FIRST SERVE

The first conference road swing of the weekend is on deck for the Oklahoma volleyball team. The Sooners will travel to Nashville, Tenn., on Friday for the first-ever match between OU and Vanderbilt. The match is slated for a 7 p.m. start. OU travels to Columbia, Mo., for the first time since 2011 to face No. 21 Missouri on Sunday at 2 p.m. Both matches will air on SEC Network+.

WEEKEND REWIND

Conference action is in full swing and the Sooners are 1-1 after opening weekend. OU got off to a hot start, sweeping LSU on Sept. 26 to open conference play with a win for the first time since 2019. A balanced attack helped OU to the sweep as the team recorded 30 kills, 30 digs and 9.5 blocks on the night.

In a tough five-set battle with Ole Miss on Sept. 28, the Sooners faltered despite impressive performances from Alexis Shelton and Kelli Jo Burgess. Shelton recorded just the second double-double of the season for any Sooner with 17 kills and 13 digs in the loss. Burgess tied her career high for the fifth time with 8.0 blocks to go with 10 kills.

THE KELLI JO SHOW

Redshirt junior Kelli Jo Burgess is quietly having the best season of her career. In 2024, Burgess tallied 78 kills in 21 matches and just one match with more than 10 kills. This season, Burgess has 91 kills and four double-digit performances. The Lehi, Utah, native, hit .238 in 2024 and is hitting .442 on 165 attempts this season.

Burgess has six games with a hitting percentage over .500 and eight games over .350. If she can keep up her current pace and reach a minimum of 200 attempts, Burgess could set the OU single-season record for hitting percentage. Burgess is currently No. 14 in the nation in hitting percentage and third in the SEC.

On the defensive side, Burgess has tallied 54.0 blocks through 12 games, putting her ahead of her output through 12 games from a season ago. Her 8.0 blocks against Saint Mary's on Sept. 13 and Ole Miss on Sept. 26 tied her career high set in 2024. Burgess is the current leader in blocks, averaging 1.17 per set.

ACES ARE HIGH

On Sunday, Sept. 21, the Sooners set a program record with 14 aces in a five-set match. Nine of the 14 came in the first set alone as Harper Hall recorded five in a row. The previous record in a five-set match was 13 in 2014 against CSUN. Fourteen aces are the most recorded in an OU match of any length in the 25-point rally scoring era.

IN THE RECORD BOOKS

On Sept. 18, Kamille Gibson added her name to the record books as she recorded five aces against Central Arkansas in a three-set victory. Gibson is now the fourth Sooner to tally five aces in a three-set match in the 25-point rally scoring era.

Alexis Shelton climbed into the top 10 in career kills as she currently sits at 1,250. The senior is now No. 10 all-time and needs 51 to take over the next spot. The senior is currently 503 kills away from the top five, but only 170 from top six. With an average of 3.47 kills/set, Lex is on pace to break the top six by seasons end.

SET IT UP

Freshman Avaya Maga has made an immediate impact at setter for the Sooners, notching eight 20-plus assist games on the year, and one 30-plus assist game. Maga tallied a season and career high 31 assists against FSU on Sept. 10 and currently has 275 on the season. Sophomore Harper Hall has been sharing the duties at setter and has notched 20 assists in five games this season, including a season high 24. Hall has tallied 210 assists on the year.

TERRIFIC TEKOA

Freshmen Tekoa Barnes had a breakout match against St. Mary's on Sept. 12, recording an impressive .524 hitting percentage with a career high 14 kills. The Boynton Beach, Fla., native broke double-digit kills for the first time in her career and tallied the second highest hitting percentage on the team in the game. Against Central Arkansas on Sept. 21, Barnes had her second double-digit kill match of the year with 11 kills.

E-MONEY

Emoni Bush had arguably the best outing of her career on Sept. 13, hitting an incredible .800 in a three-set victory over St. Mary's. Bush had the first 20-kill game

of her career and recorded zero errors on 25 swings. The graduate is the only Sooner in the 25-point rally scoring era (2008-present) to hit .800 with a minimum of 20 attempts. She is the sixth Sooner to record a .800 or higher hitting percentage with a minimum of 10 attempts and the only outside hitter to do so. Bush now leads the nation in single game hitting percentage (minimum 20 attempts).

Over the three-game week, Bush recorded two matches over .400 and now has four such on the season. She also tallied double-digit kills in all three matches and has double-digits in seven of eight matches and five straight. Bush recorded a team best hitting percentage of .477.

ALL EYES ON ALEXIS

Senior Alexis Shelton was named to the preseason watch list for the AVCA's 2025 Division I Player of the Year Award, presented by Nike Volleyball.

A 2024 third-team All-American, Shelton had a breakout junior season as she led the team with 455 kills and 4.38 kills/set. Dating back to 2022, Shelton has recorded double-digit kills in 40 of her last 42 matches.

Shelton reached the 1,000-kill mark in 2024, the 15th Sooner to achieve the feat. Her 1,271 career kills are good for 10th all-time. She is just 29 kills away from becoming just the 10th Sooner to reach 1,300 kills and move in to ninth place all-time

The list will be narrowed down to semifinalists in November, after a midseason addition in October. The names of the finalists will be released in December, with the AVCA Player of the Year announcement occurring on Dec. 19 at the ACA Awards Banquet in Kansas City.

HOT START

The Sooners 8-2 start to the 2025 season was one of their best starts since 1997. This is the sixth time since 1996 that an OU squad has finished non-conference play with two or fewer losses and the seventh time with a winning percentage of .800 or higher in non-conference action. OU has gone 8-1 through its first nine games five times since 1996.

SERIES HISTORY

VANDERBILT: 2025 marks the first meeting between the Commodores and the Sooners. Vanderbilt is in its first season of competition after a 45-year hiatus.

MISSOURI: The Tigers and Sooners are no strangers to each other after years in the Big 12 Conference. OU leads the current series 40-33, though Missouri has won the last two meetings in 2024 and 2011. The Sooners last won in Columbia in 2010.

LOOKING AHEAD

The Sooners return to McCasland Field House for a pair of conference battles with Georgia on Friday, Oct. 10 and South Carolina on Sunday, Oct. 12. The Bulldogs will be making their first trip to Norman since 1986, while the Gamecocks will be returning for the first time since 1998.

OKLAHOMA HEAD COACH AARON MANSFIELD

- Aaron Mansfield enters his third season as Oklahoma head volleyball coach in 2025.
- In his second season with the Sooners, Mansfield led the Sooners to their first NCAA Tournament since 2019 and their first NCAA tournament victory since 2013.



- Under Mansfield, Alexis Shelton became the first All-American since 2018 and first to be named to a team other than honorable mention since 2013.
- Shelton, Lydia Martyn and Kari Geissberger were named to the All-SEC and AVCA All-Central Region teams, marking the most all-region selections since 2019.
- In his first season with the Sooners, Mansfield recorded an 11-17 record, while helping Alexis Shelton to All-Big 12 honors.
- Before his time with the Sooners he was the Loyola Marymount head coach for six seasons, leading the Lions to a 94-68 (.580) record and taking them to a pair of NCAA Tournaments. While at LMU, he was an assistant coach for the women's beach volleyball program from 2017-19.
- Prior to his time in Los Angeles, Mansfield spent five seasons on Santa Clara's staff, the last three as associate head coach of the indoor team and head coach of its sand team. The Broncos made three NCAA Tournament appearances (2012, 2014 and 2015).
- Mansfield served as an assistant on the UC Santa Barbara men's volleyball staff for five seasons and as a volunteer assistant on the women's staff one season.
