pippen against cross-town rival Hendrix on 1/29/87 when the future NBA champion had 30 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists.

√ WALKING WOUNDED: The Bears had 12 players miss at least one game last season due to injury or illness. UCA played all 16 ASUN games without at least one starter. Only senior Eddy Kayouloud played in and started all 31 games last season. Camren Hunter played in 30 of 30, missing the UNA game due to illness.

$\sqrt{NOTABLES}$:

• Scotty Pippen Jr. played at Vanderbilt from 2019-22 and played in 90 games for the Commodores. He is currently in the NBA G League (Lakers).

• UCA's first postseason victory in the NCAA Division I era was a 92-90 overtime win over Seattle in the College Basketball Invitational (ČBI) on March 14, 2018 in Seattle. The Bears then returned home and hosted Jacksonville State, losing 80-59.

UCA's first ASUN Tournament victory was 74-73 over Stetson on March 1, 2022 in the first round of the ASUN Tournament at the Farris Center. The Bears advanced to the quarterfinals and played at Jacksonville, losing 79-69 at Swisher Gymnasium.

• Jacksonville State's 19 three-pointers against the Bears last season was the most since Oral Roberts made 16 on 12/10/22. The school record for opponent threes is 22, which Nicholls State made (41 attempts) on 2/23/19 at Stopher Gym in Thibodaux, La. Baylor made 18 threes on 11/5/19.

• The Bears averaged 86.6 points in their nine victories a year ago. They averaged 67.9 points in their 22 losses. UCA averaged 9.5 three-pointers made in the wins, 8.2 in the losses. The Bears shot 37.9% from three-point range in the wins, 30.4% in the losses. UCA shot 48.1% overall in the victories, 38.4% in the losses.

• UCA's three overtime games last season is the most since the 2019-20 season the Bears played four OT games. UCA was 1-2 last season, with losses to Northwestern State and Florida Gulf Coast and a win over North Florida. Irondically, all three games were at the Farris Center.

• UCA used nine different starting lineups last season. The most used was the original starting lineup of Hunter/Kayouloud/Cooper/Olowokere/ Klintman, which started 11 games.

• Sophomore guard Camren Hunter averaged 33.9 minutes per game last season, which ranked third in the ASUN.

The 33 points by sophomore guard Camren Hunter at Queens was the most since Jared Chatham scored 36 vs. Eastern Kentucky on Feb. 19, 2022.
UCA made a season-high 15 three-pointers against Queens on Jan. 12, one game after making a season-low of 3 at Austin Peay last Saturday, The previous high was 14 threes against Division II Hendrix. The previous low was four in the season opener at Wichita State. UCA averages 8.7 threes per game.

• The Bears were outscored by a whopping 40-0 margin in fastbreak points against No. 18 TCU last season, and 50-28 in points in the paint.

The Bears played their only Top 25 team of the season on Dec. 28 when they lost at No. 18 Texas Christian at Schollmaier Arena in Fort Worth, Texas.
 The last time the Bears shot less than 30 percent from the field was against Little Rock (25.5%) on Nov. 17, 2019. Against TCU, UCA shot 29.0 percent on Dec. 28 at No. 18 Texas

• The Bears went 3-1 against in-state competition last season, with wins over Hendrix, Little Rock and Arkansas State, and a loss to Little Rock.

The bears were set against inside compension as season, with with over renalize, time kock and Akansas state, and a loss to time kock.
 The crowd of 2,385 for the Arkansas State game at the Farris Center was UCA's biggest home crowd since the Nicholls game on 2/22/20 (2,912).

• Thirteen different Bears hit at least one three-pointer last season, led by Collin Cooper with 52 and Camren Hunter with 50.

• The Bears hit double figures in three-pointers 13 times, including a season-high 15 at Queens. UCA made more threes than its oponent 14 times last season, including at Top 25 TCU.

• UCA had double-figure offensive rebounds in 18 of 31 games, with a high of 21 vs. North Florida in an overtime win.

• UCA had six different leading scorers last season, including Camren Hunter (16 times), Eddy Kayouloud (11), Masai Olowokere (2), Collin Cooper (2), Johannes Kirsipuu (2) and VJ Reeves (1).

√ PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Sophomore guard Camren Hunter was named the ASUN Player of the Week on Monday, Dec. 12, 2022.

Hunter averaged 19.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 3.0 steals in UCA's two games that week. He scored 20 points, with 7 rebounds and 6 assists, and shot 53.8% from the field in the win over in-state Arkansas State on Tuesday. In the road loss at Oral Roberts on Saturday, Hunter shot 58.3 percent, scoring 19 points with 5 rebounds, 3 assists and 5 steals.

For the week, Hunter was 5 of 12 from three-point range and 6 of 7 at the free-throw line.

√ VS. THE POWER FIVE: UCA's 96-69 victory over Cal on Dec. 6, 2018 in Berkeley was the first for the Bears over a Power 5 program since moving to NCAA Division I in 2006-07. UCA almost had another one earlier in the season, ironically against another Pac-12 team, when it lost 106-101 in overtime at No. 20 UCLA on Nov. 15 at Pauley Pavilion. The closest losses previously to Power 5 teams were an 87-84 loss to Rutgers (Big Ten) in 2015, a 79-72 loss at Mississippi State (SEC) in 2012 and a 76-73 loss at Oklahoma (Big 12) in 2010.

Head Coach ANTHONY BOONE

Anthony Boone took over as interim coach of the Central Arkansas program on Dec. 14, 2019 prior to the Pepperdine game, and was then handed the reins full time at the end of that season.



Boone came to

Central Arkansas with head coach Russ Pennell in 2014-15 as associate head coach, after assisting Pennell for four years at Grand Canyon University (2009-13) and one year with the Phoenix Mercury of the WNBA before coming to UCA. Pennell was also an assistant coach at Ole Miss during Boone's playing career with the Rebels (1994-98).

As a player for Ole Miss, under Coach Rob Evans, Boone led the Rebels to back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time in 60 years. He was a senior on the team that lost in the 1998 NCAA Tournament to Valparaiso on a memorable last-second shot.


Despite undergoing four knee surgeries, Boone started 79 of 94 games at Ole Miss. Even with relatively modest career averages of 7.2 points and 4.8 rebounds, his inspirational play was recognized by the retirement of his number (41) — only the second student-athlete to be so honored by the school (quarterback Archie Manning, the father of NFL quarterbacks Peyton an Eli Manning, was the first).

After his senior season, Boone was one of seven finalists for the Chip Hilton Award, given annually by the Basketball Hall of Fame to a player

who demonstrates character on and off the court. He is a member of the Ole Miss Hall of Fame and twice was selected for the Southeastern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

Prior to Grand Canyon, Boone was a graduate assistant coach at Ole Miss, then an assistant coach for three seasons at Murray State (2000-03) and six seasons at Jackson State (2003-09). Boone has a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering and a master's in mathematics, both from Ole Miss. He was class salutatorian at Central High School in West Helena, Ark., where he was an all-state athlete.

Boone and his wife Jennifer have two daughters, Rebecca and Lyndsey.

RAGS TO RICHES - UCA's most famous athletic alumnus is **SCOTTIE PIPPEN** of Chicago Bulls fame. Pippen may have one of the greatest rags-to-riches stories in the history of sports.

The youngest of 12 children, Pippen was an average high school player (6-1, 145) at tiny Class B Hamburg (Ark.) High School in the southeast corner of Arkansas. He was allowed to walk on as a manager at UCA as a favor to his high school coach Donald Wayne, who had played for UCA Coach Don Dyer.

He earned a scholarship as a player early in his freshman year when the team lost several team members. He quickly grew to 6-7 by his sophomore year and earned first-team NAIA All-America honors as a junior and senior, averaging 24 points and 11 rebounds as a senior.

After two stunning pre-draft camps, he was taken as the No. 5 lottery pick in the 1987 NBA Draft by the Seattle Supersonics, who turned around and traded his rights to the Chicago Bulls.

The rest is history as Pippen, teaming with the immortal Michael Jordan, won three consecutive NBA championships from 1991-93, and three more from 1996-98. He was an NBA All-Star 11 times and was named one of the NBA's 50 Greatest Players of all time in 1997.

He was a member of the original Dream Team which dominated the 1992 Summer Olympic Games and was also a member of the 1996 Olympic gold medal squad. His UCA jersey was retired in 2010. He was also inducted into the UCA Sports Hall of Fame, the Arkansas Sports Hall of Fame and the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.

THE MOVE TO D-I - The University of Central Arkansas made the four-year transition from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I, beginning in 2006-07.

The NCAA requires programs making the move up to Division I to go through a four-year waiting period where no athletic teams are eligible for postseason play. UCA men's basketball became eligible for postseason competition on the conference and national levels beginning with the 2010-11 season.

The Bears were eligible to win the Southland Conference regular season divisional title during the transition period but could not advance to the SLC postseason tournament because of the automatic qualifier stipulation that the tournament enjoys.

AFFILIATION - UCA, a former member of the Gulf South Conference at the D-II level, became an official member of the Southland Conference on July 1, 2006. UCA was the only conference university from a state other than Texas or Louisiana until Oral Roberts joined the conference in 2012-13. ORU has since returned to the Summit League. The other 12 schools in the SLC are spread throughout those two states, leaving UCA on the extreme northern end of the league geographically.

UCA officially joined the 12-team ASUN Conference on July 1, 2021, joining a league spread over eight southeastern state.

IN THE PAST - The UCA Bears have a rich postseason history dating back to their NAIA days.

The Bears played in back-to-back NAIA national championship games in 1990-91 and 1991-92 against the same Oklahoma City University team. OCU, featuring former Kentucky player Eric Manuel, got the best of the Bears both times,

The first year was a 74-71 win for OCU; the second was an 82-73 overtime win. Both games were played at Kansas City's Kemper Arena.
