## GAME NOTES

The University of Dayton women's basketball team finishes up the non-conference portion of the schedule by hosting Vanderbilt University on Thursday, Dec. 19 at 7 p.m. at UD Arena.

### SCOUTING THE FLYERS

Dayton got back on the winning track with a four-point victory over Central Michigan Sunday and will finish up the non-conference schedule with a winning record for the second straight year. The Flyers are 6-4 overall and 6-1 at home this season.

Head coach Tamika Williams-Jeter is in her third season in charge of her hometown Flyers, coming over after a year at Wittenberg. She has assistant coaching stops at Kansas, Kentucky, Penn State, and Ohio State.

The Flyers are averaging 64.9 points per game and holding opponents to 62.4 points each outing. Dayton is shooting 39.8 percent overall, 27.8 percent from three point range, and 69.9 percent from the free throw line. UD benefits from a +3.6 rebounding margin, but is committing more turnovers.

Leading the way for the Flyers are seniors Ivy Wolf, with 16.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, and Arianna Smith, with 10.0 points and 7.9 rebounds each contest. Graduate student Rikki Harris has played a multitude of positions and averages 8.1 points and 2.5 assists per game.

### SCOUTING THE OPPONENT VANDERBILT

Vanderbilt comes to Dayton with a 10-1 record on the season and receiving votes in the AP Poll while holding a three-game winning streak. The Commodores are 2-0 in true road games, enjoying the majority of their success at home.

Head coach Shea Ralph is in her fourth season at Vanderbilt and is a former teammate at Connecticut with Coach Williams-Jeter, winning the national championship with her in 2000.

As a team, Vanderbilt ranks top 5 in the country in offensive rebounding, turnover margin, and is sixth in scoring margin. The Commodores are scoring 87.7 points each outing and allowing just 52.7 points to opposing squads. Vandy is averaging 46.8 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent from behind the arc, and 75.9 percent from the charity stripe.

Sophomore Khamil Pierre is having a SEC Player of the Year campaign, ranking second in the nation in double-doubles, third in steals and rebounds per game, and fifth in points per game. She is averaging 22.9 points, 11.8 rebounds, and 4.0 steals each contest. Mikayla Blakes is no slouch herself with 20.4 points per game while Iyana Moore is chipping in 11.2 points each contest.

### SERIES HISTORY

The Flyers and Commodores are meeting for the 10th time in program history with Vanderbilt holding a 6-3 series advantage. The two teams faced off almost a year ago exactly on Dec. 20, 2023 with a 70-53 win at home for the Commodors. Prior to that, UD had won the last two contests.

### LEADING THE PACK

Arianna Smith leads the A-10 in field goal percentage while Ivy Wolf ranks second in free throw percentage.

### FIRST ROOKIE HONORS FOR LEUNG

Freshman guard Olivia Leung earned A-10 Rookie of the Week accolades on Nov. 25 after her 13-points, 11 of which came on the rally in the 4th, in the win over Providence.

### DOUBLING-UP

Senior Arianna Smith recorded 11 double-doubles last season and averaged that per game. She already has two this season in the opener against SEMO and vs Central Connecticut State on Dec. 1.

### FLYERS PICKED 11TH IN PRESEASON POLL

Dayton was picked to finish 11th in the 2024-25 Atlantic 10 preseason poll with 84 points. The Flyers were picked ahead of George Washington, Massachusetts, St. Bonaventure, and La Salle. Richmond was chosen as the preseason favorites, followed by Saint Joseph's, George Mason, and Davidson.

### PREPPING FOR A-10 PLAY

Dayton's non-conference schedule features eight home games, one true road game, and two neutral site games. Besides hosting the likes of Providence and Vanderbilt, UD traveled to No. 16 Duke on Nov. 14 and participated in the Music City Classic in Nashville, Tenn.

### OFF TO A FAST START

Dayton had six players make their Flyer debut in the season opener this year and multiple players had stellar starts. Nicole Stephens scored 15 points to lead all scorers while Shantavia Dawkins had a career-high 12 points and Rikki Harris had 10 points and five rebounds. Molly O'Riordan, Ajok Madol, and Jayda Johnson all had an impact on the game as well.

### RECORD-SETTING DAY

Smith grabbed 21 rebounds in the win over Ohio Dominican on Dec. 17, the fifth-most in a single game in program history. She did so with former Dayton rebounding legend JaVonna Layfield ('18) in attendance, who has three of the top five performances in school history.

### WE'VE GOT AN AUDIENCE

Last season on Jan. 24, the Flyers hosted their annual School Day game and set a new program record for the second consecutive season. Dayton hosted 12,097 fans for its game against VCU which was the 34th biggest single game attendance last season. It was also the most attended non-Power 6 game last year.

### QUITE THE CROWD

Along with setting the single-game attendance record in program history last season, Dayton also led the Atlantic 10 and ranked 58th in the country in average home attendance with 2,762 fans per game.

### FLYERS IN REGULAR SEASON LEAGUE PLAY

Dayton has won 150 of its last 201 regular season Atlantic 10 games (.750), a streak that dates back to a 97-46 win over Rhode Island on Jan. 7, 2012, and includes a perfect 14-0 mark in conference play during the 2012-13 season.

### THREE POINTS OF EXCELLENCE

Dayton hit at least one three-point shot in 697 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 2, 2001, the longest streak in the Atlantic 10 Conference and fourth longest in the nation. That streak ended when UD was unable to make a three on Jan. 20, 2024 at Richmond. The streak lasted 8,420 days.

### 70'S THE MAGIC NUMBER

Since the 2009-10 season, Dayton is 205-26 (.888) when scoring 70 or more points, including 11-0 in 2021-22. During the 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, the Flyers only lost one game per season when scoring at least 70 points, and dropped only two games in 2019-20 when reaching that mark.

### RESETTING THE COACHING STAFF

The Dayton women's basketball program hired Colleen Day Henderson as the new Assistant Coach/Chief of Staff this past summer. Day Henderson most recently served as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Akron for five years (2018-2023). While at Akron, Day Henderson served as the team's defensive coordinator. In 2022-23 the team's defense ranked second in the league in opponent field goal percentage (39%) and first in opponent 3 point field goal percentage (29%).

Day Henderson earned three degrees from Miami, completing her Ph.D. in educational leadership in August of 2017, earned a master's degree in sports studies (2007), and a bachelor's degree in English secondary education (2004).

Day Henderson married Jermaine Henderson in August of 2020. Jermaine Henderson is entering his second season as an assistant coach on the men's basketball staff at the University. They have a daughter, Jaye.

"Olivia loves the game of basketball. Her joy and passion are felt every time she steps on the floor. Olivia is incredibly dedicated to her craft and to her team."

#### #12 Jayda Johnson

"Jayda's versatility, length, and ability to stretch the floor allow her to be a swiss-army knife for our team. Her skill level serves as a weapon which we can utilize from multiple positions on the floor."

Dayton women's basketball head coach Tamika Williams-Jeter is entering her third season at the helm of the Flyers in 2024-25.

The second season in the Williams-Jeter era saw even more growth and success as the Flyers won yet another Atlantic 10 Tournament game and increased their win total by five games. Dayton finished the year with a 12-19 mark and 5-13 A-10 record, earning the No. 12 seed in the A-10 Championship. The season opened with a road trip to Williams-Jeter's alma mater UConn, where they Flyers faced the No. 2 team in the country. UD battled a challenging non-conference schedule, including games against Power 4 opponents Purdue and Vanderbilt. The Flyers capped off the season with a 66-52 victory over No. 14 seed St. Bonaventure in the conference tournament before falling to No. 6 seed Rhode Island in the second round.

In her first season in charge, Williams-Jeter focused on putting together a competitive team and experienced coaching staff while facing a challenging schedule in and out of Atlantic 10 play. The Flyers finished the season with a 7-21 record overall, but went 5-10 in A-10 play, earning the No. 12 seed in the 2023 A-10 Championship tournament. Williams-Jeter earned her first win in charge of Dayton on Dec. 29 with a home win over Cedarville and her first postseason victory for the Flyers with a first-round win over VCU in Delaware. Senior Sydney Freeman reached the 1,000-point mark in her career while redshirt-senior Mariah Perez recorded 12 double-doubles on the season.

Williams-Jeter has been successful at every level of basketball, both as a player and as a coach. From a stellar playing career at the top levels of high school, college, and professionally, to coaching stops at Division I powerhouses such as Kansas, Kentucky, Penn State, and

Ohio State, and head coaching experience at Wittenberg and with the India National Team, she has been a winner everywhere she goes. Williams-Jeter has helped advance the game for women athletes and coaches, both domestically and internationally.

"Dayton represents my family, my foundation, and my heart," said Williams-Jeter. "The University of Dayton is a stellar academic institution immersed in a vibrant community where excellence is a standard. I am excited and honored to have the opportunity to lead this program full of phenomenal young women. I am grateful to President Spina, Neil Sullivan, and (Senior Associate A.D.) Angie Petrovic for giving me the opportunity to continue to guide UD women's basketball to greatness. Lastly, I want to thank my husband, Richard Jeter, for allowing me to bring my sons back to the city that made me. Go Flyers!"

Williams-Jeter joins the Flyers from Wittenberg University where she has served as a head coach last season, leading the Tigers to an 18-8 record overall, a NCAC Tournament Championship, and the 2022 NCAA Division III Tournament. During the season, Wittenberg rode a 10-game winning streak to the conference championship which included a win over 10th-ranked DePauw. It was their first national tournament appearance since 2014-15.

Prior to her time at Wittenberg, Williams-Jeter had assistant coaching stints at prominent Division I programs such as Ohio State, Penn State, Kentucky, and Kansas. She helped lead those programs to eight NCAA Division I Tournaments and 11 postseason season appearances overall.

Coming out of high school at nearby Chaminade-Julienne, Williams-Jeter was the No. 1 recruit in the nation and two-time Ohio Player of the Year. The former forward was named Ohio Miss Basketball and led the Eagles to their first ever Final Four appearance. A highly sought-after recruit and arguably the best women's basketball player to ever come out of Dayton, Williams-Jeter went on to UConn as part of the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation in 1998.

Collegiately, Williams-Jeter had a Ring of Honor playing career at the University of Connecticut where she won two national championships in 2000 and 2002. She earned National Freshman of the Year honors from The Sporting News and was Big East Rookie of the Year. She went on to be named Most Outstanding Performer at the 2000 Big East Tournament en route to her first national title and received All-America Honorable Mention accolades as part of her second championship in 2002. Williams-Jeter was a Naismith Player of the Year candidate her senior season as well. Her career field goal percentage of 70.3 percent is the current NCAA Division I record.

Williams-Jeter went into coaching after playing professionally for seven seasons in the WNBA. She was selected in the 2002 WNBA Draft with the No. 6 overall pick by the Minnesota Lynx and earned WNBA All-Rookie team honors her first year. She finished with over 1,400 points and 1,100 rebounds in her career, and set a WNBA single-season field goal accuracy record in 2003 at 66.8 percent that still stands today.

Williams-Jeter earned her bachelor's degree from UConn in interpersonal communication. She and her husband Richard have two sons, R.J. and Jojo.
