TIGERS OPEN SEC SEASON AGAINST VANDERBILT

University of Missouri football looks to extend the nation's longest FBS win streak Saturday when the Tigers host the Vanderbilt Commodores to open Southeastern Conference play on Faurot Field at Memorial Stadium. Winners of their last seven contests, the Tigers (3-0) enter the conference season ranked No. 7 in this week's *Associated Press* Top 25 Poll. Saturday's game kicks off at 3:15 p.m. CT and airs on SEC Network and the Tiger Radio Network.

THE SERIES

The Tigers and Commodores will square off to open the SEC season for the second-straight year. Mizzou, which holds an 11-4-1 overall series advantage against Vanderbilt, has defeated the Commodores in each of the last four matchups. MU has claimed five-straight home meetings against VU, which posted its last win in Columbia in 2012.

THE COACHES

ELIAH DRINKWITZ is in his fifth season as Mizzou's head coach and enters Saturday's game with a 31-21 mark (43-22 overall). The Alma, Arkansas, native has led the Tigers to bowl bids in each of his first four seasons, joining the late **Warren Powers** as the only two MU head coaches to achieve that feat. Only Powers (31) and **Dan Devine** (29) totaled more victories than Drinkwitz in their first four seasons at MU. Prior to taking the Mizzou job, Drinkwitz was 12-1 as the head coach at Appalachian State in 2019.

CLARK LEA brings an 11-28 overall record as Vanderbilt's head coach into Saturday's game. Now in his fourth season leading his alma mater, Lea returned to Nashville in 2021 after a three-year stint as defensive coordinator at Notre Dame. A former fullback during his two-year playing career at VU, the Nashville native earned undergraduate and graduate degrees from Vandy.

FIRST AND TEN - STORYLINES

- Missouri concluded its sixth-consecutive unblemished home non-conference slate with its win over No. 24 Boston College last Saturday to eclipse a program record with its 19th straight home non-conference victory.
- The Tigers' current seven-game win streak, dating back to Nov. 11, 2023, is the longest in the nation (NCAA FBS); it also matches Missouri's lengthiest streak since 2013 and is tied for the third-longest in program history.
- Mizzou's defense ranks fourth in the nation in total defense (184.0 ypg) and has limited each of its last five opponents to 300 yards of total offense or fewer (since Nov. 24, 2023).
- The Tigers' offense has converted each of its 15 trips to the red zone into points this season and 71-of-73 trips since the start of the 2023 season.
- Missouri has yet to allow any points in the third quarter and the Tigers have permitted only seven points in the second half this season; MU's 'Death Row Defense' joins Ole Miss as the only two SEC teams to permit seven points or less in the second half.
- QB **Brady Cook** (7,198) became just the second Mizzou quarterback to record both 7,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards, joining **Brad Smith** on that elite list with last Saturday's performance vs. Boston College.
- Cook moved into a pair of career top five lists with his 264-yard performance against the Eagles, shifting into fourth in passing yards and tied for fifth in passing TDs (40).
- With his 23-7 record on Faurot Field, **Eliah Drinkwitz** has compiled the best home winning percentage (.767) among all Mizzou football coaches with at least four years at the helm.
- MU is riding a string of 15 consecutive weeks ranked in the *Associated Press* Top 25 Poll, marking its longest since streak in a decade.
- Mizzou enters Saturday's game with a 73-25 mark at home when ranked in the *Associated Press* poll (139-76-1 overall as a ranked team).

CREDENTIALS

Credentials issued by Mizzou Athletics are required to cover all regular-season events that take place on the University of Missouri campus, or an event in which Mizzou has been assigned to distribute credentials.

Credentials are provided to working members of the media to assist in the coverage of Mizzou Athletics events. Credentials do not imply any guarantee to access. Credentials are limited to single-event or single-season duration. Credentials are not transferable and are revocable and must be worn at all times within Memorial Stadium.

Loaning or transferring credentials to another person may result in immediate permanent revocation of media credentials and ejection from the event of the original holder and unauthorized holder of the credentials. Failure to adhere to the requirements of this policy may result in revocation of credentials for the representative and their outlet. All credentials are subject to space availability restrictions in working media areas at various facilities. Media credentials should be requested by Tuesday of game week via Sports Systems' online SEC portal (sportssystem.com/clients/seccredentials).

MEDIA PARKING

Media parking is located at Tiger Avenue Parking Structure (TAPS), at the corner of Tiger Avenue and Hospital Drive. The main entrance is on the east side of the building. All parking passes are digital and distributed via email. Parking requests are available through the same online request system for single-game and season credentials.

MEDIA WILL CALL

Game day media will call is located at Gate 5W, on the west side of Memorial Stadium. Home game credentials can typically be picked up on Fridays at the south entrance of Mizzou Arena. Contact **Jessica Crusan** to arrange for pickup prior to game days.

PRESS BOX

The Memorial Stadium / Faurot Field press box is located on the sixth floor of the west side of the stadium. On game days, the facility opens to the working media three hours prior to kickoff. The space is accessible using the elevator at Gate 5W. Mizzou Athletics will provide a meal, drinks and snacks during the game.

POSTGAME

Postgame interviews with Mizzou head coach **Elijah Drinkwitz** and select student-athletes will be held in SEZ Defensive Meeting Room following a brief cooling-off period. Unauthorized in-game and postgame interviews on the field are prohibited. Visiting team post-game media availability is subject to the direction of the visiting communications staff. The visiting team's postgame interview room is located in the southeast tunnel (labeled Q20), across from the visiting locker room.

MOBILE APP

The Mizzou Tigers app for iPhone, iPad and Android devices offers fans a wide variety of information on the Tigers. The free app is available in the App Store and Google Play and required to receive MU digital parking.

TIGER TALK RADIO SHOW

The hour-long program airs weekly through the season from Bud's Classic BBQ in Columbia. Shows run from 7-8 p.m. CT on Tuesdays. Hosted by Mike Kelly, fans can listen to the show via KTGR 105.1 FM/KTGR 1580 AM, or watch via the Mizzou Athletics' Facebook page.

WEEKLY PRESS CONFERENCE

Head Coach **Elijah Drinkwitz** will be available to the media every Tuesday during the season, with the exception of MU's bye week. Drinkwitz's press conferences will take place in the SEZ Defensive Meeting Room on the second level of the building. Players will be made available immediately following Coach Drinkwitz's press conference. Please make any player requests through **Eric Doennig** before 10 a.m. (CT) on Mondays.

LAST TIME OUT - BOSTON COLLEGE

- Mizzou scored 24 consecutive points to rally from an 11-point deficit for a 27-21 win against No. 24 Boston College in front of a sold-out crowd on Faurot Field.
- With their third-straight victory to open the 2024 season, the Tigers have recorded seven consecutive wins overall, marking the nation's longest winning streak.
- The Eagles held a 14-3 edge with just under 10 minutes remaining in the opening half until the Tigers scored the final 14 points of the frame to take a three-point advantage into the break.
- K **Blake Craig** pulled Mizzou within eight following his 38-yard field goal before WR **Luther Burden III** scored on a 19-yard catch and run with the ensuing two-point conversion squaring the contest at 14.
- Craig then recorded a career-long 56-yard field goal as time expired to hand the home side the 17-14 advantage at the half.
- Mizzou added to its lead early in the third quarter when QB **Brady Cook** scored on a six-yard rush to extend the Tigers' edge to 24-14. It remained a 10-point lead until 5:58 left to play, when Craig registered his fourth field goal of the day to stretch the lead to 13.
- The Missouri defense limited Boston College to just 17 offensive yards during the third quarter, including minus-nine rushing yards, to keep the visitors at bay.
- MU also took advantage of Boston College turnovers, turning a pair of interceptions into 10 points.
- Cook completed 21-of-30 passes for 264 yards with one touchdown, while Burden finished the game with six receptions for a season-best 117 yards, RB **Nate Noel** posted his first 100-yard rushing game as a Tiger with 121 yards on 22 carries.

TIGERS AND 'DORES, BY THE NUMBERS

- Vanderbilt will be making its 10th visit to Columbia Saturday, looking to stop a five-game slide at Faurot Field.
- MU holds a 6-2-1 advantage over the Commodores in those 10 meetings, as well as an 11-4-1 overall edge in a series that dates back to 1895.
- Since Missouri joined the SEC in 2012, the Tigers have won nine of their 12 meetings with Vanderbilt, including each of the last four (since 2020).
- In three previous games vs. Vandy, QB **Brady Cook** has completed 54-of-70 pass attempts for 668 yards and six touchdowns.
- WR **Luther Burden III** has been a thorn in the Commodores' side as well, logging 15 receptions for 206 yards and three TDs, in addition to rushing for a touchdown and registering 46 yards on two punt returns in his two career games vs. Vandy.
- Mizzou is 9-0 vs. Vanderbilt when scoring 24 points or more.

MIZZOU IN SEC OPENERS

- Saturday's contest marks the start of Southeastern Conference play for the Tigers, who have gone 4-8 in league openers since joining the conference in 2012.
- The Tigers and Commodores will open the conference season for the second consecutive year, following MU's 38-21 win in Nashville (Sept. 30) to kick off the 2023 SEC campaign.
- QB **Brady Cook** completed a career-high 33 passes for 395 yards and four touchdowns last fall vs. Vandy, connecting with the duo of **Luther Burden III** (11 rec.) and **Theo Wease Jr.** (10) a total of 21 times (3 TDs) in the victory.
- Mizzou will be looking to go 3-0 vs. VU in SEC openers; the Tigers also claimed a 51-28 road victory over Vanderbilt in 2013.

TIGERS IN THE POLLS

- On the heels of its victory over No. 24 Boston College and its second straight 3-0 start, Missouri dropped one spot to No. 7 in this week's *Associate Press* poll.
- The Tigers remained at No. 8 in The *USA Today Coaches* Poll this week.
- Mizzou has been ranked among the *Associated Press'* top 25 teams in 15 straight releases of the poll, dating back to Sept. 24, 2023, marking its second-longest such streak.
- The Tigers were ranked in 30 consecutive *Associated Press* polls from Sept. 16, 2007 through the final 2008 poll on Jan. 8, 2009.
- For the first time since 2015, the Tigers entered the season ranked among the nation's top 25 squads, checking in at No. 11 in both the *Associated Press* and *USA Today Coaches* preseason polls.
- Missouri's preseason position in the rankings represented its best since the 2008 season, when the Tigers were tabbed No. 6 in the *Associated Press* preseason poll.
- This week mark's the 270th week the Tigers have been ranked by the *Associated Press* since their first appearance in the poll in 1939.

BLAKE THE MAKE

- K **Blake Craig** turned in yet another strong performance Saturday vs. No. 24 Boston College, converting 4-of-4 field goal attempts to help lift the Tigers to victory and earn SEC Special Teams Player of the Week.
- The redshirt freshman from Kansas City drilled kicks from 31, 38 (twice) and 56 yards, and successfully booted his lone PAT attempt to remain perfect (12-for-12) on the season.
- Craig's 56-yarder as time expired in the first half marked the longest field goal ever kicked by a Missouri freshman, surpassing **Harrison Mevis'** 52-yarder vs. LSU in 2020.
- The kick also tied for the fourth-longest in program history (sharing the distinction with a pair of Mevis 56-yard kicks).

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

- Missouri enters Saturday's game on a roll, bringing a string of seven consecutive victories into its SEC opener.
- The streak, which dates back to the Tigers' Nov. 11, 2023 win over Tennessee, represents the nation's longest (NCAA FBS).
- MU's seven-straight wins is the Tigers' longest win streak since 2013 and matches six other seven-game streaks for the third-longest in Mizzou history.
- With a victory Saturday, the Tigers would equal an eight-game win streak by Mizzou's 1941 Sugar Bowl

team for the second-lengthiest in school history (Oct. 4 through Nov. 22).

- MU's longest win streak came during the 1960-61 seasons, when the Tigers logged 13-straight wins (Sept. 17, 1960 through Sept. 30, 1961; that streak officially includes MU's 1960 forfeit victory over Kansas, which used an ineligible player during its 23-7 win that stopped the Tigers' nine-game win streak, which would still represent Mizzou's all-time longest win streak, excluding the forfeit.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS...

- In addition to its seven-game win streak, Missouri enters conference play on a roll in several statistical categories.
- Mizzou has won three-consecutive top 25 matchups after Saturday's win over No. 24 Boston College; the Tigers also knocked off No. 7 Ohio State in the Cotton Bowl (Dec. 29, 2023) and No. 13 Tennessee (Nov. 11, 2023).
- The Tigers have held five-straight opponents under the 300-yard mark for total offense (since Nov. 24, 2023 at Arkansas).
- Mizzou's defense has not permitted a 100-yard rusher in any of its last nine games (since Oct. 14, 2023 at Kentucky).
- WR **Luther Burden III** recorded a season-high six receptions for 117 yards in last week's win over Boston College, giving the junior at least one catch in 25 consecutive games (dating back to Oct. 1, 2022); **Chase Coffman** (2005-08) holds the Mizzou record with at least one reception in 45-straight games.
- Burden III has also reached the end zone in four-straight games and moved into a tie with **Dorial Green-Beckham** for the No. 8 spot on the Tigers' career TD reception list with 17.
- QB **Brady Cook** has recorded a rushing touchdown in six-straight regular-season games (since Nov. 11, 2023).

FEROCIOUS ON FAUROT FIELD

- Missouri has owned its home turf in recent years against non-conference competition, winning each of its last 19 non-SEC games on Faurot Field, dating back to an Oct. 21, 2017 victory over Idaho (68-21).
- MU eclipsed the program record for consecutive non-conference home wins with Saturday's victory over Boston College.
- The Tigers previously posted an 18-game streak from Sept. 17, 2005 through Nov. 17, 2012.
- Under Head Coach **Elijah Drinkwitz**, Mizzou has gone 23-7 in five seasons on Faurot, giving the Tigers' sideline boss the best home winning percentage in the history of the program (through at least four seasons).

- Mizzou brings a 327-195-19 all-time record at Memorial Stadium into Saturday's game.

COOKIN' UP A WINNER

- QB **Brady Cook** opened the 2024 season with three-straight 200-yard passing performances, marking the 20th, 21st and 22nd 200-yard games of his career.
- He enters Saturday's game with nine-straight 200-yard passing efforts on Faurot Field (dating back to Sept. 16, 2023 vs. Kansas State).
- He trails only **Chase Daniel** (38) and **Drew Lock** (34) on the Tigers' career leaderboard for 200-yard games.
- On Sept. 7 vs. Buffalo, Cook (8,274) became just the fifth Mizzou QB to top the 8,000-yard mark for total offense, logging a season-high 290 total yards.
- Cook has also rushed for at least one score in each of the Tigers' first three games of the season, stretching his personal streak of at least one rushing TD to six-straight regular-season games (since Nov. 11, 2023).
- The St. Louis native topped the 1,000-yard rushing milestone in the 2024 season opener, becoming just the sixth MU quarterback to do so; he became just the second QB in program history to pass for 7,000 yards and rush for 1,000 (joining **Brad Smith**).
- With Saturday's performance vs. Boston College, Cook moved past **James Franklin** on MU's all-time list of career games with at least one passing and one rushing TD (13 games), trailing just **Corby Jones** and **Brad Smith**, who each tallied 14 such games.
- With Saturday's performance, he moved from sixth to fourth on MU's all-time passing yards list (7,198), eclipsing **Jeff Handy** (6,959) and Franklin (6,962); Cook also moved into a tie for fifth on the Tigers' career TD passes chart with his 19-yard toss to **Luther Burden III**, marking the 16th time the duo has hooked up on a scoring pass.
- Additionally, Cook's 2023 passing efficiency rating (157.18) ranked as the third-best season mark in program history, while his career rating (144.55) is second on the Tigers' all-time chart.

HE IS HIM

- WR **Luther Burden III** notched his name in the Mizzou annals with a standout 2023 campaign that earned the St. Louis product second-team *Associated Press* All-America honors.
- A 2024 Preseason *Associated Press* First-Team All-America pick, Biletnikoff and Maxwell Award candidate, Burden leads a deep and talented wide receiver corps that returns its top five performers from a year ago.
- Last fall, Burden became just the eighth Tiger in program history — and the first since **J'Mon Moore** in 2017 — to eclipse the 1,000-yard mark for receiving yardage in a season.
- Burden, who has recorded at least one catch in 25 consecutive games (since Oct. 1, 2022), logged six 100-yard receiving games in 2023.
- His 1,212 yards for the year ranked third all-time in a season and his total of 86 receptions ranked fifth on the Tigers' single-season chart.
- Burden turned in a noteworthy start to the 2023 season, logging five consecutive 100-yard receiving performances (Sept. 9-Oct. 7).
- The only Missouri receiver to previously exceed that feat was **Danario Alexander**, who recorded six-straight 100-yard performances in 2009.
- Burden III registered a season-best 117 receiving yards in Saturday's win over Boston College.

STARTING STRONG

- Mizzou's 3-0 start to the season is its second in a row under head coach Eliah Drinkwitz.
- The Tigers kicked off the 2023 campaign with five-straight wins en route to their fifth 11-win season.
- Since 1980, the Tigers have gone on to record at least eight victories 12 times (in 13 total seasons) after starting 3-0.
- Since 2007, Mizzou has posted at least 10 wins in five of the six seasons in which it started with four-straight wins (2007, 2008, 2010, 2013 and 2023).

IN THE ZONE

- Mizzou has been nearly unstoppable in the red zone, converting each of its 15 trips inside of the opposition's 20-yard line into points this season.
- The Tigers have found the end zone on 11 of those possessions overall (73%).
- K **Blake Craig** has successfully booted each of his three red zone FG attempts (from 22, 27 and 31).
- The Tigers red zone offense was one of the nation's best in 2023, putting points on the board in 56-of-58 (96.6%) trips inside the 20-yard line to rank third among all FBS offenses.
- MU converted 36 red zone TDs, while **Harrison Mevis** booted 20 red zone FGs to rank second among all FBS kickers.

TOP O' THE HEAP

- Missouri's quick start to the 2024 campaign has included balanced contributions from all phases of the Tigers' attack.
- Mizzou's offense ranks among the nation's leaders in the following categories entering Saturday's game:

IF YOU BUILD IT, THEY WILL COME

- The University of Missouri Board of Curators unanimously approved the \$250 million Memorial Stadium Improvements Project during its Sept. 12 board meeting, authorizing a transformative renovation of the home facility for Mizzou's football program.
- The project is scheduled for completion in 2026 to coincide with the stadium's 100th anniversary and will elevate the fan experience and solidify Mizzou's competitive standing in the Southeastern Conference.
- The Mizzou faithful have made such plans possible with a stretch of unwavering support, including a current string of eight consecutive sold-out games, dating back to Sept. 15, 2023 vs. Kansas State.
- Mizzou drew 421,184 fans through the Memorial Stadium turnstiles last fall, marking the Tigers' fifth-best single-season mark ever and MU's top season total since drawing 456,996 fans in 2014.
- Attendance rose 10.4-percent from 2022 (381,677) and 29.4-percent from 2021 (325,614).
- The Tigers have kicked off the 2024 campaign with three-consecutive sellout-crowds of 62,621 fans.
- Mizzou's current sellout streak marks the program's longest since 1979, when the Tigers completed a 10-game string of capacity crowds.

PUTTING THE 'D' IN DOMINATE

- Mizzou's dominant start to the season included a string of eight-straight scoreless quarters by its defense, marking the first back-to-back season-opening shutouts by the Tigers since blanking William Jewell (39-0) and Central Missouri (7-0) to kick off **Don Faurot's** debut season as head coach in 1935.
- MU's 'Death Row Defense' extended a shutdown streak started by the 2023 Tigers that ultimately stretched to 175 minutes and 41 seconds of scoreless clock time.
- The Tigers did not yield a touchdown in three straight contests vs. Ohio State, Murray State and Buffalo in a streak spanning more than 193 minutes (dating back to Nov. 24, 2023 at Arkansas).
- Against Murray State (Aug. 29), Mizzou allowed just 27 yards passing (7-of-15), marking the fewest yards by an opponent since 2011 vs. Western Illinois (20 yards).

- MU's defense ranks among the nation's best in total defense (4th), first downs allowed (6th), passing yards allowed (7th), scoring defense (9th), interceptions (15th), rushing defense (19th) and turnover margin (23rd).
- Thanks in large part to the Tigers' dominant defensive start to the season, Mizzou also logged the largest opening two-game scoring margin in program history:

I AM THE CAPTAIN NOW

- Mizzou selected five permanent captains to lead the Tigers throughout the 2024 season.
- The group includes four players making their debuts in the role: WR **Theo Wease Jr.**, LB **Chuck Hicks**, DL **Kristian Williams** and DL **Johnny Walker Jr.** will lead MU on the field for the first time in 2024.
- QB **Brady Cook** was selected as a co-captain for the third consecutive year, making the Maxwell Award candidate just the fifth three-time Tiger captain in the 134-year history of the program.

- A three-year starter, Cook has the opportunity to become the first quarterback in the history of the Missouri program to start in four consecutive bowl games for the Tigers.

CREATING CHAOS

- One of the pillars on which the Tigers 'Death Row Defense' has been structured is the ability to create havoc on opposing offenses.
- Last year, this was evidenced in Mizzou's 19 takeaways and 0.77 turnover margin, figures that ranked first and second in the SEC, respectively.
- DE **Johnny Walker Jr.** epitomized the disruptive identity of the MU defense in the Tigers' Cotton Bowl victory over No. 7 Ohio State, registering a critical second-quarter strip-sack and 1.5 total TFLs to earn the game's defensive MVP honor.
- Walker recorded 43 tackles for the season, including a team-leading 9.0 QB hurries, 9.5 TFLs and 5.0 sacks.
- LB **Triston Newson** added 7.0 tackles for losses, as well as two fumble recoveries to lead the SEC; Newson and fellow LB **Chuck Hicks** will anchor the Tigers' linebacker corps after combining for 104 tackles a year ago.

WATCH US

- Numerous Tigers are garnering national attention with their selections to preseason watch lists, led by the tandem of WR **Luther Burden III** and QB **Brady Cook** with their inclusion on the initial Maxwell Award list.
- Burden was selected for preseason first-team All-SEC laurels by the conference's head coaches and the media, while OL **Cam'Ron Johnson** and OL **Armand Membou** were third-team picks by the coaches.
- Burden was also tabbed for the Walter Camp Award Watch List in addition to garnering preseason All-America recognition from the *Associated Press*.

A FINE HOW-DO-YOU-DO

- Mizzou improved to 88-42-5 in season openers with its dominant win over Murray State (Aug. 29).
- The Tigers topped the 50-point plateau for the fourth time in their last eight season openers.
- Thirty Tigers saw their first game action in black and gold last week, including six combined offensive and defensive starters: DE **Zion Young**, DT **Chris McClellan**, CB **Toriano Pride** on the defensive side of the ball, and RB **Nate Noel**, LT **Marcus Bryant** and LG **Cayden Green** on offense.
- K **Blake Craig** converted 3-of-3 field goal attempts and 6-of-6 PAT tries in his first start.

- **Pride Jr.**, a junior transfer from Clemson, made an immediate impact in the contest, returning an interception 25 yards for a touchdown to give the Tigers a 21-0 lead less than six minutes into the game.
- Mizzou's three touchdowns in the first 5:19 represents the fastest the Tigers have ever scored 21 points to open a contest, surpassing a Sept. 1, 2012 start vs. Southeastern Louisiana (7:25).
- Additionally, 11 different MU receivers registered a catch — the most in a game by the Tigers since 2021.

WHY STOP NOW?

- Capped by its Cotton Bowl victory over Ohio State, Missouri is coming off a memorable 2023 campaign that saw the Tigers reach the 11-win mark for the fifth time in program history.
- **Elijah Drinkwitz** has qualified for a bowl game in each of his first four seasons at the helm, becoming just the second coach in MU history to accomplish the feat (**Warren Powers**).
- Seven Tigers earned All-SEC honors in 2023, all but one of which (WR **Luther Burden III**) have moved on to the NFL.
- Under the direction of first-year offensive coordinator **Kirby Moore**, the Tigers fashioned one of the most improved offenses in the country last fall, finishing fifth in the SEC and 28th nationally in total offense by producing 434.3 yards per game.
- Mizzou's offense will benefit from the return of signal-caller **Brady Cook**, who's amassed over 3,000 yards of total offense for two years running.
- Burden returns for his junior season, as the preseason *Associated Press* All-America selection looks to build on a strong 2023 season in which he totaled 1,212 receiving yards and nine touchdowns.
- The Tigers' 'Death Row Defense' is led by first-year defensive coordinator **Corey Batoon**, who looks to extend the momentum of a unit that has ranked among the top 35 nationally in total defense for two straight seasons.
- The Tigers defense will be led by a veteran cast that returns nearly 64-percent of the unit's total tackles for losses last fall.
- Last year, Mizzou ranked 25th nationally in scoring defense (29.8 ppg) and 30th in rushing defense (122.8 ypg).
- MU recorded 39.0 sacks for the season to rank 10th among all FBS defenses, thanks in large part to 5.5 sacks by **Johnny Walker Jr.**

PAVING THE PATH

- Missouri's offensive turnaround in 2023 would not have been possible without the standout collective effort of its veteran line.
- This year's O-Line unit returns three starters — **Cam'Ron Johnson**, **Armand Membou** and **Connor Tollison** — with each starting a minimum of 12 games last fall.
- The Tigers' OL unit figures to be one of the most experienced in the nation, with a combined 104 career starts to its credit entering the season.
- Last year, the Tigers averaged 434.3 yards per game, which ranked 28th in the nation.
- All-American **Cody Schrader** led the nation in rushing yards per game (125.2 ypg), totaling a program-record 1,627 yards on the ground.

O-LINE ZOU LIVES

- Mizzou's tradition of producing premium defensive linemen continued with **Darius Robinson's** breakout 2023 campaign, culminating in the Detroit native's first-round selection in April's NFL Draft.
- Robinson recorded a career-high 8.5 sacks to lead the Tigers last fall, marking the top single-season sack total by a Mizzou defender since **Charles Harris** logged 9.0 sacks in 2015.
- Robinson's sack total ranked 20th nationally and fourth in the SEC.
- D-Rob became the program's 10th first-round pick this century and the Tigers' seventh defensive linemen taken in the first round since the 2001 draft.
- Another nine Mizzou defensive linemen have been drafted in later rounds this century:

HEAD COACH ELIAH DRINKWITZ

FIFTH YEAR • ARKANSAS TECH '04

A winner at every stage of his career, **Eliah Drinkwitz** – considered one of college football’s top offensive minds – was introduced as the University of Missouri’s 33rd football head coach in December 2019. The 2024 campaign will mark his fifth running the program and sixth season overall as a head coach.

In his eight seasons as an offensive coordinator and head coach, Drinkwitz, the 2023 Southeastern Conference Coach of the Year, has produced seven 1,000-yard rushers, five 3,000-yard passers and five 1,000-yard receivers. In three years (2015, 2017, 2018), his offenses made at least one in each category. The 2023 Mizzou team featured all three in QB Brady Cook, WR Luther Burden III and RB Cody Schrader, who led the country in rushing.

The 2023 Associated Press SEC Coach of the Year and Bear Bryant Award finalist, Drinkwitz brings a 28-21 record at MU (four seasons) and 40-22 overall mark as a head coach into the 2024 campaign. Under his guidance, the Tigers have earned bowl berths in each of his first four seasons in Columbia, joining Warren Powers (1978, 1979, 1980, 1981) as one of only two MU head coaches to achieve the feat.

Under Drinkwitz’s leadership, Mizzou produced its highest-ranked recruiting classes: 2021 No. 20, 2022 No. 15 (per 247), the No. 1 wide receiver in the 2022 class (Burden), the nation’s top player in the 2024 class (Nwaneri) and three straight Top 25 ranked classes.

The 2023 Tigers put together an 11-2 season that saw MU move into the Top 10 of all three national polls. The double-digit wins campaign was the first since 2014. Mizzou went 6-2 in SEC games, won both the Mayor’s Cup over South Carolina and Battle Line Rivalry over Arkansas and qualified for its first New Year’s Six bowl and defeated Ohio State in the Goodyear Cotton Bowl.

Mizzou’s track record of player development success was on full display at the 2024 NFL Draft, with a Tiger being selected in each of the first five rounds. Darius Robinson became MU’s latest first-round selection, going No. 27 overall to the Cardinals, while Ennis Rakestraw Jr. (2nd-Detroit), Ty’Ron Hopper (3rd-Green Bay), Javon Foster (4th-Jacksonville) and Kris Abrams-Draine (5th-Denver) all heard their names called at the Draft. Additionally, Cody Schrader signed a free-agent contract with San Francisco.

The 2022 season showcased a much-improved defense, ranked fourth in the Southeastern Conference and 34th nationally by allowing just 340.8 yards per game, 93.8 less than in 2021. Freshman phenom Luther Burden III took no time making his mark at the college level. The St. Louis native became the first true freshman since 2008 to record two receiving touchdowns, two rushing touchdowns, and a punt-return touchdown in the same season. Burden III’s eight scores from scrimmage were second amongst SEC true freshmen (Ole Miss’ Quinshon Judkins) and led true freshmen receivers nationally.

The 2021 season saw Tyler Badie set the school’s single-season record for rushing yards (1,604). His 14 touchdowns in 12 games are ninth on Mizzou’s single-season and top-10 list. He was a CoSIDA Academic All-American, the SEC Football Scholar-Athlete of the Year (Mizzou’s first-ever), first-team All-SEC and was named to multiple All-America teams.

Mizzou’s 2021 Armed Forces Bowl vs. Army West Point averaged 2.57 million viewers – up 14% from the 2020 edition of the game (Mississippi State-Tulsa: 2.25M), up 48% from Tulane-Southern Miss in 2019 (1.74M) - and was the most-watched edition of the game since 2018 (Army-Houston: 2.58M). The National Basketball Association’s Warriors-Knicks game, where Steph Curry broke the 3-point record (Dec. 14, 2021), totaled 2.35 million viewers.

In 2020, the Tigers overcame an 0-2 start to win five of their last eight games despite playing with less than 60 scholarship players for over half of those contests. Picked to finish sixth in the SEC East Division by many preseason pundits and projected to win only two or three games at most against the All-SEC schedule, the Tigers’ five SEC wins were their second-most ever behind a pair of 7-1 marks during back-to-back SEC East crowns in 2013 and 2014.

Of the SEC’s four new head coaches to begin work in the nation’s toughest conference in 2020, Drinkwitz’s 5-5 regular-season record was the league’s best, ahead of Ole Miss’ Lane Kiffin (4-5), Mississippi State’s Mike Leach (3-7) and Arkansas’ Sam Pittman (3-7).

Drinkwitz took over the Tigers program following an impressive 2019 season at Appalachian State that saw the 20th-ranked Mountaineers win the Sun Belt Conference title en route to a 12-1 record.

Drinkwitz graduated magna cum laude and was the student body president at Arkansas Tech (bachelor’s, education) before beginning his coaching career at the prep level in his hometown of Alma, Ark., in 2005. He and his wife, Lindsey (Sivils), have four daughters: Addison, Emerson, Ella and Parker Lynn.
