CONFERENCE NOTES

Weekly Honors

• *Co-Players of the Week:* Madison Scott tallied a career-best 27 points in Ole Miss' come from behind win in overtime at Florida on Thursday, to win its fifth in a row over the Gators. Shooting 10-of-14 from the field in Gainesville, Scott nailed a career-best 10 made field goals. In her performance over the Gators, Scott also grabbed 12 rebounds for her 26th career double-double to move to a tie for eighth at Ole Miss. Scott followed up her game on Thursday with yet another 20-point outing this season, this time against in-state rival Mississippi State with 20 points against the Bulldogs. Scott was an integral part in Ole Miss' second straight comeback victory, with Scott draining the game-tying layup with three seconds remaining to force overtime. Due to Scott's efforts, the Rebels went on to win back-to-back overtime games for the first time in program history.

Kamilla Cardoso returned from representing her home country in FIBA Olympic Qualifying – and earning All-Star 5 honors at the event – to lead South Carolina to a pair of SEC wins that tied and then broke the league's record for consecutive conference wins (43). She averaged 17.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 4.0 assists. At Tennessee, she scored four of the team's first eight points in the third quarter in rallying back from a three-point halftime deficit. All seven of her fourth-quarter points came in the final 3:35 to seal the victory. Against Georgia, Cardoso absolutely stuffed the box score with 16 points, a career-high tying 16 rebounds, a team-high five assists, three blocks and a career-high three steals. She dominated the second half with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the final 20 minutes. In the opening minutes of the third quarter, her three points sparked a 7-0 run that cut a nine-point deficit to just two. She went on to post seven points and six boards in the final period to secure the history-making win.

• *Freshman of the Week:* Khamil Pierre averaged 5.5 points, 7.0 rebounds, and 2.0 steals to help Vanderbilt go 1-1 on the week. The highlight of the freshman's week came in Thursday's victory at Texas A&M, where she scored a team-high 11 points. Pierre opened the week by scoring a team-best 11 points and pulled down a team-high eight rebounds at Texas A&M. Pierre drilled her second 3-point field goal of the season in the win over the Aggies. Pierre's

efforts helped Vanderbilt pick up its first win at Texas A&M since Nov. 18, 1997.

Around the League

• In the win over MSU, Saniah Tyler, a sophomore guard, led Kentucky with a career-tying 22 points on 7-of-10 from the field, 6-of-8 from the arc and 2-of-2 from the line.

• Her teammate Ajae Petty, a senior forward, had 20 points and a team-high 12 rebounds. It marked her third straight double-double and 15th double-double this season and 17th of her career.

• It was a big game for the Gamecocks, not only did they clinch a share of their third straight SEC regular-season championship with a 72-44 win over Alabama, it was also coach Dawn Staley's 600th career win.

• South Carolina's Ashlyn Watkins led the team in scoring for the first time this season, knocking down eight of her 14 points in the second quarter en route to her seventh double-double after finishing with 10 boards.

• For Ole Miss, the trio of Marquesha Davis, Madison Scott, and Kennedy Todd-Williams had a tremendous influence in the win over Georgia, combining for 51 points. Davis, Scott and Todd-Williams were in full force all scoring in double-figures for the third straight game in a row. Davis led the pack with 20 points, grabbing five rebounds and dishing out five assists. Rejecting a career-tying two shots, Todd-Williams added 15 points and four assists.

• In the win over Arkansas, four Aggies scored in double-digits for the 11th time this season (Janiah Barker – 16, Aicha Coulibaly – 11, Sahara Jones – 11, Solè Williams – 10).

2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

Tie-Break Procedure
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

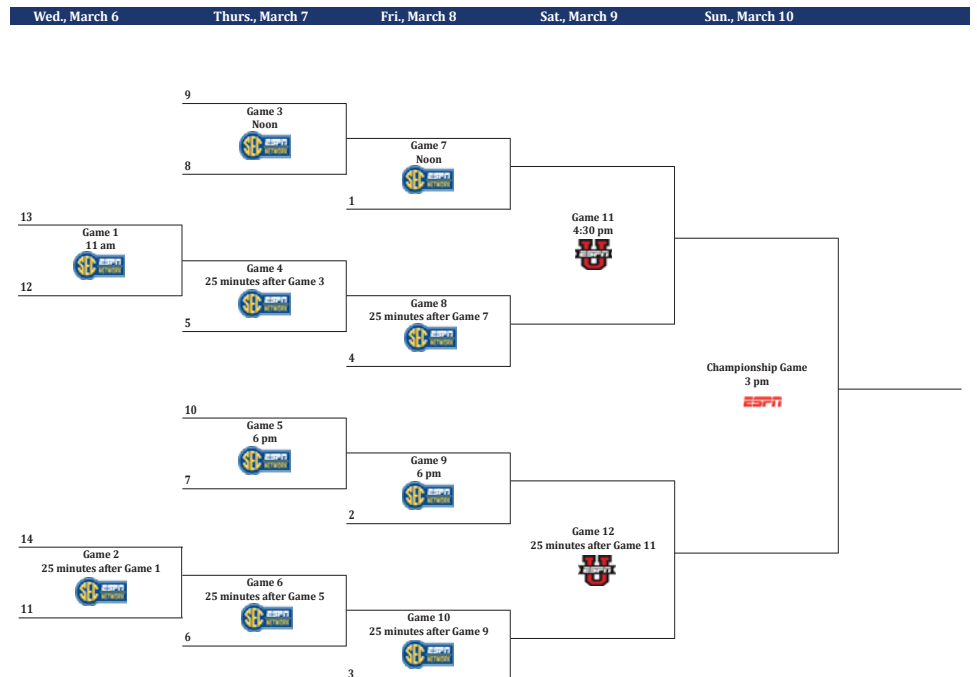
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.
