## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Weekly Honors

• **Player of the Week:** Angel Reese put together a great week, helping the Tigers win victories at Alabama and against Arkansas with two 15-rebound double-doubles. She started at Alabama where she had 20 points and 16 rebounds. It was her fifth 20-point game in a row to begin SEC play and her second SEC game with at least 20 points and 15 rebounds. On Sunday she had another solid performance with 16 points, including her first made three of the year, with another 17-rebound performance. Reese has 12 double-doubles this season and four games with at least 15 rebounds. All of her 15+ rebound games have happened over the past seven games.

• **Co-Freshmen of the Week:** Mikaylah Williams continued to show off her skills as a freshman in LSU's two victories last week. She began with 14 points and 5 rebounds at Alabama, helping the Tigers secure a victory on the road. On Sunday Williams recorded her sixth 20-point game of her debut season while coming down with 9 rebounds, one shy of a double-double. She also had three assists, a block and a steal. William's had great efficiency on Sunday shooting above 60-percent from the field and at 60-percent from beyond the arc.

• MiLaysia Fulwiley led South Carolina in scoring in its lone game this week, posting her first career 20-point game with 21 at Texas A&M, playing just 20 minutes. Her points came on efficient shooting, hitting 8-of-12 from the field (.667) and 3-of-5 from 3-point range. In the second quarter, she was a perfect 5-of-5, including three 3s, with eight of her 13 points in the period coming in the Gamecocks' 12-2 run that closed the half. Those 13 points matched the team's season high for points in a quarter. With teammates scoring six points off her three assists – two being SportsCenter-worthy – Fulwiley had her hands on 27.3 percent of the Gamecocks' offense against the Aggies.

### Around the League

• In the 63-51 win over Texas A&M, Florida was led by Leilani Correa on offense once more with a 24-point performance. On defense Faith Dut led the way with nine rebounds and two blocks. Jeriah Warren also stepped up big for the Gators with seven rebounds and seven points.

• With the 91-74 win over Vanderbilt, the Gamecocks have tallied 23 consecutive wins at home by double digits.

• Kamilla Cardoso finished with a new SEC career high of 23 points, scoring eight of the Gamecocks' first 12 points in the game then dropped 13 in the third period in just nine minutes on the court. While Bree Hall notched her 10th game this season finishing in double-figures, putting up 11 with seven coming in the first half.

• For the first time since 2017, Ole Miss toppled Tennessee, 80-75. The duo of Marquasha Davis and Kharyssa Richardson paved the way for Ole Miss, each posting 20-plus point games.

• Arkansas pulled out a 67-58 victory at Missouri in a game that saw 14 lead changes and seven ties.

• On her mother, Amy Fordham's (1990-94) Alumni Night at Missouri, Saylor Poffenbarger knocked down a career-high eight 3-pointers, one short of tying the school record to match a career-high 24 points. The Hogs have now won 11 straight against Missouri.

• In the 91-74 win over Kentucky, Alabama's Sarah Ashlee Barker (34 points/10 rebounds) and Essence Cody (14 points/10 rebounds) had double-doubles.

## 2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

**Tie-Break Procedure**  
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

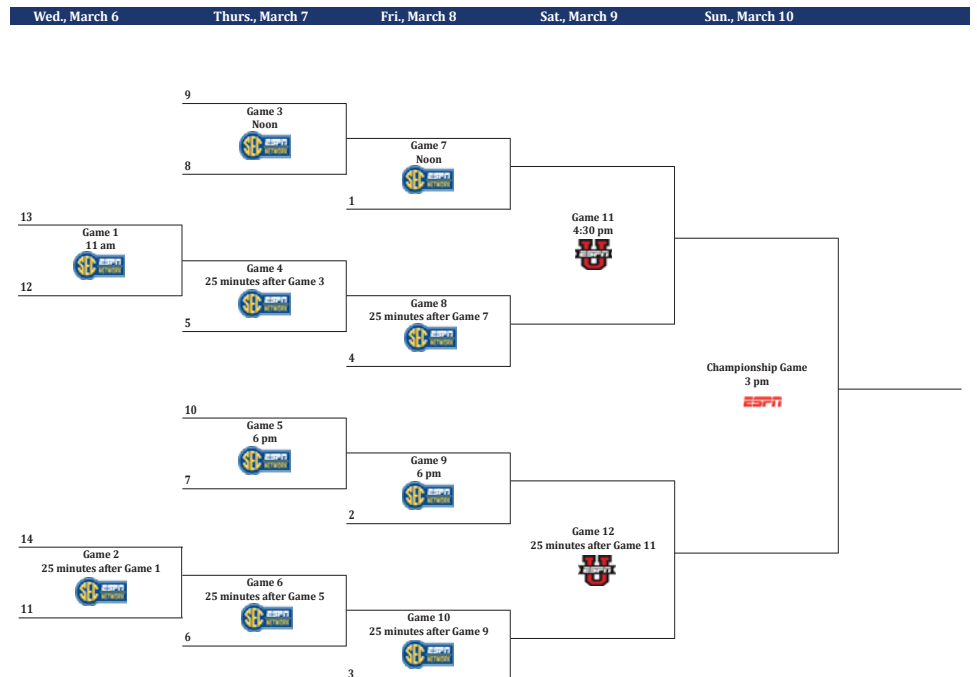
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

## SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.

• SEC women's basketball set the all-time NCAA record for conference leaders in total attendance. A total of 1,146,341 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.

• The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball average attendance for seven of the last eight seasons.

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5998-1746 (.775) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 544-249 (.653) against non-conference teams.

• Overall, teams are 6543-1997 (.766).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 28 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
