CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• *Player of the Week:* Senior guard Darrione Rogers recorded the first triple-double by a Mississippi State women's basketball player since Dec. 16, 2000, and only the second overall in program history with 14 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in 34 minutes in a 99-35 win over Mississippi Valley State on Friday, Dec. 29. It was the first triple-double by a SEC women's basketball player since LSU's Khayla Pointer on Feb. 7, 2021, and only the 40th triple-double in SEC women's basketball history. Rogers made her fourth start of the season, filling in once more due to an injury. The triple-double was the second of Rogers' career; she and Iowa's Caitlin Clark are the only two players nationally to record a triple-double each of the last two seasons. It marks the 59th game with 10-plus points, fourth with 10-plus assists and ninth with 10-plus rebounds for Rogers' career. She turned in 10 of Mississippi State's 20 assists in the effort to help Mississippi State earn its largest margin of victory under head coach Sam Purcell.

• *Co-Freshmen of the Week:* Mississippi State's Quanirah Montague finished with her first career double-double with 14 points, 13 rebounds and six blocks in only 23 minutes in a 99-35 win over Mississippi Valley State on Friday, Dec. 29. Montague surpassed career-highs in points, rebounds, blocks and minutes played in the performance and it marked her first career game with either 10-plus points or 10-plus rebounds. With the six blocks, she ties the most by a Mississippi State player this season.

Vanderbilt's Khamil Pierre averaged 10.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, while she shot 50% (9-of-18) to help the Commodores to a pair of wins this week. Pierre opened the week by scoring 12 points and pulling down seven rebounds in 20 minutes of action off the bench in Friday's 73-41 win over FDU. The 6-2 forward shot 55.6% (5-of-9) from the floor against the Knights. It was her sixth game this season shooting over 50% from the field. The freshman made her first collegiate start in Sunday's 80-53 win over Radford. Pierre scored nine points and pulled down five rebounds in 24 minutes against the Highlanders.

Around the League

• Ole Miss once again proved its defensive prowess by limiting Alabama to its lowest point total of the season. For

the 25th time in program history, Ole Miss picked up an SEC season opening win and its 16th to open road play in conference.

• South Carolina came out hot, shooting 64.7 percent in the first quarter, including 4-of-4 3-point shooting from Te-Hina Paopao. Paopao's four 3s in the first quarter matched her single-game season high for made 3-pointers.

• Senior Ajae Petty scored 22 points and grabbed a career-high 19 rebounds as Kentucky upset Arkansas 73-63 inside Rupp Arena. Petty made 11 of 19 from the floor for her 22 points, and she added a career-high-tying three assists.

• Fifth-year senior forward Javyn Nicholson paced Georgia once again with her ninth double-double of the year, fifth consecutive. She scored 20 points and added 10 rebounds in 35 minutes of action. It was her fifth 20-point scoring effort of the season.

• Vanderbilt's Iyana Moore extends her double-digit scoring streak to three games with a 29-point outing at Mississippi State. It is Moore's seventh double-figure scoring performance of the season and the 29th overall in her career, while it is her seventh career game with 20 or more points.

• Vanderbilt improves to 14-1 for the first time since the 2006-07 season. It is the fourth time that Vanderbilt has won 14 or more games during the first 15 contests of a season, it also occurred during the 1992-93 (15-0), the 1995-96 (14-1) and 2006-07 campaigns.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.

Attendance

• SEC women's basketball set the all-time NCAA record for conference leaders in total attendance. A total of 1,146,341 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.

• The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball average attendance for seven of the last eight seasons.

SEC vs Everyone Else

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5998-1746 (.775) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 544-249 (.653) against non-conference teams.

• Overall, teams are 6543-1997 (.766).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 28 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
