Series Preview: Vanderbilt takes a 10-game win streak into SEC play as Auburn comes to town for a three-game series.

- Auburn leads the all-time series 99-68-1 since the first meeting in 1908. Vandy leads the series 31-14 under head coach Tim Corbin. The Dores have won seven straight vs. the Tigers at Hawkins Field.
- This weekend's series marks the first three-game series against a ranked opponent for Vanderbilt this season. The Dores are 1-0 vs. teams ranked by D1Baseball this season.

Last Time Out: Vanderbilt swept its weekend series over Illinois State before defeating Indiana on Tuesday.

- Over their last five games, Vanderbilt's starting pitchers have a combined 0.56 ERA with 32 innings pitches and two earned runs allowed. Vandy's starting arms have issued just four walks while striking out 44 over the span.
- Devin Futrell was named SEC Pitcher of the Week after tossing a complete-game shutout vs. Illinois State last Sunday. Bryce Cunningham registered 11 strikeouts over eight innings in his start on Saturday vs. the Redbirds.
- On Tuesday vs. Indiana, RJ Austin went 3-for-4 with a double, RBI and two runs scored. Troy LaNeve drove in three runs.

Stat Spotlights: Vanderbilt ranks top-10 in NCAA DI in doubles, stolen bases and fielding percentage entering the weekend.

- The Dores lead the SEC and are seventh nationally in both stolen bases (45) and fielding percentage (0.984).
- Vandy ranks second in the SEC and ninth nationally in doubles (46).
- The Dores are 17th in DI in hits (190) and 23rd in runs (156).
- RJ Austin is second in SEC and third nationally in stolen bases (13). Jacob Humphrey's 86 career stolen bases is tied for third among active DI players.
- Vandy ranks seventh in stolen bases (45) and are tied for second in stolen bases allowed (3).

Scoring Early: Vanderbilt has scored 45 of its 156 runs in the first two innings this season.

- Vandy is outscoring its opponents 25-5 in the first inning and 20-3 in the second inning.
- The Dores are 8-1 when they score in the first frame and 11-1 when scoring first.

1,000-Win Club: Vanderbilt head coach Tim Corbin reached 1,000 career wins on March 5 vs. Eastern Michigan.

- Corbin is two wins away from 900 victories at Vanderbilt.
- Among active coaches, Corbin ranks 10th by most wins. He is second in the SEC behind Arkansas' Dave Van Horn (1,224).

Newcomers Contributing: Vanderbilt has used 12 newcomers this season, including eight freshmen.

- Jayden Davis, a transfer from Samford, is hitting .299 with six doubles, a home run and 16 RBI.
- Freshman Camden Kozeal was named SEC Freshman of the Week (March 4) after leading all DI hitters with 14 hits the previous week.
- Jacob Humphrey, a transfer from UMass Lowell, hit his first home run as Commodore in his second start Feb. 27 against Indiana State.

Streaking: A pair of Dores, **Jayden Davis** and **Alan Espinal**, have reached base safely in every game they've played this season

- Four Commodores enter the weekend with double-digit on-base streaks. Davis has reached base in all 18 games following by Espinal at 17, Camden Kozeal at 12 and RJ Austin at 10.
- Espinal reached base safely in each of Vandy's final five games of the 2023 season, for a total on-base streak of 22 games.

Preseason Accolades: Vanderbilt started the season ranked in the top-10 in all five major preseason polls.

- A pair of Dores landed on the Preseason All-SEC team. Juniors
 Carter Holton and Jonathan Vastine were both voted to the second team by the league's coaches.
- The Commodores were picked to finish third in the SEC East in the SEC Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Holton was honored by USA Baseball with a selection to the 2024 Golden Spikes Award Watch List. He is one of just eight players to appear on the watch list in both 2023 and 2024. Vandy has had a student-athlete on the watch list 31 times under head coach Tim Corbin.
- Junior Devin Futrell was named to the Perfect Game Preseason All-America second team. Futrell led the Vandy pitching staff last season with an 8-3 record and a 3.44 ERA.

Returning to the Mound: Vanderbilt returns 10 pitchers from a season ago, including eight that tallied at least 15 innings pitched.

- Junior Devin Futrell was second team All-SEC last season after ranking third in the SEC in ERA (3.44) and BB/9 (2.15). Futrell leads all active pitchers in the SEC with 18 victories at an SEC institution.
- Junior Carter Holton is a preseason All-American after making 11 starts last season. Holton dealt with an injury in 2023 after being named a unanimous freshman All-American in 2022.
- Junior Ryan Ginther played a large role in Vandy's bullpen last season. Ginther finished the year with a 4.01 ERA over 33.2 innings. His 21 appearances in 2023 leads all returners.
- Vanderbilt will also look to Sam Hliboki, Greysen Carter and Bryce Cunningham for roles on the pitching staff this season. The trio combined for 50 appearances in 2023.

Experience in the Infield: Vanderbilt has plenty of experience on the left side of the infield.

- Juniors Jonathan Vastine and Davis Diaz both started all 62 games in 2023. Vastine primarily played shortstop while Diaz was at third.
- According to D1Baseball, Vastine ranked 16th in D1 last season among shortstops in defensive runs saved (10.2).
- The duo helped Vanderbilt rank 14th in fielding percentage
 (000) in 2022
- Diaz leads all Vanderbilt returners with 57 RBI last season.
 Vastine was third on the team in hitting (.287).
- Vanderbilt also returns experience behind the plate in catchers Jack Bulger and Alan Espinal, both seniors in 2024. Bulger drove in 30 runs last season and homered five times. Espinal hit .275 with five home runs and 21 RBI.

Immediate Impacts: A pair of Vanderbilt sophomores, RJ Austin and Chris Maldonado, look to build upon their respective freshman campaigns.

- Austin finished his freshman year strong and was named SEC Tournament MVP along with All-Tournament team honors.
- Austin has been recognized for his work off the field as well, being selected to the inaugural Lou Gehrig Community Impact Team which recognizes the giving character and community impact of collegiate baseball players.
- Maldonado led Vanderbilt in hitting (.310) last season. He finished with 12 doubles, eight home runs and 32 RBI.

Unrivaled Consistency: Since head coach Tim Corbin took charge in 2003, no program has enjoyed more consistent success than the Commodores.

- Vanderbilt owns the nation's longest active NCAA Tournament streak at 17 consecutive appearances.
- Vandy has been to the College World Series five times, the finals four times and has won it all twice (2014, 2019).
- More than 50 Commodores have been named All-America, including 18 first-teamers.
- Coach Corbin has tutored more than 30 future MLB players.

2023 SEC Tournament Champions: Vanderbilt defeated Texas A&M, 10-4, in Hoover last season to claim its fourth SEC Tournament title, third under head coach Tim Corbin.

- Vanderbilt went 4-1 at the tournament and outscored its opponents 39-22.
- Then freshman RJ Austin was named tournament MVP after going 7-for-18 at the plate with a home run, two doubles and five RBIs.
- Fellow freshman Chris Maldonado also had a strong performance, going 7-for-10 with four RBIs in three games.
- The Commodores held opposing hitters to a .215 average while hitting .305 themselves. Thomas Schultz didn't allow a run through 5.2 innings over two appearances.
- Vandy tallied wins over three 2023 NCAA Regional hosts (Auburn, Alabama, Florida) en route to the championship.

 $\mbox{No-No Notes:}$ Vanderbilt's four no-hitters since 2019 is most in NCAA DI.

- Greysen Carter, Sam Hliboki, Ryan Ginther and Nick Maldonado combined for a no-hitter March 5, 2023 at Minnesota.
- Hliboki went 3.2 innings with eight strikeouts and earned the win.
- Vanderbilt was the only team to have a no-hitter in each of the last three seasons and each of the last four full seasons.
- All four of Vanderbilt's no-hitters since 2019 have come against Power 5 opponents.

Dores in the Draft: Vanderbilt continued its production of firstround draft picks with the Enrique Bradfield Jr. selection in the 2032 MLB Draft.

- Bradfield was taken 17th overall by the Baltimore Orioles making him the 28th Commodore taken in the first round.
- Vandy has had at least one first-round pick in nine of the past 10 years.
- Vanderbilt's 22 first-round selections in the Tim Corbin Era (2003pres.) is most in the SEC.

Dores in the Pros: More than 40 former Commodores competed for MLB and MiLB teams during the 2023 professional baseball season.

- Around the MLB, 14 former Commodores spent time on MLB rosters (including on IL).
- Sonny Gray put together a historic season for the Minnesota Twins en route to the team's ninth AL Central title. Gray finished the regular season with a 2.79 ERA, second-best among qualified pitchers in the AL. Gray signed a three-year deal worth \$75 million with the St. Louis Cardinals in the offseason.
- Bryan Reynolds led the Pittsburgh Pirates with 84 RBI this season. His 31 doubles were tied for the team lead and he ranked second on the club with 24 homers
- In his first season with the Cubs, Dansby Swanson finished the year with 22 homers while totaling 80 RBI, third-most on the team. Swanson proved to be one of the top shortstops defensively yet again, finishing with 14 total zone runs, tied for most among National League shortstops.
- Tony Kemp was recognized by the Oakland Athletics as their nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award, bestowed annually to the player who best represents the game of Baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field.
- Spencer Jones finished the 2023 season as the top-ranked New York Yankees prospect and the No. 73 prospect overall. Jones hit .267 with 16 homers and 66 RBIs across 117 games in High-A and Double-AA. Jones also stole 43 bases on 55 attempts.

Upgrades to the Hawk: Vanderbilt revealed artistic renderings for major enhancements to Hawkins Field, home of Vanderbilt baseball and the two-time national champion VandyBoys. A cornerstone of Vandy United's recently announced Dare to Grow phase, the Hawkins Field initiative creates extensive premium seating opportunities, expands capacity and reimagines the game day experience for supporters of one of college baseball's most successful programs.

- Second grandstand level: A new deck of seats above the existing grandstand, part of raising capacity by more than 10 percent, will feature exclusive operastyle boxes that put fans on top of the action. A second pillared concourse creates a coliseum effect for the exterior façade along the multi-use greenway developed in Vandy United's initial phase.
- Multiple innovative club spaces, including left-field wall and behindthe-plate seating: A completely new addition to Hawkins Field, club spaces give supporters unique ways to enjoy the game. Spaces include seating atop the iconic left-field wall and a partially submerged behind-the-plate vantage point in the main grandstand.
- Multiple private suite opportunities: Also all-new at Hawkins Field, private suites will form a new third level above the existing press box and offer the ultimate group experience.
- 360-degree stadium experience: Fans will be able walk between infield and outfield seating areas without leaving the facility, further enhancing the atmosphere.
- Hawkins Field entry atrium: An instantly Instagrammable spot for all VandyBoys fans, a new entry atrium beyond right field offers a place to meet before climbing the stairs to soak in the unforgettable view of the field.
- Multi-purpose building: A new 20,000-square-foot building beyond right field provides space for enhancing both the fan and student-athlete experience.
