## CONFERENCE NOTES

### Weekly Honors

• **Player of the Week:** Angel Reese averaged 18 points and 17.5 rebounds in the two games and has secured at least 15 rebounds in three straight games. To begin the week against Auburn, Reese had 25 points and 20 rebounds. It was her seventh 20/20 game over the past two seasons and sixth 25/20 game in the same span. In Knoxville against Tennessee, Reese had 11 points and 15 rebounds. She went over 2,000 career points in the game, becoming the fifth active player to have 2,000 career points and 1,000 career rebounds. Reese currently leads the SEC with 19.1 points per game and 12.9 rebounds per game. She led the conference in both categories last season and could join Wendy Scholtens (Vanderbilt, 1989 and 1990) as the only player to do so in back-to-back seasons.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Essence Cody finished the week on a high note during Alabama's 87-75 win over Mississippi State on Sunday. Cody, along with three other teammates, collected her 10th double digit game 15 points, while shooting 53.8 percent from the field (7-13) and 50 percent from the free throw line (1-2). The freshman continues to lead the Crimson Tide in rebounds (187) and blocks (56). For the week Cody averaged 8.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 2.5 bpg and 2.5 spg.

### Around the League

• Ashlyn Watkins helped lead South Carolina to a pair of wins that clinched the outright SEC Regular-Season Championship – its third straight and eighth in 11 seasons. The top rebounder and second-leading scorer last week, she poured in 13.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while also stuffing the stat sheet with 2.0 assists, 1.5 blocks and 1.0 rebounds per game.

• Javyn Nicholson is putting together one of the best seasons in Georgia history. She recorded her 15th double-double of the year this past week, scoring a game-high 26 points and totaling a game-best 12 rebounds in the Lady Bulldogs' 76-60 win against Florida. The Lawrenceville, Ga., native has now scored over 25 points in three-straight games, including a career high 27 points against No. 1 South Carolina and 26 versus Ole Miss.

• Aaliyah Nye helped lead the Crimson Tide to a bounce back win over Mississippi State on Sunday after dropping Thursday's contest to No. 1/1 South Carolina. Alabama's 87-75 victory on Sunday came behind a career-day for the senior guard. Nye led all scorers with a career-high 28 points and tied the single-game program record with eight three-pointers made in the win.

• Auburn graduate student Honesty Scott-Grayson continued her strong play in league games, averaging 18.5 points in two games at No. 13/10 LSU and at home against Texas A&M. In Thursday's game at LSU, she scored a game-high 28 points – her most ever in a road game – while knocking down a career-high five 3-pointers.

• Leilani Correa continues to be at the top of the SEC in scoring for conference play with an average of 21.21 points per game. Correa has been the number-one scorer in the league since the start of SEC play and has a combined 297 points in the Gators' 14 conference games. In all but one SEC game this year Correa has reached double-figures in scoring.

• Aliyah Matharu is second in the league for scoring with an average of 18.17 points per game and is third for steals, snagging an average of 2.75 a game. Matharu is also coming off a big week, where she set her career high in scoring Thursday night with a 28-point performance against Missouri.

## 2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

**Tie-Break Procedure**  
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

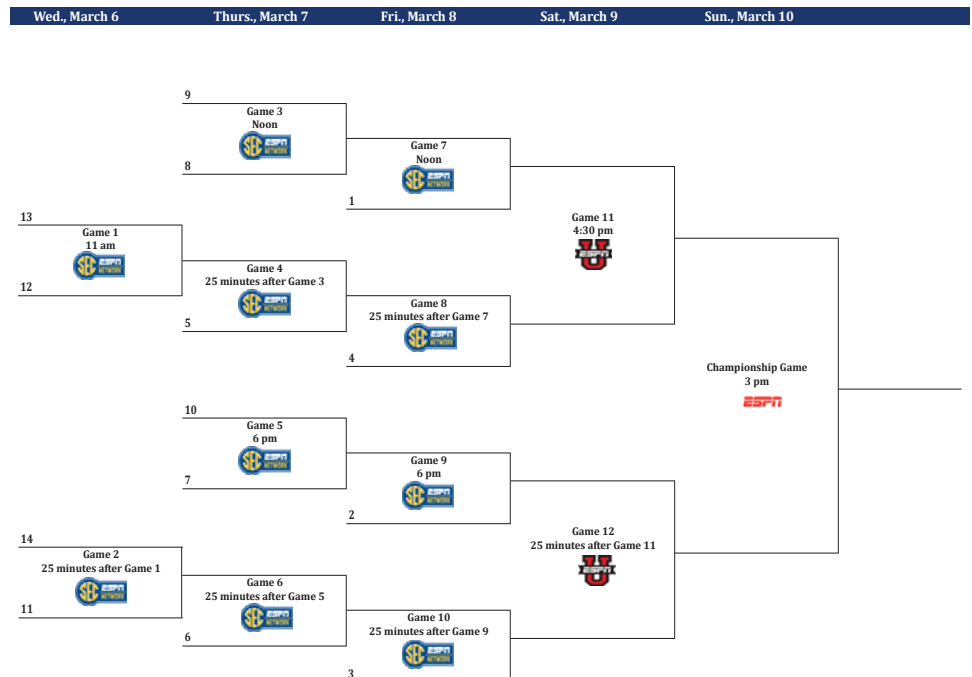
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

## SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- Four Women's Basketball Academic All-America of the Year hail from the SEC. They are Candace Parker, UT (2007 & 2008); Aliyah Boston, SC (2021 & 2022).
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.
- All 14 current members have appeared in the NCAA Tournament.
- In total, league schools have earned 263 bids to lead all conferences.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.

### Women's Basketball Leadership Council
