- Drake men's basketball is the reigning back-to-back Missouri Valley Conference Tournament champions
- The Bulldogs have earned trips to the NCAA Tournament in consecutive years (2023-24, 2022-23)
- Drake has seven NCAA Tournament appearances all-time: 1969, 1970, 1971, 2008, 2021, 2023, 2024.
- Drake earned its 24th straight home victory (dating back to 2023) which is the tied for the longest active streak in NCAA Division I basketball — Houston (24)— after defeating FGCU on Nov. 16.
- After playing just three games in the first three weeks of the college basketball season, Drake will face a tall task playing three games in four days at the Shriners Children's Charleston Classic.
- The opening round win over Miami was Drake's first victory over an Atlantic Coast Conference team since beating Wake Forest, 77-74, Nov. 17, 2017, in Lynchburg, Va.
- It was also Drake's first victory over a Power Four Conference school since beating Mississippi State, 58-52, Dec. 20, 2022, in Lincoln, Neb.
- This marked the third time in the last five years, Drake has won its first five games to start the season: 2022-23 (6-0 start) and 2020-21 (18-0 start).
- This marks the fourth time since 2018 that Drake has advanced to the championship of an early season tournament. The Bulldogs captured the 2018 Continental Tires Las Vegas Classic beating SIU Edwardsville (79-66), Rider (76-58), and New Mexico State (66-63) before stopping San Diego, 110-103, in two overtimes to capture the championship. The Bulldogs claimed the 2020 Little Apple Classic in Manhattan, Kan. with victories against South Dakota and Kansas State. The Bulldogs won the 2022 Paradise Jam championship in the Virgin Islands, beating Buffalo (80-72) and Wyoming (61-56) before toppling Tarleton State (71-64) in the championship.
- The series with Vanderbilt is also tied at 1-1 with Commodores winning the last meeting between the teams, 72-57 in the championship of the 2008 Cancun Challenge. Drake earned a 47-46 victory in the inaugural meeting between the schools Dec. 29, 1948 in the Drake Fieldhouse

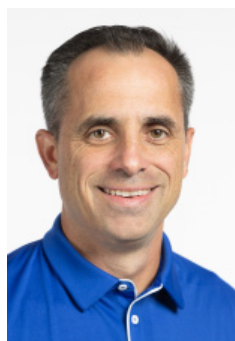

DRAKE HEAD COACH BEN MCCOLLUM

Ben McCollum, architect to the most successful men's college basketball dynasty of the last decade, was named men's basketball head coach at Drake University, Athletics Director Brian Hardin announced on April 1, 2024.

A native of Storm Lake, Iowa, McCollum arrives in Des Moines after spending the past 15 seasons as the head coach at NCAA Division II power Northwest Missouri State University. While in Maryville, he won four national championships (2017, 2019, 2021, 2022) including three tournaments in a row (2020 NCAA Tournament was canceled due to global pandemic).

McCollum amassed a record of 394-91 (81.2 win percentage) at Northwest Missouri State and earned five NABC Division II National Coach of the Year awards, the most for a single coach in Division II history. McCollum also garnered nine Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association (MIAA) Coach of the Year awards and was a 2024 Missouri Sports Hall of Fame inductee.

McCollum's individual accolades were a direct result of the high-level players he recruited and instructed. His Bearcat squads captured a dozen MIAA regular season titles, eight MIAA tournament crowns, and over the past eight seasons has averaged more than 31 wins per year and compiled a record of 253-21 (92.3 win percentage) since 2016.

During McCollum's tenure, the Bearcats' single season win totals were staggering. He led the team to at least 21 wins in each of the last 13 seasons. Five of those years included 30+ wins

highlighted by an undefeated 38-0 campaign in 2018-19. That season marked just the fifth instance in Division II history that a team ran the table through the regular and postseasons.

Individual players flourished under Coach McCollum. He guided dozens of players to All-MIAA status and a handful of others to more specialized recognition. Those individual honors were highlighted by two National Players of the Year, six NABC All-Americans, six MIAA Players of the Year, three MIAA Defensive Players of the Year, and five MIAA All-Freshman selections.

McCollum's storied coaching career began as a graduate assistant at Northwest, his alma mater, from 2003-05. He then was an assistant at Emporia State for four seasons (2005-09) before returning to Maryville and taking over as the Bearcats' head coach.

As a player, McCollum helped lead Northwest Missouri State to a 51-12 record and the program's first-ever Elite Eight appearance in 2001-02 following a 29-3 season. That was also the first time the Bearcats ever swept both regular season and tournament titles, an accomplishment he replicated years later as head coach. McCollum's playing career began at North Iowa Area Community College where he was a two-time All-Region athlete.

Born in Iowa City, McCollum was raised in Storm Lake, Iowa, and graduated from St. Mary's High School in 1999. He and his wife, Michelle, are the proud parents of two sons, Peyton and Tate, and a daughter Grace Ann.

COUPLE OF COWBOYS

Among the new faces on Drake's roster are a pair of transfers from Wyoming, Cam Manyawu and Kael Combs.

Manyawu appeared in 31 games with nine starts as a freshman for the Cowboys last season averaging 7.3 points per game and 6.6 rebounds per game. He scored a career-high 20 points on Dec. 5 versus South Dakota Mines and totaled seven double-doubles in his freshman campaign. A native of Kansas City, Mo., he played at Staley High School leading his team to a state title his senior season with an impressive 30-2 record. He was ranked as the ninth best prospect in the state of Missouri and the 53rd best power forward prospect in the nation.

Combs played in 26 games making one start as a freshman at Wyoming where he averaged 2.7 points per game. He scored a career-high 12 points on Feb. 24 against Boise State. In his hometown of Nixa, Mo., Combs was a standout basketball and football player at Nixa High School stuffing the stat sheet his senior season averaging 23.4 points per game along with 6.9 rebounds and 6.1 assists.

BULLDOGS BACK

Drake only returns a pair of players from last seasons squad in Nate Ferguson and Andrew Alia.

Alia played in 16 games in 2023-24 logging 39 total minutes. He averaged 0.9 points and 0.3 rebounds and scored a career-high five points at Belmont on Jan. 7. Alia's hometown is Kenosha, Wisconsin, where he attended St. Joseph High School and scored of 1,000 career points.

Ferguson has appeared in 108 games donning a Drake uniform while averaging 3.0 points and 2.3 rebounds. Last season, the Lemont, Ill. native played in 35 games with two starts and shot .738 from the field. He logged season highs in points with 10 at Bradley (Feb. 10) and rebounds with six versus Evansville (Mar. 8) and distributed a career-high four assists at UIC (Feb. 28)

SAME CONFERENCE, NEW SQUAD

Another addition to the Bulldogs roster, Eli Shettlar, comes to Drake as a familiar face after spending last season at fellow Missouri Valley Conference member Indiana State. Shettlar appeared in 11 games as a freshman for the Sycamores, scoring 27 total points and grabbing 12 rebounds. The Wichita, Kansas product highlighted his season scoring 13 points against Southern Indiana on 5-for-9 shooting with three triples. He averaged 17.3 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game at Andover High School. Shettlar holds the record for three pointers in a single game (9) and three pointers in a season (65) at Andover.

NORTHWEST QUARTETTE

The largest portion of Drake's roster this season is made up of four transfers from Northwest Missouri State. Isaiah Jackson, Bennett Stirtz, Mitch Mascari, and Daniel Abreu all followed Coach McCollum to Des Moines to continue their collegiate careers.

Hailing from Independence, Mo., Jackson played four seasons under Coach McCollum at Northwest Missouri State before coming to Drake. Jackson averaged 23.2 points per game over his career at Northwest to go along with 2.4 assists and 3.8 rebounds and was a part of two national championship winning teams. In his senior season he was an All-MIAA honorable mention and

named to the MIAA All-Defensive Team. He ranks No. 10 all-time on the Bearcat assist chart with 289 career assists.

Stirtz comes to Drake playing under Coach McCollum for two seasons. He immediately burst on to the scene to begin his collegiate career being named the MIAA Freshman of the Year and a Second Team All-MIAA selection in the 2022-23 season. As a freshman, he averaged 12.6 points per game and had the most steals by any NCAA Div. II freshman (65). As a sophomore he was again tabbed as Second Team All-MIAA and scored a career-high 29 points versus Southwest Minnesota State on Nov. 11. The Liberty, Mo. native was also a three-time MIAA Athlete of the Week selection.

A Geneva, Ill., native Mascari has played under Coach McCollum for the past five seasons at Northwest Missouri State. He was named to the MIAA Academic Honor Roll each year while at Northwest and led the team in three pointers last season with 82. Mascari made at least one 3-pointer in 30 of 34 games he played last season and scored a career-high 27 points with nine three-balls at Washburn (Feb. 10).

Abreu spent the last four seasons at Northwest with McCollum as his coach. The Springfield, Mo. native has averaged 6.8 points and 2.5 rebounds in his collegiate career and had his best season last year for the Bearcats highlighted by being named the MIAA Tournament Most Outstanding Player as he averaged 17.3 ppg leading the Bearcats to the title.

PRESEASON POLL

The Bulldogs were tabbed fifth in this seasons Preseason MVC poll with a total of 388 points. Drake also had Cam Manyawu and Bennett Stirtz named to the preseason Third Team.

Hailing from Plattsburg, Mo., Howard was a First Team All-State and First Team All-Conference selection his sophomore through senior years at Plattsburg High School. In his senior season he averaged 34.4 points, 13.2 rebounds, 4.3 assists, and 5.6 steals per game on 55/36/65 shooting splits. In his career, Howard totaled over 3,000 points scored.

Matteoni was originally committed and signed to Northwest, but opted to follow McCollum to Des Moines. He played high school ball at Blue Valley Northwest High School in the Overland Park, Kansas area and led his team to a state championship in 2023 and earned First Team All-State honors. Matteoni averaged 19.1 points, 8.9 rebounds, 2.1 assists, and 1.6 steals his senior season and was

another First Team All-State selection.

BIG BANKS

The lone transfer coming from the junior college level on the Drake roster is Tavion Banks.

Banks transfers in from Northwest Florida State College where he spent the past two seasons. In his career with the Raiders, he averaged 10.0 points and 11.1 rebounds in 25 minutes per contest. Banks started all 32 games he played in last season for NW Florida State leading it to the quarterfinals of the NJCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Bulldogs finished an undefeated 16-0 at home during the 2022-23 regular season and have gone 88-9 at home since the 2018-19 season. Drake has won at least 14 home games in each of the last five seasons.

With the win over York on Nov. 4, Drake has claimed eight consecutive season opening victories. The Bulldogs improved their record to 79-40 in season opening contests.

Drake also won its eighth-straight home opener dating back to 2017.

NON-CONFERENCE AT THE KNAPP

Drake has defended its home court against non-conference foes over the years and has built up a streak of 46 consecutive victories at home against teams not in the Missouri Valley.

The Bulldogs host a total of six non-conference games in the 2024-25 season and will look to keep the streak alive for another season.

The 93 points were the most scored by a Drake team in its season opener since beating Buena Vista, 98-52, Nov. 8, 2018.

The 52-point margin of victory against York tied for the seventh best mark in Drake school history. The largest margin of victory over an opponent in program history is a 76-point win (124-48) versus St. Ambrose on Dec. 21, 2022.

OH, WHAT A NIGHT

Graduate forward Daniel Abreu scored a career-high 30 points, including 19 in the first half in the season opener. He bettered his previous high of 26 points at Lincoln (Mo.) Dec. 11, 2021.

Abreu became the 52nd player in Drake history to score 30-plus points in a game.

Abreu's 30 points were the second highest scored by a Drake player in a season-opening game, trailing only 36 points scored by Tucker DeVries against Lipscomb Nov. 8, 2023.

CHARLESTON CLASSIC

Drake will head out east to Charleston, South Carolina the week before Thanksgiving to participate in the Shriner's Childrens Charleston Classic, which will be held Nov. 21-24.

The Bulldogs will begin the tournament with a rematch of their NCAA Tournament game from the 2022-23 season against the Miami Hurricanes. In the second game, Drake will face either Florida Atlantic or Oklahoma State. FAU secured a spot in the NCAA Tournament last year with an at-large bid, while Oklahoma State finished the year with a 12-20 overall record.

In the final game, Drake would go against Nevada, Seton Hall, VCU, or Vanderbilt. Seton Hall won the NIT Title last year defeating fellow MVC league member Indiana State, while VCU also participated in the NIT. Nevada earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament.

WILDCAT CLASSIC

Another prominent game on Drake's schedule comes on Dec. 17 when the Bulldogs take on Big 12 conference member Kansas State as part of the Wildcat Classic from the T-Mobile Center in Kansas City, Mo.

Drake and Kansas State have faced-off 27 times against each other with the Wildcats leading the all-time series, 20-7. The last time Drake and Kansas State played was on Nov. 25, 2020 in Manhattan, Kan., and the Bulldogs came away with an 80-70 victory. Garrett Sturtz paced Drake with a double-double performance recording 15 points and 10 rebounds to go along with a game-high four steals.

MASCARI MAKES IT RAIN

Sharp shooting guard Mitch Mascari had himself a game from beyond the arc versus Stephen F. Austin hitting eight three-pointers. Mascari's eight buckets from long range were one shy of his career-high (9 - 2/10/24 at Washburn) and he finished the game with 26 points, which was also one shy of his career-high (27 - 2/10/24 at Washburn).

Mascari's performance from deep tied for the second most three-balls hit in a single game by a Drake player. Jeff Allen owns the program record with nine three-pointers versus Tulsa on Jan. 13, 1994. The last Drake player to make eight three-pointers in a game was Reed Timmer on Feb. 14, 2018 versus Indiana State.

All 10 of Mascari's field goals this season have come from beyond the arc.

DEFENSIVE STATE OF MIND

Drake may be defined more by its defense this season. Through games on Sunday, Nov. 17, the Bulldogs enter the Charleston Classic ranked fourth in the NCAA in scoring defense, allowing opponents just 51.0 points per game and 12th

in three-point field goal percentage defense with opponents shooting just 23.3 percent beyond the arc.

The 41 points Drake allowed to York in the season opener were the fewest allowed to an opponent in a season opener since Dec. 1, 1981 when the Bulldogs surrendered just 40 points to Lewis in the Drake head coaching debut of Gary Garner.

Ben McCollum's Northwest Missouri State team last season ranked second in NCAA Division II in scoring defense (58.9).

ALL IN THE FAMILY

First-year Drake coach Ben McCollum won four NCAA Division II national championships at Northwest Missouri State, so of course he was going to surround himself with the success of that program.

Three of his assistants at Drake (Jesse Shaw, Xavier Kurth, Bryston Williams) graduated from Northwest Missouri State and four of the transfers (Daniel Abreu, Isaiah Jackson, Mitch Mascari, Bennett Stirtz) he brought in during the spring played for McCollum there. All are graduate students except for Stirtz, a junior.

TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

Drake has won three early-season tournaments since 2018. The Bulldogs captured the 2018 Continental Tires Las Vegas Classic beating SIU Edwardsville (79-66), Rider (76-58), and New Mexico State (66-63) before stopping San Diego, 110-103, in two overtimes to capture the championship.

The Bulldogs claimed the 2020 Little Apple Classic in Manhattan, Kan. with victories against South Dakota and Kansas State.

The Bulldogs won the 2022 Paradise Jam championship in the Virgin Islands, beating Buffalo (80-72) and Wyoming (61-56) before toppling Tarleton State (71-64) in the championship. Drake's Tucker DeVries was named Paradise Jam Tournament MVP.

DRAKE VS. CHARLESTON FIELD

Drake has the potential to meet two opponents in the tournament for the first time in Seton Hall or VCU.

Oklahoma State owns a 40-11 series advantage over Drake with the schools last playing Dec. 22, 1962 in Long Beach, Calif., when the Cowboys escaped with a 61-59 victory in the championship of the Long Beach Invitational.

The series with Florida Atlantic is tied 1-1 with the Bulldogs claiming a 74-62 victory in the last game between the schools Nov. 29, 2002 in Des Moines. The series with Vanderbilt is also tied at 1-1 with Commodores winning the last meeting between the teams, 72-57 in the championship of the 2008 Cancun Challenge. Drake earned a 47-46 victory in the inaugural meeting between the schools Dec. 29, 1948 in the Drake Fieldhouse

Meanwhile, Drake has an opportunity to face Nevada for the second straight year. The Bulldogs own a 5-1 series record against the Wolfpack (2-0 Des Moines, 2-1 Reno, 1-0 neutral court) after toppling Nevada, 72-53, in Henderson, Nev., Dec. 9, 2023.
