BISONS PREDICTED TO WIN ASUN CHAMPIONSHIP

The Bisons, for a second straight year, are picked to win the regular season title, as voted on by the ASUN head coaches. Totalling 140 points, the Bisons secured eight of the 12 first place votes.

The 2024 squad finished with a 19-11 overall record and a 14-2 mark in the ASUN.

Overall, Lipscomb has won seven regular season titles, with the most recent coming in 2020 as a North Division champion.

SERIES HISTORY: VANDERBILT

Playing intercollegiate volleyball for the first time since the 1979-80 academic year, Vanderbilt brought volleyball back as a varsity sport for the 2025 season.

With Lipscomb records dating back to the mid-90s, this will be the first time the two teams will meet on the volleyball court.

This will be the second match for Lipscomb in the SEC in the last three after falling to Kentucky last week.

They also played Alabama to a four-set loss in an exhibition.

Lipscomb, all-time, is 4-24 against active SEC institutions, earning wins against South Carolina (2010), Missouri (2014), Ole Miss (2016) and Oklahoma (2021).

SERIES HISTORY: MINNESOTA

The Golden Gophers will make the trek to Nashville for the first-ever meeting between the two schools on Saturday night.

Just like the SEC schools, this will be the second match against the Big Ten in the early stages of the season, taking on No. 1 Nebraska on Aug. 29.

The Bisons have a 2-15 record against the Big Ten, securing victories against Northwestern (2016) and Iowa (2018).

TIME FOR BERK TO SHINE

After being behind Meg Mersman the last three seasons, Berkley Mischler will be one the leading middle blockers for the Bisons in 2025, and she's off to a roaring start.

Totalling 12 blocks on the week, she posted 26 kills and a .392 attack percentage from the middle blocker spot in the rotation.

Sunday against Seton Hall, the senior matched a career-high 15 kills on a .444 swing percentage and added five blocks.

STRENGER MAKES STRONG IMPRESSION IN WEEK ONE

After a stellar weekend at the LUV Invitational, including picking up her first collegiate start, freshman Sydney Strenger was named the ASUN Freshman of the Week.

The McKinney, Texas native led all first years in attack percentage with a .524 clip, totaling 26 kills on 42 attempts with just four errors committed from the middle blocker position.

Against No. 1 Nebraska, she posted five kills in two sets and followed that with six kills against No. 7 Kentucky.

Sunday against Seton Hall, she earned her first collegiate start and finished as co-leader in kills with 15 with two attack errors in 21 attempts for a .619 attack percentage.

Additionally, she assisted on four blocks for 28.0 total points over the LUV Invitational.

She is the first player for Lipscomb to earn the Freshman weekly honor since Sophia Hudepohl earned it in 2022.

A "SPIKE-TACULAR" START FOR ALLIE

Allison Barrick, one of the five freshmen for this Lipscomb team in 2025, while only playing in five matches on opening weekend, was a great addition on the outside for the Bisons.

After spiking three kills against No. 7 Kentucky on Saturday, she added four more against Seton Hall.

A FIRST FOR LUV: PLAYING AND HOSTING A NATIONAL NUMBER ONE TEAM

For the first time in program history, the Bisons played a team ranked number one in the American Volleyball Coaches Association poll in Nebraska to start the 2025 season.

Along with hosting Kentucky on Saturday, the Bisons will shatter the previous highest ranked foe in Allen Arena. Tennessee came to Allen Arena on Aug. 27, 2005 as the No. 9 team in America.

Lipscomb has played four prior matches against teams ranked in the top five, all were played on the road:

- #3 - Florida - Sept. 16, 2007
- #3 - Texas - Sept. 1, 2016
- #4 - Louisville - Sept. 10, 2022
- #5 - Nebraska - Aug. 26, 2023

The Bisons have played seven matches against ranked teams inside Allen Arena, posting a 1-8 record. The win came against No. 24 Arizona on Aug. 26, 2017, a four-set win.

In the Bisons’ Division I history, the program is 3-34 against ranked foes.

JONES EARLY FAVORITE FOR PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Courtney Jones was named a unanimous selection to the preseason All-ASUN Team and has been chosen as an early favorite for Player of the Year.

A two-time ASUN selection, including a First Team honoree last year, the senior started in all 30 matches last season and led the team in kills (372), kills per set (3.54), points (422.5) and points per set (4.02).

In the Bisons record book, she sits 12th all-time in kills (834) and 11th in kills per set (2.97).

USA VOLLEYBALL PAYING ATTENTION

Last season, three players, Sophia Hudepohl, Courtney Jones and Berkley Mischler were invited to the USA Volleyball National Development Team.

For Hudepohl, it was her second straight invitation.

SOPH IS THE RIGHT CHOICE FOR PRESEASON ASUN SETTER OF THE YEAR

Also securing a unanimous honor on the All-ASUN preseason team is Sophia Hudepohl, who is the pick as the league’s Setter of the Year.

The rising senior enters her final season with the Bisons as a Second Team All-ASUN selection and is a two-time All-ASUN member. Earning the ASUN Setter of the Year honor in 2023, she led the ASUN in 2024 conference matches in assists (690) and per set (10.95).

Nationally, she finished 63rd in Division I in assists per set (9.86), playing in all 30 matches.

HIGH STANDARD YEAR AFTER YEAR

For 18 straight years, since 2007, the Bisons have finished with a winning season. LUV is currently 10th among active schools in the category.

The Bisons have played two opponents with a longer streak: Nebraska (44) and Kentucky (20). The Cornhuskers, along with Penn State, hold the longest streak in the NCAA.

HOME IS WHERE THE “WINNING” IS

The 2025 schedule will feature 26 matches, including 16 inside Allen Arena. The 16 home matches are the most in the program’s history since 2002, the first year of volleyball inside Allen Arena.

Prior to this season, the previous high for home matches in a season was 15 in 2022.

Holding a 192-81 record since the first home volleyball match in Allen Arena on Sept. 24, 2002 against Tennessee State, Lipscomb has won double digits eight times, with 12 being the most in a season (2009, 2011, 2023).

As the program is seeking to win its 200th match, the 100th victory came on Nov. 1, 2014, with a four-set win against Florida Gulf Coast.

STUDENT-athletes

For the 16th time in program history, the Bisons have achieved the AVCA Team Academic Award, which is given to teams who achieved a 3.3 GPA for the 2024-25 academic year.

With a fall GPA of 3.67 and a spring GPA of 3.52, the program was also recognized on the AVCA Honor Roll, recognizing the top 20% of GPAs in Division I.

LAUREN DEATON ADDED TO COACHING STAFF

Former All-American Lauren Deaton joined the LUV staff in February as an assistant coach.

Deaton joins the volleyball program after spending the 2024 season as assistant coach at ASUN foe North Alabama, where the Lions qualified for the ASUN Championship.

She also served alongside the beach volleyball program as an assistant as well.

Deaton began her coaching career at Houston, where she served as a graduate assistant in 2023.

A five-year letterwinner at Samford (2018-22), she is the Bulldogs program leader in career kills (1,836) and career attacks (5,551) and ranks fourth in program history in career digs (1,574).

Winning 88 matches during her career as a Bulldog, she was a part of four Southern Conference Tournament Championships and also four appearances in the NCAA Championship.

Named the Freshman of the Year in the league during the 2018 campaign, she was a five-time All-SoCon selection, including two First Teams in 2019 and 2020-21. During the spring 2020-21 season, she was named the SoCon Player of the Year and an Honorable Mention All-American by the AVCA.

EXPECT ANOTHER NO. 100 IN RPI

With Lipscomb playing three opponents in the top-11 of the preseason AVCA poll, the Bisons are expected to be a top-100 in the rating performance index for another year.

Since 2009, the Bisons have finished 100th or better 13 times in the RPI, and the high rankings have helped the Bisons earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament.

This worked in favor for the Bisons during the 2014 season. Despite losing in the finals to Jacksonville, their rating of 39 that season earned them an at-large to the national championship.

ROSENTHAL EYEING MILESTONE IN VOLUNTEER STATE

During the ASUN Championship last November, head coach Brandon Rosenthal secured his 400th career victory in the quarterfinals with a straight-set dub against the Lions.

As he begins his 23rd season at the helm of the Bisons, Rosenthal is the all-time winningest coach in the Atlantic Sun Conference by a wide margin. The second winningest coach is one who recently left the ASUN in Matt Botsford (2007-24), who totaled 263 at Florida Gulf Coast before being named the leading man at Central Florida this past winter.

He becomes the 98th coach across all three divisions to win 400 matches at one school.

However, he is closing in on a milestone when it comes to head women's volleyball coaches in the State of Tennessee.

Among Division I schools, Rosenthal is seven wins away from tying Rob Patrick's 409 victories when he led Tennessee from 1997-2017.

More impressively, the Bisons had two undefeated conference seasons in 2009 and 2010.

In the ASUN postseason, LUV has garnered seven titles (2007-09-10-11-15-16-20).

Sophia Hudepohl is looking to be one of two players in Lipscomb's Division I history with 4,000 assists.

In the first weekend of the season, she became the third player all-time to secure 3,500 assists, and she is within striking distance of Megan Elmore's 3,604 from 2016-19.

Last season against Jacksonville, Hudepohl became the fifth all-time to 3,000 assists.

She'll look to catch Jake Pease's 5,159 from 2007-10. However, NCAA volleyball played to a 30-point set until 2007. Since 2008, it has been played to 25 points. For Pease, she had 1,448 in her first season (2007), when set scores went to 30.

Brandon Rosenthal enters his 23rd season as the head coach of the Lipscomb volleyball program, and he wants to leave a legacy that will not soon be forgotten. In other words, he's not going anywhere anytime soon.

After spending part of the 2001 and 2002 seasons as an assistant coach, Rosenthal was elevated to lead the Bisons on June 23, 2003. 22 seasons later, he picked up his 400th win as head coach on Nov. 21, 2024 in the quarterfinals of the ASUN Tournament against North Alabama.

Entering the 2025 campaign with 401 wins, he is the winningest coach of the Lipscomb volleyball program and in the Atlantic Sun Conference. Inside the State of Tennessee, he is second all-time among active Division I schools in wins.

After recording losing seasons in his first few years, he elevated the program to 18 straight winning seasons, including hitting double digits 20 times, 17 seasons of 15 or more wins and 10 campaigns of 20 wins or more. In 2009, the program was one of six teams that entered the NCAA Championship with more than 28 wins in a season.

The five-time ASUN Coach of the Year has the most conference wins since the league started conference play in 1993 with a 241-71 record. The program had unbeaten conference seasons in 2009 and 2010 and won 44 consecutive league matches from Nov. 1, 2008 to Oct. 25, 2011.

He has led the Bisons to 20 consecutive ASUN Tournament appearances (since 2005), and his programs have made 12 championship match appearances with seven titles. His teams hold a 30-13 record in the postseason championship.

Individually, he has coached nine ASUN Player of the Year winners, two Setters of the Year, two Liberos of the Year and two Freshman of the Year selections. He has been a part of 56 All-Conference honors, including 29 to the All-ASUN First Team.

Nationally, Rosenthal has led his teams to eight NCAA Tournament appearances, and his program has been a staple in the Rating Percentage Index. Since 2009, the Bisons have been in the top-100 in the RPI 13 times.

Rosenthal has coached nine American Volleyball Coaches Association All-Americans. Along with 20 All-Region honorees and two Freshmen of the Year accolades, his peers honored him as the AVCA South Region Coach of the Year in 2014.

Born in Burbank, California, Rosenthal got his first taste of volleyball on the west coast. When his family moved to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, he spearheaded a drive to add volleyball to the varsity programs at his high school.

His west coast roots led him back to the "Golden State" for college, where he continued his love for the game by playing club volleyball at Pepperdine University in Malibu, California. Rosenthal earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from Pepperdine in 1998. In 2003, he added a Master of Business Administration from Lipscomb.

Rosenthal and his wife, Kate, live in Nashville. They have a daughter, Jake, and a son, Jack.

Although Rosenthal has lived in several parts of the United States, he calls Lipscomb and Nashville home.
