## NOTES

- TCU will face Vanderbilt on Sunday at 11:30 a.m. in a neutral-site contest at Dickies Arena in Fort Worth. The game is part of the USLBM Coast to Coast Challenge and will air on ESPNU.
- Jamie Dixon is seven wins away from 500 as a head coach. His 165 wins at TCU rank second all-time.
- Under Dixon, TCU is 31-19 in neutral site games and 0-2 this season.
- TCU is 4-1 in Dickies Arena and played the first college basketball game there against USC on Dec. 6, 2019.
- Not included in the 4-1 record is TCU's charity exhibition win over Arkansas, 66-65, on Nov. 1 at Dickies Arena.
- Ernest Udeh Jr., who is averaging 8.7 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.7 blocks, is TCU's only returning scholarship player.
- Udeh's rebounding average of 8.5 ranks sixth in the Big 12.
- TCU's newcomers includes six transfers and four freshmen. Two additional players are redshirt freshmen.
- Frankie Collins leads the Frogs with 11.9 points, 4.1 assists and 1.9 steals per game.
- Collins has led TCU in points, rebounds and assists in each of the last two games.
- Noah Reynolds assist/turnover ratio of 2.50 ranks ninth in the Big 12. He missed the last game with a wrist injury.
- Vasean Allette started his first game vs. Xavier and ranks fourth on the team with 9.5 points per game.
- Brendan Wenzel is TCU's top 3-point threat at 41.9 percent.
- Wenzel has made at least one 3-pointer in every game except Santa Clara.
- Trazarien White arrived at TCU with over 1,000 career points. Collins (37 away) and Reynolds (50 away) are closing in on 1,000 for their careers.
- TCU ranks third in the Big 12 and 32nd nationally in fastbreak points with 15.9 per game. TCU led the nation the last two seasons.
- TCU ranks second in the Big 12 and 69th nationally in 3-point defense, allowing 29.4 percent from three.
- Opponents are shooting 27.4 percent from three in Schollmaier Arena this season.
- TCU ranks third in the Big 12 and 43rd nationally in turnovers forced per game at 15.6.
- TCU ranks fourth in the Big 12 and 24th nationally in turnover margin at 4.8.
- TCU ranks fifth in the Big 12 and 57th nationally in scoring defense at 65.3 points per game allowed.
- TCU ranks 36th in defensive efficiency at 97.0 according to KenPom.
- Last season, TCU finished the season in the NCAA Tournament for a program-best, third-straight season.
- Dixon is one of just nine active head coaches who have made at least 15 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.
- Only 22 active DI coaches have more wins than Dixon's 492.
- TCU has 17 seasons of 20 or more wins in its history and six have come in the last eight seasons.

## SERIES HISTORY

- Vanderbilt leads the all-time series 5-1 and has won the last five meetings.
- The last meeting saw the Commodores win, 81-78, on Jan. 28, 2018 in Nashville, part of the Big 12/SEC Challenge.
- The only meeting in Fort Worth came on Jan. 3, 2004 and was a 95-60 win by Vanderbilt.

## LAST TIME OUT

- TCU made four of its final five field goal attempts to pull away from Xavier for a 76-72 win on Thursday in Schollmaier Arena.
- Frankie Collins had 16 points, one of five Frogs in double-figures. He also led in rebounds with seven and assists with five.

- TCU will next play South Alabama on Monday, Dec. 16 at 7 p.m. in Schollmaier Arena.

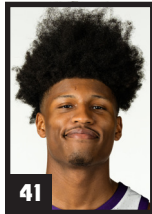

### ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- Vanderbilt is 8-1 on the season and is coming off an 80-64 win at Virginia Tech on Wednesday. The Commodores' only loss was against Drake, 81-70.
- Vanderbilt is led in scoring by Jason Edwards, whose 18.0 points per game rank sixth in the SEC.
- The Commodores take care of the ball well and are ranked ninth nationally in turnover margin at 6.2 and turnovers per game at 9.2.

- Last December, Dickies Arena was named Billboard's #1 Venue in the World with a capacity of 10,001 to 15,000. Dickies arena hosted the 2022 Men's NCAA Tournament and will host again in 2027. It is also the site of the 2026 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament Regional Rounds.

### DIXON KEEPS CLIMBING

Jamie Dixon stands in second place for most wins by a TCU head coach.

- Dixon is seven wins away from 500 for his career. Only 21 active DI head coaches have 500 career wins. Of that number, only six have won 500 games as the head coach of a major conference team. That group is Rick Barnes, Leonard Hamilton, Tom Izzo, Rick Pitino, Kelvin Sampson and Bill Self.
- Dixon is one of just nine active head coaches who have made at least 15 appearances in the NCAA Tournament. The other eight coaches are Dana Altman, John Calipari, Mark Few, Tom Izzo, Matt Painter, Rick Pitino, Kelvin Sampson and Bill Self.
- TCU's win percentage during Dixon's first eight seasons was .593, the best by a TCU coach in 20 years.
- TCU has made four NCAA Tournament appearance in the last six seasons that a postseason was held. TCU had been to one NCAA Tournament in the 30 years prior to Dixon's first appearance in 2018.

### TURNOVERS FORCED

TCU ranks third in the Big 12 and 43rd nationally with 15.5 turnovers forced per game.

- TCU forced Michigan into 21 turnovers on Nov. 15 in Ann Arbor. It was the most the Frogs have forced on the road in regulation since Bradley turned it over 21 times on Dec. 23, 2015.
- Against a power conference opponent on the road in regulation, 21 turnovers hadn't been forced since Jan. 9, 2013 when Oklahoma State turned it over 24 times.

### REUNITED

Newcomers Noah Reynolds and Brendan Wenzel are teammates for the second time. The two were at Wyoming for the 2021-22 season where the Cowboys went 25-9 overall and fell in the First Four to Indiana. They were also on the 2022-23 Wyoming team.

### EDMONDS SIGNS WITH TCU

TCU signed Xavier Edmonds and Kayden Edwards for the 2025-26 season.

- Edmonds is a 6-8 forward and three-star recruit out of Bishop Montgomery in Torrance, Calif. He played at Salt Lake Community College last season where he averaged 14.0 points and 7.4 rebounds per game.
- Edwards is a four-star recruit out of Duncanville High School in Texas. The 6-2 guard, nicknamed "Bugg," is the 61st ranked player in the Class of 2025, the sixth-ranked player from Texas and the third-best recruit in program history according to 247Sports. He is No. 59 in ESPN's top 100. Last season, Edwards averaged 23.9 points on 37.6 percent shooting from 3-point range while adding 3.4 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game.

### FRESHMAN CLASS

TCU's roster is made up of three of the top recruits the Frogs have ever had.

- This season's freshman class ranks 17th nationally by ESPN and is highlighted by Micah Robinson at No. 64 and David Punch at No. 96.

- November signee Kayden Edwards is ranked No. 3 on that list. He'll be a freshman next season.

### FROG BREAK

TCU ranks third in the Big 12 and 33rd nationally in fastbreak scoring with 15.9 per game.

- TCU led the nation in each of the past two seasons in fastbreak scoring. The Horned Frogs averaged 17.8 fastbreak points per game last season and 17.5 per game in the 2022-23 season.
- The most fastbreak points by a TCU team under Jamie Dixon is 43 against Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 17.

### OUTREBOUNDING LEADS TO WINS

- Always a focus for a Jamie Dixon coached team is rebounding. Here is a breakdown of win/loss records when TCU and/or Jamie Dixon-led teams rebound their opponent.
- TCU has been outrebounded in four games.

### KEY NOTES FROM GAME 1

- TCU put up impressive numbers in its season-opening 105-59 win over Florida A&M
- The 46-point margin of victory was TCU's largest since a 46-point win over Central Arkansas on Dec. 28, 2022 (103-57).
- TCU led by as many as 48 points. It tied for the largest lead in a game under Dixon. TCU also had a 48-point lead in its Dec. 18, 2022 game with Mississippi Valley State.
- TCU's 105 points tied for the third-most scored under Jamie Dixon.
- TCU led 59-22 at halftime. The 37-point margin was the largest halftime lead in program history. The Frogs have scored more in a 20-minute period. In 1997, TCU outscored UT Pan American by 39 points (80-41) in the second half in a 153-87 win.
- The Frogs' 29 assists tied for the second-most under Dixon and the most since 29 assists were recorded against Central Michigan on Nov. 30, 2018.
- TCU's five turnovers were the fewest it's had since March 17, 2023 when it had five against Arizona State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
- TCU was 14-of-30 from 3-point range including 11-of-16 in the first half. The 14 made 3-pointers were the Frogs most since Feb. 15, 2020 when they made 15 against Kansas State. It was also tied for the fifth most by TCU under Dixon.
- It was TCU's 300-straight game with a made three.

### EXHIBITION WIN OVER NO. 16 ARKANSAS

A game-winning 3-pointer by Brendan Wenzel led the Frogs to a 66-65 win over No. 16 Arkansas in a charity exhibition on Nov. 1 at Dickies Arena. Ernest Udeh Jr. led TCU with 13 points, on 6-of-7 shooting, and eight rebounds.

### WHAT WAS LOST

The Horned Frogs lost nine scholarship players from last year's team, including their top seven scorers.

- TCU returned just 4.7% of its scoring from last season, the fewest in the Big 12 and 10th fewest in the nation.
- TCU's 14.2% of returning rebounding ranks as the second

- TCU returns 7.5% of its minutes played from last season, which are the fewest in the Big 12 and 12th in the country.
- Top departures from last year's team included all-conference players Emanuel Miller and Jameer Nelson Jr.
- All six players who ran out of eligibility last season signed with a professional team.

#### WHO IS HERE

- Ernest Udeh Jr. is the lone returning scholarship player. He started 29 games last season and averaged 4.3 points and 5.3 rebs.
- TCU's incoming class includes six transfers and four freshmen.
- The freshman class ranks 17th by ESPN and highlighted by Micah Robinson (64) and David Punch (96).
- Also included in that class four-star center Malick Diallo and three-star guard Ashton Simmons.
- Among the transfer class are Frankie Collins, Noah Reynolds, Trazarien White and Brendon Wenzel, who each have played at least three years of college basketball before arriving at TCU in the summer.
- White is a two-time All-Colonial Athletic Association guard from UNC Wilmington and has 1,298 career points.
- Collins started at guard the past two seasons at Arizona State and averaged 13.6 points and 3.2 assists last year.
- Reynolds ranked third in the Horizon League with 20.0 points at Green Bay last season.
- Wenzel is a career 37.7% 3-point shooter after shooting exactly that percentage at Wyoming last season.
- Newcomer, Vasean Allette, averaged 17.4 points and 5.7 rebounds as a freshman at Old Dominion.
- Another newcomer is Denton, Texas, native RJ Jones who played at Kansas State last season as a freshman.
- Returning to the team are Isaiah Manning and Jace Posey, who redshirted last season as freshmen.

- Of TCU's 38 wins over AP Top 25 teams in its history, 23 have come under Dixon.
- TCU is 9-4 against AP Top 25 teams at home in the past three seasons.
- Of TCU's six road wins against AP Top 25 teams, five have occurred in the past five seasons.

- TCU is 4-6 all-time as a top 25 team against a top 25 team. Nine of those matchups have come under Dixon.

- TCU won 89 home games in the first seven years under Dixon, the most wins at home in a seven-year period. Billy Tubbs is second on that list with 88.
- The Frogs had won eight straight Big 12 home games until a loss to No. 14 Kansas on Feb. 11, 2019, which was the most for TCU in a conference since the 1996-97, 1997-98 and 1998-99 seasons when the Frogs won nine straight in the Western Athletic Conference.

NASHVILLE, Tenn. - The Vanderbilt Commodores gave themselves something to celebrate in what's been a very trying season.

Riley LaChance's 3-pointer with 1:17 left put Vanderbilt ahead to stay, and the Commodores beat TCU 81-78 Saturday afternoon in the Big 12/Southeastern Conference Challenge.

TCU (15-6) came in off an upset of No. 7 West Virginia, and another win might've gotten the Horned Frogs back in the Top 25. Now the Horned Frogs now have lost five of seven overall. They also are 3-2 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge and haven't beaten Vanderbilt since 1951.

"We shot 56 percent and outrebound by 15," TCU coach Jamie Dixon said. "It's hard to lose a game when you do those two things, but we found a way."

TCU guard Alex Robinson's layup tied it up at 76 with 2:19 left. But Robinson missed a 3-pointer as the shot clock expired with 1:27 left, and LaChance gave Vandy the lead for good with his fourth 3. Vladimir Brodziansky scored on layup to pull TCU within 79-78. LaChance hit a pair of free throws with 10.8 seconds left, and Kouat Noi's 3-pointer hit off the front rim with 3 seconds left for TCU.

Kenrich Williams led five Horned Frogs in double figures with 17 points. Brodziansky added 15, Robinson finished with 13, Desmond Bane 12 and Noi 11.

The Horned Frogs scored the first four points of the second half to take a 44-43 lead on a bucket by Bane. But LaChance answered with a 3, and Lee scored on a fast-break layup followed by a layup by LaChance with 17:39 left.

Vanderbilt led 43-40 at halftime after leading by as many as nine in the first half. TCU used 11 straight points to go up 21-16 before the Commodores went on a 19-5 run to take the lead back.

## ABOUT THE UNIFORMS

TCU men's basketball debuted its uniforms in the 2022-23 season.

- The design on the side of the uniforms are "SPINES" which represent the anatomical spines on the Horned Frog.
- From an frontal and rear view, the "SPINES" are represented to imitate the spines on the top and bottom of the Frog. The view can be seen when a player is at the free-throw line and seeing just hints of the tips of the spines.
- The red line in the middle has multiple meanings - the bloodline that shoots from the eyes of the Horned Frog when threatened. It also represents the 'Blood is Thicker Than Water' mentality that a close family has in their bloodline
- The design originates from the myth/origin of the horned lizard itself. The "ZIG ZAG" motif is often found in Texas Native America culture as a representation of lightning striking the earth and the red representing the horned lizard fighting back to a much bigger foe.
- The origin of the horned lizard is a fight between the lizard and lightning. Lightning states it can defeat anything on earth and challenged the lizard to four strikes (hence the four combined ZIG ZAGS on the sides of the uniform). Lightning missed the quick lizard and the Horned Frog "SPINED" the lightning from above. As payment, lightning now sends SPINES of light throughout the sky as homage to the tiny, yet mighty, Horned Frog.

#1. Desmond Bane (6'6"-G-1998, played in 2016-20, plays pro in the NBA) led Memphis Grizzlies to an easy victory against the Indiana Pacers (9-12) 136-121 in the NBA last Sunday. He scored 16 points, had 6 rebounds and dished 6 assists in 31 minutes. The Memphis Grizzlies have a solid 14-7 record this season. It was his team's sixth consecutive victory in a row. But this is still an early stage of the season and everything may happen. It's Bane's fourth year with the team. Bane has individually a very good season with high stats. He averages 13.9ppg, 6.4rpg and 3.9apg in 14 games he played so far.

#2. Vladimir Brodziansky (6'11"-C/F-1994, played in 2015-18, plays in Spain). Brodziansky could not help Universidad Catolica de Murcia CB (0-3) to beat Gran Canaria (6-3) in the Spanish Liga Endesa. He scored 9 points. But Universidad Catolica de Murcia CB was badly defeated 83-63 on the road by the lower-ranked Gran Canaria (#4). So far Universidad Catolica de Murcia CB lost all three games in the Regular Season. But the season just started, so everything may happen. This year Brodziansky averages 7.1ppg and 2.9rpg.

#3. Damion Baugh (6'4"-G-2000, played in 2024-24, currently in the NBA G League), who plays in the NBA G League was not able to help the Westchester Knicks (4-4) in their last game. Despite his very good performance the Westchester Knicks (#5) were edged 129-127 in Washington by the Capital City Go-Go. Baugh scored 23 points, grabbed 5 boards, passed 8 assists and added 3 steals in 32 minutes; quite an impressive performance considering it's only his first season in pro basketball. It was Knicks' third consecutive loss in a row. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. Baugh has relatively good stats this year 12.5ppg, 4.0rpg and 7.0apg in eight games.

#4. Experienced Garlon Green (6'7"-F-1991, played in 2009-13, plays pro in France) was not able to secure a victory for Sharks Antibes (7-2) in their last game on Friday. Despite his very good performance the league leader Sharks Antibes was badly defeated 99-82 in Aix-les-Bains by the lower-ranked Aix-Maurienne (#5). Green was the second best scorer with 17 points. He also added 8 boards, handed out 3 passes and blocked 2 shots. Green has relatively good stats this season 13.2ppg, 4.8rpg and 1.7apg.

#5. Kenrich Williams (6'6"-G/F-1994, played in 2014-18, plays in the NBA) contributed to an easy victory against the Sacramento Kings (9-12) crushing them 130-109 in the NBA on Monday night. Williams recorded 10 points, 5 rebounds and 4 assists in 15 minutes. The Oklahoma City Thunder has a solid 15-5 record this season. It was his team's fourth consecutive victory in a row. But the season is still in its first stage and everything can happen. It's Williams' fifth year with the team. This season he averages 5.0ppg and 2.6rpg in 10 games.

#6. Kouat Noi (6'7"-F-1997, played in 2016-16, currently in Australia), who plays in the Australian NBL couldn't help Sydney Kings (2-4) in their last game on Sunday. Despite Noi's good performance Sydney Kings were edged 101-98 in Melbourne by the leading United. He recorded 12 points (made all of his five free throws). This season Noi averages 9.5ppg and 1.5rpg. He has also Australian passport.

#7. Chuck O'Bannon Jr. (6'6"-F-1999, played in 2020-24, plays pro in Slovakia) couldn't help Blue Wings (7-5) in their last game. Despite O'Bannon Jr.'s good performance Blue Wings lost 80-84 at home to the higher-ranked (#3) Levice. He scored 14 points and blocked 3 shots in 30 minutes. O'Bannon Jr. has very impressive stats this year 16.5ppg, 4.0rpg and 1.5spg in 11 games.

#8. Kyan Anderson (5'11"-PG-1992, played in 2011-15, plays in Hungary) couldn't help DEAC in their game against Szolnok in the Hungarian A Division. Anderson recorded 8 points, 6 assists and 3 steals. His team was defeated 80-67. He has relatively good stats this season 14.5ppg, 2.6rpg, 5.4apg and 2.3spg.

#9. Chauncey Collins (6'1"-PG-1995, played in 2014-16, currently in Lithuania), who plays in the Lithuanian LKL couldn't help Mazeikiai (1-9) in their last game. Despite his good performance Mazeikiai lost 83-93 on their home court in Mazeikiai to the leading Rytas. Collins recorded 11 points and added 3 passes in 25 minutes. He has relatively good stats this year 14.7ppg, 2.2rpg and 2.5apg in six games.

#10. Mike Miles Jr. (6'2"-G-2002, played in 2020-23, plays pro in the NBA G League) led Iowa Wolves to an easy victory against the Wisconsin Herd 115-98 in the NBA G League last Saturday. He recorded 11 points. This season Miles Jr. averages 5.4ppg and 1.1rpg.
