CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **Player of the Week:** Tennessee's Rickea Jackson has been on a tear since returning from an eight-game hiatus due to injury, helping Tennessee reel off five straight wins and open SEC play at 2-0 with victories at Auburn Thursday night and at home vs. Kentucky on Sunday. At Auburn, Jackson contributed 24 points and a career-high 19 rebounds as Tennessee overcame an 11-point second-quarter deficit. Against Kentucky, Jackson again came to the rescue over the final 20 minutes, allowing the Big Orange to record another comeback win tallying 16 points in the second half. She averaged a double-double of 25.5 points and 13.0 rebounds last week while dishing out 2.0 assists per contest and shooting 54.3 percent from the field, 40 percent beyond the arc and 73.3 percent from the free-throw line. Her scoring average is tops in the league after two games, while her rebounding average ranks fourth, her defensive rebounds per game average (10.0) is third and her field goal percentage is eighth. For the season, Jackson is averaging 21.2 ppg. and 10.5 rpg. while shooting 48.5 percent from the field, 33.3 percent from the arc and 80 percent at the charity stripe.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Mikaylah Williams showed her ability to impact games in multiple ways, helping LSU begin 2-0 in league play. In her first SEC game, Williams managed to score in double figures despite not shooting the ball like her typical self. Her seven assists against Missouri were a career high as she found open shooters and also impacted the game with six rebounds, 2 steals in a block. On Sunday at Ole Miss, Williams showed off her scoring prowess, scoring 20 points for the fifth time this season. She was especially lethal from beyond the arc, shooting 4-5 from three-point range. As she was able to get her shot whenever she wanted it did not stop Williams from finding open players as she dealt out four assists. She made an impact defensively too with four steals, including one at the top of the key that she took and popped a three-pointer on the other end. When LSU trailed by one in the third quarter, Williams charge that she took helped the momentum swing back towards LSU for the Tigers to leave Oxford with an 11-point road victory.

Around the League

• Rickea Jackson was honored by the USBWA as one of the five Ann Meyers Drysdale national honorees. As well as earning weekly honorable mention by The Associated Press.

• Bree Hall was South Carolina's top scorer with 15 points in each of the Gamecocks SEC wins, helping them open league play 2-0 for the 10th time in the last 11 seasons. The junior guard was efficient from the field, hitting 68.8 percent overall and 71.4 percent (5-of-7) from 3-point range.

• Angel Reese opened up SEC play with two 21-point performances, leading LSU to multiple victories. LSU opened SEC play at home against Missouri as Angel Reese recorded her 41st double-double at LSU with 21 points and 13 rebounds.

• Javyn Nicholson continued her historic season, becoming the first Georgia player since Hall of Famer Janet Harris in 1984-85 to post seven-straight double-doubles. Nicholson's 10 double-doubles this season also ties for the lead in the SEC.

• Iyana Moore averaged 24.5 points while she shot 57.1% from the field in a pair of SEC victories at Mississippi State and home vs. Florida this week. Moore's performance this week helped Vanderbilt improve to 15-1 overall on the year, which is the second-best start through 16 games in program history.

• Florida's Leilani Correa led both teams in scoring Thursday evening with a 28-point performance. Correa's 28-point outing against South Carolina is the largest amount to be put up against the first-ranked Gamecocks in conference play thus far. It also marks Correa's new season high in scoring.

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

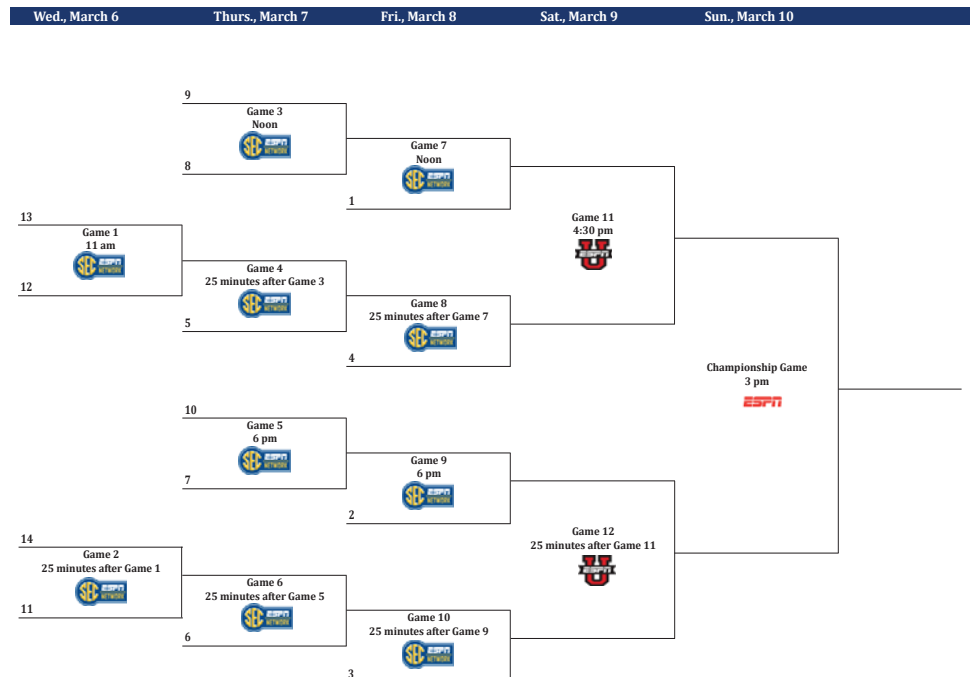
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.
