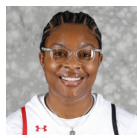

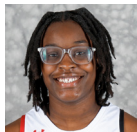

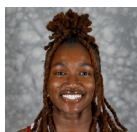

PREVIEW

**CLARKSVILLE, Tenn.** - Austin Peay State University women's basketball hits the road for the first time this season for a 6:30 p.m., Friday game against Vanderbilt at Memorial Gymnasium

The Governors are coming off a 64-52 loss to Bethel, on Nov. 4, at F&M Bank Arena. La'Nya Foster paced the Govs with 14 points, nine rebounds, and four blocks. Briana Rivera made three baskets from beyond the arc, making up her nine points.

Six players made their APSU debut in Monday's game, with Sa'Mya Wyatt and Nariyah Simmons starting for the Govs for the first time.

Vanderbilt most recently defeated fellow Atlantic Sun Conference member, Lipscomb, 102-50, Nov. 4, at Memorial Gymnasium. Khamil Pierre led with 25 points and 14 rebounds, and Mikayla Blakes scored 23 points.

The Commodores are currently receiving votes in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll.

This will be the eighth meeting between the Governors and the Commodores, with the last being a 70-61 Governor loss, Nov. 17, 2022.

Up next, the Govs continue their road game stretch with a 6 p.m., Nov. 15 game at Indiana State.

**The Fast Break**

- Brittany Young is in her fourth season as a head coach and fourth year with the Governors.
- Young made additions to her staff during the off-season in David Lowery, Iesia Walker, Anna Gomez, and Tiya Douglas.
- The Governors' returners are La'Nya Foster, Anala Nelson, Abby Cater, JaNiah Newell, and Jeanine Brandsma. Newell and Brandsma did not see action last season due to injury. Foster, Nelson, and Cater make up 44.0 percent of the Govs' returning points, 37.1 percent of returning rebounds, and 48.5 percent of returning assists.
- Foster returns after being named the Atlantic Sun Conference's Freshman of the Year, making her the first player in program history to be named the ASUN Freshman of the Year and the first Governor to receive Freshman of the Year honors since APSU Hall of Famer Gerlonda Hardin won the Ohio Valley Conference's award for the 2000-01 season.
- Nelson extended her starting streak to 62 consecutive games.
- Nisea Burrell, Jordan Boddie, Nariyah Simmons, and Jenny Ntambwe transferred to Clarksville this season, and Anovia Sheals, Briana Rivera, Rose Azmoudeh, and Sa'Mya Wyatt have begun their college careers with the Governors.
- The Gov's schedule consists of four first-time opponents in Manhattan, Florida Atlantic, High Point, and the ASUN's newest member, West Georgia.
- The Governors were picked fifth and sixth in the preseason coaches and media poll, respectively.
- La'Nya Foster is the Governor's returning rebound leader with 177 boards in 33 games.
- Anala Nelson is the returning assist leader with 136 in 33 games, which ranks second in the ASUN conference and 89th in Division I. Her 4.1 assists per game rank third in the ASUN and 97th in division I.
- Nelson's 43 steals paced the Govs last season.

**Scouting the Commodores**

- Won their season opener 102-50 against Lipscomb, Nov. 4
- Head Coach Shea Ralph is in her fourth season leading the program and is 52-48 in her time at Vanderbilt.
- The Commodores' 2023-24 season ended with an 80-63 loss to Baylor in the first round of the NCAA tournament, March 22.
- The Commodores are currently receiving votes in the Associated Press Top 25 Poll.

GOVS NOTES

**BRITT'S FOURTH YEAR**

Head Coach Brittany Young is in her fourth year at the helm of Austin Peay women's basketball. Young's 54 wins in her first three seasons are the most by a head coach over their first three years. Young has also won a postseason game in each season she has been with the Governors.

**NEW STAFF, WHO DIS**

Brittany Young added four new members to her staff this season: David Lowery joins as the associate head coach, Ieasia Walker as an assistant coach and Director of sport performance, Anna Gomez as the director of operations, and former Governor Tiya Douglas as a graduate assistant. Lowery comes to Clarksville with over 20 years of college coaching experience and made four NCAA tournament appearances, five WNITs, and coached 30 All-Conference players across the SoCon, A-10, SEC, and Atlantic Sun. He has coached three ASUN Conference Newcomers of the Year and made two ASUN Semifinal appearances. Walker played collegiately under head coach Dawn Staley at South Carolina where she was named the 2012-13 Southeastern Conference Defensive Player of the Year. She has served as a strength and conditioning coach for Tuskegee, Auburn, and Howard and spent time in the NBA referee development program. Gomez served as a student manager for Vanderbilt women's basketball for four seasons and was the head student manager. She most recently served as Vanderbilt's graduate assistant. No stranger to Austin Peay, Douglas joins the staff after playing two seasons for the Governors. She played in 60 games, making 59 starts and lead the 2022-23 team with 37 three pointers.

**THE GOVS ARE BACK**

La'Nya Foster, Anala Nelson, Abby Cater, JaNiah Newell, and Jeanine Brandsma are the Governors returners. Newell and Brandsma did not see action last season due to injury. Foster, Nelson, and Cater make up 44.0 percent of the Gobs' returning points, 37.1 percent of returning rebounds, and 48.5 percent of returning assists.



**HAYWOOD EARNS FIRST ASUN CONFERENCE HONOR**

La'Nya Foster was the first player in program history to be named the ASUN Freshman of the Year and is the first Governor to receive freshman of the year honors since APSU Hall of Famer Gerlonda Hardin won the Ohio Valley Conference's award for the 2000-01 season.

**THE NEW GOVS**

The 2024-25 roster consists of five transfers and four freshmen. Nisea Burrell, Jordan Boddie, Jenny Ntambwe, and Nariyah Simmons bring in junior and four year college experience while Anovia Sheals, Briana Rivera, Rose Azmoudeh, and Sa'Mya Wyatt have begun their college careers with the Gobs.

**GOVS TAKE DOWN KENTUCKY**

The Governors defeated Kentucky on Nov. 14, 68-63, for their fourth all-time win against an SEC opponent and first since a 71-66, Dec. 16, 1997 win at Georgia. Anala Nelson's career-high 21 points paced the Gobs as they outscored the Wildcats. This was the first Power Five win for APSU under coach Brittany Young.

**FIRST WIN AT THE NEW HOME**

Austin Peay women's basketball picked up its first win at the new F&M Bank Arena in a 72-64 victory against Fisk, Dec. 14. The Gobs are 8-9 all-time on Gary Mathews Court at F&M Bank Arena.

**ASUN RANKINGS**

The Gobs lead the ASUN with 6.0 blocks per game, which ranks them 40th in Division I. Their 34.0 field-goal percentage defense is second in the ASUN and 93 nationally. Individually, La'Nya Foster is first in the ASUN with 4 total blocks and 4.00 blocks per game. She also leads with 7 free throw attempts. Her 9.0 rebounds per game rank her third in the conference. Jenny Ntambwe and Sa'Mya Wyatt are third in the conference with 1.0 blocks per game. Briana Rivera is fifth with 3.00 three pointers per game and 11 three point attempts. Her 3 three pointers rank ninth in the conference.

**GOVS IN THE POLLS**

The Gobs were picked to finish fifth in the Atlantic Sun Coaches' Poll with 90 points. They are in a tie for fifth with Jacksonville. FGCU, last year's regular season and tournament champion, was selected to repeat by the league's coaches with 144 points, followed by Central Arkansas (128 points) and Lipscomb (110 points).

This season also brings the first meeting of Austin Peay and High Point and the newest member of the ASUN, West Georgia.

**OVER 70, UNDER 60**

Under the leadership of Young, the Govs are 27-4 when scoring at least 70 points. The Govs are 37-10 when allowing opponents 60 or less points.

**ANALA'S STARTING STREAK**

Anala Nelson extended her starting streak to 62 straight games with her start against Bethel, Nov. 1. The junior has been a part of the starting five in each game she has played in her three year career.

**SMARTY GOVS**

The Govs posted a 3.59 GPA for the spring 2023 semester which is the second-best team GPA in program history. Seven Govs were on the Athletic Director's Honor Roll (3.0-3.499 GPA) and four Govs were apart of the Dean's List (undergraduates with 12 hours earned and at least a 3.50 GPA).

**CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'**

Austin Peay takes off to Berkley, California for a Dec. 15 game against California. This is the second time the Govs have been to California in program history, with the first and only being a 70-69 loss to Cal Poly, Nov. 26, 2011, in San Luis Obispo.

**MAINLAND HS PREPPED**

Anovia Sheals and Jordan Boddie are new to the Governors roster, but this is not the first time they have been teammates. Sheals and Boddie prepped at Mainland High School in Daytona Beach, Florida. The two were on the 2022-23 FHSAA 5A State Championship team.



**THE FRESH GOVS OF CLARKSVILLE**

This year's roster consists of four freshmen in Anovia Sheals, Sa'Mya Wyatt, Briana Rivera and Rose Azmoudeh. This matches the largest freshmen class in Brittany Young's four years at the helm of the program, with the 2020-21 season also including four freshmen.

Brittany Young enters her fourth year as the Austin Peay State University head women's basketball coach after being named the 12th head coach in program history, March 19, 2021.

Young became the first head coach in program history to lead the Governors to back-to-back conference tournament semifinal appearances to begin their APSU career and her 37 wins are the most by a head coach in their first two seasons.

During the 2022-23 season, Young coached one of the nation's best defensive unites, as the Governors finished top 25 in Division I in scoring defensive and three-point percentage. The Gobs also have earned eight postseason honors with Young at the helm, including five last season which was highlighted by Shamarre Hale being tabbed Second Team All-ASUN, and to the ASUN Women's Basketball Championship All-Tournament Team.

She led Austin Peay to a 20-13 overall record and 11-7 mark in Ohio Valley Conference play in her first year as a head coach. Young was the fourth coach in program history to lead Austin Peay to a 20-win season and just the second coach to win 20 games in their debut season, joining Andy Blackston (2003-04).

Young earned her first-career win in a 78-49 victory against Pikeville Nov. 12, 2021, in the Winfield Dunn Center. Later in her inaugural season, she led APSU to its first OVC Tournament victory since 2012 following a 67-52 win against Tennessee State, joining Blackston as the second coach in program history to win their tournament debut.

After leading Austin Peay to the semifinals of the OVC Tournament, Young led the Governors to their first postseason victory in program history in a 73-59 win against Furman in the Women's Basketball Invitational, March 19, 2022.

Young took over the Austin Peay women's basketball program after a season as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Mississippi State. In her season with the Bulldogs, she helped sign KN'isha Godfrey, a four-star rated recruit by espnW and the No. 8 point guard in the country to aid the program's rebuilding process.

When Mississippi State head coach Nikki McCray-Penson moved to Starkville after three seasons at Old Dominion, Young joined her. The pair led a successful three-season turn at Old Dominion where they helped the program reach its first postseason appearance since 2015 amidst back-to-back 20-win campaigns.

In Young's second year in Norfolk, Old Dominion boasted the seventh-youngest roster in the country after signing nine athletes during their first season. Despite the youth movement, the Monarchs posted a 13-win improvement from an 8-23 season to a 21-11 record in 2018-19. The following season, ODU rolled to a 24-6 record and finished second in Conference USA. The Monarchs were a potential at-large team before the Conference USA and NCAA Tournaments were canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before joining McCray-Penson the past four seasons, Young spent two seasons as assistant coach at Stetson. She helped the Hatters back-to-back 20-win campaigns: a 20-12 mark in 2015-16 and a 26-7 record in 2016-17 that included a 13-1 conference record to win the Atlantic Sun regular-season title. Stetson qualified for national postseason play each season, participating in the 2016 Women's Basketball Invitational and the 2017 Postseason WNIT.

Young's first full-time coaching position was at Daytona State College (2013-15). She was the program's recruiting coordinator, director of player development, director of operations, academic coordinator, and strength and conditioning liaison. Young, a Moncks Corner, South Carolina native, was a CoSIDA Academic All-District and all-conference performer at Francis Marion University. She was a member of the school's all-decade team and earned team "Most Valuable Player" honors twice.

In addition to her success on the court, Young was President of the Student Athletic Advisory Council and was just one of 26 recipients of the NCAA Ethnic Minority and Women's Enhancement Postgraduate Scholarship for Careers in Athletics in 2011. She graduated from Francis Marion in 2008 with a degree in Political Science.
