CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• **Co-Players of the Week:** Sarah Ashlee Barker played a huge role in Alabama's back-to-back road wins where she averaged 24.5 points per game, 10 rebounds, five assists and 2.5 steals. She picked up her second consecutive double-double (24 points, 11 rebounds) during the Crimson Tide's 86-70 win over Arkansas in Bud Walton Arena and shot 60 percent from deep (6-9). Barker tallied her third consecutive 20-or-more points in Monday night's 74-66 comeback win over Vanderbilt, which included a 19-point second half to propel the Tide to victory. Barker leads Alabama with 17.3 points per game, which ranks eighth in the SEC.

Tennessee's Jewel Spear added 25- and 22-point efforts this week after scoring 30 at Ole Miss last Sunday to post three-straight 20 spots for only the second time in her career. She was sensational against Georgia and Missouri, averaging 23.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals. She also shot a blazing 60.7 percent from the field and went nine of 16 from the three-point arc (55.6 pct.) as the Lady Vols won for the 10th time in their past 12 games and took sole possession of second place in the SEC at 14-7 overall, 7-2 in league play.

• **Freshman of the Week:** MiLaysia Fulwiley was the Gamecocks' second-highest scorer of the week with 14.5 points per game. The team's top scorer at Auburn, she scored six of her 15 points during a 6-2 run late in the second quarter to help the Gamecocks take a five-point lead into halftime despite a tough-shooting first half. Her traditional three-point play midway through the third sparked a 9-0 run that gave the Gamecocks breathing room and a 15-point lead. Against Ole Miss, she capped an 8-0 second-quarter run with a buzzer-beating layup for a nine-point halftime lead. For the week, she shot 44.8% with a 77.8% free-throw percentage.

Around the League

• Erynn Barnum surpassed her Mississippi State high point total with a game-high 22 points on 9-11 from the field with six rebounds and three assists in 31 minutes to lead Mississippi State to a road win at Texas A&M, 74-63.

• Javyn Nicholson continued her historic season, scoring in

double figures for the 20th time in 21 games and recording her 12th double-double – the second-best total in the SEC this year and the most for a Georgia player in a season since Janet Harris in 1983.

• After being sidelined six games due to injury, Taliah Scott delivered big time in her first week back in action. The freshman put on a show in Arkansas' win over Auburn, logging 33 points off nearly 50 percent shooting from the field and 50 percent from beyond the arc, tying a career-high six 3-pointers.

• Auburn's Honesty Scott-Grayson put together the best back-to-back games of her career, scoring 58 points over two games against No. 1 South Carolina and Arkansas. Against the Gamecocks, she matched a career-high with 31 points, going 11-of-23 from the field (47.8%) and hitting 8-of-10 free throws. It was the most points scored by an SEC player against the Gamecocks in more than three years.

• Ashlyn Watkins finished with the Gamecocks' only double-doubles of the week, hitting the mark in both games. At Auburn, that double-double nearly came in the first half as 10 of her career-high 15 rebounds came in the opening 20 minutes as did eight of her SEC career-high 14 points and three of her five blocks. Against Ole Miss, Watkins scored six of the team's 17 first-quarter points, and she snagged six of the team's nine third-quarter rebounds.

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

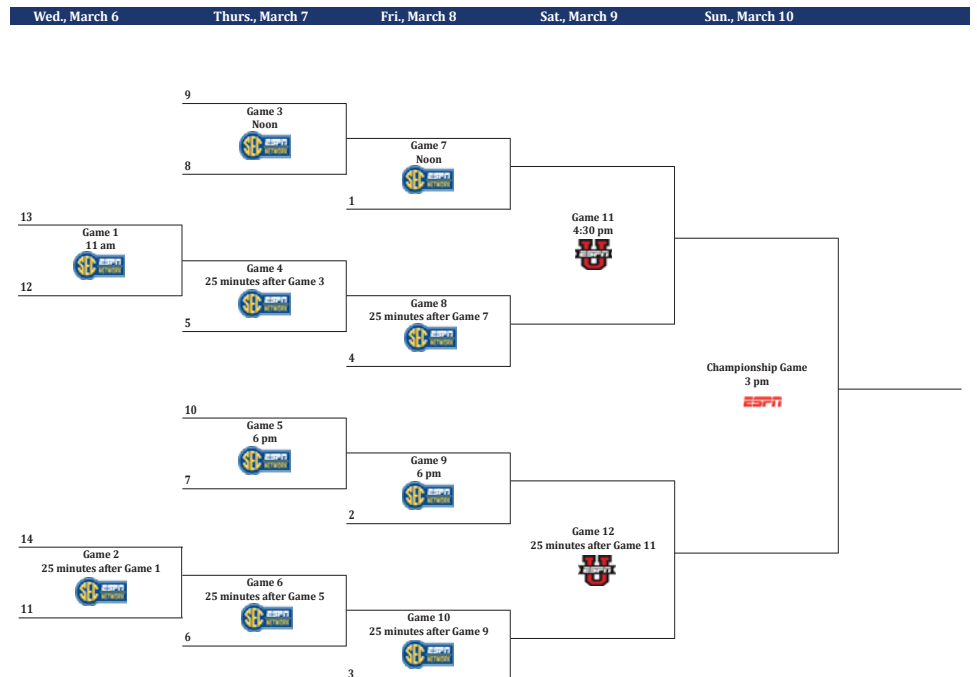
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.
