CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **Co-Players of the Week:** Auburn's Honesty Scott-Grayson scored 21 points to help the Tigers pull off one of the season's biggest upsets as Auburn defeated No. 7/4 LSU 67-62 Sunday at home, ending the 16-game win streak of the defending national champions. She hit clutch shot after clutch shot – three of her made field goals in the second half flipped the lead in Auburn's favor, including a layup at the 6:34 mark to give Auburn the lead for good. With a pair of steals, she helped lead an Auburn defense that held LSU to its lowest point total of the season. For the week, Scott-Grayson averaged 18.5 points over Auburn's two games, adding a 16-point effort at Ole Miss as the Tigers rallied from an 18-point deficit to get within a point in the final minute before falling just short. For the season, Scott-Grayson averages a team-leading 15.8 points per game, and she has scored in double-figures in 15 of the 16 games she has played. For the week, she averaged 18.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.0 steals.

Mississippi State's Jessica Carter averaged 22.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 2.0 blocks on 64.5 percent from the field in 34.5 minutes over two contests last week. Carter was the leading scorer in both contests and turned in consecutive 20-point performances for the first time this season. Carter finished with 22 points, 19 rebounds, three assists and two blocks in 32 minutes in a 66-63 road win at Arkansas – the last block which came on the Razorbacks' final possession in its attempt to tie or take the lead. The 19 rebounds for Carter surpassed her previous SEC high total. With her 22 points and 19 rebound effort at Arkansas on Jan. 11, Carter now has 35 career double-doubles which ranks second among active SEC players and third in program history. The Arkansas effort also marked her 11th career 20-plus points and 10-plus rebounds performance. Carter followed up that performance with 22 points, five rebounds and two blocks in 37 minutes in a 69-57 home win over rival Ole Miss on Jan. 14. It marked the third 20-plus point contest of the season and the 17th of her career.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Vanderbilt's Khamil Pierre averaged 16.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game in a pair of SEC contests this week. The highlight of Pierre's career-best week came in Sunday's contest against Missouri, where she recorded the first double-double of her career with a 16-point, 12-rebound performance off the bench. Pierre opened the week by scoring a career-high 16 points in a 95-73 win at Kentucky. She had shot 72.7 percent from the

field in the win over the Wildcats, while she pulled down six rebounds and had two assists. The freshman rounded out the week with her best performance in a Commodore uniform against Missouri. Pierre matched her career-best in points with 16 and pulled down a career-high 12 rebounds to record the first double-double of her career. The forward shot 50 percent from the field against the Tigers and had two steals. Her back-to-back 16-point performances against Kentucky and Missouri this week mark the first time that Pierre has scored 10 or more points in back-to-back games in her collegiate career.

Around the League

- Honesty Scott-Grayson was honored by the USBWA as one of the five Ann Meyers Drysdale national honorees.
- Vanderbilt is now 17-2 this season, which is the second-best start to a season in program history. The Dores' best start to a season came during the 1992-93 season when Vandy was 18-1 through 19 games
- Tennessee recorded its fourth double-digit come-from-behind SEC win and fifth such victory of the season, clawing its way back from a 13-point second-quarter Mississippi State lead to win, 75-64. The Lady Vols previously won after trailing Auburn (11), Kentucky (17) and Florida (12) by more than 10. The Lady Vols also came from 10-down to Oklahoma in the third quarter to defeat the then No. 22/20 Sooners on Nov. 25. For the season, UT has bounced back from being behind to win nine of its 17 games.

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

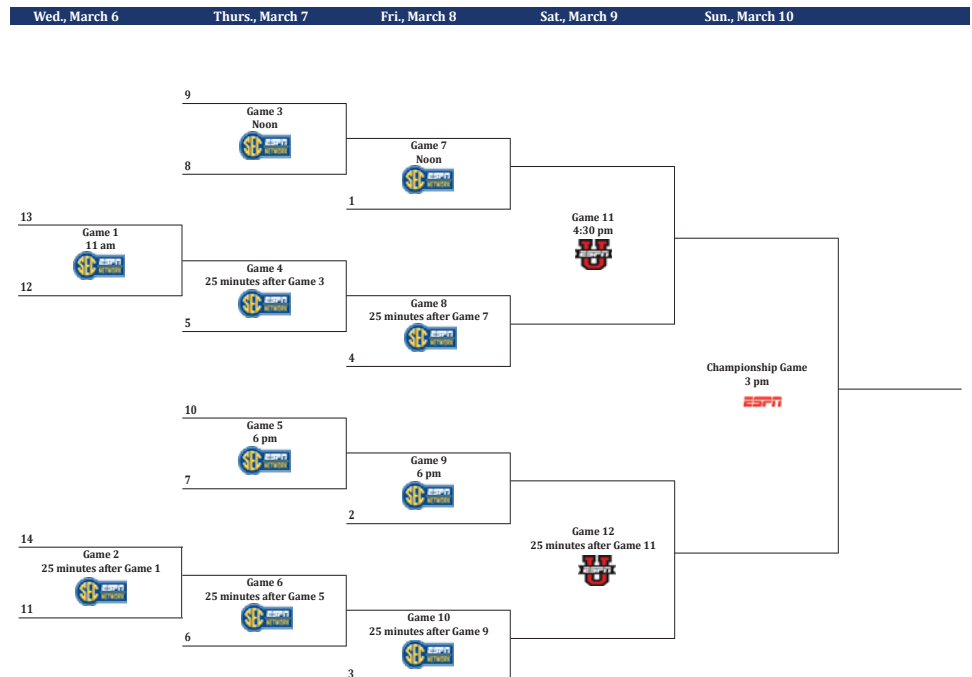
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.
