STORY LINES

- Today's meeting will be the first meeting between the two schools. Although the two schools have never met, head coach Mo Williams is no stranger to Nashville as he brought Alabama State to Memorial Gymnasium in 2021-22.
- This game marks the beginning of 10-day road trip with four games in two states - Tennessee and Kentucky. The trip starts and ends in Nashville with games against Vanderbilt and Lipscomb.
- The game against Vanderbilt marks the first of two this week against SEC opponents as the Tigers will face nationally-ranked Kentucky on Friday in Rupp Arena.
- The Tigers split a pair of exhibition games in the month of October, winning at home before extending Southern Miss to overtime on the road. Several players sat out the final exhibition game against Southern Miss including Daeshun Ruffin (two games), Romelle Mansell, and Avaughn Johnson. Meanwhile, Juan Reyna III sat out the first exhibition game against Belhaven before leading the team in scoring against Southern Miss.
- In the win over Belhaven five players scored in double figures led by Jayme Mitchell Jr. [17 points]. He was joined by Keiveon Hunt [14 points], Jalen Tatum [13 points], Dylan Canoville [12 points], and Dorian McMillian [10 points]. Meanwhile, against Southern Miss, the Tigers had three players in double figures including Reyna [20 points], Jalen Tatum [15 points], and Mitchell [14 points].
- Jackson State will look to replace the top six scorers from a season ago. They will turn to Daeshun Ruffin [Ole Miss] who sat out last year and transfers Shannon Grant [Florida A&M] and Juan Reyna III [UTSA] to team with returning players Romelle Mansell [Long Beach State] and Jayme Mitchell Jr. [Alabama State] who missed most of last season.
- Jackson State head coach Mo Williams received a contract extension on Friday, Nov. 1 [just three days ahead of the season opener]. He joined Vice President/Athletic Director Ashley Robinson and head football coach T.C. Taylor in getting extensions.

BACK TOGETHER AGAIN

A pair of Tigers are back together again after playing their freshmen at another institution - Alabama State - in the conference. Juan Reyna III joined the Tigers this season after transferring from UTSA where he sat out last year, joining former teammate Jayme Mitchell Jr. on the Tigers' roster. Ironically, both were recruited by head coach Mo Williams and associate head coach Trey Johnson to Alabama State and then to Jackson State.

NOT FAR FROM HOME

Jackson has several players on the roster from Jackson (Miss.) this year. The roster features Jayme Mitchell Jr. (Forest Hill HS), Keiveon Hunt (Callaway), Avaughn Johnson (Murrh), Daeshun Ruffin (Callaway), and Cowandric Samuel (Callaway). Three of those all went to the same high school in Hunt, Ruffin, and Samuel.

RETURN TRIP TO NASHVILLE

Juan Reyna III and Jayme Mitchell Jr. are making a return trip to Vanderbilt after visiting in 2021 with Alabama State. Reyna played 20 minutes and scored 10 points in the loss, while Mitchell played 18 minutes and scored eight points - both off the bench.

FIVE IS THE LUCKY NUMBER

Marcus Watson Jr. has hit the number five in two different categories in back-to-back games, both career-highs. The junior point guard recorded five steals in a loss at High Point, and then dished out five assists on the road against Xavier.

MITCHELL AND MANSEL RETURN IN A BIG WAY FOR TIGERS

Romelle Mansel and Jayme Mitchell have both returned this season for the Tigers, with both starting the last game on the road against Xavier. The two lead the team in scoring through the first three games of the season, with Mansel scoring 22 on the road against High Point and Mitchell adding 18. Mitchell then scored a career-high 26 in a loss to Xavier. They are both currently averaging in double figures.

RUFFIN LOOKS TO GET BACK ON THE COURT THIS SEASON

Daeshun Ruffin looks to get back on the court after missing all of last season due to an injury. He originally signed with Ole Miss out of high school, playing two years there before transferring.

While at Ole Miss he appeared in 11 games 2022-23, making two start. He averaged 18.3 minutes, 9.5 points, 1.1 rebounds, and 3.2 assists per game while scoring in double figures six times.

MITCHELL AND MANSEL MISSED MOST OF 2023-24

A pair of Tigers look to return to form after getting injured early last season in Jayme Mitchell Jr. and Romelle Mansel. Mitchell played in nine games before getting injured last season, averaging 6.6 points per game. The redshirt has been injured during his collegiate career, suffering injuries in his first year at Alabama State and again at Jackson State.

Meanwhile, Mansel returns after playing just two games last season before an injury. Prior to that, he averaged 8.7 points in two years at Jackson State after transferring from Jackson State.

TIGERS PICKED IN TOP HALF OF THE LEAGUE IN PRESEASON STANDINGS

Jackson State was picked to finish fourth in the preseason poll with 153 total votes and one first-place vote. They followed Grambling State (212), Texas Southern (200), and Southern (160) in the preseason poll.

SHANNON GRANT NAMED FIRST TEAM PRESEASON ALL-SWAC

Jackson State center Shannon Grant was named First Team Preseason All-Conference in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) released at Media Days by a vote of the league's head coaches and communications professionals.

Grant, a transfer from Florida A&M, averaged 10.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game last season. He scored in double figures in 18 games including 13 in conference play, including scoring 13 points and grabbing eight rebounds against his current team - Jackson State.

He joins Kintavious Dozier (Grambling State), T.J. Madlock (Alabama State), Tidjiane Dioumassi (Southern), and Chad Moodie (Alabama A&M) on the first team.

TIGERS PICKED UP ON ESPN+ AGAINST PRAIRIE VIEW A&M

The Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) has announced its ESPN regular season lineup for the 2024-25 season.

Jackson State is one four games listed on the lineup and will be featured against Prairie View A&M inside the Lee E. Williams AAC at 8 p.m. on March 3.

Other games featured in the lineup include Grambling State at Texas Southern (Jan. 6), Alcorn State at Grambling State (Feb. 3), and Texas Southern at Southern (Feb. 17).

Jackson State will kick off coverage on the SWAC Digital Network with a pair of games on Jan. 11 against Alabama State at the Lee E. Williams AAC, followed by another doubleheader at home on Jan. 25 against Bethune-Cookman.

One of two road contests featuring Jackson State takes place at Grambling State on Feb. 1, followed by home games against Mississippi Valley State (Feb. 8) and Alcorn State (Feb. 22). The Tigers appear two more times on the SWAC Digital Network to close out the regular season against Texas Southern (March 1) and at UAPB (March 6).

Times have yet to be announced for the games.

CLOSE TO HOME FOR COACHING STAFF

Not only is the roster dotted with players from Jackson or the surrounding area, but so is the coaching staff. Head coach Mo Williams and associate head coach Trey Johnson both starred at Murrah High School before going to Alabama and Jackson State respectively. They each played professionally. The coaching staff also features Tyler Adams from Brandon (Miss.) who went on to play at Georgetown and Kydarrius Williams.

HAVE TO REPLACE A TON

Jackson State looks to replace 90.3 percent of its scoring from last season.

WILLIAMS IN SPECIAL CLASS

Mo Williams is one of 19 head coaches at the NCAA DI level that played in the NBA. That list includes: Speedy Claxton [Hofstra]; Steve Alford [Nevada]; Hubert Davis [North Carolina]; Johnny Dawkins [UCF]; Bryce Drew [Grand Canyon]; Kim English [Providence]; Penny Hardaway [Memphis]; Fred Hoiberg [Nebraska]; Bobby Hurley [Arizona State]; Mark Madsen [California]; Cuonzo Martin [Missouri State]; Mark Pope [Kentucky]; Roger Powell Jr.; [Valparaiso]; Damon Stoudamire [Georgia Tech]; Rod Strickland [Long Island]; Reggie Theus [Bethune-Cookman]; Darrell Walker [Little Rock]; Mo Williams [Jackson State]; and Mike Woodson [Indiana].

He is also one of four who have won an NBA Championship including Claxton [2003 Spurs]; Madsen [2001 and 2002 Lakers]; Walker [1993 Bulls]; and Williams [2016 Cavs].

HEAD COACH

THIRD SEASON AT ALABAMA STATE

NBA Champion and Jackson native Mo Williams was named Jackson State University men's basketball coach on March 14, 2022 and returns for his third season with the Tigers.

Last season, Williams coached the SWAC Player of the Year in Ken Evans and the SWAC Defensive Player of the Year while earning the sixth seed in the conference tournament. He led the Tigers to non-conference wins over Missouri and Arkansas State in 2023-24. In his first season, Williams defied the odds of a predicted seventh-place finish as he led the Tigers to a tie for third place and a berth in the SWAC Tournament semifinals. The Williams era was sparked by a win over SMU during non-conference play en route to a 12-6 conference record.

SWAC play was highlighted by wins over eventual regular season co-champ Alcorn and eventual tournament champion Texas Southern as JSU won seven of its last eight regular season games prior to the conference tournament.

The Jackson native and former Murrah High School star returned home as head coach of the Tigers after spending the previous two seasons as head coach at Alabama State University. In his final season, the Hornets ranked in the top four in the SWAC in scoring, assists, three-point field goal percentage, free throw percentage, and blocked shots.

Williams entered the coaching ranks at Cal-State Northridge as an assistant coach under his former college coach Mark Gottfried, who Williams played for at Alabama. Cal State Northridge led the Big West Conference in scoring in both seasons, setting school records for three-point field goals made, field goals made, fewest turnovers, and blocked shots.

Williams spent 14 years in the NBA, averaging more than 13 points and nearly five assists per game. Drafted by Utah, Williams would play his rookie season with the Jazz before spending the next four seasons with the Milwaukee Bucks. Williams played three seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (2008-11) where he teamed up with LeBron James and helped the Cavs post a league-best 66 wins in 2008-09 and a berth in the NBA Finals. Williams was selected to the NBA All-Star Game in his first season with Cleveland.

After stints with the Los Angeles Clippers (2011-12), Portland Trail Blazers (2013-14), Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15) and Charlotte Hornets (2015), Williams returned to Cleveland for the 2015-16 campaign as the Cavaliers completed an historic comeback from a three-game-to-one deficit to defeat the Golden State Warriors to win the NBA Championship.

Williams was named Mr. Basketball during his senior year at Murrah High in 2001, and also earned McDonald's All-America and Parade Magazine third-team All-America honors. He went on to play two seasons at Alabama, averaging more than 13 points and four assists per game. Williams was named Sporting News National Freshman of the Year and Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year in 2002, helping lead

The Tide to the SEC regular season championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Williams also earned third-team all-conference accolades in 2003 before turning pro after his sophomore year.

Williams has seven sons – Kydarrius, Maurice, Michael, Mason, Maxwell, Asa, and Ezra. A native of Jackson (Miss.), he is the son of Griceldia and Isaiah Williams and has three siblings – Marcia, Michael (a West Point graduate) and Montrell. Williams is married to his wife, Antonia.
