OPENING TIP

➤ West Georgia is back in the win column after going wire-to-wire for a road victory over Alabama State, handing the Hornets an eighth consecutive loss in a 63-46 triumph in Montgomery on Wednesday.

➤ The Wolves, winners of five of their last six, are on the road for the final time in non-conference play, taking on the Vanderbilt Commodores in Nashville.

➤ During that six game stretch, the Wolves' only loss was an overtime loss to Western Carolina on the road, and the Wolves are outscoring opponents by a 14.8 per game average.

➤ Destiny Jones, who scored 22 on Wednesday to give her back-to-back 20-point games, has averaged 14.5 points per game in the last six games, and recorded three double-doubles in that span.

➤ Saturday's game is the fourth of four straight games on the road. The Wolves' next home game isn't until December 29 when UWG hosts Brenau in a final tune-up before conference play begins.

➤ Vanderbilt enters Saturday's game with an 11-1 record after knocking off Dayton on Thursday night, extending their win streak to four games. The Commodores are the only team in any Division of NCAA women's basketball with two players averaging at least 20 points per game.

THIRD YEAR AT UWG // RECORD: 34-33

Joanna Reitz, a seasoned coach with experience in Division I play, was announced as the University of West Georgia's 12th head women's basketball coach in program history prior to the 2022-23 season. Reitz comes to UWG following a distinguished career as an assistant coach, spending nearly 15 years in the southeast, including stops at GSC rival Shorter and Division I Mercer, before landing at her most recent position at Division I Utah in 2017.

Reitz's second season in Carrollton, saw the Wolves' go 16-13 overall, a three-win improvement, and finish .500 in league play, also an improvement from the year prior. Two individuals garnered great success in year two, led by Zuriyah Davis who became UWG's first All-GSC selection in seven seasons and finished third in the conference in points per game as a junior. Sophomore center K'Nari Holliday finished the season as an NCAA Statistical Champion in Field Goal Percentage under Reitz in 2024, shooting 61.7 percent from the field, becoming the third player in UWG history to earn the honor of NCAA Statistical Champion.

In her first season at the helm of the UWG program, Reitz and the Wolves saw solid improvement, winning the most games since the 2019-20 season with 13 victories. The Wolves ended the regular season 6-2 and returned to the Gulf South Conference Tournament for the first time since 2020 and earned the league's sixth seed, despite being picked 11th in the GSC Preseason Poll.

Individually, Reitz's team produced the GSC Freshman of the Week eight times with Aliyah Washington earning the honors seven times throughout the season, while Katelyn Dunning earned it once. Washington's seven Freshman of the Week selections, under Reitz's leadership, led her to become West Georgia's first GSC Freshman of the Year since 1991. Under Reitz, Senior Forward Peace Okeke recorded eight double-doubles during the season, the most by a single UWG player since the 2016-17 season.

Off the court, Reitz helped improve the team's GPA from 3.11 to 3.47. Reitz and her team also contributed over 80 hours of community service.

In her career, Reitz has coached a total of 20 players who went on to play professional women's basketball, with recent University of West Georgia alum Jada Powell becoming her first former player at UWG to join the professional ranks.

Reitz ventured to the "City of Dreams" after spending five seasons at Utah following previous coaching stints at USC-Aiken (assistant coach – 2015-17), Mercer (assistant coach – 2013-15), Shorter (assistant coach – 2011-13) and as the Director of Recruiting Operations at Florida State (2010-11). She spent three additional seasons with the Seminoles as a graduate assistant from 2007-2010.

While at Utah, Reitz had significant responsibilities in the area of player development, recruiting, scouting, and game planning. In addition, she was an academic liaison for the Utes and played a role in booster, campus, and community relations. As a recruiter, she helped recruit and sign back-to-back top-25 recruiting classes in 2019 and 2020. In her time at Utah, Reitz recruited two Pac-12 Freshmen of the Year, six Gatorade Players of the Year, and six All-Conference selections. In her final season in Salt Lake City, she guided the Utes to a pair of upsets in the Pac-12 conference tournament as Utah made their first-ever appearance in the Pac-12 Championship game.

At USC-Aiken, she was involved with all aspects of the program, helping the Pacers to improve by four wins in 2016-17, going from six Peach Belt Conference wins in the 2015-16 season to 10 conference wins in 2016-17. Reitz also recruited and signed Kwajelin Farrar, the 2017 PBC Freshman of the Year.

Prior to her stint in Aiken, Reitz was an assistant coach at Mercer University in Macon, where she recruited three of the most successful players in the Bears' history. She recruited and signed three players who were named as the SoCon Player of the Year for four consecutive years. That includes Kahila Lawrence, who was the 2015 Southern Conference Freshman of the Year, then was named the Southern Conference Player of the Year in 2016, 2017, and 2018. In 2018, she became the highest draft pick in SoCon women's basketball history as the 24th overall pick in the WNBA draft.

Before Mercer, Reitz spent two seasons on the bench as an assistant coach at a Gulf South Conference member institution, helping the Shorter Hawks to a 28-7 record in 2011-12. She helped guide the Hawks to transition from NAIA Division I to NCAA Division II, and as defensive coordinator in 2011-12, Shorter was the top defensive team in NAIA Division I, allowing just 31.6 percent shooting on the year. She also recruited Taylor Adams to Rome and Adams eventually became a First Team All-GSC performer and a WBCA All-American.

Following a successful playing career at Covenant College, Reitz became a graduate assistant at Florida State, where she helped with recruiting, camps, player care, and scout team oversight for the back-to-back ACC Regular Season Champions, making a trip to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2010. In 2010-11, she was elevated to the Director of Recruiting Operations, handling recruiting coordination, game scheduling, camp direction, and booster/alumni liaison.

She played college hoops at Covenant College from 2002-06 where she was a four-year starter, three-time team captain, and three-time all-academic selection. She was named to the All-Conference team in 2006. She was a 1,000-point scorer at Covenant, finishing her career with 1,557 points, which is ninth all-time as of 2022. She made 146 three-pointers in her career and is eighth all-time at Covenant with 584 field goals made.

Reitz graduated with a degree in natural science in 2006 and went on to receive master's degrees in physical education and business administration from Florida State.

Five of Six

Wednesday's win over Alabama State was the Wolves fifth win in the last six games, going an impressive 5-1 after starting the season 0-3. In that stretch, the Wolves have gotten 14.5 points and 8.2 rebounds per game from Destiny Jones while Zuriyah Davis has added 14.3 per game. As a team, UWG has outrebounded opponents, 251-199 in the six games combined, and 44 percent from the field. For the entire season, the Wolves are shooting 42.2 percent which is third best in the ASUN.

Des Does it Again

Freshman Destiny Jones just keeps turning heads, as she notched her second career 20-point game and third career double-double with a 22-point, 11-rebound game at Alabama State. That game put her over the 100-point mark for the season, becoming the fastest UWG freshman to reach 100 points in the modern-stat era. Jones now averages 7.2 rebounds per game which is third in the league and ranks eighth in the country amongst Division I freshmen. Her 63 percent clip from the field is good enough for 11th in the country and leads all freshmen in Division I. The Louisville native has scored in double-figures in eight of nine games this season and is averaging 13.4 for the year. In the last three games, Jones is averaging 20.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game.

Nari Nearing 300

Junior center K'Nari Holliday has played in 38 career games, averaging 7.1 rebounds per game, and is 32 rebounds away from hitting the 300 career rebound mark. She's the first to eclipse the 300-rebound mark in a career since Siera Carter finished her four years at UWG in 2022 with 381 career rebounds. Holliday grabbed seven in her most recent performance at Alabama State. Her career-high is 15 which she grabbed last season against West Florida.

Grace O'Share-a

Sophomore point guard Grace O'Gara is UWG's leader in assists, averaging 3.1 per contest. That number ranks seventh in the ASUN and she is one of three Wolves inside the top-10 in that category. In assist/turnover ratio, O'Gara is second best in the league at 1.6. The Worcester, Massachusetts native trails only former All-American and Memphis transfer Emani Jefferson from FGCU in that category. Her assist/turnover ratio is inside the top-150 of all players in the country.

Give Me That

Mykah Anderson arrived at UWG with a reputation as a relentless defender, and she's continued that trend at the Division I level, entering Saturday's game ranked second in the ASUN in steals per game at 2.1. The Phoenix, Arizona native has at least one steal in every game this season, and has at least three steals in four of nine games thus far. Anderson's career-high in steals is seven, which she recorded last season against Valdosta State on December 7, 2023.

Final Stretch of Non-Conference Play

West Georgia has two non-conference games remaining before the gauntlet of ASUN basketball starts. After Saturday's game at Vandy, UWG returns to action on December 29 at home, hosting Brenau in a final non-conference tune-up. The Wolves' conference slate starts on January 2 as the Wolves take on Stetson on the road before taking on FGCU on Saturday at 4 p.m.

Division I Breakthrough

The UWG women's basketball team becomes the fourth team at UWG to notch their first win over a Division I opponent since the University elevated to Division I and the Atlantic Sun Conference. The Wolves are also the only new Division I team in 2024-25 to win a game against a Division I opponent. The NCAA's other newest Division I member, Mercyhurst, is 2-4 on the year, but their wins are over Division II Davis and Elkins and juco opponent Bryant & Stratton.

Something to Prove
